

## ***POST-GAME NOTES: NEW MEXICO 78, EVANSVILLE 59***

### **Match Up Notes:**

- Starting Lineup: Chris McNeal, Troy Simons, Dane Kuiper, Sam Logwood, Joe Furstinger
- Lobos are 2-1 on the season in white jerseys.
- This is the first time in program history the Lobos and the Purple Aces have faced off.
- Attendance: 8,943

### **In-Game Notes:**

- Lobos shot 40% FG in the first half and improved to 58.1% in the second half for a 49.2% total (30-61).
- Lobos held Evansville to 36.5% from the field and 23.1% from three.
  - Evansville entered the game ranked 2nd in the nation in 3-point FG percentage (47.8%).
- Lobos are the first team to hold Evansville without a three in the first half this season.
- Lobos had eight turnovers in the first half but only 3 in the second (11 total).
- Lobos have hit over 10 threes in all four home games this season.
- Lobos have forced at least 20 turnovers in four of their seven games this season.
  - Lobos entered the game ranked 4th in the nation in forced turnovers (21.33%).
- Lobos have had at least 20 assists in all three of their wins this season.
- Five players (Sam Logwood, Chris McNeal, Troy Simons, Makuach Maluach and Anthony Mathis) scored in double digits.
  - The last time New Mexico had five double-digit scorers was on Jan. 16, 2016 against Wyoming.
- Evansville ranked 8th in the nation prior to Wednesday's game in scoring defense, allowing just 58.2 points per game.
  - Lobos scored 78 points against the Aces, the most points of any opponent this season.
