#GoLobos at a Glance (#UNMvsBSU)

The Game:

The University of New Mexico Lobos (2-2, 1-0 MW) will look to move to 2-0 in Mountain West play, but the task is tall as the No. 19 Boise State Broncos (4-0, 1-0 Mountain West) are looking to do the same thing in a Friday night tilt at University Stadium.

The Coaches:

The University of New Mexico Lobos are coached by Bob Davie, who is 20-34 in his fifth season with the Lobos, and he is 55-59 overall in his 10th season. He spent his first five seasons as a head coach manning the Notre Dame Fighting Irish. For the Broncos, they are coached by Bryan Harsin who is in his third season with BSU, and his fourth overall. He is 25-6 with Boise State and 32-11 overall as he coached at Arkansas State for one season.

Series History:

The Broncos lead the all-time series 6-1, but the Lobos did win the last meeting 31-24 in Boise, just the fourth Bronco loss in the previous 100 games at home for BSU. That win, punctuated by a game-saving tackle by Markel Byrd, clinched UNM's first bowl berth under Bob Davie.

Under Bob Davie, three of the four games have been decided by 11 points or less, including a 32-29 loss at University Stadium in 2012.

Bob Davie Interview Opportunities

Coach Davie has several media availability times during the week. He is available after practices on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday. He also meets with the local media on Tuesday at noon as part of UNM's weekly fall sports media luncheon (other fall sport coaches meet with the media at 11:30 a.m. prior to Davie speaking).

For South Dakota (Thursday game), the entire week is pushed backwards two days.
 For Boise State week (Friday game), the entire week is pushed backwards one day.

New Mexico Media Luncheon

The New Mexico Media Luncheons are Tuesdays from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Coach Davie is available at approximately noon. Audio and video clips from Davie are available at www.golobos.com. The press conferences are also streamed on GoLobos.com by LoboTV. Please note that the Mountain West no longer will conduct a football coaches teleconference. The luncheon is on the Zia II level of the West Pressbox.

New Mexico Player Interview Opportunities

All player interviews must be arranged through the UNM athletics communications office. The main time for interviews is after practice. Wednesday is the last day for player interviews, and Tuesday is the last day for quarterback interviews. For lengthier interviews, please call the communications office to arrange, which we are happy to do, working around class schedules. These will normally take place in the communications suite in the Maloof Center.

Postgame: The UNM locker room is closed. Requested players will be brought to an area to be determined after home games and outside the locker room for road games.

For road games, all interviews will be posted to UNM's Media Dropbox account, along with selected highlights. These are provided for your usage, but please credit LoboTV.

Game Credentials

Regular UNM media will receive game credentials prior to the start of the season. For media members with season credentials, that pass also serves as a parking pass for the Baseball East or Baseball South lot across from the stadium.

Visiting team media should request single-game credentials through their team's media relations office. Parking passes for the Baseball East and media lots will be needed.

Media members not associated directly with a team can email requests to fmercog@unm.edu. Please have these Wednesday of game week (Tuesday for Friday night home games).

For media members picking up credentials at will call without parking passes, it is located in the Northeast corner of the stadium by Gate 7 or 8. For media members picking up with parking passes, credentials will be located at the University Drive entrance to the Baseball & Pit East lots with the parking attendant. This should allow you to get your credential without having to wait in line or deal with parking on the north side of the stadium.

The Opening List

The Lobos rushed for 446 yards against San Jose State on Saturday night, and that was the most yards rushing for UNM since getting, appropriately enough, 505 against Boise State in a wild and somewhat controversial 60-49 loss back in 2014. However, since Bob Davie has been at the helm, hitting the 400-yard mark rushing is really nothing new. While it's the second time UNM has done it this season, it's the 10th time in Davie's first 54 games, and those 400-yard games are the subject of this week's opening list.

Totally Great Offensive and Defensive Numbers

New Mexico currently ranks 35th nationally in total defense and 34th in total offense, and that total offense number should really be higher, as the team is averaging 476.0 yards per game, which in 2008 would actually rank as the No. 9 offense in the country. With UNM averaging 476.0 yards per game, the team would end the regular season with 5,712 yards at that pace, and that would be the best mark in school history. Here are all seven seasons of 5,000 yards for New Mexico football:

Rank and File

New Mexico traditionally has struggled against ranked opponents, as the Lobos all-time are just 5-52 overall against teams in the AP Top 25 polls. New Mexico is 3-25 at home against ranked teams, 2-26 on the road, and 0-1 in neutral sites (the 1997 WAC title game). The Lobos last defeated a ranked opponent in 2003 when the Lobos took down No. 23 Utah on October 25 by a 47-35 score. UNM's last home win over a ranked team was back in 1994, when the Lobos defeated No. 21 Utah 23-21.

UNM is 0-10 at home against ranked opponents since the last win in 1994, and the Lobos overall have dropped their last 16 games against ranked opponents.

A Pretty Good Run for the Defense So Far

The Lobos opened up this season with three straight games of allowing 350 yards or fewer, which is pretty good in this video game age of college football, but it's even better when looking at UNM's recent history. Those three games of 350 yards or fewer yards allowed equals the amount of times in the previous 44 games that UNM had allowed a team 350 or fewer yards, spanning three years, 10 months, one week and two days (or 1,409 days).

Lamar Moves Up to 24th

Lamar Jordan rushed for 45 yards on Saturday night, moving him into 24th place on the UNM career rushing list with 1,565 yards. He moved ahead of Sam Scarber, who rushed for 1,531 yards from 1968-70.

With him in 24th, it gives UNM three players in the top 25 in UNM rushing, joining Teriyon Gipson, who is 10th, and Cole Gautsche, who is 18th.

Rock Me Amadeus

When UNM needs a touchdown, it's handy to give the ball to "The Rock", Richard McQuarley. On Saturday, McQuarley scored three touchdowns, a career-high. It marked the first time that UNM had a someone rush for three touchdowns since Lamar Jordan did it against Arizona in the 2015 Gildan New Mexico Bowl.

McQuarley now leads UNM with seven touchdowns, and his seven rushing touchdowns is tied for seventh nationally. It also equals his entire total from last year, which he did in just four games as opposed to 13 last year.

McQuarley has 14 career rushing TDs, and he already is just five touchdowns out of being tied for 10th on the UNM single season rushing touchdowns list.

When 28 + 32 = 2

On UNM's special teams, Jake Rothschiller (number 28) was joined for the first time this season by Kyle Rothschiller (number 32). Jake and Kyle are identical twins, and they are one of seven sets of twins in the FBS that play the same position as both are defensive backs. Along with UNM, twins play the same position at Texas A&M, Rice, West Virginia, Maryland, BYU and FIU. Overall, they are one of 16 sets of twins that play for the same team in the FBS.

With the win over San Jose State to open the 2016 Mountain West season, New Mexico is 8-6 in its last 14 conference games. Those eight wins are more than in UNM's previous 50 conference games, as the Lobos were 7-43, a .140 winning percentage. UNM's 8-6 record is a .571 winning percentage.

Bell was an undrafted free agent and is his fifth season in the NFL and first with Tennessee after four with the Panthers. He has started 72 games in his NFL career, playing in 78 of 80 games. He was placed on injured reserve.

Saqwan Edwards Oakland Raiders **Cornerback**
Edwards was an undrafted free agent and is his second season in the NFL. He played in one game last season. He was placed on injured reserve.

Glover Quin Detroit Lions **Safety**
Quin completed his seventh season in the NFL, and third with Detroit. Glover was a 4th round draft choice, and the 112th overall pick by the Houston Texans in 2009. He has played in 111 out of a possible 112 games in his career with 511 total tackles, 3.0 sacks, five forced fumbles, four fumble recoveries, 19 interceptions and 71 passes defended.

There's No Time Like the Present

The Lobos are now 1-0 in Mountain West play for the fifth time since Mountain West play began. UNM, along with the win in 2016, won its opener in 1999, 2000, 2005 and 2015. Sanders Continues Kickoff Prowess, Despite Sea Level Conditions

Jason Sanders was a perfect 8-for-8 on kickoffs against San Jose State, hitting all eight for touchbacks. Sanders now has 12 consecutive touchbacks.

Sanders is currently ranked second nationally in touchback percentage as the Lobo junior has hit 24 of his 27 kickoffs for touchbacks, a mark of 88.9%. Overall his 24 touchbacks are tied for fifth nationally.

Jason Sanders hit all six extra points he attempted on Saturday, running his streak to 42 in a row. He would need four more to break into the top three on the UNM list, behind Wes Zunker, who hit 46 in a row over the 2003 and 2004 seasons. Joe Hartshorne made 47 in a row over the 1970 and 1971 seasons for the second-most, and Justus Adams hit 76 in a row over the 2012 and 2013 seasons.

Counting his streak with former kicker Zack Rogers, who hit 32, UNM has a current streak of 74 consecutive extra points made dating back to November 22, 2014.

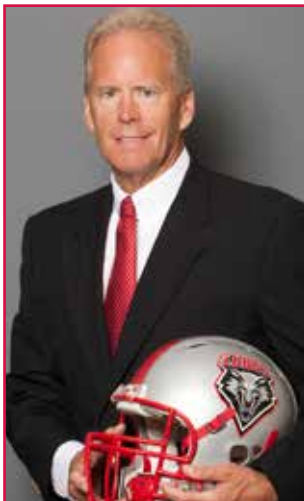

Bob Davie enters his fifth season at The University of New Mexico, where he has led the program back to bowl eligibility and a level of national respect as UNM qualified for the 2015 Gildan New Mexico Bowl, the first bowl game for the Lobos since 2007.

Davie's 18 wins in his first four seasons already has him tied for eighth on the career wins list at UNM, and he has helped the program achieve levels not seen in Albuquerque for many years. Yet it's how he has been able to do it that is what has Lobo fans excited for the program.

Davie has completely flipped and turned his rosters over, combining an energetic mix of talent from Texas and California while averaging nearly 25 native New Mexican players per season on the roster, with many of those major contributors.

It all clicked in 2015 as after 11 wins in his first three seasons which nearly quadrupled the previous three seasons' total, the program took a big leap, picking up three signature wins in the month of November as the Lobos clinched its first winning season and bowl game since the 2007 season. The Lobos knocked off three 10-win teams from a year ago, including a pair of stunning upsets to open November. First UNM took down first place Utah State 14-13. Then, UNM announced their presence to the college football world with a 31-24 victory on the road over Boise State to clinch bowl eligibility. UNM then defeated Mountain Division champions Air Force 47-35. Those wins were the first three wins over bowl eligible teams in the last seven seasons.

The Lobos tied for its most conference wins since the 1997 season with five. Offensively the team tied a school record with 42 rushing touchdowns and finished in the top 10 in the NCAA in rushing for the fourth straight season and was ninth nationally in fourth down conversion percentage and 11th in total conversions. UNM also led the nation in total plays from scrimmage of 60 yards or more (11) and 70 yards or more (7), showcasing the explosive offense.

Defensively, UNM ranked as the fourth-most improved defense in the nation in terms of yards allowed, shaving off 81.6 yards per game from 2014. UNM also shaved 7.5 points per game off their 2014 scoring defense, and that was the 15th most improved in the NCAA. UNM's rushing defense was the nation's third-most improved in terms of yards per game (76.3 yards per game less than 2014) and it was fourth in terms of yards per carry (1.29 yards per carry less than 2014).

All of that added up to a 7-5 regular season, a 5-3 mark and second place in the Mountain West's Mountain Division and a berth in the 2015 Gildan New Mexico Bowl, which UNM fought down to the wire in a 45-37 loss to Arizona. UNM picked up four All-Mountain West honors, including a Second Team selection as a returner for Carlos Wiggins. The Lobos also picked up 19 Mountain West All-Academic honors, the second-highest total in program history.

An overall hallmark of the program under Davie has been special teams, as UNM's eight touchdowns on kickoff returns over his first four seasons are tied with Kansas State for the most in the FBS over that time frame.

And the success and improvement isn't just on the field ... it's off it. In the first four seasons under Davie, the Lobos have picked up 69 Mountain West All-Academic selections, including a program record 20 in 2014, and 19 in 2015, the second-best total for football in school history. UNM also had five Mountain West Scholar-Athletes in 2013, the second-best total among the MW's 12 football programs.

Over his time, the Lobos have posted the second-highest single semester GPA in program history (Spring of 2016) and two of the top three Fall semester GPAs in program history (Fall of 2013 and Fall of 2015).
