The UNLV men's basketball team will travel to Albuquerque, New Mexico, for its first Mountain West road game of the season as it will face New Mexico on Tuesday, Jan. 8 at 9 p.m. MT/8 p.m. PT at The Pit.

UNLV (8-6, 2-0) is off to its first 2-0 start in conference play in 13 years after home wins against Colorado State last Wednesday (78-76) and Wyoming on Saturday (68-56). Against the Cowboys, freshman forward Joel Ntambwe scored a career-high 31 points and tallied 10 rebounds for his fourth double-double of the season.

UNLV has been led in scoring this year by senior guard Kris Clyburn, who is averaging 12.5 ppg. Ntambwe is close behind at 12.4 ppg, while sophomore guard Amauri Hardy is third at 11.7 ppg. Senior forward Shakur Juiston, who will miss the rest of the season with a knee injury, averaged 10.8 ppg and 8.8 rpg over eight games played. Among active players, sophomore forward Mbacke Diong is the team's leading rebounder (6.6 rpg) and he also leads the team in blocks (second in the MW) with 1.9 bpg. Senior guard Noah Robotham is the Runnin' Rebel assist leader (3.6 apg).

New Mexico (8-6, 2-0) is coming off an 85-58 upset of then-No. 6/5 UNR on Saturday at The Pit. The Lobos opened MW play 65-58 victory at Air Force last Wednesday. UNM is led in scoring by Anthony Mathis' 16.4 ppg. Mathis earned this week's MW Player of the Week award.

Tuesday's game will be televised on ESPN2 with Sam Farber and Richie Schueler calling the action. Jon Sandler, former Runnin' Rebel Robert Smith, and Steve Cofield (sideline reporter) will handle the UNLV radio call, which may be heard live on ESPN Radio 1100 AM and online via the UNLV Gameday App and Tuneln (link at UNLVRebels.com).

THE UNLV RUNNIN' REBELS (8-6, 2-0 MOUNTAIN WEST)

- The 2018-19 season marks the third at UNLV for head coach Marvin Menzies. Prior to coming to UNLV, he spent the previous nine years as head coach at New Mexico State where he compiled a 198-111 (.641) record. His current career record is 237-151 (.611) and he is 39-40 (.494) at UNLV.
• Coming to UNLV was actually a return to Las Vegas for Coach Menzies. He spent a year with the Runnin' Rebels on Lon Kruger's staff in 2004-05 as an assistant coach.
• The Runnin' Rebels opened the season with seven straight games at the Thomas & Mack Center before traveling to Illinois on Dec. 1. UNLV played eight of its first nine games of the season in Las Vegas (BYU was at T-Mobile Arena on the Las Vegas Strip).
• Senior forward Shakur Juiston is UNLV's leading returning scorer from last year's team, but after playing in this season's first eight games, he will miss the rest of the year because of a knee injury. He averaged a double-double with 14.6 points and 10.0 rebounds per game in 2017-18 and shot 63.9 percent from the field, which ranked seventh in the country and No. 5 on the all-time UNLV seasonal chart. He also tallied 15 double-doubles last year, which ranked 20th in the nation. Juiston was named second-team All-Mountain West and second-team All-District 17 (NABC) last year.
• UNLV has two other seniors this season: point guard Noah Robotham, a transfer from Akron, who is from Las Vegas, and guard Kris Clyburn, who is in his third season at UNLV.
• Last year's team won 20 games, which was its highest win total in four years. It also marked a nine-game improvement in the win column from the previous season. Key losses from last year include Mountain West Freshman of the Year Brandon McCoy and seniors Jovan Mooring and Jordan Johnson. All three averaged double figures in scoring.
• This year's team returned seven student-athletes who played last season, which is the most for the program from the previous season in seven years.
• This year's roster has a total of 11 freshmen and sophomores. Junior forward Cheickna Dembele will also miss the rest of this season because of a finger injury. With Juiston and Dembele out, nine of the team's available 12 players are freshmen and sophomores.
• UNLV was picked to finish sixth in this year's Mountain West race by the media in October.
• The Runnin' Rebels are led this season in scoring by Clyburn, who is averaging 12.5 ppg. Freshman forward Joel Ntambwe is right behind at 12.4 ppg, while sophomore guard Amauri Hardy is third at 11.7 ppg. Juiston averaged 10.8 ppg and 8.8 rpg over eight games played. Among active players, sophomore forward Mbacke Diong is the team's leading rebounder (6.6 rpg) and he leads the team in blocks (second in the MW) with 1.9 bpg. Robotham is the team's assist leader (3.6 apg).
• UNLV leads the MW in offensive rebounding (16.3 orpg, 2nd in the country) and blocks (4.6 bpg). The Runnin' Rebels rank second in the league in rebound margin (+9.4, 12th in the country) and rebounds per game (41.9, 14th in the country).
• UNLV had won four straight games from Nov. 13-23, then lost three straight before the overtime win vs. BYU on Dec. 15. With the National Finals Rodeo occupying the Thomas & Mack Center and then the holiday tournament in Hawaii, UNLV went 31 days between home games (Dec. 1 - Jan. 2).

THE NEW MEXICO LOBOS (8-6, 2-0 MOUNTAIN WEST)

- New Mexico upset then-No. 6/5 UNR on Saturday at The Pit, 85-58, handing the Wolf Pack their first loss of the season. The Lobos opened MW play with a 65-58 victory at Air Force.
• UNM has won three straight games and four of its last six.
• Anthony Mathis leads the team in scoring (16.4 ppg), while Vance Jackson (7.1 rpg) is the team's leading rebounder. Drue Drinnon leads the squad in assists (3.1 apg).
• New Mexico is 4-4 at home this year, 4-1 on the road and 0-1 on a neutral court.
• The team is scoring 78.9 ppg, while limiting its opponents to 75.9 ppg. New Mexico ranks 27th in the country in 3-pointers per game with 9.9 (1st in the MW). Mathis is sixth in the nation (1st in the MW) with 3.8 made per contest.
• In Saturday's game, Mathis scored a career-high 27 points. Jackson nearly had a triple-double with 18 points, 10 rebounds and seven assists.
• UNM was 19-15 overall last season, finishing third in the Mountain West with a 12-6 league mark. The Lobos lost in the Mountain West Tournament's championship game to San Diego State to end their season last year.
• Head coach Paul Weir, who was an assistant coach under current UNLV head coach Marvin Menzies at New Mexico State, is in his second season leading the Lobos and has a record of 27-21 (.563) at the school. He is in his third year overall as a head coach with a career mark of 55-27 (.671).
• New Mexico returned just four letterwinners, including one starter from last year's team.
• The Lobos were picked to finish third in this year's MW preseason poll.

SERIES HISTORY

- This will mark the 59th meeting between UNLV and New Mexico in men's basketball.
• UNLV leads the all-time series 33-25.
• New Mexico swept the season series last year with an 85-81 win in Las Vegas and a 91-90 victory in Albuquerque.
• UNLV's last win against New Mexico came at The Pit on Jan. 10, 2017.
• UNLV is 12-14 all-time at New Mexico. The Runnin' Rebels are 3-2 in their last five trips to The Pit.
• UNLV is 351-168 all-time against teams that currently make up the Mountain West.

FIRST 2-0 START IN MW PLAY IN 13 YEARS

UNLV is 2-0 in Mountain West play for the first time since the 2005-06 season, a span of 13 years. The last time UNLV was 3-0 in conference play was during the 1998-99 season as part of the WAC. UNLV has never started MW play 3-0.

THE MARVIN MENZIES ERA AT UNLV

The 2018-19 season marks the third for UNLV under head coach Marvin Menzies. He officially became the 13th full-time head coach in the history of Runnin' Rebel basketball in April of 2016 after returning to Las Vegas after nine years as the head coach at New Mexico State, going 198-111 (.641) with the Aggies. Now in his 12th year overall as a head coach, his career record is 237-151 (.611) and he is 39-40 (.494) leading the Rebels. He led his team to the postseason in each of his last five seasons at NMSU and six of the last seven. He was an assistant coach on Lon Kruger's staff at UNLV in 2004-05.

ROSTER MAKEUP

UNLV returns seven student-athletes who played last season, which is the most for the program from the previous season in seven years. The Runnin' Rebels have been led this year by seniors Shakur Juiston (out for the rest of the season with a knee injury), a second-team All-Mountain West honoree in 2017-18, Noah Robotham, a Las Vegas who transferred from Akron, and Kris Clyburn, who is in his third year at UNLV. The team has welcomed six freshmen this season. In all, the young team has a total of 11 freshmen and sophomores on this year's roster.

"3-POINT GOAL..." - UNLV HOLDS NCAA RECORD

UNLV holds the NCAA record for most consecutive games scoring at least one 3-pointer. Since the 3-point field goal was adopted by the NCAA in 1986-87, UNLV has converted at least one 3-pointer in all 1,053 games played.

NTAMBWE COMING ON STRONG

After not scoring in double figures in each of the season's first seven games, freshman forward Joel Ntambwe has caught fire. He has scored in double figures in each of his last seven games, including a career-high 31 points on Saturday vs. Wyoming. Over the last seven games, he has averaged 19.9 points and 9.6 rebounds per game. With 10 rebounds vs. the Cowboys, he registered his fourth double-double of the season.

HARDY STARTING

Sophomore guard Amauri Hardy was moved into the starting lineup for the first time in his career last Wednesday in the MW opener vs. Colorado State. He again started vs. Wyoming on Saturday and in his two career starts, he has tallied 17 assists with just three turnovers. He recorded a career-high nine assists vs. the Rams.

NTAMBWE EARNS UNLV'S FIRST MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONOR

Freshman forward Joel Ntambwe was named Mountain West Men's Basketball Player of the Week on Dec. 17. It was his first career weekly honor and also the first for a Runnin' Rebel player this season. Originally from Kinshasa, Democratic Republic of the Congo, he scored a career-high 22 points in UNLV's thrilling overtime buzzer-beating victory against BYU on Dec. 15 at T-Mobile Arena. He recorded the first double-double of his career with a game-high-tying 11 rebounds. The win snapped a three-game losing streak for UNLV. Ntambwe sank two free throws with 27 seconds left to send the game into overtime, tied at 83. For the game, he went 6 for 8 (75 percent) from the field, including 3 for 4 (75 percent) from 3-point range. He also made 7 of 8 (87.5 percent) free throws.

ROBOTHAM EARNS OUTSTANDING REBEL OF THE WEEK AWARD

Senior guard Noah Robotham was named the DC Solar Outstanding Rebel of the Week, UNLV announced Dec. 19. The award goes to the student-athlete who turned in the best individual performance during the previous week of competition from Monday through Sunday as voted on by the UNLV Athletic Communications department. Robotham, a local product out of Bishop Gorman High School, delivered the game-winning shot to lift the Runnin' Rebels to a 92-90 overtime victory over BYU at T-Mobile Arena last Saturday. With UNLV trailing 90-89 with under five seconds remaining in overtime, sophomore Amauri Hardy attempted to drive but instead found Robotham on the right wing, who launched a fallaway 3-pointer that hit nothing but net right as the final buzzer sounded, giving UNLV the two-point win. Robotham was one of five Runnin' Rebels to score in double figures, finishing with 12 points in the victory. The buzzer-beater also came in at No. 4 on SportsCenter's Top-10 Plays of the Day.

AT THE THOMAS & MACK CENTER

The 2018-19 season marks the 36th year of Runnin' Rebel basketball in the Thomas & Mack Center. UNLV has posted an all-time record of 484-121 (.800) in the arena since it opened in 1983.

OUT-REBOUNDERS

UNLV has out-rebounded each of its first 14 opponents this season. UNLV ranks second in the country in offensive rebounds per game (16.3) and 12th in rebound margin (+9.4 per game). The Runnin' Rebels also are 14th in the country in rebounds per game (41.9).

FROM THE FREE-THROW LINE

Prior to the game at Illinois, senior guard Kris Clyburn had made 20 of his 21 free-throw attempts (95.2 percent). He is currently 41 of 51 on free throws for the season for 80.4 percent, which ranks seventh in the MW. UNLV freshman forward Joel Ntambwe is currently the team leader in free throws at 83.9 percent (47 of 56), which ranks fifth in the league. UNLV made 20 of 24 free throws (83.3 percent) in its MW opener last Wednesday vs. CSU and sank 76.2 percent (16 of 21) vs. Wyoming.

20 WINS LAST SEASON

In Coach Menzies' second year at the helm of the UNLV program (2017-18), the Runnin' Rebels recorded 20 wins, which was their highest win total in four years. It also marked a nine-game improvement in the win column from the previous season.

MORE ON LAST SEASON

The Runnin' Rebels finished the 2017-18 season with an overall record of 20-13 ... UNLV had four players average double figures in scoring and was led by freshman forward Brandon McCoy's 16.9 points per game ... He also led the team in rebounding at 10.3 rebounds per contest ... Shakur Juiston also averaged a double-double with 14.6 ppg and 10.0 rpg ... Jordan Johnson was the team's assist leader with 6.0 per game ... McCoy was named the Mountain West Freshman of the Year and declared for the NBA Draft ... UNLV led the MW in scoring (83.4 ppg) and rebounding (40.5 rpg), ranking 13th and 10th in the nation, respectively.

GETTING IT DONE IN THE CLASSROOM

The Runnin' Rebels have recorded a collective grade point average of at least 3.0 in three consecutive semesters, which is a first for the program. The team set a GPA record with a 3.17 in the spring of 2018.

MOUNTAIN WEST'S SECOND-BEST RECRUITING CLASS

This year's UNLV men's basketball recruiting class has been ranked as high as No. 2 in the Mountain West.

61ST YEAR OF RUNNIN' REBEL BASKETBALL

The 2018-19 year marks the 61st season of Runnin' Rebel basketball at UNLV. Since the program's inception in 1958-59, the Runnin' Rebels have posted an all-time record of 1,279-559 (.696).

FIFTH-WINNINGEST PROGRAM EVER

With an all-time record of 1,245-543 (.696) against four-year American institutions (entering the 2018-19 season), UNLV ranks as the fifth-winningest program by percentage in NCAA Division I history (min. 25 years in Div. I). The only schools ahead of UNLV are Kentucky, North Carolina, Kansas and Duke.

A WINNING PROGRAM

UNLV has finished the season with a winning percentage above .500, 55 times in its 60-year history.

NBA DRAFT PICKS

UNLV had a total of four NBA Draft picks over a four-year span from 2013-16: Anthony Bennett (No. 1 overall in 2013 by the Cleveland Cavaliers), Rashad Vaughn (No. 17 overall in 2015 by the Milwaukee Bucks), Patrick McCaw (No. 38 overall in 2016 by the Golden State Warriors) and Stephen Zimmerman Jr. (No. 41 overall in 2016 by the Orlando Magic).

RUNNIN' REBELS IN THE NBA

As of October, there were six former Runnin' Rebels on NBA rosters. They were Khem Birch (Orlando Magic), Derrick Jones Jr. (Miami Heat), Patrick McCaw (Golden State Warriors), Brandon McCoy (New Orleans Pelicans), Rashad Vaughn (Dallas Mavericks) and Christian Wood (Milwaukee Bucks). Birch, Jones Jr., McCoy and Wood all went undrafted, while McCaw was a second-round selection in 2016 and Vaughn was picked in the first round in 2015.

NEW VIDEO BOARD IN THE THOMAS & MACK CENTER

As part of a \$5 million, multi-year commitment from Boyd Gaming Corporation – the largest corporate commitment in the history of UNLV Athletics - the Thomas & Mack Center has a brand new larger state-of-the-art center-hung video board.
