SCOUTING LOYOLA MARYMOUNT

Loyola Marymount enters play this week with a 2-7-0 record on the season. Thus far, the Lions have scored just eight goals in nine games and have allowed 19. The Lions and Lobos have three common opponents with games against Seattle, Cal State-Northridge, and Cal State Fullerton. LMU is 1-2 against that trio with a win against CSUN. Conversely, the Lobos are 2-1 with their lone loss to CSUN.

CONFERENCE PLAY STRAIGHT AHEAD

After falling short in the conference opener (L 1-2) to RV Old Dominion, the Lobos regained momentum, defeating Florid Atlantic (W 2-0). This game was the first Lobo shutout of the season, with four shots on goal saved by freshman goalie, **ALEX FETTERLY**. The Lobos fell short in conference play against Florida International (L 2-4), but look ahead as the team faces only one more non-conference opponent for the rest of the season. Lobos will face Loyola Marymount Tuesday, October 2 at the UNM Soccer Complex.

THE FIRST OF MANY FOR THE LOBOS

The Lobos proved that they have more than just a few go-to players, but rather a whole team of talent which provides for an offence that is hard for opponents to track. The Lobos, with their first shutout of the season against Florida Atlantic, had two new scorers to add to the stat book. Senior **SIMON SPANGERBERG** and RS Sophomore **BILLY JONES** both posted their first goals for the 2018 season against FAU. This was also Jones' first goal for the Lobos.

NEW MEXICO MATCH NOTES

SHUTOUTS ARE A LOBO SPECIALTY

Since 2015, the Lobos have forced 16 shutouts, adding one to the record this season already. In conference play, UAB (2-6-2, 0-3-1) knows this feeling all too well, as they have been scoreless against the Lobos in two of their past three meetings. The Lobos are set to meet with the Blazers on October 6 in Birmingham.

SCHEDULE FULL OF RANKED TEAMS

Four of UNM's first five matchups of the season have been against ranked squads at the time of the game including No. 22 Seattle, No. 24 Washington, No. 30 Cal State Fullerton and No. 23 Tulsa. Half of those ranked matchups came at home with the Lobos hosting Seattle and Washington in consecutive games. UNM went 1-1 against those opponents and is also 1-1 against ranked teams on the road.

In their victories against Seattle and Cal State Fullerton, the Lobos scored a combined nine goals with five coming against Cal State Fullerton.

CSUN was also ranked at one point this season, making the first five squads the Lobos have taken on, be top-30 teams in 2018. Old Dominion was receiving votes in the national poll at the time of the game against the Lobos and now the Monarchs are currently ranked.

Saint Mary's, UNM's opponent on September 26 was ranked No. 10 at the time making them the sixth opponent the Lobos have played be ranked at the time of the game.

OFFENSE ON FIRE

In the first 10 games, the Lobos have racked up 49 points on 16 goals with 17 assists, placing the team in first place for goals in the C-USA. Individually, **TOM SMART** is first in the C-USA in assists, racking up six thus far. Matt Puig is also in the top-10 list in the C-USA for assists, ranking sixth with three asists.

SCORES GALORE!

Last season, the Lobos scored 25 goals all season. With 16 goals in 10 games, UNM already over the halfway mark to matching last year's goal total.

Only four players scored three goals or more in 2017, but this 2018 squad features two players with at least three goals and another two that are a goal shy of the mark. Freshman **OMAR GREY** currently leads the team with five goals, followed by sophomore **MATT PUIG** with four. Senior **SIMON SPANGENBERG** had three and Senior **ANTOINE VIAL**, Sophomore **NICK TAYLOR**, and RS-Sophomore **BILLY JONES** have registered the remainder of the goals with two apiece.

FRESHMAN PHENOM

Freshman midfielder **OMAR GREY** has gotten his collegiate career off to a resounding start. The Seattle, Wash. native has not started a game yet for UNM, but has played in all eight games thus far. Despite not being a starter, Grey has come off the bench and sparked the Lobos' offense as he currently leads the team with five goals. Four of those came in consecutive games (9/2 - 9/15).

TWO PROTECTING ONE

Redshirt-junior **FORD PARKER** and true freshman **ALEX FETTERLY** have both seen time in goal for the Lobos this season with Parker getting the lion's share of the work thus far. Parker has started seven games and registered 33 saves for a .702 save percentage in 642:17 minutes. Fetterly has started the three games and logged the lone shutout for the team this season, blanking FAU. On the season, Fetterly has saved 84% of shots on goal he has faced.

PRO CONTRACTS MEAN PLAYERS STEP UP

Several significant players from last year's squad have graduated or advanced to the professional level leaving last season's underclassmen and redshirts to step up. Players that departed for professional contracts include goalkeeper **JASON BEAULIEU** (Montreal Impact MLS), **AARON HERRERA** (Real Salt Lake MLS), **SAM GLEADLE** (Reno 1868 FC USL) and **ALEX VEDAMANIKAM** (Eintracht Braunschweig of the Second Bundesliga).

While we're on the topic of professional contracts - former Lobo **CHRIS WEHAN** received USL Rookie of the Year honors last season as a member of Reno 1868 FC and has now signed with the San Jose Earthquakes (MLS). Speaking of former Lobos, Wehan's classmate **NIKO HANSEN** is still with the Columbus Crew SC (MLS).

LOBO SOCCER: A MILE HIGH AND LOUDER THAN ...

The UNM Soccer Complex has a reputation as one of the nation's toughest venues to play in. In addition to being "a mile high and louder than...", New Mexico has turned Albuquerque into one of the hottest tickets in college soccer. The Lobos have ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally every season since the NCAA began keeping those statistics in 2001.

EXCELLING OFF THE PITCH

Lobo Soccer has a rich tradition of academic success. During the **FISHBEIN** era (2002 to present), UNM has had 22 Academic All-Americans - more than any other men's soccer program in the country among all divisions. In addition, the Lobos have garnered 95 Academic All-Conference honorees and 20 NSCAA Scholar All-Americans under Fishbein's tutelage. As a team, the Lobos have earned the NSCAA Academic Team Award in 13 of the last 14 seasons - Soon to be 14 of the last 15 when the new awards are released.

INTERNATIONAL PRIDE

While the diversity of the team roster is obvious, many Lobos have some serious international credentials. Eight have represented their country in top-level international competition: **BILLY JONES** (captained New Zealand U17 in select World Cup qualifying matches), **AARON SCOTT** (U15, U16, U17 Scottish National Team), **TOM SMART** (Northern Ireland U19, U20), **GLADEMIR MENDOZA** (United States U20), **OMAR GREY** (Jamaica U17), **MALIEK HOWELL** (Jamaica U17, U20) and **ALEX FETTERLY** (United States U18).

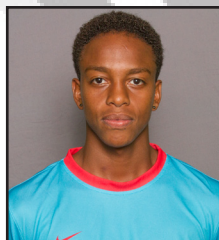

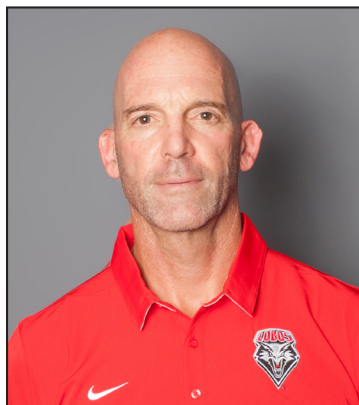
