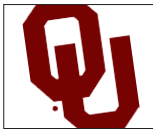

## GAMEDAY STORYLINES

▶ Oklahoma wraps up its home non-conference schedule on Saturday as it hosts undefeated New Mexico at Lloyd Noble Center. The Sooners have won five straight meetings against the Lobos dating back to 2005 and lead the all-time series with New Mexico, 9-2.

▶ Senior guard **Gabbi Ortiz** turned in a career performance against South Florida last Saturday, finishing with a career-high 31 points on 9-of-14 shooting. The senior knocked down eight 3-pointers in the victory, which is tied for the fourth-most in a single game by a Sooner in program history. Heading into Saturday's matchup with New Mexico, Ortiz leads the Big 12 in minutes played (38.1), 3-pointers made per game (3.4) and free throw percentage (.952). The senior's 3.4 3-pointers per game rank 16th in Division I.

▶ Oklahoma is the only school in the Big 12 to have multiple 30-point scoring performances this season: **Gabbi Ortiz** (31 vs. South Florida) and **Vionise Pierre-Louis** (32 at Oregon). Its the first time OU has had two different players with 30-point scoring performance in one year since the 2010-11 season (**Aaryn Ellenberg** and **Danielle Robinson**).

▶ OU's freshmen duo of **Ana Llanusa** and **Shaina Pellington** are two of the top three scorers among Big 12 freshmen. Pellington leads Big 12 freshmen at 12.8 points per game and a .541 field goal percentage. Llanusa has scored in double figures six times in her first nine collegiate games and is third among Big 12 freshmen with 10.8 points per game.

▶ In OU's four wins, getting to the free throw line has been key. The Sooners are averaging 17.3 free throws made per game in each victory this season. Nationally, the Sooners rank 30th in free throw attempts (205) and 33rd in the nation in free throws made (148).

**SATURDAY'S GAME BASICS**

The Sooners host their final home non-conference game of the season as New Mexico visits Lloyd Noble Center on Saturday at 2 p.m. CT. The Lobos enter the game as one of 11 unbeaten teams left in the country at 11-0. OU has won the last five meetings against New Mexico.

Saturday's game will be televised on Fox Sports Oklahoma with **Adam Young, Brenda VanLengen** and **Megan McDonald** on the call. The contest will also air on the Sooner Radio Network with **Brian Brinkley** and **McKenna Treece** calling the action.

**GAME NINE RECAP: SOUTH FLORIDA**

► After trailing by three at halftime, Oklahoma came back to upset No. 16 USF, 79-74, at Lloyd Noble Center. The win was OU's first over a ranked team this season and marked the first victory by the Sooners against a top-25 non-conference foe at home since 2013.

► OU's second-half shooting was the key as the Sooners posted a .750 (18-of-24) clip from the field over the final two quarters. The Sooners trailed USF, 56-53, heading into the third quarter, but used a 17-3 run to secure the lead for good.

► **Gabbi Ortiz** was lights out for Oklahoma as the senior went 8-for-12 from behind the arc and finished with a career-high 31 points on 9-of-14 shooting. In the first half alone, Ortiz had 18 points and all five of Oklahoma's made three-pointers. The senior's eight treys are tied for the fourth most by a Sooner in a single game in school history and just one shy of tying the program record. Ortiz's final 3-pointer of the game put the Sooners in front for good at 68-67 with 4:06 to play.

► **Vionise Pierre-Louis** was almost perfect from the field, finishing with 18 points on 8-of-9 shooting. The senior scored 12 of her 18 points in the second half. **Ana Llanusa** added 15 points and nine rebounds for the Sooners, both career highs. The freshman recorded eight of her 15 points in the final quarter. **Gileysa Penzo** dished a career-high seven assists, while Maddie Manning filled the stat sheet with seven points and six assists.

**PREVIEWING NEW MEXICO**

► New Mexico enters the contest with an 11-0 record after defeating Navy, 94-87, in overtime last Saturday. The Lobos are averaging 88.1 points per game and are shooting .444 from the field, .399 from beyond the arc and .716 at the free throw line. New Mexico ranks fifth in country in turnovers per game (11.1) and turnovers forced (112). The Lobos are sixth in Division I with 174 made free throws.

► Senior guard **Cherise Benyon** leads the Lobos in scoring, averaging 17.9 points per game. The senior also ranks 20th in Division I with 6.2 assists per contest. New Mexico's **Tesha Buck** is one of the country's top 3-point shooters, hitting 35 triples this season and averaging 15.8 points a game. **Jaise Dunn** has recorded a double-double in seven of 11 contests for the Lobos, while averaging 14.5 points and 10.5 rebounds per game.

► New Mexico is under the direction of second-year head coach **Mike Bradbury**. Bradbury is 26-15 in his two seasons with the Lobos. He previously served as the head coach at Wright State (2011-16) and Morehead State (2008-10).

**STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE**

► OU is in the middle of a four-game stretch that is arguably the toughest slate that a team will face to close the month of December. After defeating No. 16/16 South Florida, OU will take on undefeated New Mexico (11-0) this Saturday. OU wraps up its non-conference schedule at No. 1/1 Connecticut on Dec. 19 before opening its Big 12 slate on Dec. 28 at home against No. 8/8 Texas.

**ORTIZ MOVING UP THE CHARTS**

- ▶ The transition from moving to off the ball from point guard seems to be paying off for senior **Gabbi Ortiz**. Ortiz is averaging a career-best 12.8 points a game, while shooting .425 from beyond the arc. The Racine, Wis., native ranks seventh in school history with 162 career triples and needs just three more treys to pass **Whitney Hand** (164, 2009-13) for sixth in the program's record book.
- ▶ Against South Florida, Ortiz had a career day by scoring 31 points on 9-of-14 shooting and knocking down a career-best eight 3-pointers. Ortiz's 31 points were also a career high, while her eight made treys are tied for the fourth-most in a single game by a Sooner in program history.
- ▶ Ortiz also leads the Big 12 in minutes played per game (38.1), free throw percentage (.952) and 3-pointers made per game (3.4).

**O CANADA!**

- ▶ Freshman guard **Shaina Pellington** has provided a spark for OU's offense over the last four games. The freshman is averaging 15.3 points per contest during that time span and has led the Sooners in scoring three times in four contests.
- ▶ Pellington, the fourth Canadian to play for the Sooners, is tied for third on the team in scoring with 12.8 points per game and is shooting .541 from the field. Those numbers also rank first among Big 12 freshmen.

**LLANUSA HITTING HER STRIDE**

- ▶ Freshman guard **Ana Llanusa** has provided the Sooners a consistent scoring option in her first season at Oklahoma. The freshman made her first career start against USF last Saturday and did not disappoint, scoring 15 points and leading the Sooners with nine rebounds.
- ▶ Llanusa has scored in doubles figure six times in nine games. The Choctaw, Okla., native is averaging 10.8 points per game. Llanusa is third in scoring among all Big 12 freshmen.

**CLOSING IN ON 1,000 POINTS**

- ▶ OU's **Maddie Manning**, **Gabbi Ortiz** and **Vionise Pierre-Louis** are all closing in on the 1,000-point mark for their collegiate careers. Pierre-Louis has 954 points, while Manning has scored 952 at OU. Ortiz has 916 career points in 108 career played games and needs 84 points to reach the 1,000-point plateau.
- ▶ Seven players have reached the 1,000-point mark for their OU careers in the last five seasons. Those players are: **Whitney Hand** (2012-13), **Aaryn Ellenberg** (2013-14), **Morgan Hook** (2013-14), **Nicole Griffin** (2013-14) and **Sharane Campbell-Olds** (2014-15), **Kaylon Williams** (2015-16) and **Peyton Little** (2016-17).

**QUICK HITS**

- ▶ Oklahoma is 16-6 all-time against current members of the Mountain West Conference. The Lobos will be the second Mountain West team the Sooners have played this season. OU rolled past Colorado State, 78-46, on Nov. 21 in Fort Collins, Colo.
- ▶ **Gabbi Ortiz's** run of consecutive made free throws came to an end against South Florida. Ortiz's streak ended at 37, which ranks second all-time at OU, after missing her second attempt of the game at foul line against the Bulls. **LaNeisha Caufield's** streak of 38 consecutive free throws made during the 2001-02 season is the program record.
- ▶ The Sooners' victory over South Florida last Saturday gave OU its first win as unranked team over a ranked non-conference opponent on its home floor in school history. It marked the first time the Sooners have defeated a ranked non-conference foe since 2013 when OU topped No. 25 Gonzaga inside Lloyd Noble Center.
- ▶ The Sooners' bench combined to play just 18 minutes against USF, the second lowest total in the **Sherri Coale** era.
- ▶ OU's seven turnovers against Florida were the second fewest in a single game during the **Sherri Coale** era. The Sooners also outscored Florida's bench, 48-0, marking the 16th time that OU has held an opponents' bench from scoring in a single game.
- ▶ Oklahoma's non-conference schedule includes matchups against five NCAA Tournament teams from last season (Belmont, DePaul, Oregon, UConn and South Florida). Nine of the Sooners' 11 non-conference opponents made postseason appearances last year.

**UP NEXT**

- ▶ OU will wrap up its non-conference slate at the Women's Holiday Showcase on Tuesday against No. 1/1 Connecticut in Uncasville, Conn. The game will take place at the Mohegan Sun Arena and be televised on CBS Sports Network.

# LLOYD NOBLE CENTER

## HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

► The Lloyd Noble Center on the campus of the University of Oklahoma in Norman features excellent seating and some of the best college basketball in the nation. Since its opening in 1975, nearly four million fans have come through the LNC doors in anticipation of a Sooner victory.

► A \$17.1 million expansion and renovation project in 2001 added key improvements. A 70,000-square-foot addition to the south side of the facility included two new full-sized practice courts: one for men's basketball and one for women's. The project also enhanced the Lloyd Noble Center for the wide variety of public events it hosts, including graduations, concerts and large meetings.

► Both OU basketball programs also boast new offices, film rooms, training rooms, locker rooms, spa/sauna rooms and a full-sized weight room in the addition.

► Improvements included an expanded LNC parking lot, renovated arena ceiling and a modernization of the electrical systems. At a cost of more than \$3 million, a state-of-the-art four-sided center-hung LED video display, corner-hung display boards and a revamped sound system made their debut during the 2007-08 season.

► In 2015, the OU Board of Regents approved a \$7 million new strength facility for both the men's and women's basketball programs. The facility will be named the Griffin Family Performance Center, in honor of OU men's basketball's great Blake Griffin.
