ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- Wednesday's contest against Eastern NM marks the 2019-20 season opener for the Lobos.
- ENMU is coming off of an exhibition loss on the road at Tennessee (107-59) on Oct. 30.
- UNM features a stacked lineup that includes three returning starters and five of last season's six top scorers.
- Returning starters include redshirt-junior Vance Jackson, junior Makuach Maluach, and redshirt-senior Carlton Bragg Jr.
- UNM also returns six additional letterwinners including senior Corey Manigault and redshirt-junior Keith McGee who each averaged at least nine points per game last season.
- Highly-anticipated transfers JaQuan Lyle (Ohio State) and Zane Martin (Towson) are expected to take the court. The duo will finally join Bragg (Kansas/ASU) on Bob King Court after sitting the last season (or two).
- The last time the Lobos took on the Greyhounds in a regular season contest was on Nov. 29, 2000 under former head coach Fran Fraschilla. The Lobos emerged with a 90-50 victory in ABQ.
- Wednesday's game will serve as regular-season competition for UNM, an exhibition for ENMU.
- UNM holds the advantage over the Greyhounds 15-1 in the series with the only loss coming on December 2, 1991 (81-76) in Albuquerque.
- The last time the two teams met, UNM claimed an exhibition win (88-66) on Nov. 4, 2016.
- Eastern NM its top scorer from 2018-29 in junior Devin Pullum. Pullum averaged a team-high 12.7 points per game as a sophomore last season.
- Overall, the Greyhounds return seven letterwinners from last year's 14.

ABOUT THE 2019-20 LOBOS

The 2019-20 Lobos feature nine returning letterwinners including three starters. Starters include redshirt-junior Vance Jackson, junior Makuach Maluach and redshirt-senior Carlton Bragg Jr. Joining the trio are senior Corey Manigault, redshirt-junior Keith McGee, sophomore Tavian Percy, redshirt-sophomore Clay Patterson, sophomore Drue Drinnon and sophomore Jordan Arroyo.

STARTER STATS

The trio of returning starters from the 2018-19 season return some impressive stats. Jackson collected 13.1 points per game last season to go along with 7.0 rebounds and a 40.5 percent shooting clip. Jackson saw action in all 32 games last season along with Maluach, who started 28 of them. Maluach registered 9.9 points per game while Bragg posted 10.5 points and 8.8 rebounds per contest to go along with shooting 49 percent from the floor.

YOUNG AND OLD

The Lobo roster is made up of exactly half (8) underclassmen and another eight upperclassmen for a balanced roster of experience and new talent.

LOBO TRANSFERS

Four of the seven newcomers to the 2019-20 roster are transfers, that includes redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle who has sat on the bench in his last two seasons as a Lobo. Adding to his experience from Ohio State, redshirt-

junior Zane Martin hails from Towson while redshirt-junior JJ Caldwell last saw the floor at Texas A&M and redshirt-sophomore Vante Hendrix last competed at Utah.

SWITCH IT UP

For a fresh look this season, several players have made some jersey number switches. Redshirt-senior Carlton Bragg will don #15 instead of #35 this season while redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle will rock the #5 jersey instead of last season's #13. Last year's #5, Clay Patterson, has also switched to #20.

PAIR OF KWACHES?

Don't adjust your speakers this season or yell at the television thinking the announcers have it wrong. The Lobos now have TWO "Kwaches." Junior Makuach Maluach serves as the original "Kwach" while freshman Emmanuel Kuac (pronounced Kwach) is affectionately referred to by the team as "Baby Kwach." In a recent media interview, Kuac said that he doesn't mind the nickname as he sees Makuach Maluach as a great friend and role model.

LOBOS FROM NEAR AND FAR

Just two Lobos on the 2019-20 roster hail from New Mexico including sophomore Jordan Arroyo and redshirt-sophomore Clay Patterson. The remainder of the roster includes players from 10 states and a total of four countries including the U.S., Australia, Canada and the Central African Republic.

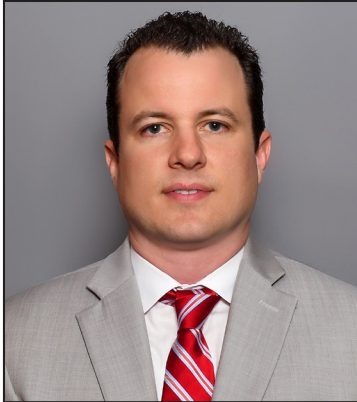

THE GREATEST GAME EVER PLAYED

The Pit was the site of one of the greatest college basketball games ever played. It hosted the 1983 national championship game that saw the NC State Wolfpack upset Hakeem Olajuwon, Clyde Drexler and the Houston Cougars. Coach Jimmy Valvano and the Wolfpack downed the Cougars on a last second put back by Lorenzo Charles. The iconic shot of the late Valvano running onto the court looking for a hug is one of the lasting images in college basketball history.

- Capacity of 15,411 (previously 18,018)
- \$60 million renovation was completed in 2010

As part of the exciting Dreamstyle changes, University Stadium, UNM's football stadium, officially became Dreamstyle Arena on the same date.
- Less than 30 of 345 NCAA Division I basketball programs play in a college-only arena named after a business or organization founded or headquartered in its home state.
- The Lobos have averaged an astounding 15,410 fans the past 49 years, an amazing 95% of capacity
- The Pit has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally nearly every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.

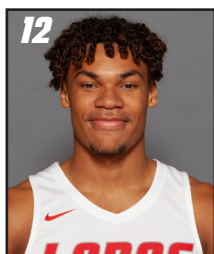
