- Three Lobos finished in double-figures: Makuach Maluach (19 points, 13th game this season), Corey Manigault (17 points, 16th game this season) and Keith McGee (11 points, ninth game this season).
- Maluach tied his season-high 19 points which he last collected on Dec. 22, 2019 against Houston Baptist.
 - He went 6-for-7 from the floor, 1-for-2 from three and 6-for-10 from the stripe.
 - Six made free throws ties his most made this season while 10 attempts marks a new season-high for the junior.
- Zane Martin racked up a UNM career-high eight assists to go along with his eight points and five rebounds.
