

POST-GAME NOTES: NEW MEXICO 100, BOISE STATE 83

- Starting Lineup: Cherise Beynon, Tesha Buck, N'Dea Fly, Alex Lapeyrolerie, and Jaisa Nunn.
- The Lobos now 7-10 all-time against the Broncos
- UNM is 4-3 against Boise in Dreamstyle Arena -The Pit.

In-Game Notes:

- The Lobos have a 12-game home win streak, eighth longest in program history
- It's the third time this season the Lobos have reached at least 100 points in a game, the first time doing it in a conference game while being a part of the Mountain West (started in 1999) and the first time doing it in a conference game since beating BYU 100-51 Feb. 1, 1996.
- New Mexico had five double-digit scorers: Alex Lapeyrolerie (23 points), Jaisa Nunn (19 points), Cherise Beynon (18 points), Tesha Buck (15 points), and Antonia Anderson (13 points).
 - The last time was on Dec. 10, 2017 against Navy.
- New Mexico had 25 assists vs. Boise State's 15 assists.
- New Mexico led with 31 fast-break points vs. Boise State's 10.
- Leading scorer for the Lobos was Alex Lapeyrolerie, who posted 23 points.
 - She surpassed her previous career high of 22 points and season high of 20 points.
 - She led the Lobos with 13 points at the half.
- Cherise Beynon hit another double-double with 18 points and 15 assists.
 - She tied her own UNM record in assists
- Tesha Buck surpassed her season high of seven rebounds with eight.
- Antonia Anderson contributed 13 points for the Lobos off the bench.
 - She beat her previous career high of nine points and tied her career high of two steals.
