## In-Game Notes:

- New Mexico led the entire way until a three-pointer with 3:31 to go gave UNLV a 47-46 lead. That was part of a 13-1 run as the Lobos missed. The Lobos never led again, getting as close as 68-66 with 4.8 seconds left.
- With 4.4 seconds left, UNLV's Katie Powell missed two free throws, and UNM was able to get the ball to Cherise Beynon, but her desperation 35-footer was off the mark.
- Alex Lapeyrolerie led UNM with 19 points, and she was one of four in double-figures. It was Lapeyrolerie's 14<sup>th</sup> double figure scoring game of the season.
- Tesha Buck moved into seventh on the UNM single-season threepointers list by hitting three, giving her 67 for the season. Next up are Miranda Sanchez (twice) and Katie Montgomery, who are tied for fourth with 74.
- Lapeyrolerie remained ninth on the UNM career three-pointers attempted list with 393. Next up is Abbie Letz in eighth with 409 attempts.
- Jasmine Smith, who made her first career start, hit her first career three-pointer early in the first quarter.
- UNM shot 50.0% from the field in the first half but just 22.2% in the second half, including just 15.4% (2-for-13) in the fourth quarter.
- UNM's 13-game home winning streak, which started at the beginning of the season, ended.

- UNLV has now won four straight in the series.
- Jaisa Nunn recorded her 10<sup>th</sup> double-double of the season with 15 points and 13 rebounds.
