## Post-game Notes:

- Four Lobos finished in double-figures: JaQuan Lyle (16 points, 17th game this season), Vance Jackson (15 points, ninth game this season), Makuach Maluach (11 points, 14th game this season) and Keith McGee (11 points, 10th game this season).
- Jackson accumulated 10 points in the first half to mark the third time this season he has posted double figures in the first half.
  - Jackson's 15 points marks the 31st time in his career at UNM that he has posted double figures.
- Lyle led the Lobos with 16 points to mark the 11th time this season he has led the team in scoring.
- UNM shot 84.6 percent from the line, going 11-for-13.
  - This is the fifth time this season the Lobos have shot 80 percent or better from line.
  - Four Lobos were perfect from the stripe: Jackson (4-for-4), Vante Hendrix (2-for-2), Corey Manigault (1-for-1) and McGee (1-for-1).
- The Lobos shot 32.4 percent from 3-point range, 11-for-34, marking the sixth time this season that UNM has shot 10 or more threes in a game.
  - Five of those games have come in the last nine.
- UNM allowed 13 threes on the night marking the 14<sup>th</sup> time this season that the Lobos have allowed their opponent to score 10 or more from behind the arc.
  - Tuesday night also marks the fifth time in the last seven games that UNM's opponent has hit 10 or more 3-pointers.
