## Post-game Notes:

- The Lobos went on a 23-8 run over the span of 7:07 in the first half to recover from a 15-point deficit to take the 27-26 lead over the Quakers at the 5:17 mark, which was their first lead of the game.
  - Of the 23 points, Anthony Mathis scored 13, Vance Jackson scored six, and Corey Manigault and Vladimir Pinchuk both netted two.
  - Mathis registered 10-straight points during the run that allowed UNM to tie the game at
    24 before Jackson's three helped the Lobos take the lead.
- UNM saw another run with 13:23 left in the second half that allowed the Lobos to regain the lead. The 9-0 run lasted 2:26 and included an and-one by Bragg followed by back-to-back 3-pointers by Keith McGee and Drue Drinnon.
- The Lobo bench outscored that of the Quakers 33-14.
- UNM had four players score in double digits including Carlton Bragg, Anthony Mathis and Corey Manigault who each tallied 13, along with 10 by Vance Jackson. It is the fifth time this year that the Lobos have had four players reach double figures.
- All nine of the Lobos who saw playing time scored at least once in the game.
- Manigault and Jackson tied for the team high in rebounds, both collecting eight on the afternoon.
  - Bragg posted seven boards in the contest, marking the redshirt-junior's third time in as many games that he has recorded seven rebounds.
  - Mathis posted a season-high five boards.
- The two squads recorded equal amounts of rebounds (41), while New Mexico led in steals (8-6), blocks (2-1) and assists (17-16).
