ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Lobos enter Tuesday's game against the Buffs coming off of a pair of tough losses at New Mexico State and against Saint Mary's in the Basketball Hall of Fame Classic.
- Colorado enters riding a five-game win streak including victories over Air Force (93-56), Portland, Colorado State (86-80), South Dakota and UIC.
- Tuesday's game will mark Hispanic Heritage Night in The Pit as the teams from Boulder and Albuquerque face off. The night will include special appearances and performances honoring Hispanic Heritage.
- The Lobos are ranked 24th in the country in 3-point field goals made per game (10.1). Colorado averages 7.9 (171st).
- The Buffs are currently 14th in the country in rebound margin (10.1) and 19th in scoring offense (85.1).
- The series is tied 7-7 with Colorado taking the last meeting in Boulder last season on Dec. 6, 75-57.
- Colorado is led by three players scoring in double figures including sophomore McKinley Wright (15.1), junior Lucas Siewert (12.1) and sophomore Tyler Bey (12.1). Bey also leads in rebounds with 8.5 per game.
- UNM is led by senior Anthony Mathis (14.0 ppg), junior Corey Manigault (12.8 ppg) and redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (12.4 ppg). Jackson is also the Lobos' leading rebounder with 7.1 per game.

SCOUTING COLORADO

Colorado enters Tuesday's game riding a five-game win streak that includes a pair of victories over Mountain West opponents Air Force (93-56) and Colorado State (86-80).

The Buffs are ranked 19th in the country in scoring offense with 85.1 points per game compared to 80.7 for the Lobos. CU is also outscoring its opponents by 16.3 points while UNM has been outscored by 5.4 points over the first seven contests of the season.

In the teams' last meeting last season on Dec. 6, the Buffs led by just two points at halftime, 35-33, before pulling away in the second half 40-24 for a 75-57 final. The Lobos came out of the game 3-6 on the season while Colorado improved to 7-1.

LAST TIME OUT

The Lobos dropped a 25-point contest to Saint Mary's (CA) on Friday night, 80-65, at the STAPLES Center in Los Angeles, Calif. in the 2018 Basketball Hall of Fame Classic. The Lobos were led by redshirt-sophomores Keith McGee who scored 12 points and Vance Jackson who tallied eight rebounds.

Senior Anthony Mathis, who was previously ranked first in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage and averages 3.4 threes per game, went scoreless from behind the arc (0-8) while scoring just twice from the floor.

TURNOVERS? NO PROBLEM.

While the Lobos have not done the best job protecting the basketball this season, posting 15.3 turnovers per game for a -0.4 turnover margin, it does not appear to be holding the Lobos back. UNM is 3-1 this season when having more turnovers than its opponent.

In fact, in Tuesday's loss at NM State, the Lobos had the least amount of turnovers

than in any other game this season with 11. They followed it up with just 10 turnovers in the loss to Saint Mary's for a new season-low.

"NEXT POSSESSION"

If one listens closely during a Lobo basketball game, he/she can hear "next possession" coming constantly from the bench. The "next possession" mentality focuses on letting go of mistakes from the past and focusing on promise of the future.

Throughout the first five games of the season, the Lobos shot 88.0 points per game and were ranked the 13th-best scoring team in the nation. Despite last week's tough results, the Lobos are looking to move forward toward the "next possession."

IT'S RAINING THREES

Even in a loss, the Lobos are still shooting 10 or more 3-pointers per game consistently. The Lobos achieved the feat in the first six of their seven games this season. So far in 2018-19, the Lobos have scored 71 times from behind the arc.

WELL-BALANCED SQUAD

Last week, senior leaders Anthony Mathis and Dane Kuiper were held almost quiet, combining for seven points against NM State and six against Saint Mary's. In their place, freshman guard Drue Drinnon and redshirt-sophomore guard Vance Jackson picked up the slack, scoring 13 and 11 points, respectively against the Aggies. In UNM's loss to Saint Mary's it was redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee and sophomore Makuach Maluach who registered double figures (12, 10 points).

The Lobo squad is so balanced that nine of UNM's 11 players who have touched the court so far this season have scored in double figures at least once in the first seven games.

AND THEN THERE WERE NONE ...

Sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk started the first four games for the Lobos and was the only consistent starter - until Dec. 1 against Bradley. That lineup featured three freshman, senior Dane Kuiper and sophomore Makuach Maluach. The Lobos officially no longer have a single player that has started in all of their games.

In addition, senior Dane Kuiper marks the lone starter to return from last season and he has started just once this season in Coach Weir's system of deflections.

DRINNON BREAKS OUT

Rivalry games are typically full of nerves

for freshmen, especially true freshmen. But freshman Drue Drinnon stepped up and stood out on Tuesday night against NM State while the rest of the Lobo squad struggled. He put up 13 points in the second half to try to power the Lobos to a comeback. UNM was outscored by just seven points in the second half in the 35-point loss.

In Friday's game against Saint Mary's, the shortest player on the Lobo squad registered UNM's lone block on the night and saw 27 minutes on the court.

MISSING MANIGAULT

The Lobos were down one of their top three scorers against Saint Mary's Friday as junior Corey Manigault was benched as a consequence of an incident that occurred prior to the UNM at NM State game on Dec. 4.

MATHIS 26TH IN THE NATION

Lobo senior Anthony Mathis is currently ranked 26th in the nation in 3-point field goals per game (3.43) and 32nd in 3-point field goal percentage (47.1).

ABOUT THE 2018-19 LOBOS

The 2018-19 Lobos have just four returning letterwinners from the 2017-18 squad, including leading-scorer Anthony Mathis (12.7 ppg) who finished fourth in the nation in 3-point percentage and broke the UNM record for most 3-point field goals in a conference season (66) as a junior. The squad also adds nine newcomers and returns a pair of sitting transfers to the team that finished third in Mountain West regular-season play last season.

In addition to Mathis, UNM's returners include senior Dane Kuiper, who is the lone returning starter, and sophomores Makuach Maluach and Vladimir Pinchuk. Maluach finished his inaugural season averaging 9.6 points per game and ranks fourth all-time on the Lobo freshman single-season scoring list.

fifhtupleing his career point production as a junior - that's right, in two seasons at UNM, Mathis scored just 86 points in 228 minutes, and multiplied that total by five in his junior season. In 2017-18, Mathis took the term "breakout" to a whole new level, dropping 433 points in 760 minutes on the floor. His shot from 3-point range couldn't be stopped as he finished the season with a program-record 66 3-pointers in conference play. He also fired from behind the arc at a clip of 47.3%, ranking fourth in the nation among other NCAA DI players.

THE STUDENT BECOMES THE MASTER

After posting a breakout inaugural season of his own last year, sophomore Makuach Maluach is expected to be a high-profile returner for the Lobos this year. He's been ranked on several preseason lists and even made the cover of Lindy's Sports Magazine in August. Most recently, the soft-spoken sophomore was ranked 19th on the Mountain West Wire's Top 25.

CONSISTENCY IS OVERRATED

Last season, the Lobos debuted the most starting lineups in NCAA Division I with 21. Coach Weir made it clear in his first season that starting lineups would be determined by the numbers of deflections a player accumulated in the previous game, hence the sky-high number of lineup combos.

MW PRESEASON NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR

Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson was named 2018 Mountain West Preseason Newcomer of the Year following the league's media poll in October. Jackson transferred from UCONN where he shot 40.9 percent from the field, 39.7 from behind the arc as a freshman in 2016-17. He reached double figures in 13 games and led the team twice in scoring in his inaugural collegiate season.

WE'RE NOT IN KANSAS ANYMORE ...

The Lobos return a pair of transfers that sat out last year and also welcome five more, including the highly-anticipated Carlton Bragg (Kansas/ASU transfer) who is currently eligible for conference play. Joining Bragg

REMEMBERING LAST SEASON

The 2017-18 Lobos were picked to finish ninth in league play, but shocked everyone when they pulled off a third-place finish in regular-season play, earned the MW Tournament bye and took on San Diego State in the Championship game, falling by just seven points.

The Lobos also ranked 15th out of 351 NCAA Division I teams in turnover percentage last season.

RECORDS ARE MEANT TO BE BROKEN

En route to their first appearance in the league championship since 2014, the Lobos broke the program records for 3-pointers in a season (367), most 3-point field goals attempted (979) and highest free throw percentage (77.7%). For reference, the previous records were 301, 782 and 75.7%, respectively.

As a team, the Lobos also broke the record for most points in a game (147 vs Northern New Mexico), most points in a conference game (119 at Wyoming) and most points in a conference season (1,507). Old records for the above: 136, 113 and 1,373, respectively.

STELLAR SCHEDULE

The Lobos are taking on a field of top-notch teams this season including five squads that advanced to the 2018 NCAA Tournament. Last season's Big Dance squads include New Mexico State, Iona, Penn, San Diego State and Nevada. With UNM facing NMSU, SDSU and Nevada twice apiece, that makes for eight games against NCAA post-season opponents, not to mention a matchup with last season's CBI tourney winner, North Texas.

UNDER THE RADAR

This offseason, the Lobos were ranked by the NCAA's Andy Katz as one of five "under the radar" teams to watch this season.

Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (UCONN) will finally get his chance to don the Cherry and Silver this season and was named 2018 MW Newcomer of the Year. Jackson’s fellow bench-warmer last season, Ohio State transfer JaQuan Lyle, suffered an Achilles injury during practice in September and is expected to miss the 2018-19 season. Two more transfers of note include Towson’s Zane Martin, who will be sitting out in 2018-19 due to NCAA transfer rules, and redshirt-freshman Clay Patterson. A native of Rio Rancho, N.M., Patterson transferred back home from NCAA DII Fort Lewis. He is eligible to compete in 2018-19.

BRINGING PEOPLE TOGETHER

The Lobo squad is as varied as it gets when it comes to hometown pride. Each player on the team is from not only a different town, but a different state or country entirely! With the late addition of walk-on Clay Patterson, the only exception is a pair of native New Mexicans. States and countries represented include: Pennsylvania, Maryland, California, New York, Florida, Australia, Indiana, Alaska, Germany, Georgia, France, Oregon, New Mexico and Ohio.

THERE’S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

The famous home of Lobo basketball enters its second year under the name “Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit” as part of an exciting renaming of both of UNM’s largest-capacity athletic venues.

This July, “The Pit” was tabbed #17 on the top-30 list of best arena atmospheres in college hoops by the NCAA.

“The Pit” has also been consistently recognized nationally as one of the nation’s top basketball venues. Sports Illustrated has ranked it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico men’s basketball program. Since the Mountain West conference began in 1999-2000, New Mexico has ranked in the top two in home attendance among MW teams in every year except one, including 12 seasons as the top-ranked MW team in overall attendance.

Lobos Fall to Saint Mary's in BHOF Classic

LOS ANGELES, Calif. --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team dropped a 25-point contest to Saint Mary's (CA) on Friday night, 80-65, at the STAPLES Center in Los Angeles, Calif. in the 2018 Basketball Hall of Fame Classic. The Lobos were led by redshirt-sophomores Keith McGee who scored 12 points and Vance Jackson who tallied eight rebounds.

"These last two games have been exposing to us in a lot of ways that we're not where we want to be," head coach Paul Weir said. "(Right now) we're 4-3, we've won some games that I was really really happy about, we've lost two games by incredibly wide margins, and we just have to keep pushing forward from here.

"Hopefully the reps that we're getting these guys, just like the reps for the guys last year, will allow us to grow as the season unfolds and make us a really good team as the season unfolds."

Just two Lobos scored in double figures on the night including McGee and sophomore Makuach Maluach (10), followed by sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk (9) and Jackson (9). Saint Mary's (6-4) was led by a trio of double-digit scorers including Jordan Ford who went 10-for-15 from the floor en route to 28 points. Ford was followed by Malik Fitts (15) and Tommy Kuhse (10).

The Lobos (4-3) were outshot 34.8 - 60.0 percent from the floor and 15.4 - 33.3 percent from 3-point range. Seniors Anthony Mathis and Dane Kuiper combined for 0-11 behind the arc, contributing to UNM's season-low four 3-pointers on the night. Friday night's game marks the first time this season the Lobos have failed to reach 10 or more threes.

Like the last couple of matchups, UNM got out to a slow start, getting behind by 15 points in the first 6:35 by a score of 19-4. Saint Mary's eventually pushed the lead to 17 with 7:41 left in the first but the Lobos went on an 8-2 run that included four points by Pinchuk and layups from Maluach and McGee to make it an 11-point game, 35-24.

The Gaels hit a free throw but freshman Drue Drinnon followed with a three at the 3:02 mark to cut the Saint Mary's lead back to single digits, 36-27. The comeback was short lived however, as the Gaels once again increased their lead and finished the half on top by 14, 43-29.

At halftime, UNM was shooting 38.7 percent from the floor and 20.0 percent from 3-point range compared to 53.8 and 20.0 percent for the Gaels. Mathis and Kuiper went scoreless throughout the first half including an 0-for-4 mark from behind the arc for Mathis. Kuiper registered three fouls early and saw action in just 15 minutes on the night.

The Lobos looked to capitalize on some carryover momentum from near the end of the first half, but Saint Mary's quickly dispelled that hope. The Gaels exploded for a 13-0 run, forcing Coach Weir to call a timeout, and converted it to a 17-1 run to make it a 30-point game, 60-30, just four minutes into the half.

It was then that Mathis registered his first (and only) points of the game on back-to-back jumpers. The Gaels held a 25+ lead for the remainder of the game.

UNM turned the ball over just 10 times on the night and turned over Saint Mary's 15 times. Ten turnovers marks the least of any game so far this season for the Lobos while the next lowest of the season was 11 against NM State on Tuesday night - two of UNM's largest losses.

The Lobos were missing junior Corey Manigault on Friday night, sitting out due to a pregame incident that occurred Tuesday night. Manigault averages 12.8 points per game.

UNM returns to action on Tuesday night (December 11) at home against Colorado. Tipoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. on ESPN2.

Lobos Defeated at Colorado in Second Half

BOULDER, COLO. --- Despite a strong first-half performance, The University of New Mexico men's basketball team suffered a 75-57 loss on the road at Colorado on Wednesday night, letting a two-point halftime margin slip away over the final 10 minutes of the game.

Junior Anthony Mathis led the Lobos (3-6) with 15 points, just one shy of his career-high, as the only Lobo to score in double figures. Mathis went for 5-for-9 from the field including 3-for-6 from three and 2-for-3 from the free throw line.

The Lobos started out strong, turning the Buffalos (7-1) over three times in just the first three minutes, exhibiting an outstanding defense that burst on the scene with arguably the most energy and intensity it has had all season. UNM held the Buffs scoreless for the first two minutes of the game and eventually forced 23 turnovers.

"I think defensively, it was a little bit of a step forward for us tonight, particularly the first 28-29, actually 31-32 minutes," head coach Paul Weir said. "I thought our defensive energy was really good and man if we could just find a way to convert some layups and some free throws I really think it would put us over the top."

The Lobos struggled from the floor going 21-for-71 for a season-low 29.6 percent field-goal percentage while shooting 29.0 percent from three (9-31) on the night.

"We got a lot of really good looks I thought around the rim, (Colorado) just did a really good job of protecting the glass," Weir said. "When you get 20 more shots than your opponent, you usually feel really good about what you did, but we just weren't able to convert a lot of shots around the rim."

The Buffalos shot 50 percent from the floor (26-52) and 60 percent (9-15) from three, taking advantage of their opportunities. CU slowly gained an 11-point lead midway through the first half, but the resilient Lobos went on an 11-2 run to erase the advantage, cutting the Buffalo lead to one, 29-28 with 1:58 left in the first half. The run was capped by a Mathis three and a dunk by freshman Makuach Maluach.

A 3-pointer from junior Troy Simons tied it up at 33 apiece with 43 seconds on the clock and the Buffs put in one more to make it 35-33 at the half.

Maluach nearly tied it up again, attempting to toss in a layup just before the buzzer, but the clock expired just before the shot went in.

The Lobos kept the game close early in the second half, continuing the momentum from the first. A dunk by senior Joe Furstinger tied it up at 35-35 and UNM held the Buffs within six points until the 9:29 mark when Colorado's McKinley Wright hit a jumper to extend the CU lead to eight, 56-48.

Despite a follow-up three from Mathis to cut it back to five, the Buffs took off from there and finished 19-9 for the 18-point victory that included a last-second three from Dominique Collier.

Despite the loss, the Lobos led in several statistical categories including points in the paint (31-30), points off of turnovers (28-7), second-chance points (9-8), fast-break points (11-6) and bench points (36-35).

The Lobos, previously ranked 17th in the nation in free throw percentage, shot a season-low 37.5 percent from the stripe (6-16).

"I think we played with a lot of energy in both halves," Mathis said. "I just think it was a matter of shots going in (in the first half) and then shots not going in (in the second half). Overall I think we played really hard, we're taking steps, it's just one step at a time."

The Lobos look to rebound when they take on New Mexico State in the in-state rivalry rematch at Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit on Saturday night. Tip off is scheduled for 7:02 p.m. on ESPN3.

Wright's Run Lifts Buffs To Win Over UIC

BOULDER — While Colorado's defense may not have been at its best Saturday afternoon, McKinley Wright IV was, particularly down the stretch.

That was enough for the Buffs. The sophomore point guard scored CU's final 10 points of the game, including all eight in a decisive 8-0 CU run, to lift the Buffs to an 84-72 win over Illinois-Chicago.

Colorado won its fifth straight to improve to 7-1 while UIC dropped to 4-6. CU also surpassed the 80-point barrier for the fifth straight time and sixth time this season.

Wright finished with 21 points, nine assists and six rebounds. Sophomore forward Tyler Bey collected his second double-double of the year with a 15-point, 15-rebound effort (a career high), and Shane Gatling and D'Shawn Schwartz each scored 12 for Colorado.

Marcus Ottey led the Flames with 22 points, as UIC shot 56.6 percent from the field (30-for-53). A big difference came at the free throw line, where Colorado hit 25 of 33 attempts while UIC was 6-for-10 from the stripe.

The Buffs finished with 16 turnovers, but forced 24 UIC miscues, which Colorado converted into 20 points. The Buffs also scored 50 points in the second half, the fifth time this season they have scored at least 50 after intermission.

"That was a hard-fought win against a really talented UIC team," head coach Tad Boyle said. "We have a lot of room for improvement after a game like this, but we'll take it."

HOW IT HAPPENED: Wright's run started after UIC's Godwin Boahen hit a 3-pointer to pull the Flames within four, 74-70, with just more than three minutes to play.

Wright hit two free throws at the 2:20 mark to bump CU's margin to six, then hit a basket in the lane after a steal 20 seconds later. He drew an offensive foul on UIC's next possession and followed it up with another basket to give CU a 10-point cushion with 1:35 to play.

Wright also had a key rebound in the final minute, hit two free throws with 40 seconds left to give Colorado a 12-point cushion, and then iced the game with two more free throws with 30 seconds remaining.

"He's just a winner," CU head coach Tad Boyle said. "He makes winning plays. We expect so much of him and he just makes big plays down the stretch."

Wright credited his teammates with his key run.

"My teammates just do a good job of helping me create shots, get open and be able to attack the rim," he said. "Without those guys, I'm not going to be able to do that, so all the credit goes to them."

The Buffs never trailed in the game, and led for nearly 38 of the 40 minutes. But every time Colorado threatened to build a comfortable cushion, the hot-shooting Flames had an answer. CU led by five at the half, had 10-point leads at several junctures after intermission, and pushed the lead to 11 with 4:33 to go.

But the Buffs could not put the game away until the final two minutes. It was the second time in a week that the Buffs allowed an opponent to shoot better than 50 percent from the field, as CSU also managed the feat in an 86-80 Colorado win on Dec. 1.

"It seems like they couldn't miss," Wright said. "We have to do a better job of helping each other and having each other's back. We'll watch film and get better."

Colorado did do a good job on UIC leading scorer Tarkus Ferguson, holding him to just three points, 14 under his average. But along with Ottey's 22 — most of which came on drives to the rim — the Flames also got 20 from Jordan Blount and 15 from Boahen. The Flames did most of their damage in the paint, outscoring Colorado 42-30 near the rim.

Still, the Buffs made plays when necessary. CU held a solid 36-28 edge on the boards, which helped the Buffs to a 16-2 edge in second-chance points. Four of Bey's 15 rebounds were on the offensive end, and he finished with 33 minutes, 16 seconds of playing time, also a career high.

"I honestly just come into the game and do whatever I have to do to win," Bey said. "I'm trying to be consistent every game and that's one thing me and coach talked about before the season started."

It was Bey's fourth career double-double and second of the season, while Wright was just one assist short of his second double-double of the year.

"We forget that McKinley is a sophomore and Tyler is a sophomore," Boyle said. "We expect so much of them because they are so important to our team. We have to keep getting better."

TURNING POINT: The game was up for grabs until Wright sparked an 8-0 Colorado run over the final two minutes. Wright had back-to-back baskets, fueled by a steal and offensive charge, in a 20-second stretch with just under two minutes to play that pushed CU's lead to 10 with 1:35 to go.

WHAT IT MEANS: With a five-game win streak, the Buffs hope to take that confidence and momentum on the road, as they play their next six away from home, including Tuesday's game at New Mexico, followed by three games at the Diamond Head Classic in Hawaii before their Pac-12 opening weekend at Arizona (Jan. 3) and Arizona State (Jan. 5).

CU STANDOUTS: The Buffs had four players in double figures, led by McKinley Wright with 21 points, nine assists, six rebounds and three steals. ... Tyler Bey had a 15-point, 15-rebound double-double, his second of the season. ... Shane Gatling and D'Shawn Schwartz each scored 12 points.

KEY STATISTICS: The Buffs had 36-28 edge on the boards that paved the way for a 16-2 edge in second-chance points. Colorado also forced 24 turnovers and and reaped 20 points off those UIC miscues.

QUOTEWORTHY: "We are not where we need to be defensively. That is a concern of mine as we head into this stretch (Colorado plays its next six games away from home). We just haven't shown it on a consistent basis against quality teams. We're going to see some quality teams and we have to get better. (But) the one thing about our team that is nice is that we're explosive offensively." — CU head coach Tad Boyle.

NEXT UP: The Buffs head to New Mexico on Tuesday for a 7 p.m. game with the Lobos.

THE GREATEST GAME EVER PLAYED

The Pit was the site of one of the greatest college basketball games ever played. It hosted the 1983 national championship game that saw the NC State Wolfpack upset Hakeem Olajuwon, Clyde Drexler and the Houston Cougars. Coach Jimmy Valvano and the Wolfpack downed the Cougars on a last second put back by Lorenzo Charles. The iconic shot of the late Valvano running onto the court looking for a hug is one of the lasting images in college basketball history.

- The Lobos have averaged an astounding 15,410 fans the past 49 years, an amazing 95% of capacity
- The Pit has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally nearly every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.

Lobos Win Opener on Mathis 3-Point Buzzer-Beater

NORTHRIDGE, Calif. --- Senior Anthony Mathis of The University of New Mexico men's basketball team hit a buzzer-beating three to lift the Lobos over the CSUN Matadors on Tuesday night, officially opening the 2018-19 season with an exciting 87-84 victory. Four Lobos scored in double figures on the night that saw UNM's new squad shoot 50.9 percent from the floor and 42.3 percent from 3-point range.

The Lobos (1-0) and the Matadors (0-1) battled throughout 40 minutes with 13 lead changes and six ties.

Despite a shaky start full of first-game-of-the-season-nerve, UNM outshot CSUN in every category including from the floor (51.9 - 45.8 percent) from behind the arc (42.3 - 35.0 percent) and from the free throw line (75.9 - 52.4 percent).

In his first game as a Lobo, junior Corey Manigault led the squad on the night with 16 points going 4-for-6 from the floor and 8-for-9 from the charity stripe. Senior Dane Kuiper and sophomore Makuach Maluach followed with 15 points apiece. Kuiper went 4-for-5 from behind the arc, 5-for-8 from the floor and Maluach was 5-for-9 from the floor with a three and four free throws.

Mathis was the fourth player to score in double figures, registering 12 points with a 4-for-7 performance from 3-point range.

CSUN freshman Lamine Diane led all players on the night with 34 points going 15-for-28 from the field. Diane scored 30 and 23 points in CSUN's exhibition matchups.

"Ball control was clearly an issue for us tonight," head coach Paul Weir said. "Our size was almost a problem tonight (because CSUN was so quick), but you've got to tip your cap to CSUN, they played their hearts out. Diane is a tremendous player, puts a lot of pressure on defenses, particularly on the glass, and they were able to go out and show that tonight."

The Lobos opened Tuesday night's contest with a 2:54 drought before sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk registered UNM's first points on a pair of free throws with 17:06 on the clock to make it 6-2 CSUN. A minute later, Manigault shot a pair of free throws to make it 6-4 but the Lobos did not score from the floor until 5:08 into the game when Kuiper hit a jumper to make it 8-6 Matadors.

Kuiper's jumper was followed by a three-pointer just 32 seconds later to spark a Lobo 10-0 run over 2:57, putting UNM on top 16-10.

Both teams continued to respond and with CSUN leading by one at the conclusion of the half, a foul was called at the buzzer that sent Maluach to the line. He hit the shot and tied it 42-42 heading into the locker room.

Over the first half, UNM was out-rebounded 21-15.

Once again it was Kuiper in the second half to give the Lobo offense life as he came out of the locker room with the first six points for UNM on a pair of three split by a jumper by Diane, 48-44.

The fifth tie of the game occurred at the 4:07 mark when redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson hit a free throw to tie it up 77-77. The Lobos built a four-point lead, 84-80 before a layup by CSUN's Cameron Gottfried made it 84-82, with just 30 seconds left on the clock.

The Lobos attempted to keep the ball and run down the clock but a UNM turnover allowed the Matadors to have one more possession that ended in another jumper by Diane to make it 84-84 with 6.1 seconds left.

The Lobos gained possession with the clock winding down and took about 4.5 seconds to cross half-court. Mathis looked up, saw the clock and took a long three from the right wing and sunk it for the win, 87-84.

On the night, CSUN dominated in the paint, 44-24 and registered 25 points off of turnovers compared to 22 for UNM. CSUN also tallied 13 second-chance points to just four for the Lobos and 12 on the fast break.

The Lobos are set to return to action on Saturday, Nov. 10 when they take on Northern New Mexico in exhibition competition as part of the second-annual New Mexico Classic tournament hosted by UNM.

Lobos Open 2-0 With 90-83 Win over Iona

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- Two Lobos racked up double-doubles on Tuesday night as The University of New Mexico men's basketball team earned a 90-83 win over the visiting Iona Gaels to start the 2018-19 season 2-0. Junior Corey Manigault and redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson led the Lobos with 20 and 18 points, respectively while collecting 10 and 12 boards apiece.

The victory marks the 16th straight season in which the Lobos came away with the win in their home opener.

After a slow start offensively, seniors Anthony Mathis and Dane Kuiper closed the game, combining for the thrilling final 10 points, including a pair of fast-break layups, to keep the Lobos on top throughout the final three minutes.

"The depth that we have, the way we spread our minutes and the style that we play allowed us to break away at the end and get a big win," head coach Paul Weir said. "It was a good basketball team that we beat, and we have come a long way in the last 12 months. We have not arrived and we have a lot of work to do the next few days in order to continue to get better, but just to get a win against a good basketball team early in the year shows our progression as a program."

The Lobos held the lead for 24:35 of the game that had nine lead changes and five ties. On the night, UNM outshot Iona from the floor 50.9 - 40.0 percent and 40.0 - 34.6 percent from behind the arc. Five Lobos scored in double figures including Manigault (20), Jackson (18), Mathis (14), redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee (13) and sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk (10).

Pinchuk's 10 points went along with seven rebounds, one steal, three assists and two blocks in a new career-high 30 minutes.

With just 7:05 left in the game and the Lobos down by one, 72-71, Manigault poked the ball out of the hands of Iona's Isaiah Still, raced to the other end of the court unguarded and slammed a crowd-pleasing dunk to put the Lobos back on top for the final time, 73-72.

When the Gaels reduced the Lobo lead back to one, 75-74, sophomore Makuach Maluach sunk a dagger of a three at 5:28 that put the Lobos back up by four, 78-74. Iona was able to take a five-point lead to just two, 80-78, at the 2:59 mark on a Still three before Mathis nailed his fourth 3-pointer of the night to put the Lobos back up by five, 83-78, and spark a Lobo offensive surge through the final minutes.

The Gaels would get no closer than three as Kuiper drilled his lone three of the night - a big one - with 1:52 left, 86-80, followed by a pair of fast-break layups from Mathis and Kuiper to keep the crowd of over 10,000 fans roaring through the end.

The Lobos forced 15 turnovers and posted five blocks, including two from Pinchuk. UNM also collected 19 assists to just 15 for Iona.

UNM went down by as much as five points in the back-and-forth first half that featured a 10-0 Iona run at the 13:43 mark. UNM battled back and responded with a 11-0 run with just 5:30 left in the first half to head into the locker room tied 39-39.

The Lobos came out of the halftime break with the first six points to take a commanding 45-39 lead before Iona whittled it back down to one with 16:20 on the clock.

Overall the teams finished relatively even in points off of turnovers (15-14 UNM), points in the paint (28 apiece), second-chance points (13-12 UNM), fast-break points (31-29 Iona) and bench points (29-20 UNM).

The Lobos return to action on Saturday, November 17 when they take on in-state rival New Mexico State for a 4 p.m. clash in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit. The game will be the Lobos' Nike TV contest featuring the highly-anticipated turquoise uniforms and will be televised on AT&T SportsNet.

Late Comeback Falls Short, Three score 20+ Points

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- After falling behind by as much as 19 points with just 9:08 left to play, The University of New Mexico men's basketball team put on an impressive show in a comeback attempt that saw the Lobos rack up a 13-0 second-half run in front of over 14,000 fans inside Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit. The run fell short however, as UNM eventually suffered a four-point loss, 98-94, to the Aggies in the Rio Grande Rivalry matchup.

A trio of Lobos racked up 20 points or more including redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson (27), senior Anthony Mathis (22) and junior Corey Manigault (20). The game marks Manigault's second straight in which he has netted 20 points. The fourth Lobo to score in double figures was senior Dane Kuiper, who posted 10.

Jackson added a team-high six rebounds to his 27 points and drew nine fouls on the night. He was also one of six Lobos to accumulate four or more fouls.

The Lobos outshot NMSU in every category including 59.6 - 56.6 percent from the field, 55.0 - 52.2 percent from behind the arc and 70.0 - 66.7 percent from the foul line, but the Aggies' redshirt-junior AJ Harris went an unstoppable 9-for-11 from the field, 6-for-6 from 3-point range and 7-for-10 from the free throw line to total 31 points, leading NMSU to victory. NMSU also knocked in 26 free throws compared to 21 for UNM, accounting for the four-point differential.

"First, thank you so much to all of the fans that came out today," head coach Paul Weir said in a press conference. "It was an exceptional sign of how far I think we've grown and where our program is hopefully headed. Unfortunately, the result is not what we wanted. It's incredibly disappointing, and inevitably that falls on me."

The teams remained within three points over the first five minutes until the Lobos began to pull ahead on a Mathis three and a jumper by sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk, making the score 13-5 for an eight-point lead, the most for UNM of the day.

The Aggies closed the gap and claimed a one-point advantage, 14-13, with 9:46 left in the first half and extended it to six at the break, 44-38. It was the first time the Lobos have been down at the half so far this season as UNM has tied its opponents heading into the break in both of its first two regular-season games.

Mathis cut the six-point deficit to three within the first 12 seconds of the second half (44-41) to set the tone, but NMSU took off on a 16-3 run over the ensuing 4:34 to get back out to a commanding 16-point lead, 60-44.

It was then that Manigault took the game into his own hands, scoring the next 10 points for the Lobos on three field goals and four free throws. Manigault scored eight points in 56 seconds including a 5-0 run to reduce the deficit to 11-49, before he was substituted at the 13:02 mark with NMSU leading by 13, 65-52.

Manigault was off the floor for 1:42 during which the Lobos endured a scoring drought and allowed the Aggies to pull back ahead by 19. Manigault returned and hit a jumper at the 10:36 mark to cut it back to 17 as UNM continued to battle.

With the Aggies up by 19 for the third time in the contest, the Lobos erupted for a 16-5 run over 3:15 to cut the score back to single digits, 80-72, with 5:12 on the clock. After suffering another barrage of Aggie points, UNM cut another 14-point deficit down to eight over 1:15 on a pair of threes by Mathis and Jackson, as well as a pair of Mathis free throws with 1:10 left, 92-84.

The score was 96-89 with just 34 seconds left on the clock and the game looked over until Jackson hit a huge three to make it a four-point game followed by a Weir timeout.

Mathis notched a layup out of the timeout to make it a two-point game with seven seconds left but with little time left on the clock, the Lobos were forced to play the foul game, allowing for a pair of free throws from NMSU for the 98-94 final.

The Lobos caught 14 turnovers, committing 15, and collected eight steals to six for NMSU. The Aggies capitalized on turnovers for 23 points compared to 18 for UNM while the Lobos outscored NMSU 32-30 in the paint.

UNM has a week to recuperate before returning to action on Saturday, Nov. 24 when it hosts UTEP at 5:30 p.m. on the Mountain West Network.

Lobos Fall to Saint Mary's in BHOF Classic

LOS ANGELES, Calif. --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team dropped a 25-point contest to Saint Mary's (CA) on Friday night, 80-65, at the STAPLES Center in Los Angeles, Calif. in the 2018 Basketball Hall of Fame Classic. The Lobos were led by redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson who scored 12 points and tallied eight rebounds.

"These last two games have been exposing to us in a lot of ways that we're not where we want to be," head coach Paul Weir said. "(Right now) we're 4-3, we've won some games that I was really really happy about, we've lost two games by incredibly wide margins, and we just have to keep pushing forward from here.

"Hopefully the reps that we're getting these guys, just like the reps for the guys last year, will allow us to grow as the season unfolds and make us a really good team as the season unfolds."

Just two Lobos scored in double figures on the night including Jackson and sophomore Makuach Maluach (10), followed by sophomore Vladimir Pinchuk (9). Saint Mary's (6-4) was led by a trio of double-digit scorers including Jordan Ford who went 10-for-15 from the floor en route to 28 points. Hunter was followed by Malik Fitts (15) and Tommy Kuhse (10).

The Lobos (4-3) were outshot 34.8 - 60.0 percent from the floor and 15.4 - 33.3 percent from 3-point range. Seniors Anthony Mathis and Dane Kuiper combined for 0-11 behind the arc, contributing to UNM's season-low four 3-pointers on the night. Friday night's game marks the first time this season the Lobos have failed to reach 10 or more threes.

Like the last couple of matchups, UNM got out to a slow start, getting behind by 15 points in the first 6:35 by a score of 19-4. Saint Mary's eventually pushed the lead to 17 with 7:41 left in the first but the Lobos went on an 8-2 run that included four points by Pinchuk and layups from Maluach and redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee to make it an 11-point game, 35-24.

The Gaels hit a free throw but freshman Drue Drinnon followed with a three at the 3:02 mark to cut the Saint Mary's lead back to single digits, 36-27. The comeback was short lived however, as the Gaels once again increased their lead and finished the half on top by 14, 43-29.

At halftime, UNM was shooting 38.7 percent from the floor and 20.0 percent from 3-point range compared to 53.8 and 20.0 percent for the Gaels. Mathis and Kuiper went scoreless throughout the first half including an 0-for-4 mark from behind the arc for Mathis. Kuiper registered three fouls early and saw action in just 15 minutes on the night.

The Lobos looked to capitalize on some carryover momentum from near the end of the first half, but Saint Mary's quickly dispelled that hope. The Gaels exploded for a 13-0 run, forcing Coach Weir to call a timeout, and converted it to a 17-1 run to make it a 30-point game, 60-30, just four minutes into the half.

It was then that Mathis registered his first (and only) points of the game on back-to-back jumpers. The Gaels held a 25+ lead for the remainder of the game.

UNM turned the ball over just 10 times on the night and turned over Saint Mary's 15 times. Ten turnovers marks the least of any game so far this season for the Lobos while the next lowest of the season was 11 against NM State on Tuesday night - two of UNM's largest losses.

The Lobos were missing junior Corey Manigault on Friday night, sitting out due to a pregame incident that occurred Tuesday night. Manigault averages 12.8 points per game.

UNM returns to action on Tuesday night (December 11) at home against Colorado. Tipoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. on ESPN2.
