

Should New Mexico State complete the sweep of Battle of I-25 rival New Mexico on Tuesday, Aggie head coach Chris Jans would become the only head coach in program history to sweep both rivals back-to-back years in his first two seasons at the helm.

AGGIES VS. LOBOS: ROUND II

The second edition of the Battle of I-25 this season is set to take place this Tuesday, Dec. 4, at 7 p.m. (MT) in the Pan American Center when the Aggies and Lobos battle on Lou Henson Court for the 222nd time in program history.

New Mexico State has won the last four meetings between the two programs, including a 2-0 mark during that stretch at home. NM State's last loss at home to the UNM came on Nov. 15, 2015 (83-74).

The Lobos come to Las Cruces with a 4-1 record overall so far with their lone losing coming at the hands of New Mexico State back on Nov. 17 at Dreamstyle Arena aka The Pit. Since its loss to NM State, New Mexico have reeled off wins over UTEP (84-78) at home and Bradley (85-75) on the road.

Anthony Mathis leads the pack in scoring as well as several other categories. The 17.8 points average is good for a team-best to go along with his .587 shooting clip, 23 shots from downtown, .923 clip from the free-throw line and 13 assists.

Joining Mathis in the double-digit column is Corey Manigault, who is averaging 14.8 points and 5.8 rebounds. Vance Jackson, the team leader in rebounds with 7.2 boards per game is also averaging 13.4 points while Dane Kuiper checks in at 10.4 points per game. Kakuach Maluach isn't too far off, averaging 9.0 points for the Lobos.

As a team, UNM has allowed 83.6 points per game to opponents and have been outrebounded by opponents to the tune of a -1.0 rebounding margin. The Lobos have also turned the ball over 17.2 times per game while only turning opponents over 15 times per game.

In its latest game at Bradley, New Mexico had three players score in double-figures led by Mathis - who had 23 points on 7-of-14 shooting from beyond the arc. Manigault chipped in with a double-double for 18 points and 11 rebounds - including a 10-of-11 night from the free-throw line. Rounding out the list is Kuiper, who had 15 points on 6-of-10 shooting. The Lobos were able to outrebound the Braves that game 40-33.

LAST TIME OUT

The Aggie defense and timely plays on both ends of the floor down the stretch saw New Mexico State topple its first Power-5 team at home since 2002 this past Saturday when it defeated Washington State 69-36 on Lou Henson Court.

NM State led wire-to-wire, but WSU kept clawing back and tied the game up twice before a 3-pointer from Shunn Buchanan gave the Aggies some breathing room before sealing the victory. NM State used 19 Wazzu turnovers and converted them to 20 points while also holding a 17-5 edge in fastbreak points.

FEAR THE PANAMANIACS

With its win on Saturday over Washing State, New Mexico State captured its first victory over a Power-5 opponent at home since Nov. 27, 2002, when the Aggies defeated Colorado 75-71. NM State has now taken down a Power-5 opponent at least once in the last three seasons.

Since the 1999-2000 season, NM State has only hosted eight teams from a Power-5 conference. Of those eight games, the Aggies have gone 4-4.

LOOKING AHEAD

After the Aggies return home from road trip to Kansas City, NM State will play host to a pair of games as part of the Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic. First up on the docket for the Aggies will be Northern Colorado on Tuesday, Dec. 17 followed by CSUN on Wednesday, Dec. 19. Both games are scheduled to tip-off at 7 p.m. (MT).

After those two games, the Aggies immediately head to Las Vegas for the remaining two games of the tournament at Orleans Arena. NM State's first opposition in Sin City will be Drake on Saturday, Dec. 22. The Aggies then take on either Washington State or San Diego the very next day on Sunday, Dec. 23 depending on the results from Saturday's games.

DEEPER DIVE INTO THE RIVALRY (UNM)

With the 98-94 win on Nov. 17, NM State has now won four-straight against Battle of I-25 rival New Mexico. The last time the Aggies won four-straight games against UNM came during the 1993-94 seasons - coincidentally also the last time NM State swept New Mexico in back-to-back seasons.

Below is a list of instances the Aggies have swept the Lobos in back-to-back season with a few notations.

- 1916 and 1917 (1 game each)
1922 and 1923 (4 games in 1 year, unknown dates for 2 games)
1937 and 1938 (4 games each year)

HISTORIC HAPPENINGS

With New Mexico State's defeat of UTEP on Nov. 28, 2018, Aggie head men's basketball coach Chris Jans became just the second head coach ever to sweep the Miners in his first two seasons at the helm. That other coach? None other than legendary head coach Lou Henson, who did it his first two seasons from 1966-68. Meanwhile, the last head to sweep UTEP in back-to-back seasons was Coach Henson during the 1998-2000 seasons.

A LEAGUE OF THEIR OWN

Heading into the 2018-19 season, the Aggies are one of 41 basketball programs in the country that have won at least 20 games in the last six seasons. Of those 41, only New Mexico State, Arizona, Boise State, BYU, Gonzaga, Oregon and Saint Mary's hail from the western states.

Through games on Sunday, Dec. 2, New Mexico State is just 1-of-9 schools in the west to have won at least 100 or more games at home since the 2011-12 season. The other eight? Arizona, BYU, Gonzaga, Oregon, San Diego State, Saint Mary's, UCLA and Wyoming.

RIVALRY REWIND

Head coach Chris Jans became the only first-year head coach in New Mexico State basketball history to sweep both New Mexico and UTEP last season. The win also gave NM State its first victory in Albuquerque since 2013. The last time NM State swept both the Lobos and Miners was during the 2002-03 season under legendary head coach Lou Henson. That was also the last time the Aggies claimed three-straight wins against UNM. The last NM State first-year head coach to sweep the Lobos was Weldon Drew (1979-80).

THE BIG 5-0

The 2017-18 campaign serves as the 50th anniversary since the Pan American Center was built in 1968-69 and has since been home to the NM State men's basketball team. To celebrate, the NM State marketing department created a special edition posters that includes an image from the construction of the building.

PROJECT THIS HOUSE

New Mexico State is 623-154 (.802) all-time inside the Pan American Center and has gone 142-24 the last 10 years at home (including the 2018-19 season [4-1]). NM State has not lost more than two games on its home floor, since 2011-12 when it dropped three games on Lou Henson Court.

New Mexico State began the 2018-19 campaign with a dominant 102-11 (.903) record on Lou Henson Court dating back to the 2011-12 season. After this past Saturday's win at home to Washington State, the Aggies are now 106-12 (.898) at home since the 2011-12 season.

MINER RUSHED

After a slow start, the NM State men's basketball team's engine began to rev and it sure went fast, outscoring Battle of I-10 rival 84-48 after going doing 21-12 at the 14:48 mark in the first half for the 96-69 victory. The Aggies were paced by five players in double-figures while the bench erupted for 52 points to UTEP's three. As a team, New Mexico State also held a 42-26 advantage in the paint against the Miners. The Last time NM State had five players score in double-figures against a Division I team was against Long Beach State on Dec. 3, 2016, a 93-85 battle in favor of the Aggies. NM State did have five players score in double-figures against Eastern New Mexico last season, however, the Greyhounds are a Division II team.

Clayton Henry led the Aggies with 14 points and five boards on 5-of-9 shooting while C.J. Bobbitt added 13 points and four rebounds on 3-of-6 shooting from beyond the arc. Meanwhile, Eli Chuha, Terrell Brown and Ivan Aurrecoechea chipped in with 11 points apiece in the rout of UTEP. Redshirt freshman Jabari Rice had a nice showing off the bench, scoring six points with six rebounds four other Aggies tallying six or more points.

#FLASHBACKFRIDAY

Last Friday's Battle of I-10 rivalry game against UTEP, the New Mexico State men's basketball wore throwback jerseys that paid homage to its teams from the past. The throwback jerseys will be auctioned off later in the year. Further details will be forthcoming regarding the auction.

NM State head men's basketball coach Chris Jans picked up his 50th career victory at the Division I level on opening night of the 2018-19 campaign when the Aggies dispatched North Dakota State 73-56 at home as part of the Summit League/WAC Challenge.

With just five players returning from last year's historic run, Coach Jans and his staff scoured the country once again and finished with 10 new players. The Aggie men have now won ive-straight home-openers and eight of their last nine. Only loss during

Of the 10, four will redshirt during the 2018-19 season and of the four, one is sitting out due to NCAA transfer rules. The Aggies will also get the services of JoJo Zamora, Jabari Rice, C.J. Bobbitt and Robert Brown, who redshirted last season.

Freshman Berrick JeanLouis comes to NM State as a three-star recruit according to 247Sports.com after spending his last two prep seasons at Canterbury School. There, he led the Cougars to the Florida High School Athletic Association Class 3A finals as a senior after an undefeated run in District 6 play (14-0) before finishing with a 21-6 overall record. He was also named The News-Press Male Athlete of the Year at the Annual Southwest Florida Sports Award after averaging 17.7 points, 7.1 rebounds, 4.3 assists, 2.0 steals and 1.3 blocks.

JUCO transfer Terrell Brown is set to make his Aggie debut this season after leading City College of San Francisco to its second California Community College Athletic Association championship in three years. The junior was named the Coast Conference-North MVP and also earned CCCAA All-State Championship Tournament Team honors after leading CCSF to a 33-1 overall record and undefeated mark in conference play (12-0). The 6-1 guard averaged 15.9 points, 4.3 rebounds and 3.0 assists while shooting 50.3-percent from the floor and 47.3-percent from beyond the arc.

The Canadian pipeline continues for NM State with Clayton Henry. The JUCO transfer from Palm Beach State College averaged 10.3 points, 6.4 rebounds and 2.6 assists as a sophomore with the Panthers. Henry tallied seven double-doubles that year, including a triple-double against Miami Dade with 22 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists on 10-of-19 shooting. As a freshman, the Calgary, Canada, product heled guide Palm Beach State College to a 25-6 overall record and participated in the Southeastern JUCO Jamboree and All-American Jamboree.

Ivan Aurrecoechea, a top-10 ranked JUCO player when he signed with the Aggies, led Indian Hills Community College to its fifth-consecutive National Junior College Athletic Association National Championship appearance and finished 33-1 on the year – which was a program best in wins. The 6-8 forward earned Iowa Community College Athletic Conference All-Region First-Team for the second-straight year after averaging a double-double with 13.1 points and 11.5 rebounds with a .592 shooting clip. Aurrecoechea tallied 17 double-doubles while pulling down 10-plus boards in 19 games.

Addison Wallace was highly touted coming out of Cleburne High School where he guided the team's resurgence into relevancy with its first playoff appearance in eight years as a junior. The 6-3 guard wrapped up his high school career leading CHS to a 22-12 overall mark while averaging 24.0 points, 10.4 rebounds, 4.0 assists, 2.4 steals and 1.3 blocks as a senior. Wallace named District 9-5A MVP as a junior and senior while garnering all-district honors his entire prep career – including Johnson County MVP honors as a junior. The Cleburne, Texas, native also excelled in the classroom, owning the third-highest GPA in his graduating class and is a member of the National Honor Society as well as the Beta Club.

Last, but not least, is Mohamed Thiam, who is a JUCO transfer from Marshalltown Community College. The 6-9 forward had a breakout sophomore campaign, averaging 19.7 points, 9.6 rebounds and 1.8 assists while leading Marshalltown CC to another National Junior College Athletic Association Tournament appearance. The sixth-ranked JUCO player according to JucoRecruiting.com garnered NJCAA Third-Team All-American accolades for his efforts as well as First-team All-Region XI honors this past season. He opened last season with 13-straight games with double-digit scoring and finished the season with 16-straight contests in double-figures.

Redshirting this season for NM State will be Junub Chuol, William McNair, Tennessee Owens and Trevelin Queen.

#WACVEGAS

For the ninth-consecutive year, the Western Athletic Conference Tournament returns to Orleans Arena (March 14-16). The Aggies are 29-5 all-time at the WAC Tournament, good the most victories in conference tournament history. Its .853 winning-percentage is the best amongst WAC Tournament teams with a winning record.

LOFTON SIGNS TWO-WAY CONTRACT WITH PISTONS

Former Aggie guard Zach Lofton signed a two-way contract with the Detroit Pistons after a impressing the front office at the NBA Summer League and training camp. Lofton averaged 10.8 points, 2.5 rebounds, 1.0 steals and 1.0 assists in six games for the Pistons, including a 21 point performance against the Los Angeles Lakers in the quarterfinals of NBA Summer League Playoffs.

A couple days after signing his two-way contract, Lofton saw action in the Detroit Piston's opening-night roster. The 6-4 guard made his NBA debut that night and started the second quarter for Detroit and registered a steal.

Lofton had a tremendous debut with the Grand Rapids Drive, the G League affiliate for the Detroit Pistons, on opening night. The St. Paul, Minn., native was an assist shy of a triple-double in his G League debut, posting 26 points on 10-of-23 shooting with 11 rebounds and nine assists along with four steals.

#SUPERJJ SIGNS WITH SOUTH BAY LAKERS

Former NM State All-American Jemerrio Jones was selected No. 18 overall by the Santa Cruz Warriors in the 2018 G League Draft before being traded to the South Bay Lakers. The 6-5 forward made his pro debut with the South Bay Lakers on Saturday, Nov. 3, posting five points, nine rebounds, three assists and two steals.

#PROAGGIES

New Mexico State men's basketball has 16 former players who are currently playing professional basketball around the world. The list is highlighted by 2016 NBA first rounder Pascal Siakam and 2018 undrafted free-agent Zach Lofton. When Lofton entered the game on opening night in the second quarter, he and Pascal became the first pair of Aggies to play on opening-night of the NBA since Randy Brown (CHI) and Reggie Jordan (MIN) did so in 1997. SUMMIT LEAGUE/WAC CHALLENGE

The first season of a two-year deal between the WAC and Summit League that'll pit teams from each conference against another begins this season. The Challenge features head-to-head competition between all nine teams. ATHLETIC PROWESS

At the end of last season, New Mexico State was one of 13 schools with 28 wins in 2017-18, joining Virginia, Cincinnati, Gonzaga, Villanova, Michigan





State, Loyola Chicago, Saint Mary's, Xavier, Purdue, Stephen F. Austin, South Dakota State and Michigan.

Of those 13 teams, ONLY New Mexico State (Arizona Bowl), Michigan State (Holiday) and Purdue (Foster Farms Bowl) had their football program win a bowl game while their men's basketball team posted 28 wins on the season.

WAC BLUE BLOODS

Since joining the Western Athletic Conference, New Mexico State has enjoyed great success, winning eight of the 13 conference tournaments it has played in - including four-straight from 2012-15.

The Aggies are 29-5 all-time at the WAC Tournament, giving them the most victories in conference tournament history and passed Battle of I-10 rival UTEP (27-15). Its .853 winning-percentage is the best amongst WAC Tournament teams with a winning record.

VIVA LAS VEGAS!

New Mexico State is now 18-2 all-time when playing at Orleans Arena after last season and 29-5 all-time in the WAC Tournament - including an 11-0 stretch where the aggies won four-straight WAC Tournament titles (2012-15). The two losses for NM State in Las Vegas came in the first year the tournament was moved to Sin City when it lost to the second-seeded Broncos of Boise State in the semifinals while playing as the No. 3 seed. NM State's other loss came in 2016 to CSU Bakersfield in the championships game on a buzzer beater.

ONE TIME FOR THE ONE TIME

With its resounding 82-58 win over UMKC in the Pan American Center on senior day last year coupled with a Utah Valley loss, New Mexico State clinched the Western Athletic Conference regular-season title for the third time in four years. Other than the three the Aggies had won since the 2014-15 season, the last time NM State won a regular-season title outright was when it captured the Big West Conference back-to-back years from 1992-94.

Chris Jans also became the only first-year head coach in program history to win a regular-season conference title outright last season. Former Aggie head coach Marvin Menzies shared the WAC regular-season title his first year at the helm.

TITLETOWN USA

New Mexico State wrapped up its 10th WAC Tournament Championship appearance since joining the conference in the 2005-06 season with a 72-58 victory over Grand Canyon this past March. The Aggies moved 8-2 when playing in tournament title games, losing only in 2008 and 2016. NM State also played in its seventh-straight championship game, it last missed out on the title match in 2011. Counting last season's championship game, NM State has played in the title match 10-of-13 years since joining the league. In addition, the WAC Tournament MVP has come from NM State eight of the last 13 seasons after Jemerrio Jones was crowned the tournament MVP in 2018.

WAC DOMINANCE CONTINUES

After a successful 2017-18 regular-season campaign, New Mexico State head coach Chris Jans was named the Western Athletic Conference Don Haskins Coach of the Year. He became the first WAC men's head coach since Nevada's Mark Fox (2004-05) to win coach of the year honors in his first season at the helm. Jemerrio Jones' WAC Player of the Year honor made it three-straight for New Mexico State. It was also the fourth time an Aggie has been named the league's top player in five years.

The Aggies posted a 25-5 overall mark in the regular-season and 12-2 record in conference play under his direction. The 12-2 record in the WAC gave NM State its third regular-season title in four years outright and is the second-best record in conference play since joining the WAC. In addition, Jans guided the Aggies to their first win over an AP top-10 ranked opponent since 1990 when NM State defeated then-No. 6/7 Miami 63-54 in the semifinal game of the 2017 Hawaii Airlines Diamond Head Classic.

CONFERENCE POWERHOUSE

Heading into the 2018-19 season, New Mexico State has finished in the top-three in conference play for 13-straight years, which ranks them fifth in the nation and trails only Gonzaga (22), Kansas (19), Belmont (17) and BYU (14).



New Mexico State Director of Athletics Mario Moccia handed the reigns to the coveted Aggie men's basketball program to Chris Jans on Monday, April 17, naming the Fairbank, Iowa, native the 26th head men's basketball coach at NM State.

The 25-year veteran took the helm of an Aggie team that won a program record 28 games and won 28 games himself in his first year. Since his arrival, New Mexico State has beaten its first AP top-10 opponent in 17 season as well as take down a pair of Power 5 teams in Illinois and then #6/7 Miami. His tenure started off with a bang, sweeping both UNM and UTEP before winning 11-straight.

Jans was named the WAC Coach the Year after leading the Aggies to a 12-2 conference finish to claim the regular-season title and added a WAC Tournament title to his name when the Aggies defeated Grand Canyon 72-58. Under his direction, Jemerrio Jones was named the WAC Player of Year while Zach Lofton was named First-Team All-WAC. Jones was also named to the all-defensive team while AJ Harris joined Lofton on the all-newcomer list. In addition, Jones and Lofton were named to the U.S. Basketball Writers Association's All-District VIII team.

He recently began his second-stint at Wichita State prior to the start of the 2016-17 season under head coach Greg Marshall. At the conclusion of this past season, Jans was elevated to associate head coach before taking the NM State head coaching job.

Prior to returning to WSU, Jans coordinated one of the nation's best turnarounds in 2014-15 in his first year as the head coach at Bowling Green. In just one season, he took a BGSU team that lost 20 games in 2013-14 and guided it to a record-setting 21-12 overall mark in 2014-15 - which was the most wins in a single-season for Bowling Green since 2001-02 (24).

With the 21 wins, Jans became the first head coach in Falcons history to lead the team to 20 wins or more in his first year at the helm. His record-setting 21 wins eclipsed the 18 wins set previously by hall of famers Harold Anderson and Bill Fitch.

The 2014-15 campaign also saw Jans lead BGSU to its first national postseason

tournament victory since 1975 when the Falcons defeated Saint Francis (Pa.) in the 2015 Collegeinsider.com Tournament (CIT).

In that same year, Bowling Green finished Mid-American Conference play 11-7 - which was the most wins in MAC play for BGSU since going 11-5 during the 2008-09 season. In addition, the Falcons also reeled off 11 road victories for the first time since the 1947-48 season.

With the historic year for Falcon men's basketball, Jans was chosen by his peers as the National Association of Basketball Coaches' top first-year head coach with the 2015 Joe B. Hall National Coach of the Year award.

Before taking the helm at BGSU, Jans spent seven years alongside Marshall at Wichita State (2007-14). He was a member of the inaugural staff with Marshall at WSU and turned the program around to become the staple of the NCAA Tournament it is now. After just one season, the Shockers earned a CBI bid in 2009 followed by an NIT bid at home in 2010 with the help of future NBA guard Toure' Murry and center Garrett Stutz.

The Shockers began to break through in the 2010-11 campaign when they recorded 24 wins and a runner-up finish in conference play. Despite missing the Big Dance, WSU gave Shocker fans some hope when it reeled off five-consecutive wins and won the program's first NIT Championship.

Wichita State claimed the Missouri Valley Conference title the following year and made its first appearance in the NCAA Tournament since 2006 as the No. 5 seed before falling to the 12th-seeded Cinderella VCU Rams.

Jans was instrumental in landing Ron Baker, a future All-American and NBA player, who helped guide WSU to its deep run in the NCAA Tournament in 2013. The Shockers broke a lot of brackets that season, taking down Pittsburgh and the overall No. 1 seed Gonzaga to reach the Sweet 16 before taking down a hot La Salle and Ohio State team to earn Wichita State its first Final Four appearance since 1965.

In the final season of his first stint with the Shockers, Jans helped Wichita State set an NCAA record with a 35-0 start to the season. During that stretch, WSU ran the gamut in the Valley and became the first program to go undefeated in nearly 30 years. That season also saw Fred VanVleet, Cleanthony Early and Baker earn first-team all-conference selections while Early and VanVleet notched All-America honors on top of VanVleet adding MVC Player of the Year to his mantle of awards.

He began his coaching career as an assistant coach at NCAA Division III Elmhurst College in 1992 before taking a similar role at NAIA Grande View College in 1994. Jans earned his first head coaching opportunity when he took over at NJCAA Division II Kirkwood Community College in 1996.





Jans was named the Region XI Coach of the Year after guiding the Eagles to a 25-10 season, which included a conference title and the program's first-ever national tournament appearance. He followed up his rookie season with a 31-6 campaign highlighted by Kirkwood capturing the NJCAA Division II National Championship and Jans being named the National Coach of the Year.

Sandwiched in between his time at Independence Community College (1998-99) and Howard College (2001-03), Jans got his first taste of the Division I level as an assistant coach at Idaho (1999-01) under David Farrar.

After Howard, he took over at Chipola Junior College and joined forces with Greg Heiar - who played for Jans in his rookie season as a head coach at Kirkwood CC and was a fellow assistant coach at WSU. Success continued to follow Jans as he led Chipola JC to its first conference title in a decade while finishing sixth at the NJCAA Division I National Tournament and finished 32-5 overall.

Jans then made his second appearance at the Division I level, this time as an assistant coach at Illinois State (2004-07) on Porter Moser's staff before joining Marshall at Wichita State.

Jans was a three-year starter at Loras College (1987-91) and was named a captain as a senior. During his time in Dubuque, Iowa, he helped the Duhawks break 16 scoring records and two NCAA Division III records for three-point shooting.

A graduate of Loras College in 1991, Jans earned his bachelor degrees in marketing and finance. He and his wife Sheri have two kids, Nick and Maddie Gazda.


