Quick Hits

It's pronounced KY-yotes (two syllables)

Bob Nielson (hired Dec. 15) is in his first season as head coach of the Coyotes. He is the reigning MVFC Coach of the Year after leading Western Illinois to the 2015 FCS playoffs

The Coyotes are taking on a FBS program for the ninth time in the last seven seasons

USD beat Minnesota 41-38 in 2010 for its last win against a FBS team

Five of the 10 teams from the MVFC made the 24-team field for the 2015 FCS playoffs. NDSU has won the last five national titles.

USD beat NDSU 24-21 inside the Fargodome last season en route to a 5-6 record

Six of USD's 10 FCS opponents are ranked in the preseason top 25

Senior safety and co-captain Tyson Graham is a preseason MVFC honoree

USD has not announced a starting quarterback. The candidates include returning starter and senior Ryan Saeger, University of Minnesota transfer Chris Streveler, and redshirt freshman Austin Simmons

USD returns eight starters on offense and four on defense ... senior RB Trevor Bouma has rushed for 1,700 yards and 12 scores throughout his career ... senior QB Ryan Saeger passed for nearly 2,000 yards and 12 scores last year ... senior safeties Tyson Graham and Jacob Warner have both made 22 career starts

About the Lobos (7-6, 5-3 MWC): New Mexico returns four starters on offense and 10 on defense from a team that achieved the program's first winning record since 2007 and competed against Arizona in the Gildan New Mexico Bowl ... wins against Utah State, Boise State and Air Force highlighted the season ... offensively, the team tied a school record with 42 rushing TDs and finished in the top 10 nationally in rushing for the fourth straight season ... junior QB Lamar Jordan (807 rush yds, 9 TDs) and senior TB Teriyon Gipson (848 yds, 6 TDs) return ... senior DL Nik D'Avanzo and senior LB Dakota Cox are preseason all-MWC picks

THIS WEEK'S NOTES

South Dakota is opening a season against a Mountain West opponent for the second time in six seasons and for the first time since 2011 when USD dropped a 37-20 decision at Air Force. USD and New Mexico are meeting for the first time.

2 USD is competing against its ninth FBS foe in the last seven years. A look at how the Coyotes have fared in those games follows:

Sept. 4, 2010: Central Florida 38, USD 7 Sept. 11, 2010: USD 41, Minnesota 38 Sept. 3, 2011: Air Force 37, USD 20 Sept. 24, 2011: Wisconsin 59, USD 10 Sept. 22, 2012: Northwestern 38, USD 7 Sept. 7, 2013: Kansas 31, USD 14 Aug. 31, 2014: Oregon 62, USD 13 Kansas State 34, USD 0 Sept. 5, 2015:

3 Bob Nielson is in his first season with the Coyotes following three years at Western Illinois. USD is the sixth program Nielson has served as head coach at. He has taken four of the previous five programs to the playoffs within his first four years and captured NCAA Division II national championships with Minnesota Duluth in 2008 and 2010.

Pass game coordinator **Ted Schlafke** (starting quarterback) and co-defensive coordinator **Tyler Yelk** (starting safety) won a NCAA Division II national championship under Nielson at Minnesota Duluth in 2008 (15-0).

5 Nielson has listed three quarterbacks in his depth chart and all three could see action in the opener.

Ryan Saeger started all 11 games last season and four games as a sophomore in 2014 when starter Kevin Earl went down with an injury in the season opener at Oregon. Saeger (7-8 as a starter) was the fourth-leading passer in the Valley last season at 180 yards per game. He accounted for all three touchdowns in the team's win at North Dakota State and surpassed 200 yards in four of his last six games. On the season, he totaled 350 yards rushing and three scores.

Chris Streveler earned a degree in kinesiology from University of Minnesota last spring and transferred to USD with two

seasons of eligibility remaining. Streveler played five games at quarterback in 2014. He started against San Jose State, completing four passes for 27 yards and one touchdown and rushing 18 times for 161 yards and a touchdown. His rushing total is third-most by a quarterback in a game in Minnesota history. In 2015, he switched to wide receiver and caught one pass for four yards in five games.

Austin Simmons is a redshirt freshman who passed for 2,066 yards, ran for 1,194 yards and combined for 46 touchdowns (25 pass, 21 rush) at Lewis Central (Iowa) as a senior in 2014 to earn elite all-state honors.

G USD running backs include senior **Trevor Bouma** and sophomore **Michael Fredrick**. Bouma has had his season cut short the last two seasons with the same injury. His final carry of 2015 set up the game-winning field goal in the Coyotes' upset of North Dakota State in Fargo.

Fredrick, a true freshman in 2015, averaged 80 yards per game as the starter over the final five games of the season. He rushed for a season-high 143 yards when USD nearly pulled off the upset against South Dakota State in Vermillion.

The Coyote receiving core includes junior **Brandt Van Roekel** and returns junior **Riley Donovan**, who missed nearly all of 2015 due to injury. Van Roekel led USD with 518 yards and six scores last season. Donovan combined for 69 catches for 1,048 yards and three touchdowns in his first two seasons at USD.

South Dakota's initial depth chart includes four true freshmen including receivers **Randy Baker** (Daytona Beach, Fla.) and **Trystn Ducker** (Bellevue, Neb.). Junior college transfer **Alonge Brooks** caught 29 passes for 476 yards and five touchdowns at Riverside City College in California.

9 The Coyote offensive line includes senior captain **Nile Banks**, who has converted from guard to center this season, and left tackle **Nick Jensen**, who started every game a year ago as a redshirt freshman. Guards **Stetson Dagel** and **Ed Kennedy** have starting experience. Right tackle **Tanner Anderson**, a sophomore, is expected to make his first collegiate start.

10 Of the 95 players on USD's fall camp roster, 40 percent (38) are new to the program and another 12 players redshirted as freshmen.

11 Of the 42 letter winners from last year's squad, nine have changed positions. Those on this week's depth chart include:

Paul Anderson from WR to RB Danny Rambo from WR to DB Drew Potter from FB to TE Taylor Lambert from FB to DL Jet Moreland from DB to LB Alex Gray from DB to LB

12 Senior **Miles Bergner** has been the Coyotes' doeverything special teamer for each of the last three seasons. His 42 career field goals are two shy of the program record. He's also averaged 41 yards per punt and has 37 career touchbacks on kickoffs.

13 Paul Anderson ranked third in the MVFC in punt return average (7.4 ypr) and fifth in kick return average (20.8 ypr) as a redshirt freshman last season. He earned the starting gig for both in week three of 2015.

14 The last Coyote to run a kickoff back for a touchdown was Jeremy Blount in 2008. The last punt return for a score was by Stefan Logan in 2006.

15 The departure of Andrew Van Ginkel means senior end Colin Mertlik is the one to watch on the defensive line. Mertlik has competed in all 35 games for the Coyotes the last three seasons. He's compiled 54 tackles including 9.5 for loss and 4.0 sacks. He had 38 tackles and forced four fumbles while starting all 11 games a year ago.

16 USD graduated two senior linebackers and is likely without the service of senior captain **John Wessel** (injury) to begin 2016. Junior **Jim Litrenta** is in line to earn his first collegiate start at middle linebacker.

17 Coyote senior safeties **Tyson Graham** and **Jacob Warner** have combined for 307 tackles and nine interceptions throughout their USD careers. Both have 22 collegiate starts. Graham began at wide receiver before converting to safety prior to his sophomore campaign in 2014.

Junior Adam Harris is the Coyotes' most senior cornerback with his five starts last season. He registered 19 tackles with seven break-ups a year ago.

Doug Lewis, who had two picks in each of his two seasons at College of DuPage in Illinois, is slotted at the other corner.

19 South Dakota has just one 100-yard receiving performance in the team's last 24 games dating back to 2013.

 $20\,$ South Dakota led the Valley and ranked fifth nationally in red zone offense in 2015. The Coyotes scored on 29 of their 32 trips inside the 20 and came away with a touchdown 20 times.

21 The Coyote defense allowed just nine runs of 20 yards or more all last season and four came against Illinois State in blizzard-like conditions in the season finale. USD ranked third against the pass (184 ypg) and fourth against the run (159 ypg) in the MVFC a year ago.

Head Coach Bob Nielson



Bob Nielson was introduced as the 30th head coach in the history of University of South Dakota football in December of 2015. It is the sixth head coaching stint for Nielson, who has enjoyed success at nearly every level of college football. He is a three-time national coach of the year recipient, a two-time national champion head coach, and the reigning Missouri Valley Football Conference Coach of the Year.

Nielson has been labeled a builder throughout his career and his resume supports the description. He has compiled a 186-80-1 record in 23 seasons as a head coach for five

different programs. He's taken four of those programs to the playoffs within his first four years and captured NCAA Division II national championships with Minnesota Duluth in 2008 and 2010.

Most recently, Nielson served as head coach at Western Illinois University in Macomb for three seasons from 2013-15. He led the

Leathernecks to a 7-6 record in 2015 and to the second round of the FCS playoffs. It was the first playoff appearance for the Leathernecks since 2010.

Nielson grew up in Marion, Iowa, and received his bachelor's degree from Wartburg College in Waverly, Iowa, in 1982. He began his career as an offensive line coach at his alma mater before being promoted to defensive coordinator in 1987.

Ripon College in Wisconsin gave Nielson his first head coaching gig. He was 2-6-1 in his first season and improved to 7-2 in year two. It was the first season the Red Hawks had posted more than four victories in eight years.

Nielson returned to Waverly in 1991 to serve as head coach of the Knights. In 1993, his third season, Wartburg won an Iowa Conference title, Nielson earned his first conference coach of the year award, and the Knights returned to the NCAA Division III playoffs for the first time in 11 years. One year later, Wartburg had its first NCAA playoff victory.

Nielson's Duluth Dynasty began in 1999. In year three, Duluth made its first postseason appearance by competing in the Mineral Water Bowl in Missouri. The following season, the Bulldogs won the 2002 Northern Sun Championship with a 9-0 record and qualified for the NCAA Division II playoffs for the first time.

Duluth was 38-19 in its first five years under Nielson, who turned in his whistle after the 2003 season to serve as the Bulldogs' athletic director. He remained the AD when he returned to coach the football team in 2008. That year, Duluth earned its first national championship with a 15-0 record. The Bulldogs duplicated the feat in 2010.

Nielson was 100-26 in 10 seasons at Duluth. In his second five-year stint, the program was 62-7 with five NCAA playoff appearances, four NSIC titles and two undefeated seasons. Nielson was named national coach of the year in both championship years and totaled three Northern Sun Coach of the Year awards.

Nielson joined the FCS ranks in 2013 when he made the move to Macomb. The Leathernecks combined for five wins from 2011-12, but progressed to four, five and seven wins in three seasons under Nielson. The Leathernecks featured seven all-MVFC honorees including four in 2015.

Nielson and his wife, Terri, have two daughters, Amanda Taylor and Kasey King, a son, Kyle, and two grandchildren, Cash and Rowan Taylor. Nielson holds a master's degree from University of Northern Iowa, which he completed in 1988.
