2:11	Three Big I2 teams are ranked in the top I5 of the AP Top 25 Women's College Basketball Poll TCU is No. 9, Iowa State is No. IO, Baylor is No. I5. Oklahoma State, Texas Tech and Arizona
	State received votes

- The league has six teams inside the top 30 of the NET rankings released Dec. I5. TCU is No. 8, lowa State is No. I3, West Virginia is No. 21, Texas Tech is No. 25, Oklahoma State is No. 26 and Baylor is No. 28. The Big I2 joins the Big Ten and SEC as the only leagues with at least six teams in the top 30.
- League play tips off this week with eight Conference matchups, including Kansas taking on No. 10 lowa State on ESPN2 Sunday at Noon CT.
- The Big I2 has had three teams start I2-0 this season, while the rest of Division I has combined for two such starts entering the week.
- The Conference is a combined 46-22 (.676) in away and neutral-site games through six weeks, the second-highest win percentage among all DI conferences.
- The league ranks second among Power Four leagues in total record against P4 opponents after six weeks (19-14, .576). The Conference is 8-4 against the ACC and 6-4 versus the Big Ten.
- The Big I2 has had five different teams defeat an AP Top 25 opponent this season. That is tied for second most among all DI conferences going into the seventh week of the year.
- Iowa State's Addy Brown (player) and BYU's Olivia Hamlin (freshman) acquired weekly Big I2 women's basketball hardware for the sixth week of the 2025-26 campaign. ISU's Audi Crooks, TCU's Olivia Miles and Utah's Lani White joined the pair on the Big I2 Starting Five, which highlights strong performances from around the league.
- Brown recorded back-to-back 20-point games to help the IOth-ranked Cyclones pick up wins over in-state opponents, then-No. II lowa and Northern lowa. The forward from Derby, Kansas finished the week shooting nearly 55% from the floor while posting two double-doubles.
- Hamlin was an anchor for BYU during the week as the freshman led the Cougars to two wins, completing an II-I non-conference record. The guard from Santa Clara, Utah led her team with 2I points per game on 50% shooting with 3.0 steals and 2.0 assists per game in victories over Idaho State and UTEP.
- Crooks posted 30 points and I0 rebounds in ISU's takedown of the Hawkeyes. Miles is one of three players in Big I2 history to post multiple triple-doubles in the same season after putting up I5 points, II rebounds and I0 assists against Jacksonville. White went I2-for-I2 from three during the week, including a 7-for-7 performance against Northwestern while averaging 24.5 points over the two games. White is the only player nationally so far this season to make at least seven 3-pointers while shooting I00% from three in a single game and her seven made 3-pointers without missing is tied for the second-most in league history.
- Entering the week, TCU is II-O while allowing opponents to have a 28.7 field-goal percentage and 23.2 three-point percentage this season. The only other DI teams this century to start II-O while holding their opponents to such shooting marks or lower are South Carolina (2022-23) and UConn (2007-08).
- lowa State's Audi Crooks has recorded at least 30 points and a 65.0 field goal percentage in three straight games going into week seven. That is tied for the longest streak by any DI player (men's or women's) this century, along with Baylor's Brittney Griner (March 2013).
- At Big I2 Basketball Media Days presented by New Era, the Conference announced a leaguewide women's basketball documentary. The series puts a never-before-seen spotlight on the Conference's coaches and players heading into the season. All three episodes are available now on the league's official YouTube channel.

- All-session and Weekend Pass tickets for the 2026 Phillips 66 Big I2 Women's Basketball Tournament are now on sale. The premier postseason event returns to Kansas City's T-Mobile Center for the third consecutive season. The Tournament will begin Wednesday, March 4, with the championship game slated for Sunday, March 8, unless BYU advances to the final, in which case the game will be moved to Monday, March 9. Tickets are available on BigI2Sports.com.
- BYU's Sydney Benally and Olivia Hamlin are the only DI true freshmen duo to each have at least 100 points and 20 steals through six weeks this season.
- Texas Tech's Jalynn Bristow is the eighth Big I2 player this century to have at least 90 rebounds, 20 steals and 20 blocks through I2 games of a season. She is the only one in that group whose team started I2-0.
- Iowa State's Audi Crooks has scored at least IO points in 78 straight games entering the week, the longest active streak in Division I. It is the longest run by a Big I2 player since Baylor's Brittney Griner had a II6-game stretch from March 2010 to March 2013. She also leads the nation in points per game entering week six (27.6).
- The Conference has two teams in the top three nationally after six weeks in field goal percentage defense with TCU (No. 1, 28.7%) and Texas Tech (No. 3, 31.2%). The league also has multiple teams in the top three nationwide for 3-pointers per game with Oklahoma State at No. 2 (II.2) and the Horned Frogs at No. 3 (I0.8).
- BU's Taliah Scott and KU's S'Mya Nichols are tied for the national lead in made free throws with 84 entering the week while WVU's Gia Cooke ranks fifth with 69.
- Crooks leads the country in points per game (27.8) while TCU leads the nation in scoring defense (48.5) entering week seven.
- Arizona State is 4-0 in road games in 2025-26, with wins over San Diego, Santa Clara, Penn State and Oregon State. It was 9-41 (.180) the previous five seasons. ASU's four road wins matches the most since 2020-21, while the 2019-20 team went 5-6.
- Baylor's Jana Van Gytenbeek had a triple-double against Alabama State with IO points, IO rebounds and I3 assists. It is the first time the league has had four triple-doubles in a single season since 2010-II (5).
- BYU heads into conference play with an II-I or better record for just the fourth time in program history.
- UCF's Sytia Messer earned her IOOth career win in the victory over Morgan State.
- The lowa State lowa matchup was the most-watched women's Jimmy V Classic Game ever with I.OM viewers, was ESPN's 2nd most-watched Nov./Dec. game ever and was the most-watched NCAA women's basketball game across all networks so far this season.
- ISU's Jada Williams' I2 assists against No. II lowa are the most nationally in a victory over a top 25 team entering week seven.
- West Virginia took a 57-49 win over then-No. I5 Duke with just five available WVU players in the second half. The 49 points mark the fewest points a team has given up against a top 25 team entering the fourth week of the year.
- The opening day of the season was the fifth time since 2000-01 that the Big I2 went a perfect 9-0 or better on a single day and it was the first one where each team allowed fewer than 65 points.
- The Big I2 announced a multi-year extension of its long-standing sponsorship with Phillips 66, continuing the brand's role as the title partner of the Phillips 66 Big I2 Men's and Women's Basketball Tournaments. The 2026 Phillips 66 Big I2 Women's Basketball Tournament returns to Kansas City's T-Mobile Center March 4-8/9.
- The Conference's preseason coaches' honors were headlined by Iowa State's Audi Crooks (Player), TCU's Olivia Miles (Newcomer) and Cincinnati's Dee Alexander (Freshman).
- TCU was selected as the favorite in the league's preseason coaches' poll for the first time in program history. The Horned Frogs swept the regular season and postseason Big I2 titles during the 2024-25 campaign and advanced to the Elite Eight for the first time in school history.
- The Horned Frogs were also the top pick in the Big I2 media preseason poll, which was voted on by Big I2 and national media members. A full listing of preseason honors can be found on Page 2.
- The Big I2 Conference, in partnership with ESPN and FOX Sports, announced its women's basketball linear television schedule for the 2025-26 season, the most games picked up for national broadcast from the league's television package in seven years. A total of 20 league-controlled selections will be showcased by the Conference's broadcast partners throughout the season, plus other marquee matchups at neutral sites.
- Four league teams have new head coaches entering the 2025-26 season: Arizona Becky Burke, Arizona State Molly Miller, BYU Lee Cummard, Houston Matthew Mitchell.
- Iowa State's Crooks and TCU's Miles helped Team USA capture the 2025 FIBA Americup title, as the Big 12 further solidified its reputation as a global leader in women's basketball. More than 20 student-athletes from the Big 12 competed in international events across the globe this summer.
- Crooks and Miles were also named to ESPN.com's Top 25 women's NCAA basketball players entering the season. The Big I2 was one of two leagues to have multiple teams with at least one player in the top IO. A full listing of preseason national honors can be found on Page 6
- The Big I2 has had at least seven teams make the NCAA Tournament in each of the last two seasons, while the league has had four straight seasons with at least six Conference teams making March Madness. Four of the last five NCAA tournaments have featured multiple Big I2 teams in the Sweet I6.
- In 2024-25, the Big I2 led the nation with a .743 home winning percentage (200-69) and was one of three conferences to have over I million in total attendance for the season. The Big I2 had five teams win at least 25 games last season, tied for the most among all DI conferences.
