### SERIES HISTORY

The Lobos are 48-26 all-time against New Mexico State, including 26-12 at home (22-14 in Las Cruces). UNM is 36-5 against NMSU since 1996, though the Aggies have won four of the last five meetings. The teams split last season with each team winning at home - the Lobos 84-55 in Albuquerque and the Aggies 77-70 in Las Cruces.

### HEADING INTO THE MATCHUP

The Lobos have had a noteworthy week heading into Saturday's matchup, beating No. 16 Marquette 88-87 Monday night for its first victory over a ranked opponent since 2010 and followed it up by setting a school scoring record Wednesday in beating Northern New Mexico 107-66 Wednesday night - both games at Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit.

In Monday's win the Lobos got a career night from Jaisa Nunn as the junior set a Lobo record with 39 points to go along with 13 rebounds. She went 14-for-15 from the field and 11-for-12 from the free-throw line to help her surpass Yvonne McKinnon's UNM record of 35 points set Feb. 19, 1992. On Wednesday, the Lobos saw all 13 players play at least 10 minutes while scoring 107 points, breaking the old school record of 106 set in 1979. Freshman Madi Washington paced four UNM players in double figures with 27 points - the second-most points by a player off the bench and tied for the sixth most points by a freshman in Lobo history.

New Mexico State enters Saturday's contest 1-1 after beating UT-Permian Basin 88-58 at home on Tuesday night - led by Gia Pack's 18 points and seven rebounds. The Aggies opened the season with a home loss to Western Michigan 64-55 on Sunday - a team the Lobos defeated two nights before 88-76 at Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit. Brooke Salas led the Aggies with 15 points and 15 rebounds in the loss.

**NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES****SCOUTING NEW MEXICO STATE**

The Aggies under first-year coach Brooke Atkinson were selected unanimously as the WAC preseason favorites - the third year in a row they were picked to win the conference.

NMSU returns two starters and four letter winners from a 2016-17 season that saw them go 24-7 and qualify for the NCAA Tournament. The returning players include 2016-17 All-WAC first-team member Brooke Salas (also selected to preseason first team) and Zaire Williams, who was named to the WAC preseason second team.

Salas is averaging 11.0 points and 11.0 rebounds through two games this season while Williams is at 6.0 points per contest. Gia Pack leads the team at 12.5 points per game to go along with 8.0 rebounds and 2.5 steals per contest. Monique Mills is also averaging double figures at 11.0.

**BRADBURY CLOSING IN ON WIN NO. 200**

UNM coach Mike Bradbury has had a successful 10-plus seasons as a head coach and now he's closing in on win No. 200 in just his 11th season. The second-year Lobo coach sits at 196 victories and averaged 19.3 victories per season in his first 10 years as a head coach.

**RECORD SCORING NIGHT FOR THE LOBOS**

The Lobos broke a 38-year-old scoring record Wednesday, Nov. 15, when they defeated Northern New Mexico 107-66 - breaking the old record set March 3, 1979, when UNM defeated Northern Arizona 106-81. It's the first time the Lobos have reached 100 points in a game since beating Morgan State 101-22 on Jan. 4, 2005.

**WASHINGTON NEARLY SETS RECORD OFF BENCH VS. NNMC**

UNM freshman Madi Washington came off the bench against Northern New Mexico and scored 27 points during the Lobos' win Wednesday, Nov. 15 - tied for the second-most points off the bench and tied for the sixth-most points for a freshman in UNM history. The UNM record for points off the bench is Jordan Adams who scored 30 against Utah Feb. 3, 2000. The Lobo record for points by a freshman was the previous UNM overall scoring record set by Yvonne McKinnon with 35 points against Adams State on Feb. 19, 1982.

**NUNN BETTER AGAINST NO. 16 MARQUETTE**

Junior post Jaisa Nunn had a night for the ages during the Lobos' 88-87 win over Marquette on Monday, Nov. 13. She set a school-record with 39 points (besting the previous record of 35 by Yvonne McKinnon in 1982) on 14-for-15 shooting from the field (new career high in field goals made) and going 11-for-12 from the free-throw line (New career high in free throw makes and attempts). She also grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds.

**FIRST WIN OVER A RANKED TEAM SINCE 2010**

In the Lobos' 88-87 victory over No. 16 Marquette, it marked the first Lobo win over a ranked team since beating No. 25 SMU March 17, 2010 - a stretch of eight consecutive

losses to ranked teams. It's the highest-ranked opponent the Lobos have defeated since UNM beat No. 16 BYU March 4, 2006.

### BEYNON NAMED MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK

For the first time in her decorated career, senior Cherise Beynon was named Mountain West Player of the Week on Monday, Nov. 13, after nearly putting up a triple-double in the Lobos' season-opening win over Western Michigan. The Las Vegas, Nevada, native had 24 points, nine assists and eight rebounds in the victory. It's just the second time a Lobo has earned the honor in the previous three seasons.

### NICE DEBUT BY BUCK

Senior transfer shined her Lobo debut during an 88-76 win over Western Michigan on Friday, Nov. 10. The Wisconsin-Green Bay transfer racked up 22 points and added five assists in the victory. She was, not surprisingly, deadly accurate from beyond the arc - going 5-for-8 from long distance.

### LOBOS PICKED FOURTH IN MOUNTAIN WEST

The Lobos has been selected to finish in the top third of the Mountain West Conference by the coaches and media as UNM was picked to finish fourth in the conference. The Lobos collected four first-place votes (there were 25 votes total) and 186 points - only behind Boise State (221 points, seven first-place votes), Wyoming (216 points, six first-place votes) and Colorado State (211 points, six first-place votes).

### UNM SWEEPS PRESEASON CONFERENCE AWARDS

The Lobos swept the three preseason Mountain West individual awards with Cherise Beynon named the MW Preseason Player of the Year (as well as to the All-MW Preseason Team), Tesha Buck selected the MW Preseason Newcomer of the Year and N'Dea Flye voted the MW Preseason Freshman of the Year.

### BEYNON CLIMBING CAREER UNM CHARTS IN ... ALMOST EVERYTHING

Cherise Beynon's first three seasons as a Lobo have been spectacular to say the least and the do-it-all guard will continue to climb the Lobo all-time lists this season. The Las Vegas, Nevada, native is in the career top 15 in points (1,217 - 10th), field goals made (458 - seventh), field goals attempted (1,307 - sixth), 3-pointers made (135 - sixth), 3-pointers attempted (461 - sixth),

assists (393 - seventh) and steals (182 - fifth). She's also nearing the top 15 in rebounding (588 - No. 15 is 603) and the top 10 in minutes played (2,878 - No. 10 is at 3,406). She can also become the second UNM basketball player - male or female - to reach the 1,000-point, 500-rebound and 500-assist mark (Mandi Moore finished with 1,057 points, 603 rebounds and 651 assists for the Lobos from 2002-05).

### BEYNON 2016-17 ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICAN

Cherise Beynon was named the second Academic All-American in program history last season as she is one of just five players in the nation to make the CoSIDA Academic All-American First Team list.

### ABOUT THE 2017-18 LOBOS

The 2017-18 University of New Mexico women's basketball team returns key pieces from head coach Mike Bradbury's first season and the additions of several others have the Lobos in a position to play the up-tempo style Bradbury hopes for and improve from their 15-15 campaign in 2016-17.

UNM returns All-Mountain West and Mountain West All-Defensive Team member Cherise Beynon as well as fellow starters Alex Lapeyrolerie and All-Mountain West Freshman team member Mykiel Bureson. UNM also returns Jaisa Nunn in the post and guards Laneah Bryan and Emily Lines. Add to it with two talented transfers and five freshmen that all will likely see action and UNM is excited to see what 2017-18 has in store.

### ADDITION BY ADDITION

Of the 13 players that will dress for the Lobos (Kansas transfer Aisia Robertson must sit for a season per NCAA rules), seven will be new to UNM fans this season, including a pair of transfers who sat last season for UNM in Tesha Buck and Erica Moore.

## THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

The Pit is still there, but it will be going by a new name starting this season as the nationally famous facility will now be known as Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit. The arena is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico women's basketball program. The Lobos have led the Mountain West in attendance every year of the conference's existence since the 1999-00 season. During that same span, the program has ranked in the top 20 nationally in attendance in each of those years. The UNM women's basketball team is an impressive 388-202 at home all-time.

## MESSED AROUND & GOT A TRIPLE-DOUBLE ... TWICE

Senior guard Cherise Beynon put together one of the more impressive seasons in recent Lobo history in 2016-17 - averaging 15.8 points, 7.5 rebounds, 6.6 assists and 1.9 steals. Along with posting those well-rounded numbers - the Las Vegas native also had not one, but two triple-doubles last season, becoming the first Lobo since 1979 to have a triple-double. Beynon posted 15 points, 15 rebounds and 10 assists on Feb. 18 against Fresno State after notching her first on Feb. 8 against Air Force. In that game, Beynon put up 20 points, 12 assists and 12 rebounds. Beynon also finished just three assists short of her third triple-double on Feb. 22 at Colorado State.

Beynon is one of just 24 players to record a triple-double this season and is tied for second in the nation with most triple-doubles at two. Just one player has tallied more, Sabrina Ionescu of Oregon (4). Only three players have registered multiple triple-doubles this season in Division I.

## THE BUCK STOPPED HERE - IN NEW MEXICO

The Lobos will get a boost this season in Wisconsin-Green Bay transfer Tesha Buck. The Minnesota native, who sat out last season due to NCAA transfer rules, scored 1,003 points and hit 183 3-pointers in her three seasons with WGB along with averaging 4.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.5 steals per game. The 6-foot guard hit 57 or more 3-pointers in each of her three seasons - and she's a winner as the team went a combined 78-20 during her time there.

## STUDENT-ATHLETE SPIRIT

Academic excellence has become the norm for the New Mexico women's basketball. The Lobos are regularly taking home Mountain West Academic all-conference and Scholar-Athlete awards, but they shine in national academic rankings as well. For seven of the last nine seasons, and nine of the last 12 seasons, UNM has finished in the WB-CA's Academic Top 25 rankings.

## LETTING IT FLY FROM 3 - MW EDITION

The Lobos set a program record for 3-pointers made (115) and attempted (413) during a conference season in 2016-17. Cherise Beynon paced the Lobos by taking a program-record 118 3-pointers during conference play.

## LAPEYROLERIE ENTERS 3-PT SINGLE-SEASON TOP 10

Redshirt senior Alex Lapeyrolerie made her way into the UNM single-season top 10 in 3-pointers made and attempted in 2016-17 as she made 55 (10th in UNM single-season history) on 182 attempts (fifth). Cherise Beynon also found her way into the 3-pointers attempted single-season UNM list with 205 in 2016-17.

# Lobos fall at New Mexico State

## UNM ATHLETICS

**LAS CRUCES, N.M.** --- After claiming a commanding 29-point victory at home in their first matchup of the season, the University of New Mexico women's basketball team (2-4) fell in the final minutes to New Mexico State (5-2) by a final score of 77-70 on Wednesday evening in Las Cruces, N.M. in the Rio Grande Rivalry game. Three Lobos scored in double figures, two of which surpassed the 20-point mark.

The game marks the fourth-straight loss for UNM, all of which the Lobos led at some point during the contest.

"I thought we played relatively hard for three quarters, we were outrebounded but we were winning," head coach Mike Bradbury said. "But we got crushed on the boards in the fourth quarter and didn't respond very well."

The Lobos were led by junior Cherise Beynon and senior Richelle van der Keijl who each passed the 20-point threshold on the night. Beynon led with a season-high 22 points before fouling out on a questionable call with 40.3 seconds left in the game. van der Keijl followed with 21 for her third 20+ point game in six games this season, tying her career high.

The Lobos have had at least one player rack up 20 points or more in five of their six games this season.

"Offensively (van der Keijl and Beynon) were both really good," Bradbury said. "We needed both of their points to be in the game. I think they have been kind of our leaders throughout the year so hopefully they continue."

The Lobos went down early in the game, allowing the home team to take a nine-point advantage halfway through the first quarter, 15-6. The Lobos went on a 12-2 run to halt the Aggies and take the lead. It was junior Laneah Bryan who hit a three-pointer to take the first lead of the night for UNM, 18-17. The teams ended the exciting first quarter tied at 19 apiece with van der Keijl and Beynon leading the Lobos with seven points each. Bryan and sophomore Jaisa Nunn combined for five.

The Lobos had picked up momentum in the final minutes of the first quarter and took it into the second where they outscored NMSU 21-18 to head into the locker room up 40-37 at the half. Freshman Mykiel Burluson hit a three with 31 seconds left on the clock in the first half to break a 37-37 tie.

In the first half, UNM shot 45.5 percent from the field including 33.3 percent from behind the arc and 56.0 percent at the stripe. The Aggies were just 39.1 percent overall, 38.9 from three-point land and 84.2 from the free-throw line (16-19).

The Lobos, more specifically van der Keijl, came out on fire in the second half. After the Aggies scored the first basket of the third quarter, van der Keijl went off for five straight points to give UNM a six-point lead, 45-39. The Aggies cut the lead to one again before she knocked in two more free throws to extend the lead to three, 47-44. The teams traded baskets throughout the quarter and NMSU's Tamera William, who led all players with 23 points) drilled a half-court three with just a fraction of a second on the clock to pull the game within one, 57-56 Lobos.

After three quarters of hard work, the Lobos slipped in the fourth quarter. The Aggies scored five straight points to make it 61-57 before senior Kianna Keller cut the lead back to two on a jumper, 61-59. NMSU followed a 6-0 run on two threes from Brooke Salas over just 58 seconds to make it 67-59 NMSU with 7:46 to play.
