Currently riding a six-game winning streak, Liberty (7-11) heads to Austin, Texas, for the Longhorn Invitational, Friday through Sunday. The Lady Flames open the tournament on Friday at 2:30 p.m. ET against Texas Southern and will face the host No. 1 Texas Longhorns and New Mexico twice each. Texas was ranked No. 1 by Softball America this week.

This is the second year in a row in which Liberty will play in Texas, as the Lady Flames went 3-2 at the 2019 Texas A&M Invitational. Liberty defeated then No. 19 Texas A&M 4-2 that weekend.

Liberty posted a 4-0 record in its home-opening Liberty Softball Classic last weekend, outhitting opponents .353-.147 while scoring 25 runs and allowing just four. The Bishop twins, Amber and Autumn, combined to go 11-for-20 with three doubles, five homers and 17 RBI last weekend. Liberty's top pitchers (Megan Johnson - 2-0, 0.64 ERA, .167 OBA; Karlie Keeney - 2-0, 1.00 ERA, .140 OBA) combined to shut down the opponents at the Liberty Softball Classic.

Liberty went 2-2 two weeks ago at the Gamecock Invitational in Columbia, S.C. Facing a 5-1 deficit to No. 6 Michigan on Feb. 23, Amber Bishop hit a three-run homer in the fifth before Bishop's walk-off solo shot gave Liberty a 6-5 win. It was Liberty's 11th win all-time over a Top 25 opponent and tied the highest-ranked opponent the Lady Flames have ever beaten.

Amber Bishop was named ASUN Softball Player of the Week for the second week in a row after hitting hit .600 with four homers, nine RBI and five runs scored. She set the program record with her 250th career hit on Friday against Hofstra and added her fifth career two-homer game against Elon.

For the second year in a row, Liberty was predicted to win the ASUN in the preseason coaches poll. Additionally, Amber Bishop, Autumn Bishop and Madison Via were all named to the ASUN Preseason Softball All-Conference team.

Three-time NFCA All-Region player Amber Bishop bats .400 with a conference-best eight homers and 18 RBI. 2019 ASUN All-Freshman Team member Kara Canetto, who missed the final half of the 2019 season with injury, hits .364 with a team-high five doubles. Freshmen Caroline Hudson (.294), Blake Gibson (.273) and Savannah Channell (.250) have provided a spark offensively. Three-time first team all-conference player Autumn Bishop has hit .203 with 14 RBI (second on team) so far, while two-time all-conference outfielder Madison Via has batted .234 with five steals.

In the circle, Liberty has had to replace its two top starters from last year, when the Lady Flames ranked fifth in the nation with a 1.60 team ERA. Freshman Karlie Keeney is 4-4 with a 2.91 ERA, and she has gone 3-2 with a 1.78 ERA and .181 opponents batting average in her last six appearances. That includes games against top 10 opponents Florida State and Michigan. Junior college transfer Megan Johnson (3-3, 4.67) is 3-0 with a 2.33 ERA in her last three starts, including a two-hit shutout where she struck out a career-high eight batters against Elon on Sunday.

#### **Team Notes**

- Four teams (Alabama, Washington, UCLA and Texas) have been ranked No. 1 in at least one of the four major national polls at least once this season. After this weekend, Liberty will have played all four of those teams. No other team has all four of those teams on its schedule this season.
- Liberty has played 10 out of its first 18 games against Top 25 opponents. The Lady Flames downed No. 21 Ole Miss on Feb. 9 before taking down No. 6 Michigan on Feb. 23.
- Liberty faced the No. 1 teams in back-to-back games, losing a late lead to No. 1 Washington in a 10-6 setback on Feb. 14 before falling to No. 1 UCLA (DISoftball.com) 9-1 on Feb. 15.
- After posting a 6.08 team ERA through the first 10 games of the 2020 season, Liberty's pitchers combined for a 2.02 ERA and .184 opponents batting average in the last eight games.
- Through the first 12 games this season, Liberty was batting .206 while averaging 2.1 runs per game. After shaking up their lineup Feb. 23 against Michigan, the Lady Flames have batted .359 and scored a combined 43 runs (7.1 runs per game) in its next six games, all wins.
- Liberty is 2-8 against Top 25 teams this season after downing No. 6 Michigan on Feb. 23. That ties Liberty's highest-ranked win, as the Lady Flames also defeated Michigan on March 24, 2007 when the Wolverines were ranked No. 6. Liberty is 0-23 all-time against Top 5 teams.
- Liberty set program records for Top 25 meetings and Top 25 wins in 2007, when the Lady Flames went 3-9 against nationally-ranked opponents.
- Liberty competed in the St. Pete/Clearwater Elite Invitational Feb. 13-16, falling to five teams who appeared in the Top 10 in at least one poll that week. The Lady Flames led No. 1 Washington 6-5 after Caroline Hudson's three-run homer off of All-American Gabbie Plain in the fifth inning before the Huskies rallied in the sixth to win 10-6, Feb. 14.
- Autumn Bishop's diving catch against Washington on Feb. 14 was Play No. 4 on SportsCenter's Top 10 plays. Amber Bishop's walk-off grand slam against Radford, April 23, 2019, made it on SC-Top 10 that night.
- Liberty is 1-1 in games decided by exactly two runs this season after going 10-2 in such games last year. The Lady Flames went 5-12 in one-run games in 2019 and are 2-2 in one-run games this year.
- Liberty opened the 2020 season with a 6-2 loss to No. 15 Kentucky. It was the third time in program history that Liberty faced a Top 25 team in its season opener.
- The Lady Flames started five freshmen (Karlie Keeney, Blake Gibson, Caroline Hudson, Savannah Channell and Gaby Ruiz) against Kentucky. That is the most freshmen to start a season opener for Liberty since five freshmen started against #17 UCF, Feb. 11, 2016.
- Most of Liberty's pitching production came from a pair of seniors last year, three-time All-Region choice Julia DiMartino (19-11, 1.20 ERA) and 2019 All-Region selection Chase Cassady (15-4, 1.50). Liberty was one of three teams in NCAA Division I with two pitchers in the top 25 in the nation in ERA, with the other two being national finalists UCLA and Oklahoma.
- Liberty opened the 2020 season with its first 13 games against Power 5 opponents, and has as many games against Power 5 teams (21) as it does ASUN Conference games (21) this year.
- The Lady Flames graduated four NFCA All-Region selections from last year's team (pitchers Julia DiMartino and Chase Cassady and infielders Sarah Robertson and Jaclyn Amader).
- Liberty posted its third straight 40-win season and fifth in program history last year. The Lady Flames went 46-24 during their NISC title season in 2017 and a program-record 49-14 in 2018. Liberty is one of 13 NCAA Division I softball teams to win 40+ games in 2017, 2018 and 2019.
- Liberty outscored its opponents by an exact 2-to-1 ratio last year, scoring 260 runs and allowing just 130 in 62 games played. So far this season, Liberty has been outscored 80-44.
- The Lady Flames are tied with Michigan for the 12th most wins among all NCAA Division I softball teams over the last two seasons (2019-20) combined (89), and Liberty is 13th overall with 135 wins over the last three years (2017-19).
- Liberty went 40-22 last year, finishing second in the ASUN with a 16-5 record in its first season in the conference. The Lady Flames competed in the NISC for the second time in the last three seasons, shutting out all three opponents to win the NISC Lynchburg Regional.
- Liberty's 2019 senior class posted the most wins (166) of any four-year span in program history. With 135 wins over the last three seasons, this year's senior class needs 32 victories this season to set a new four-year wins record.
- Liberty received votes in the NFCA national poll five times last season. The Lady Flames received their first-ever Top 25 ranking, appearing 22nd in the preseason Softball America Top 25 Poll.
- Liberty posted program record streaks of nine consecutive shutout games (Feb. 21-March 8) and 60 straight shutout innings (Feb. 21-March 8), scoring 75 unanswered runs during that span.
- From 2017 through 2019, Liberty competed in 19 postseason games, tying with Arizona for the eighth most postseason contests played during that span by an NCAA Division I softball team.

#### **Player Quick Hits**

- Amber Bishop has batted .688 with seven homers and 16 RBI during Liberty's six-game winning streak. That includes two-homer/five-RBI games against both Michigan and Elon.
- Amber Bishop has hit three career walk-off homers, including a walk-off grand slam against Radford on April 23, 2019 and Feb. 28's solo shot against No. 6 Michigan.
- Amber Bishop homered in four straight games, Feb. 23 through Feb. 28. That ties Dawn Jeffs' (2007) program record for most consecutive games with a home run.
- Amber Bishop was the sixth player at Liberty to record 200 or more career hits, 100 or more career RBI and 100 or more career runs scored. Her twin sister, Autumn Bishop, joined her in that elite group, recording her 100th career RBI against Missouri on Feb. 14 before posting her 200th career hit on Feb. 16 against Florida State.
- Amber Bishop was named to the Softball America list of Top 100 NCAA Division I Softball Players, checking in at 89.
- 2017 Big South Freshman of the Year Amber Bishop broke Ashley Williams' program career record last Friday against Hofstra when she recorded her 250th career hit.
- Autumn Bishop hit a grand slam on Friday against Penn, her second career grand slam. Her first career grand slam came April 17, 2018 off of Virginia Tech's Jordan Dail (now with Oregon).
- Autumn Bishop's 13-game hitting streak in April 2019 was Liberty's longest hitting streak last season. In 2018, Bishop went on a 20-game hitting streak.
- Four times in their careers, (most recently Feb. 28 vs. Penn), both Amber and Autumn Bishop hit home runs in the same game. Neither instance was back-to-back.
- Current Lady Flames Emily Sweat (3/25/17 vs. Radford) and Amber Bishop (4/6/19 vs. Stetson; 4/23/19 vs. Radford; 2/23/20 vs. Michigan all homers) have both recorded at least one gamewinning walk-off hit in their career.
- Sophomore Denay Griffin hit her first career homer on Feb. 7 against Illinois. She became the first Liberty player since Sydnei Lester (2012 vs. Georgetown) with a pinch-hit homer.
- Griffin has already surpassed her season RBI total from her freshman year of 2019.
- Freshman Karlie Keeney leads Liberty in most pitching categories so far this season. She allowed just two runs to No. 21 Ole Miss on Feb. 9 and yielded just one run to No. 6 Michigan, Feb. 23. The opening-game starter against No. 15 Kentucky, she has pitched in nine of Liberty's games against Top 25 teams in 2020, and holds a 3.00 ERA versus nationally-ranked opponents.
- Keeney became the first Liberty freshman to pitch a complete-game victory over a Top 25 team, Feb. 9 against No. 21 Ole Miss.
- Megan Johnson pitched a two-hit shutout against Elon on Sunday, the first Liberty player this season to toss a shutout.
- Sophomore Kara Canetto recorded her first career three-hit game in a win over No. 6 Michigan. She is batting .467 (14-for-30) against Top 25 teams this season.
- Kara Canetto posted two doubles March 27, 2019 at Duke, including a go-ahead two-run double in the ninth before sustaining a season-ending injury.
- Madison Via is the first Liberty player since Katie Zavodny in 2013 with two four-hit games in the same season, doing so last year. She hit an inside-the-park home run against Stetson on April 6, the first Lady Flame to hit an inside-the-park homer since 2015.
- Emily Sweat made her first start of the 2020 season on Feb. 16 against No. 3 Florida State. She doubled and homered, the first Lady Flame with multiple extra-base hits in a game this season. Her homer, the second of her career, was Sweat's first home run since March 29, 2017 at N.C. State.
- Sweat posted the first two-double game of her career on Sunday against Elon.
- Junior Emily Kirby is Liberty's lone returning pitcher from last year. She holds a 6-5 career record, with a 5.48 career ERA in 60 innings pitched. Last year, she went 4-2 with a 3.55 ERA and a .216 opponents batting average in 12 appearances (seven starts) spanning 25 2/3 innings.
- Freshmen Caroline Hudson and Blake Gibson both had hits Feb. 7 against No. 15 Kentucky, making this the fifth season in a row that a Liberty freshman has recorded a hit in the season opener.
- Hudson bats .294 on the season after hitting .444 (8-for-18) during the last six games, all wins.
- Hudson had the biggest hit of her young career Feb. 14 against No. 1 Washington, hitting a threerun bomb to left off of All-American Gabbie Plain to give Liberty a 6-5 lead in the fifth.
- Hudson is the first Liberty player since Ashley Williams against Tennessee's Monica Abbott March 26, 2007 to homer against the No. 1 ranked team in the nation.
- In six games as the leadoff hitter, Blake Gibson has batted .300 with a .391 on-base percentage.
- Gaby Ruiz drove in an insurance run against No. 21 Ole Miss on Feb. 9, her first career hit.
- Savannah Channell went 3-for-4 with a career-high three RBI on Feb. 23 agaist Elon. It was her first career three-hit game and first career multiple-RBI contest. Channell is batting .333 with six walks and a .556 on-base percentage during Liberty's six-game winning streak.
- Kayla Harris, who played catcher at Liberty as a freshman in 2017, before playing the 2018 season at Northwest Florida State College, returned to the Lady Flames last season. Harris hit her first two career homers April 6 in a 5-3 win over Stetson. She was the first Lady Flame since Jamie Crisp against ETSU in 2014 to hit her first two career homers in the same game.
- McKenzie Murray singled in her first career at bat, Friday against Elon.

#### **All-Region**

Liberty placed a program-record five players on the NFCA All-Mid-Atlantic Region team last year. Julia DiMartino and Amber Bishop were voted to the first team, while Jaclyn Amader, Chase Cassady and Sarah Robertson were all named to the second team.

In 2018, DiMartino and Amber Bishop were named first team all-region selections, while Autumn Bishop was second team all-region.

DiMartino and Amber Bishop are the first two Liberty players to receive NFCA All-Region awards three times.

#### Bring on the Awards

Liberty placed six players on the 2019 ASUN All-Conference team, including a league-best four on the first team.

Liberty's All-ASUN first-team selections were: juniors Autumn Bishop (1B) and Amber Bishop (2B) and seniors Jaclyn Amader (Utility) and Julia DiMartino (P).

The Lady Flames were represented on the all-conference second team by: sophomore outfielder Madison Via and senior shortstop Sarah Robertson.

Amber and Autumn Bishop are the third and fourth players in program history to earn first team all-conference honors as freshmen, sophomores and juniors.

#### **Watch Out**

Amber Bishop was named to the Top 50 Watch List for the 2020 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year. She was the only ASUN player on the Top 50 Watch List. The Top 25 will be announced on April 22. The Top 10 finalists will be named on May 6. The field will be reduced to three on May 20, before the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year is announced on May 26.

This is the second year in a row that Liberty has had a player named to this list, as Autumn Bishop appeared on the 2019 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top 50 Watch List.

Liberty is scheduled to play against 20 of the Top 50 Watch List players this season.

#### **USA**

Liberty took on Team USA on Feb. 12 at the Eddie C. Moore Complex. This will be a special event for seventh-year head coach Dot Richardson, who won two Olympic Gold medals during a storied career with the USA Women's National Team. Junior lefty Emily Kirby pitched against one of her heroes, Cat Osterman, who was Team USA's starting pitcher.

#### **First Things First**

Each of the last three years (2017-19), a Liberty freshman has recorded a two-hit game in the season opener. In the 2017 season opener, Amber Bishop went 2-for-3 with a double versus Chattanooga. On Feb. 9, 2018 against Fairleigh Dickinson, freshman Madison Via batted 2-for-3. Then, Feb. 8 against BYU, Kara Canetto went 2-for-4 with two doubles in her career debut.

On Feb. 10, 2018 versus Toledo, freshman Emily Kirby earned the win in relief, her first collegiate appearance.

#### **Family Matters**

Seniors Amber and Autumn Bishop are one of approximately 22 sets of twins competing in NCAA Division I softball this season. Two of Liberty's 2019 opponents, Penn (Kayla and Sarah Ketring) and Virginia (Molly and Rachel Keshin), have twins playing on their team.

Current Liberty Associate Head Coach Paige Cassady is the daughter of John Cassady, who is on staff as a volunteer assistant coach. Paige Cassady was named the 2018 NFCA National Assistant Coach of the Year.

#### **Tough Schedule**

During the 2020 season, Liberty will face 2019 Women's College World Series competitors Alabama, Washington and national champion UCLA. The Lady Flames will also take on NCAA Super Regional participants Kentucky, Ole Miss, Florida State, Texas, James Madison and Tennessee along with NCAA Regional Finalists Auburn, Mississippi State, Missouri and North Carolina. In total, Liberty will face 15 teams in a combined 20 games who qualified for the 2019 NCAA Tournament.

Liberty faces 16 teams that finished the 2019 season in the top 50 in RPI, including 12 of the top 25 and eight of the top 15.

# HEAD COACH DOT RICHARDSON 213-175, 82-53 CONF.

Two-time Olympic Gold medalist, Dr. Dot Richardson has led the Liberty softball program to new heights.

During the 2018 season, Richardson's Lady Flames won a program-record 49 games (49-14), taking a 19-game winning streak into the NCAA Columbia Regional Final. She led the team to its first-ever NCAA Regional Final appearance, being named Big South and VaSID State Coach of the Year.

In 2017, she led Liberty to its first-ever postseason championship, as the Lady Flames captured the National Invitational Softball Championship title with a 3-1 win over Lamar. The Lady Flames returned to the NISC in 2019, winning the Lynchburg Regional and finishing with a season record of 40-22.

- Liberty finished the 2018 season with a program-record RPI of 29.
- Richardson and her staff were named the 2018 NFCA Mid-Atlantic Regional Coaching Staff of the Year.
- Richardson was instrumental in the planning for the state-of-the-art Liberty Softball Stadium, which debuted during the 2015 season. Liberty Softball Stadium, a 1,000-seat structure, opened March 19, 2015 with the Lady Flames defeating Rider 9-2.
- Liberty's 2-0, 10-inning win over No. 24/24 Hofstra in the first round of the 2018 NCAA Columbia Regional on May 18, 2018, was Liberty's first win over a ranked opponent since the 2007 season.
- The Lady Flames improved in the win-loss column each of the first five years under her guidance, including an NCAA-leading 18-win improvement from the 2014 to 2015 season. Liberty then posted a 15-win improvement from 2016 (31-28) to 2017 (46-24).
- On Feb. 13, 2015, Richardson led the Lady Flames to a 5-2 win over Arkansas, the first win over an SEC team in program history.
- The 2016 season saw Liberty post a 31-28 record, the team's first 30-win season since 2011.
- Coach Richardson's team went 6-1 against ACC opponents in 2018, and is 14-6 versus the ACC in the last three seasons combined.
