#GoLobos at a Glance (#GoLobos)

The Season:

The University of New Mexico, has three third place finishes this season, and now heads for the NCAAs in Stowe, Vermont. The Lobos have four top-5 seeds going into the championships, including the top two men's Nordic skiers in the country. The Lobos are looking for their best NCAA finish since 2014, when the team finished third in Utah.

The Coaches:

The University of New Mexico Lobos are coached by Joe Downing, who is the program's head alpine coach. Joe was named the interim head coach after former coach Fredrik Landstedt left for the University of Utah to become Director of Skiing after an 11-year run as UNM's head coach. Taking over as the head Nordic coach is former student-athlete and NCAA participant Christian Otto, who was previously an assistant Nordic coach. Aljaž Praznik and Carl-Johan Öster are former student-athletes for the Lobos who are serving as assistant coaches for Nordic and alpine, respectively.

What to Look For

New Mexico is looking to win a second national title, and first since 2004 as the team heads to Stowe, Vermont for the NCAA Championships. The 2019 championships are in the East Corridor with Vermont as host. The 2020 championships will be hosted by Montana State, the 2021 by Middlebury College, and the 2022 championships by Utah.

UNM has four top-five seeds out of the west in the event, with Kornelius Grøv the top seed in the freestyle, with teammate Ricardo Izquierdo-Bernier fourth. In the men's classic, Grøv is the No. 2 seed and Izquierdo-Bernier is No. 3.

In alpine, Rebecca Fiegl is the No. 3 seed in the slalom, and on the men's side, Vegard Busengdal is the No. 3 seed as well.

1-2-4-5

Those aren't special numbers for the greatest television show in history LOST (no arguments allowed), those are the placements for one of the greatest Nordic races in UNM history, as the Lobos went 1-2-4-5, giving UNM 108 of a possible 111 points. The Lobos saw Kornileus Grøv finish first, Ricardo Izquierdo-Bernier second, Johan Eirik Meland fourth and Ben Berend fifth.

It was the first Nordic race in school history in which UNM finished in four of the top five slots

We Ran Out of Fingers

There have been 10 Nordic races this year. A Lobo has crossed the finish line first in 60% of them. Kornileus Grøv has won five on his own, and we will get to that in a minute, and Ricardo Izquierdo-Bernier has won win as well. Overall UNM has won four of five freestyle races and two of five classical races.

The six wins in one season is the most by the Lobos, topping 2010 when Martin Kaas won three classical and two freestyle races, giving UNM five that year.

So It's Been a While

With Kornileus Grøv and Ricardo Izquierdo-Bernier both winning races in Nordic, it marked the first time that UNM had two different men win Nordic races in the same season since Jonas Kjellmart won a classical race and Niklas Skogland won a freestyle race in 1994. No one on the current team was alive when that occured. Additionally, here is what wasn't around back then:

Kornileus Grøv has tied a host of records with his five Nordic wins this season. Grøv has tied Jimmy Vika's record for most freestyle wins in a season with four, and he has also tied the career record as well with four as well. Grøv also has tied the record for most overall Nordic wins in a season with five, and he is one win away from tying the career record for Nordic wins, which would be six.

Grøv, Busengdal, Moravcíková Named RMISA Skiers of the Week

Vegard Busengdal and Kornileus Grøv both earned weekly honors as the pair were named RMISA men's alpine and men's Nordic skiers of the week respectively. Both skiers were honored for their performances in the Montana State Invitational.

The honor is the first for Grøv and the third weekly honor for Busengdal, having earned the honor now in each of his three seasons. The skiers teamed up to help the Lobos finish a very close third at the MSU Invitational.

Busengdal picked up his first podium of the season at Montana State, coming in third in the slalom. He paired that with a fourth-place finish in the giant slalom, as he scored 65 points on the weekend. Grøv had an even better weekend in earning Nordic honors. He won his second straight freestyle race, and then finished in second place in the classical race to earn his accolades.

Grøv scored 77 points, and ironically his closest competitor for skier of the week was his own teammate Ricardo Izquierdo-Bernier, who finished first in the classical race and second in the freestyle race. Both skiers picked up 77 points out of 80 on the weekend, but Grøv had a faster combined time for the two races, giving him the honors.

For Soňa Moravčíková, she earned it following a third place and first place finish at the UNM Invitational. She scored 74 of a possible 80 points. The win was the first of her career, as were both podiums.

Snowed Out?

Not exactly, but the combination of a hard snowfall and a really sloggy, skittish track forced officials to abandon the men's slalom at the Colorado Invitational, and ran it on January 19 in Montana at Bridger Bowl. It marks the second straight year a meet had to be completed in a different state due to weather.

Last year, The UNM Invitational's Nordic races were held in Colorado due to the light amount of snow on the trails in Red River at The Enchanted Forest.

Keep On Winning

UNM's different teams have won nine team races this season. The men's Nordic team has won four times, winning the freestyle three times (Montana State, UNM and UAA) and classical once (RMISA/NCAA West). The women's alpine squad has won the slalom three times (winning twice at UNM and once at UAA) and the men's alpine squad has two wins, a giant slalom win at Montana State and a slalom win at Colorado.

NCAA History for UNM

The Lobos have finished seventh in each of the last three NCAA Championships, and the team has never finished lower than ninth. Here are all the times the team has finished with a trophy.

Make Up!!!

The 2019 Lobo ski team is made up of 20 skiers, with the team having six men's alpine, six women's alpine, four men's Nordic and four women's Nordic. Nine skiers return from the 2018 team, seven of which are alpine skiers. UNM has back five NCAA alpine skiers from a year ago (Katharine Irwin, Rebecca Fiegl, Hailey Cutler, Vegard Busengdal and Tyler Theis) and two in Nordic (Ricardo Izquierdo-Bernier and Brenna Egan).

As far as where they are from, nine are from the United States (Colorado 3, Utah 2, Idaho 1, Wisconsin 1, Minnesota 1, New Mexico 1), Norway (5), Canada (2), Russia (1), Slovakia (1), France (1), and Austria (1).
