

NEW MEXICO 92, SAN JOSÉ STATE 60

- Lobos now lead the all-time series 14-1 overall and 8-1 in The Pit against the Spartans

Post-game Notes:

- Four Lobos finished in double figures: redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee (20), junior Corey Manigault (17), senior Anthony Mathis (16) and sophomore Makuach Maluach (14).
- McGee set a new season high scoring 20 points off of seven made field goals and two free throws. He was 4-of-6 from behind the arc, which was the most threes he has made this season.
 - His previous season high came just two games ago vs. San Diego State in which he scored 19 points.
 - McGee has led the Lobos in scoring two of the last three games and a total of three times on the season.
 - McGee has scored in double figures in three of the last four games.
- The Lobos held the Spartans' leading scorer and rebounder, junior Michael Steadman, to eight points and zero rebounds on the night.
 - He entered Wednesday's game averaging 13.1 PPG on the season and 12.7 PPG in Mountain West play. He averaged 8.3 boards on the season and 7.3 in MW games.
 - It is the first time this season that he has not recorded a rebound.
- The Lobos bested their season scoring average (76.0), finishing with 92 points and shooting 50 percent from the floor.
 - The Lobos are now 2-1 when scoring between 90-99 points, 4-1 when shooting 50 percent or better and 10-1 when outshooting their opponents from the floor (5-0 in conference play).
- UNM was down by three, 30-27, with 5:01 left to play in the first half. The Lobos proceeded to go on a 15-2 run to create a 10-point lead heading into the half.
 - During the run: Jackson scored two threes, Bragg and Mathis each hit two free throws, Mathis scored a jumper, Maluach made a free throw, and Manigault made a layup to cap off the run with three seconds left in the half.
- The Lobos began the second half with another 15-2 run from the start of the second half to 16:19 left to play in the game.
 - During the run: Manigault scored three jumpers, McGee made a layup, Maluach scored a three and a layup, and Bragg had a dunk.

- Between 5:10 left in the first half and 16:19 left in the second half, the Lobos went on a 30-7 run that lasted 8:51.
 - During the run, the Lobos were 11-of-13 from the field, shooting 3-for-4 from behind the arc to go along with five free throws.
 - The Lobos tallied three steals during the run, accounting for seven of the 30 total points during the course of the run.
- Three of the Lobos' five wins in conference play have come by a margin of 25 or more points.
- Wednesday's game marked the Lobos' largest margin of victory against Division I opponents this season (32).
