### A DIFFERENT LEAGUE



Four Big 12 teams are ranked in the AP Top 25 Women's College Basketball Poll, all coming within the top 20. Baylor is No. 12, Texas Tech is No. 16, TCU is No. 17 and West Virginia is No. 19. Iowa State received votes. The Conference joins the Big Ten and SEC as the only three leagues to have at least four ranked teams.



The Week 15 slate features four national broadcasts, including two top-25 showdowns critical to the Big 12 regular-season title race.



On Thursday, No. 17 TCU heads to Waco for a rematch of last year's Big 12 Tournament final with No. 12 Baylor on ESPN at 6 p.m. CT. Sunday will see Iowa State host K-State at 1 p.m. CT on ESPN before the Horned Frogs welcome No. 19 West Virginia for a prime-time feature on FSI at 7 p.m. CT. On Presidents Day, Utah takes on Oklahoma State at 1 p.m. CT on FOX.



The league has 12 teams inside the top 60 of the NET rankings released on Feb. 9. TCU is No. 13, West Virginia is No. 22, Baylor is No. 26, Texas Tech is No. 27, Oklahoma State is No. 29, Iowa State is No. 32, Colorado is No. 45, Utah is No. 48, Arizona State is No. 49, Kansas is No. 50, BYU is No. 57 and K-State is No. 60.



Entering the week, 50% of the league is within three games of first place in the league standings, the highest percentage among major conferences.



The Big 12 has had three teams win at least 21 of their first 25 games this season (Baylor, TCU, Texas Tech). That is tied for the league's most this century.



The Conference has four teams this season with one or fewer road losses (Baylor, Texas Tech, Utah, West Virginia). That is the most of any DI conference in 2025-26.



The league has three different players averaging at least 20 points and five rebounds per game in Conference play (Audi Crooks, Jaliya Davis, Olivia Miles). That is the Conference's third most in any season this century, behind 2020-21 and 2021-22 (both four).



Ten Big 12 teams are currently at .500 or better in league play. Of Big 12 teams that have historically been .500 or better in regular-season conference play, 89.2% (157/176) have made the NCAA Tournament, including 102 of 110 (92.7%) since the 2006-07 season.



The Conference enters the week tied for the second-best combined winning percentage in Quad I and Quad 2 games of any conference (.400).



Entering the week, every Big 12 school has faced at least two ranked opponents this season. The Big Ten and the SEC are the only other DI conferences to do that in 2025-26.



The Conference is one of three leagues nationally to have at least eight teams within the top 40 of Wins Above Bubble and one of three to have a lowest average NET ranking by conference under 65 entering week 15.



The Big 12 joins the Big Ten and SEC as the only three Division I conferences with a non-conference winning percentage of at least .800 this season. No other league outside of those three has a non-conference winning percentage above .700 as of Feb. 9.



TCU's Olivia Miles (player) and Kansas' Jaliya Davis (freshman) collected Big 12 women's basketball hardware for the 14th week of the 2025-26 campaign. Davis joins former K-State player Ayoka Lee (2019-20 season) as the only two players in league history to win the league's Freshman of the Week honor six consecutive weeks. Davis was named a Tamika Catchings Co-National Freshman of the Week by the USBWA.



Davis leads all freshmen nationally in scoring in conference games with 22.9 points per game.



At Big 12 Basketball Media Days presented by New Era, the Conference announced a league-wide women's basketball documentary. Miles averaged 28 points during the week, including scoring a career-high 31 points in TCU's road contest against Colorado. The guard from Phillipsburg, New Jersey led all scorers with 25 points in TCU's victory over Houston to start the week. Miles shot 64.5% from the field during the two games and 91.7% from the free-throw line.



Davis led the Jayhawks to a 2-0 record by scoring 28 points in both games against BYU and Cincinnati. The forward from Overland Park, Kansas recorded her first career double-double by adding a career-high 12 rebounds in the win over the Cougars. Davis pulled down eight rebounds against the Bearcats to average a double-double for the week with 10.0 rebounds per game. Davis is the only freshman to have four 28+ point performances in conference games nationally so far this season.



Baylor's Taliah Scott, Colorado's Jade Masogayo and West Virginia's Jordan Harrison join the award winners on the Big 12 Starting Five, which highlights strong performances from around the league.



Scott averaged 21.5 points while guiding Baylor to two victories during the week. Masogayo had a career-high of 23 points, including a game-winning and-one free throw to take an 80-79 victory over then-No. 14 TCU. Harrison recorded a career-high eight steals against Arizona and started the week with six against Colorado, while also scoring double-figures in both WVU victories.



Iowa State is the first Big 12 WBB team since at least 1999-00 to lose five straight games and then win five straight games immediately after.



The Big 12 has an 18.4 average scoring margin in non-conference games this season. That ranks third in Division I behind the SEC (27.1) and Big Ten (22.5), but ahead of the ACC (13.9) and Big East (10.7).



Baylor is one of two DI programs that have won at least 20 games in all 26 seasons since 2000-01 (UConn).



Kansas is averaging 4,011 fans per game this season, just under 100 fans per game away from the school record average of 4,109 fans during the 2008-09 season.



West Virginia's Jordan Harrison has recorded at least five steals and 14 points in four straight games. That is the longest streak by any Big 12 player this century.



This marks the fourth straight season WVU has reached the 10 win mark in league play.



The Big 12 has three teams inside the top 10 of Nielsen's Top 10 most-watched teams of the year (No. 1 Iowa State, No. 5 Oklahoma State, No. 10 Baylor) through Jan. 18. The Conference is one of two leagues to have at least three teams in the top 10.



The Big 12 is the only conference to have five 40+ point performances by league players so far this season.



Iowa State head coach Bill Fennelly is now the winningest coach for Big 12 league wins with 299. Former Baylor head coach Kim Mulkey ranks second on the list with 296.



ISU's Audi Crooks and TCU's Olivia Miles were named to the 2025-26 Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 Watch List. Both players also earned spots on ESPN's Midseason Top 25. The Big 12 joins the SEC as the only leagues with multiple teams that have players in the top 10. Baylor's Taliah Scott checked in at No. 23.



ISU's Audi Crooks broke the record for the fewest games played to reach 2,000 career points in Big 12 history (89 games). Her 89 games to reach the 2,000 points are the eighth fewest number of games needed to reach the 2,000 mark by any women's DI player whose career began in 1999-00 or later.



ISU's Crooks is the only major conference player averaging at least 23.0 points and 9.0 rebounds per game in conference play. The only Big 12 players this century to finish a campaign of conference play with those marks are NaLyssa Smith (2021-22), Brittney Griner (2012-13) and Courtney Paris (2006-07).



The Big 12 is 8-4 against the ACC and 6-5 versus the Big Ten this season and has the second-best record among Power Four leagues in games against other P4 teams (19-15, .559).



The Conference is tied for the most players with a triple-double (5) by any league in history for a single season. The eight triple-doubles are the most in league history for a single season and tied for the third most all-time (record is 9).



The league joins the Big Ten and SEC as the only leagues to have at least 11 different teams defeat an AP Top 25 opponent this season.



Iowa State's Audi Crooks has scored at least 10 points in 90 straight games entering the week, the longest active streak in Division I. It is the longest run by a Big 12 player since Baylor's Brittney Griner had a 116-game stretch from March 2010 to March 2013. She also leads the nation in points per game entering the week (25.9).



KU's Jaliya Davis is one of four Power Four freshmen with a 30-point game so far this season.



ISU's Audi Crooks and KU's Jaliya Davis are two of the three players nationally averaging at least 20.0 points per game this season while doing so in less than 30 minutes per game entering the week.



Baylor ranks first in the country in 3-point percentage defense (23.2%).



Kansas' Elle Evans (No. 1, 49.6%) and Iowa State's Arianna Jackson (No. 3, 47.0%) rank in the top three nationally for 3-point percentage. KU's S'Mya Nichols (No. 1, 167) and BU's Taliah Scott (No. 3, 146) rank in the top three nationally in made free throws entering the week.



TCU's Olivia Miles and Marta Suarez became the second duo in NCAA history to post triple-doubles in the same game (first against an NCAA Division I Opponent). Miles became the first Big 12 player ever to have three straight triple-doubles and is the third player to do so all-time. The eight triple-doubles are the most in league history for a single season, while the four different players to have a triple-double so far this year are tied for the most in Conference history.



The Iowa State - Iowa matchup was the most-watched women's Jimmy V Classic Game ever, with 1.0M viewers and was ESPN's 2nd most-watched Nov./Dec. game ever.



West Virginia took a 57-49 win over then-No. 15 Duke with just five available WVU players in the second half on Nov. 14. The 49 points are still tied for the second fewest points a team has given up against a top 25 team entering the 15th week of the year.



The Conference's preseason coaches' honors were headlined by Iowa State's Audi Crooks (Player), TCU's Olivia Miles (Newcomer) and Cincinnati's Dee Alexander (Freshman). TCU was selected as the favorite in the league's preseason coaches' poll for the first time in program history. The Horned Frogs swept the regular season and postseason Big 12 titles during the 2024-25 campaign and advanced to the Elite Eight for the first time in school history. The Horned Frogs were also the top pick in the Big 12 media preseason poll, which was voted on by Big 12 and national media members. A full listing of preseason honors can be found on Page 2.



The Big 12 Conference, in partnership with ESPN and FOX Sports, announced its women's basketball linear television schedule for the 2025-26 season, the most games picked up for national broadcast from the league's television package in seven years.
