#### MW FOOTBALL NOTEBOOK

#### RECEIVING VOTES

Three Mountain West teams are receiving votes in both national top 25 polls (AP Top 25 and Amway Coaches' Poll), led by Utah State. The Aggies currently sit at No. 27 in both national polls.

Also receiving votes is San Diego State and Utah State. All three teams have compiled 6-1 records to open the season, with losses on the road against Autonomous 5 competition.

#### **BOWL ELIGIBILITY**

Last Saturday, Fresno State, San Diego State and Utah State became eligible for the postseason. Fresno State is bowl eligible for the second consecutive year under head coach Jeff Tedford. San Diego State is bowl eligible for the ninth consecutive season, while Utah State has earned postseason eligibility for the fifth time under head coach Matt Wells.

Two Mountain West teams can become bowl eligible with a victory in Week 9:

- Boise State With a victory on Saturday at Air Force, the Broncos can earn postseason eligibility for the 17th consecutive year. This streak is tops among the Group of Five and trails only Florida State, Georgia, LSU, Oklahoma and Virginia
- Hawai'i With a victory against Nevada on Saturday would make the Rainbow Warriors bowl eligible for the first time since 2016.

#### **MOVING UP THE CHARTS**

#### HAWAI'I BRINGS BACK THE RUN-N-SHOOT OFFENSE

This season, Hawai'i brought back the Run-N-Shoot offense, a style they used from 1999-2011. Below are some of the Rainbow Warrior's offensive highlights:

- In the season opener at Colorado State, UH threw for 418 yards and rushed for another 199 yards. The 617 yards of total offense is the Rainbow Warriors' highest output in a single-game since Nov. 23, 2013 (624 yards at Wyoming).
- In the Conference-opener against the Rams, sophomore QB Cole McDonald set a program record for passing yards (418) in a starting debut. The record was previously held by now-head coach Nick Rolovich, who threw for 367 yards vs. Portland State in 2001.
- In a home-opening victory against Navy, McDonald threw for 428 yards and six touchdowns. He is the first Mountain West QB to throw for 400 yards in backto-back games since Colorado State's Garrett Grayson in September of 2014.
- Hawai'i ranks 15th nationally in passing offense (307.0 yards per game).

#### UTAH STATE'S HOT START

Utah State is off to its first 6-1 start since 1974 and are 3-0 in league play for the first time since 2013. The Aggies are currently riding a six-game win streak, which is tied as the seventh-longest active streak nationally.

Utah State hosts New Mexico on Saturday, Oct. 27 (2 p.m. MT on Facebook), looking for its first seven-game win streak since 2012.

Utah State ranks fourth nationally in scoring offense, averaging 47.7 points per contest. The Mountain West record for points in a season is 608 by BYU in 2001. Utah State is sitting at 334 points scored through seven games.

#### WINNING STREAKS

San Diego State and Utah State are both riding six-game win streaks heading into Week 9. The Aztecs dropped their season opener on the road at nationally-ranked Stanford, while the Aggies lost in Week 1 at nationally-ranked Michigan State.

The six-game win streak is tied as the seventh-longest active streak nationally. Meanwhile, the Aztecs have won seven consecutive MW games, which ranks as the seventh-longest active FBS streak.

The Aggies haven't won seven straight games since 2012.

#### NOT JUST A FLASH IN THE PAN

Below are a couple notes about Mountain West teams with continued success:

- On Saturday, Sept. 8, the Mountain West won three games against the Pac-12 (Nevada beat Oregon State, Fresno State over UCLA and San Diego State defeated Arizona State) in the same weekend for the first time since September of 2008.
- The Mountain West has won four consecutive games against an opponent from the American Athletic Conference (Boise State over UConn, Hawai'i over Navy, Fresno State over Houston and Air Force over Navy).
- In the last three seasons, San Diego State has racked up 38 victories, which is the most among the Group of 5 and sixth-best nationally, trailing only Alabama (49), Clemson (47), Ohio State (42), Oklahoma (40) and Wisconsin (39).
- Head coach Rocky Long has led the Aztecs to a bowl game in his first seven seasons. Long is the all-time winningest head coach in Mountain West history
- Boise State has defeated an Autonomous 5 institution in six of seven seasons since joining the Mountain West. Since 2010, BSU has compiled a 12-9 (.571) record against current Autonomous 5 programs. The Broncos have defeated Arizona, Arizona State, Georgia, Oregon, Oregon State, Utah, Virginia, Washington and Washington State.
- Boise State has been nationally-ranked for at least one week for the 17th consecutive season.
- Boise State has made 16 consecutive postseason appearances, the longest streak among Group of 5 institutions and sixth-best nationally.
- Over the last 14 seasons, the Mountain West owns the second-best win percentage in bowl games among the 10 FBS conferences (.560), trailing only the SEC (.628).

#### **MOUNTAIN WEST'S 20TH FOOTBALL SEASON**

Led by the vision of then-Colorado State President Dr. Albert Yates, the Mountain West was formed when presidents of eight institutions - Air Force, BYU, Colorado State, New Mexico, San Diego State, UNLV, Utah and Wyoming - decided to form a new NCAA Division I-A intercollegiate athletic conference.

Mountain West football began its 20th season last Saturday as Hawai'i defeated Colorado State, 43-34. The Rams, who are an original member of the MW, played in the first-ever Conference game on Sept. 16, 1999 as BYU hosted CSU.

- @FresnoStateFB WR KeeSean Johnson leads the nation with at least one reception in 43 consecutive games.
- .@SDSUFootball ranks fifth nationally in rush defense, limiting opponents to just 83.6 yards per game. In the season opener, the Aztecs held Stanford's Bryce Love to 29 rushing yards.
- The Aztecs' 38 victories in the last three years are the sixth-most nationally and the most among the Group of 5, trailing only Alabama (49), Clemson (47), Ohio State (42), Oklahoma (40) and Wisconsin (39).
- .@wyo\_football's Andrew Wingard enters the week with 428 career tackles, just 27 shy of setting the @MountainWest record (New Mexico's Carmen Messina -454).
- The @MountainWest has four quarterbacks ranked in the top 20 nationally in passing yards/game: @HawaiiFootball's Cole McDonald (5th; 325.9), @BroncoSportsFB's Brett Rypien (8th; 309.4), @CSUFootball's K.J. Carta-Samuels (19th; 271.5) & @NevadaFootball's Ty Gangi (20th; 269.0).
- @USUFootball PK Dominik Eberle tied two NCAA single-game records on Sept. 8 against New Mexico State: points scored kicking (24) and most field goals from 50-plus yards (3).
- .@FresnoStateFB defeated UCLA 38-14 on Sept. 22, earning its first victory against an Autonomous 5 opponent since Sept. 15, 2012 (Colorado, 69-14).
- .@FresnoStateFB defeated Idaho 79-13 in the season opener. The 79 points are the second-most scored in a single game in @MountainWest history.
- .@FresnoStateFB is off to its best seven-game start (6-1) since going 7-0 in 2013.

If both teams are ranked in the latest available CFP Selection Committee ranking, the highest-ranked team that wins in the final weekend of the regular season;

If neither of the ranked teams win in the final weekend of the regular season, a composite average of selected computer rankings after all games conclude the final weekend of the regular season will be used;

If neither team is ranked in the latest available CFP Selection Committee ranking going into the final weekend of the regular season, a composite average of selected computer rankings after all games conclude the final weekend of the regular season will be used.

- If still tied, the best record against common Conference opponents.
- If still tied, the team with the highest overall winning percentage (Conference and non-conference excluding exempt games).
- If still tied, a coin toss will be conducted by the Commissioner.
