**CINCINNATI 89, LIPSCOMB 62**

**ATTENDANCE: 9,793**

### Team and Series Records

- Cincinnati improved to 8-5 on the year, while Lipscomb dropped to 7-6.
- The game was the fourth in the all-time series between the Bearcats and Bisons, with Cincinnati winning all four.

### Team Notes

- UC held a 19-7 advantage in points off turnovers, a 46-20 edge in points in the paint and a 17-4 lead in fast-break points.
- The game marked the eighth time this season Cincinnati limited its opponent to less than 40% shooting from the field. The Bearcats are 7-1 in those games.
- The game was the ninth time the Bearcats have scored at least 70 points. Cincinnati is 8-1 in those games.
- Cincinnati improved to 8-1 on the year in games played at Fifth Third Arena.

### Player Notes

#### *Jizzle James*

- James scored 16 points for his third double-figure scoring game of the year and 44th of his career.
- James' five assists marked a season high.

#### *Kerr Kriisa*

- With 15 points, Kriisa notched the 50th double-figure scoring game of his career and third of the season.

#### *Baba Miller*

- Miller pulled down career highs in offensive (six), defensive (15) and total rebounds (21)
  - o The total marked the most rebounds for a Bearcat since Tre Scott grabbed 21 in double-overtime contest vs. UCF Feb. 19, 2020
  - o It also tied Scott for the second-most boards by UC player dating back to the 1996-97 season. Kenyon Martin grabbed 23 vs. DePaul Feb. 21, 1998.
  - o First 20-rebound game by a Big 12 player this season

- With 11 points, 21 rebounds and seven assists, Miller became just the 16th player in all of college basketball – and third from a power conference school – to go for at least 10 points, 20 rebounds and seven assists in a game dating back to the 1996-97 season.
- Miller dished out a season-high seven assists.
- The game marked his eighth double-figure scoring game of the year and 39th of his career.

#### *Moustapha Thiam*

- Thiam notched his eighth double-figure scoring game of the year and 26th of his career, pouring in 18 points.
- The 18 points tied a season and career high.

#### **Cincinnati Head Coach Wes Miller**

- Cincinnati head coach Wes Miller improved his career record to 275-199 and 90-64 at the helm of the Bearcats.
- He evened his career record against Lipscomb at 1-1.
