

NEW MEXICO 91 GRAND CANYON 71

- UNM now leads the series 4-1 overall including four wins in Albuquerque starting on Dec. 11, 1979.

Post-game Notes:

- The Lobos are now 8-0 at home on the season and are on a six-game win streak.
 - The last time the Lobos were 8-0 at home was the 2010-11 season, a streak the squad extended to 9-0 before its first home loss.
- Tuesday's game marks the fifth game this season the Lobos have scored 90 or more points in a game.
 - The last time the Lobos scored 90 points was on Nov. 16, 2019 against McNeese.
- UNM recorded its best free throw percentage of the season as it went 15-16, good for 93.8 percent.
 - This marks the first time this season the Lobos have shot above 90 percent from the line.
- UNM also recorded its most threes of the season, going 14-for-26 from behind the arc.
 - This marks the first time this season the Lobos have hit over 10 3-pointers.
 - The game also marks just the second time this season that UNM has scored more from behind the arc than its opponent.
 - The Lobos fired a season-high 53.8 percent from 3-point range.
- Five Lobos posted double figures: redshirt-senior JaQuan Lyle (21), redshirt-senior Carlton Bragg Jr. (20), redshirt-junior Vance Jackson (12), redshirt-sophomore Vante Hendrix (12) and redshirt-junior Zane Martin (11).
 - Bragg and Lyle have now both scored in double-digits 11 times this season.
 - The last the Lobos had five double-digit scorers was on Nov. 16, 2019 against McNeese.
- The last time the Lobos had two or more 20-point scorers was last season on Nov. 17, 2018 against NM State.
 - Vance Jackson (27), Anthony Mathis (22), and Corey Manigault (20)
- Bragg posted his third straight double-double of the season and his fourth in the last five games with 20 points and 14 rebounds.
 - This marks his eighth career double-double at UNM and his fifth this season.
 - Bragg tied his season high of 20 points which he posted against Montana on Dec. 1, 2019.
 - He went 7-10 from the field, 2-2 from the behind arc and 4-4 from the line on Tuesday.
 - Bragg's 2-2 from the arc marked just his second and third career 3-pointers.
- Hendrix went 4-6 from behind the arc to contribute to his 12 points during his first outing as a Lobo.
- The Lobos scored more points off of turnovers (20-11) while registering more second-chance points (14-10).
 - UNM also outscored off the fast break (16-12) and off the bench (29-4)
