Cincinnati vs. TCU

Nov. 29, 2025 | Amon G. Carter Stadium

Team Notes

- Cincinnati's all-time record now stands at 674-620-50.
- This marked the fifth all-time series between the teams, all taking place as Conference USA and Big 12 rivals.
- There was a one-hour, 33-minute storm delay midway through the first quarter.
- Cincinnati had four captains pre-game: redshirt senior defensive lineman Dontay Corleone, redshirt senior offensive lineman Gavin Gerhardt, redshirt junior quarterback Brendan Sorsby, and redshirt senior cornerback Logan Wilson.

Offensive Notes

- Gavin Gerhardt made his 48th start, surpassing Deyshawn Bond (2013-16) for the most by a center in school history. That number is seventh all-time in the program.
- Brendan Sorsby's three touchdown passes pulled him within one of Desmond Ridder (37) for the most combined TDs in single-season program history.
 - Sorsby's 27 TD strikes are in sole possession of fifth.
 - Ridder had 30 passing scores, six rushing and one receiving in the 2021 CFP season.
- Sorsby's +22 TD/INT margin is now second only to Tony Pike's +23 in 2009.
- Sorsby has accounted for two or more touchdowns in all 12 games this season, which entering the week marked the third-longest active streak among FBS quarterbacks.
- It was also his fourth game of 3-plus passing TDs this season.
- Sorsby's 41-yard rush in the fourth quarter matched a career-long (2024 at Iowa State).
- Evan Pryor's 26-yard touchdown catch in the first quarter was his first scoring grab of the season, as well as a season-long.
- Jeff Caldwell's 14-yard touchdown catch was his third-straight game with a score, in addition to his sixth TD of the year.

- Cyrus Allen's touchdown reception in the fourth quarter was his 12th, tying him for second in school history with Jim O'Brien (1968) and one off Marcus Barnett's 13 in 2007.

Defensive Notes

- Montay Weedon collected his first two-career sacks; the first came in the first quarter and the other on an intentional grounding on a trick-play in the third.
- Matthew McDoom's eight tackles matched his season-high and led the Bearcats.
- Jiquan Sanks' forced fumble at the TCU 2 was his first of the season and second of his two-year career.

Special Teams Notes

- Max Fletcher had his 17th punt inside the 20 this year, upping his donations to Cincinnati's Save the Animals Foundation to \$340.
