Saint Mary's enters play this week at 9-0-0 overall. They are one of 10 NCAA DI programs yet to lose a game, but are just one of two that have not also tied either. The Gaels possess the most potent offense in DI as they currently lead the nation in goals scored (27) and points (75). On average, the Gaels are scoring 3.00 goals per game which ranks second in the country.

LOBOS BEGIN THREE-GAME HOMESTAND

The next three games for the Lobos will be played within the friendly confines of the UNM Soccer Complex as the men's soccer team will play home games against nationally-ranked Saint Mary's this Wednesday, Florida International on Saturday, September 29 and then Loyola Marymount on Tuesday, October 2. Traditionally, the Lobos have been nearly unbeatable at home, but will be looking to improve upon their current 1-3 mark at home.

SCHEDULE FULL OF RANKED TEAMS

Four of UNM's first five matchups of the season have been against ranked squads at the time of the game including No. 22 Seattle, No. 24 Washington, No. 30 Cal State Fullerton and No. 23 Tulsa. Half of those ranked matchups came at home with the Lobos hosting Seattle and Washington in consecutive games. UNM went 1-1 against those opponents and is also 1-1 against ranked teams on the road.

In their victories against Seattle and Cal State Fullerton, the Lobos scored a combined nine goals with five coming against Cal State Fullerton.

NEW MEXICO MATCH NOTES

CSUN was also ranked at one point this season, making the first five squads the Lobos have taken on, be top-30 teams in 2018. Old Dominion was receiving votes in the national poll at the time of the game against the Lobos and now the Monarchs are currently ranked.

With the 9-0-0 start to their season, UNM's upcoming opponent Saint Mary's is ranked No. 10 making them the sixth opponent the Lobos have played be ranked at the time of the game.

OFFENSE ON FIRE - LEADING C-USA

In the first eight games, the Lobos have racked up 42 points on 14 goals with 14 assists to lead C-USA in all three categories. Individually, **TOM SMART** is tied for the lead in the C-USA in assists, racking up five thus far. He has also registered an assist in three of his last four games.

SCORES GALORE!

Last season, the Lobos scored 25 goals all season. With 14 goals in eight games, UNM has surpassed the halfway point of that mark. Only four players scored three goals or more in 2017, but this 2018 squad features two players with at least three goals and another two that are a goal shy of the mark. Freshman **OMAR GREY** currently leads the team with five goals, followed by sophomore **MATT PUIG** with three. Senior **ANTOINE VIAL** and sophomore **DICK TAYLOR** have registered two apiece. **BILLY JONES** and **SIMON SPANGENBERG** joined the goal scoring party with their first goals of the season against Florida Atlantic.

FRESHMAN PHENOM

Freshman midfielder **OMAR GREY** has gotten his collegiate career off to a resounding start. The Seattle, Wash. native has not started a game yet for UNM, but has played in all eight games thus far. Despite not being a starter, Grey has come off the bench and sparked the Lobos' offense as he currently leads the team with five goals. Four of those came in consecutive games (9/2 - 9/15).

TWO PROTECTING ONE

Redshirt-junior **FORD PARKER** and true freshman **ALEX FETTERLY** have both seen time in goal for the Lobos this season with Parker getting the lion's share of the work thus far. Parker started the first six games and registered 25 saves for a .714 save percentage in 552:27 minutes. Fetterly has started the last two games and logged the lone shutout for the team this season, blanking FAU. On the season, Fetterly has saved 85% of shots on goal he has faced.

5 OR MORE

The last time the Lobo scored five goals or more in a single game prior to the 5-1 win over Cal State Fullerton came on Oct. 1, 2014 when the then No. 15 Lobos topped West Virginia 6-1.

3 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

In Coach Fishbein's tenure, the Lobos are 80-1-0 when scoring three goals or more in a match, which UNM has done twice so far this season.

TAYLOR EMERGES

Sophomore **DICK TAYLOR** scored twice all season in 2017 in 12 games and 354 minutes. In UNM's 5-1 victory over No. 30 Cal State Fullerton on September 2, Taylor scored twice, including the first goal of the game to give UNM the advantage.

PUIG RETURNS HOME

A native of Edmond, Okla., **MATT PUIG** had a homecoming as the Lobos traveled to Tulsa on September 7 to take on the Golden Hurricanes. Not only is Puig from the area, he also played for Tulsa last season before transferring to UNM. In the game, Puig registered a pair of shots with one coming on goal.

EARLY RANKED OPPONENT TRADITION

COACH FISHBEIN'S Lobos have a habit of starting off the season with a strong, nationally-ranked test. Including 2018, the Lobos have faced a nationally-ranked opponent within their first three games in the last seven seasons. Last season, the Lobos entered the season ranked No. 20 in the nation and fell 2-1 to then-No. 11 Washington. In 2016, UNM took on No. 15 Indiana (L, 1-0) and No. 9 Notre Dame (L, 1-0). UNM fell by just one (1-0) in the 2015 season opener at No. 1 UCLA, tied No. 18 San Diego 2-2 and then claimed a 2-1 victory over No. 13 UCSB at home.

PRO CONTRACTS MEAN PLAYERS STEP UP

Several significant players from last year's squad have graduated or advanced to the professional level leaving last season's underclassmen and redshirts to step up. Players that departed for professional contracts include goalkeeper **JASON BEAULIEU** (Montreal Impact MLS), **AARON HERRERA** (Real Salt Lake MLS), **SAM GLEADLE** (Reno 1868 FC USL) and **ALEX VEDAMANIKAM** (Eintracht Braunschweig of the Second Bundesliga).

While we're on the topic of professional contracts - former Lobo **CHRIS WEHAN** received USL Rookie of the Year honors last season as a member of Reno 1868 FC and has now signed with the San Jose Earthquakes (MLS). Speaking of former Lobos, Wehan's classmate **NIKO HANSEN** is still with the Columbus Crew SC (MLS).

PRESEASON HONORS

While the Lobos might have lost some significant starters last year to graduation and professional contracts, there are still some stellar returners set to take to the pitch in the Cherry and Silver this season. Redshirt-junior and 2018 co-captain **TOM SMART** was named to the Conference USA Preseason Team on August 5.

Smart was named to the C-USA Second Team last season for his extraordinary defensive efforts.

LOBO SOCCER: A MILE HIGH AND LOUDER THAN ...

The UNM Soccer Complex has a reputation as one of the nation's toughest venues to play in. In addition to being "a mile high and louder than...", New Mexico has turned Albuquerque into one of the hottest tickets in college soccer. The Lobos have ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally every season since the NCAA began keeping those statistics in 2001.

EXCELLING OFF THE PITCH

Lobo Soccer has a rich tradition of academic success. During the **FISHBEIN** era (2002 to present), UNM has had 22 Academic All-Americans - more than any other men's soccer program in the country among all divisions. In addition, the Lobos have garnered 95 Academic All-Conference honorees and 20 NSCAA

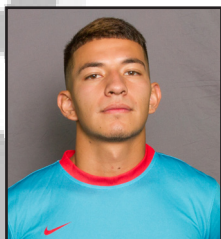
