ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Lobos enter Tuesday's game against Omaha coming off of a record-breaking 147-76 victory over Northern New Mexico on Saturday
- Omaha is coming off of a 108-89 loss at Oklahoma on Sunday afternoon.
- The two teams have not met in the history of the programs.
- Omaha was tabbed to finish sixth in the Summit League in the 2017-18 Preseason Poll after finishing third last season.
- Omaha has just one starter returning from the team that made a post-season run in 2016-17, advancing to the Summit League Championship before falling to South Dakota State, 79-77.
- The Mavericks completed 2016-17 with an 18-14 overall record.
- The Lobos have opened the season 2-0 in their last five seasons. The last time UNM opened the season 1-1, however, the Lobos earned the Mountain West regular-season and tournament titles in 2011-12 followed by two games in the NCAA Tournament
- In UNM's last outing, eight Lobos racked up double figures while the team shot 64.7
 percent from the floor and 46.2 percent from 3-point range. The Lobos posted 18
 3-pointers, 40 assists and 22 steals while forcing 33 turnovers.

SCOUTING OMAHA

The Omaha Mavericks are entering Tuesday's game 0-2 on the season after falling in the Summit League Championship to end their 2016-17 season. The Mavericks return just one starter on the season and seven letterwinners while welcoming nine newcomers.

The Mavericks are led by senior Daniel Norl who averages 20.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game. Norl posted 29 points in Omaha's season opener against Montana State and followed it up with an 11-point performance in the Mavericks' last outing.

RECORD-BREAKING OPENER

The Lobos opened the 2017-18 season on Saturday against Northern New Mexico posting a record-breaking 147 points, breaking the previous record of 136 which occurred on Nov. 23, 1990 against Texas-Arlington. The 71-point victory margin also tied the highest victory margin in program history.

The Lobos posted an outstanding 40 steals (ties program record vs Dartmouth on Dec. 17, 1978 and vs. Texas-Arlington on Nov. 23, 1990).

IMMEDIATELY IMPACTING LOBOS

While three returning Lobos reached double figures on Saturday, including Sam Logwood, Dane Kuiper and Anthony Mathis, five newcomers also scored over 10 points on the day including Chris McNeal (24), Antino Jackson (12), Makuach Maluach (18), Vladimir Pinchuk (12) and Troy Simons (19).

McNeal not only led the Lobos in points, but also collected a team-high 10 assists, registering UNM's first points/assist double-double since 2014.

IT'S RAINING THREES

The Lobos shot 46.2 percent from the arc on Saturday, hitting 18 3-pointers on the night. McNeal led with six, followed by Mathis who went 5-for-9 from three. Both Simons and Kuiper added three in the parade of triples.

STEALING SIMONS

Troy Simons not only registered the second-most points on the squad Saturday, but also posted UNM's first 5-steal game by an individual since Demetrius Walker collected five against Montana on Dec. 20, 2011.

LEADING THE MOUNTAIN WEST

While Mountain West teams have only played a game apiece (with the exception of Air Force which as yet to compete), the Lobos are currently in first with most 3-pointers (18) and highest free-throw percentage (86.4).

The Lobos signed their first recruit of the 2018-19 season to NLI just before game time on Saturday, adding 4-star point-guard Drue Drinnon to the roster.

NEW MEXICO NOTES

ABOUT THE 2017-18 LOBOS

The 2017-18 Lobos have just five returning student-athletes from the 2016-17 squad and feature an outstanding nine newcomers. Under first-year head coach Paul Weir, the Lobos look to improve on their 17-14 overall record last season, 10-8 in Mountain West play.

Top returners for the Lobos include lone regular starter Sam Logwood who averaged 7.3 points per game for a .449 field goal percentage and a .671 percentage from the free throw line. All four other Lobos to return to UNM this season played in at least 10 games, including junior Dane Kuiper who started 13 games, averging 6.0 points per game.

New Coach. New era

At the helm of the Lobos in the 2016-17 season will be head coach Paul Weir, officially named the 21st head coach in UNM men's basketball history on April 11, 2017. Weir spent the last season with New Mexico State where he finished 28-6 and led NMSU to a WAC Tournament Championship and an NCAA appearance. Weir is the first basketball coach to serve as the head coach for both New Mexico DI institutions.

Of the nine fresh faces to the UNM squad, the Lobos welcome in six new transfers, four of which will be eligible to compete in the 2017-18 season. Those that are eligible and will don the Lobo Cherry & Silver this season include junior Chris McNeal (Indian Hills), senior Antino Jackson (Akron), junior Jachai Simmons (Midland College) and junior Troy Simons (Polk State). The pair of transfers that will not see action this season is JaQuan Lyle (Ohio State) and Vance Jackson (UCONN) due to NCAA transfer rules.

UNM had 22 of 26 UNM and MW controlled games selected for TV while three non-conference road games, at New Mexico State, at UTEP and at Colorado are expected to be broadcast as well. The Lobos will be on ATT SportsNet/ROOT eight times, on CBS Sports Network five times, ESPN3 five times, and ESPNU and the Mountain West Network on Stadium once. Additionally, two games (at UNLV on January 17 and January 27 at home against Colorado State) are flex games that will be either on ESPNU or ESPN3.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

After two years as WisePies Arena - The Pit, the famous home of Lobo basketball has been given a new name. While it will still be referred to as "The Pit," this season will be the first that the Lobos will compete in "Dreamstyle Arena" as part of an exciting \$10 million agreement for naming rights by Dreamstyle Remodeling of both of UNM's largest-capacity athletic venues. In addition to the official renaming of the Lobo basketball arena, the UNM football stadium, formerly referred to as "University Stadium" is now officially named "Dreamstyle Stadium."

In conjunction with the new name, The Pit was given a new floor this season, featuring both "New Mexico" and "The Pit" on the baselines, the new university interlocking UNM logo, fresh Mountain West logos customized in the Lobo cherry and silver, cherry free throw lines and dual Dreamstyle Arena logos on both sides of center court.

"The Pit" is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico men's basketball program. Since the Mountain West conference began in 1999-2000, New Mexico has ranked in the top two in home attendance among MW teams in every year except one, including 12 seasons as the top-ranked MW team in overall attendance.

Lobos from near and far

Just one Lobo on the 2017-18 roster hails from near as a New Mexico native, freshman Matt Vail. Of the remaining 13 players on the roster, two are from California (Joe Furstinger and Vance Jackson) and two more are from Indiana (Sam Logwood and JaQuan Lyle). That leaves nine players all from different states or countries.

The Lobo melting pot includes players from as close as Arizona (Connor McDougall) and Texas (Antino Jackson) and as far as Alaska (Dane Kuiper), New Jersey (Jachai Simmons), Oregon (Anthony Mathis), Pennsylvania (Troy Simons) and Tennessee (Chris McNeal).

Not only are the Lobos' home towns spread across the United States, but two come from overseas including freshmen Makuach Maluach from Sydney, Australia, and Vladimir Pinchuk from Schwelm, Germany.

Lobos Break Records in Season Opener, Win 147-76

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team shocked a crowd of over 10,500 fans in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit in its first regular-season outing under first-year head coach Paul Weir on Saturday night. The Lobos shattered the UNM record for points scored in a game (136), claiming a 147-76 victory over Northern New Mexico.

The 71-point victory margin also ties the nearly 45-year-old record for largest victory margin, which occurred on December 29, 1972 against Dartmouth at The Pit.

Northern New Mexico is now 2-8 on the season while the Lobos start out 1-0 for the 15th straight season.

"I am extremely thankful to every fan that came through the door tonight and hopefully they'll continue to come out and support us as we try and earn their trust and their respect as a basketball program," Coach Weir said. "Obviously (this was) the kind of offensive game we've been looking for. Our last scrimmage was a very similar outcome, so we're thankful that we're shooting the ball the way we are."

The fiery Lobo offense dominated early and refused to let up. UNM got out to a 15-point lead less than five minutes into the first half, taking a 22-7 advantage with 15:38 still remaining in the first half. The Eagles went on an ensuing 7-0 run, testing the Lobo defense and cutting the home lead to eight, but UNM quickly pushed back ahead and extended the lead to 20 on a three from junior Troy Simons with 9:43 left.

The Lobos concluded the first-half performance with a trio of back-to-back-to-back 3-pointers, two from junior Anthony Mathis and a third from junior transfer Chris McNeal. McNeal collected four threes in the first half alone and helped pace UNM to a 74-point first-half showing, just two points shy of the UNM record for most

points in a single half. The record is 76, which occurred on November 23, 1990 against Texas-Arlington.

The Lobos shot 61 percent from the field in the first half (25-41) and 50 percent from 3-point range (10-20). Three players had reached double digits including McNeal (13), senior Sam Logwood (12) and freshman Makuach Maluach (11).

Junior Dane Kuiper opened the second half with a pair of free throws to put the Lobos up 40, 75-35.

Simons and freshman Vladimir Pinchuk shined in the second half, putting up 11 and 10 points, respectively en route to the victory.

McNeal burst on the scene in his first regular-season game as a Lobo with the first UNM double-double in points and assists since March 2, 2014. He posted a team-best 24 points on the night to go along with 10 assists.

Led by McNeal, eight of the 11 Lobos to hit the floor scored in double digits including Simons (19), Maluach (18), Kuiper (17), Mathis (16), Logwood (14), Pinchuk (12) and senior Antino Jackson (12).

As a team, the Lobos collected 40 assists and 22 steals, both ranking high in Lobo history. Forty assists ties the record for most in a game, which the Lobos had done twice previously, the first on December 16, 1978 against Central Florida and again on November 23, 1990 against Texas-Arlington. Twenty-two steals is the second-most in a game in team history (25 is the record).

On the night, UNM shot 64.7 percent (55-85) from the floor including 46.2 percent from three and 86.4 percent from the free-throw line. The Lobos' 55 field goals is just four shy of the record for most in a game. The Lobos posted 59 in the November 23, 1990 game against Texas-Arlington.

The Lobos also posted an outstanding 18 3-pointers on the night, just two short of the record 20 set on November 13, 2004 against Santa Clara, while defensively UNM posted six blocks and collected 32 defensive rebounds (45 overall). Senior Joe Furstinger led the way with three blocks.

The Lobos will have just a few days to rest before continuing their season start. UNM will play Nebraska-Omaha on Tuesday, Nov. ember14 at 7 p.m. on The Mountain West Network.

Omaha Falls 108-89 at Oklahoma

NORMAN, Okla. -- The Omaha men's basketball team took on Oklahoma for the first time Sunday afternoon, falling 108-89 at the Lloyd Noble Center. The Mavericks are now 0-2 in the midst of their season-opening road trip, while the Sooners improve to 1-0.

Leaders for Omaha

Junior Zach Jackson led a contingent of four Mavericks in double figures, scoring a career-high 24 points on 8-of-15 shooting and a 7-of-8 effort at the free throw line. He added six rebounds, two assists, two steals and a block.

Sophomore JT Gibson also had a career-best scoring performance, finishing with 16 points on 5-of-7 shooting with three 3-pointers alongside four rebounds, four assists and three steals. Junior Mitch Hahn chipped in 13 points with another trio of triples, as well as four rebounds, two assists, three steals and a block. Senior Daniel Norl rounded it out with 11 points, six boards, two assists and two steals.

Leaders for Oklahoma

Oklahoma was led by Trae Young, who tallied a double-double in his collegiate debut with 15 points, 10 assists, six rebounds, two steals and two blocks. Five other Sooners finished in double figures: Jamuni McNeace (14), Christian James (14), Matt Freeman (13), Brady Manek (11) and Jordan Shepherd (10). McNeace also had a game-high six blocks.

Team Stats

The Mavericks shot 43.8 percent (32-of-73) to Oklahoma's 55.7 percent (39-of-70). Omaha, which had just two 3-pointers in its season debut Friday night, hit 12 against the Sooners and finished at a 54.5 percent (12, of 22) diagram languages.

and finished at a 54.5 percent (12-of-22) clip from long range. OU had the advantage on the glass, 46-31, and outscored the Mavericks 50-32 in the paint.

Inside the First Half

Omaha shot 39.4 percent (13-of-33) in the first half but managed to hit six threes as a team. Oklahoma shot 54.1 percent (20-of-37) and took a 52-38 halftime lead behind 12 points from McNeace and six points, five boards and seven assists from Young. Jackson reached double figures before the break for Omaha with 11 points.

Inside the Second Half

The Mavericks shot an improved 47.5 percent (19-of-40) and cut the margin to 12 early in the second half, but OU pushed back out to a 17-point advantage. Omaha later went on a 10-0 run between 15:12 and 13:06, with a Hahn three punctuating it at 70-61. But the Sooners built up to a 20-point lead on a Brady Manek dunk with 5:32 left and led by at least 16 the rest of the way.

Up Next

Omaha returns to action on Tuesday, Nov. 14, visiting New Mexico. Tipoff is set for 8 p.m. CT in Albuquerque, N.M., and Gary Sharp will have the radio call on 1180 Zone 2. Links to live stats, audio and video will be available on OMavs.com.



Lobos Break Records in Season Opener, Win 147-76

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team shocked a crowd of over 10,500 fans in Dreamstyle Arena -The Pit in its first regular-season outing under first-year head coach Paul Weir on Saturday night. The Lobos shattered the UNM record for points scored in a game (136), claiming a 147-76 victory over Northern New Mexico.

The 71-point victory margin, also ties the nearly 45-year-old record for largest victory margin, which occurred on December 29, 1972 against Dartmouth at The Pit.

Northern New Mexico is now 2-8 on the season while the Lobos start out 1-0 for the 15th straight season.

"I am extremely thankful to every fan that came through the door tonight and hopefully they'll continue to come out and support us as we try and earn their trust and their respect as a basketball program," Coach Weir said. "Obviously (this was) the kind of offensive game we've been looking for. Our last scrimmage was a very similar outcome, so we're thankful that we're shooting the ball the way we are."

The fiery Lobo offense dominated early and refused to let up. UNM got out to a 15-point lead less than five minutes into the first half, taking a 22-7 advantage with 15:38 still remaining in the first half. The Eagles went on an ensuing 7-0 run, testing the Lobo defense and cutting the home lead to eight, but UNM quickly pushed back ahead and extended the lead to 20 on a three from junior Troy Simons with 9:43 left.

The Lobos concluded the first-half performance with a trio of back-to-back 3-pointers, two from junior Anthony Mathis and a third from junior transfer Chris McNeal. McNeal collected four threes in the first half alone and helped pace UNM to a 74-point first-half showing just two points shy of the UNM record for most points in a single half. The record is 76, which occurred on November 23, 1990 against Texas-Arlington.

The Lobos shot 61 percent from the field in the first half (25-41) and 50 percent from 3-point range (10-20). Three players had reached double digits including McNeal (13), senior Sam Logwood (12) and freshman Makuach Maluach (11).

Junior Dane Kuiper opened the second half with a pair of free throws to put the Lobos up 40, 75-35.

Simons and freshman Vladimir Pinchuk shined in the second half, putting up 11 and 10 points, respectively en route to the victory.

McNeal burst on the scene in his first regular-season game as a Lobo with the first UNM double-double in points and assists since March 2, 2014. He posted a team-best 24 points on the night to go along with 10 assists.

Led by McNeal, eight of the 11 Lobos to hit the floor scored in double digits including Simons (19), Maluach (18), Kuiper (17), Mathis (16), Logwood (14), Pinchuk (12) and senior Antino Jackson (12).

As a team, the Lobos collected 40 assists and 22 steals, both ranking high in Lobo history. Forty assists ties the record for most in a game, which the Lobos had done twice previously, the first on December 16, 1978 against Central Florida and again on November 23, 1990 against Texas-Arlington. Twenty-two steals is the second-most in a game in team history (25 is the record).

On the night, UNM shot 64.7 percent (55-85) from the floor including 46.2 percent from three and 86.4 percent from the free-throw line. The Lobos' 55 field goals is just four shy of the record for most in a game. The Lobos posted 59 in the November 23, 1990 game against Texas-Arlington.

The Lobos also posted an outstanding 18 3-pointers on the night, just two short of the record 20 set on November 13, 2004 against Santa Clara, while defensively UNM posted six blocks and collected 32 defensive rebounds (45 overall). Senior Joe Furstinger led the way with three blocks.

The Lobos will have just a few days to rest before continuing their season start. UNM will play Nebraska-Omaha on Tuesday, Nov.ember 14 at 7 p.m. on The Mountain West Network.
