#GoLobos at a Glance (#UNMvsNMSU)

The Game:

The University of New Mexico Lobos (1-0, 0-0 MW) will look to go 2-0 for the first time since the 2005 season as they travel to New Mexico State to face the Aggies (0-1, 0-0 Sun Belt).

The Coaches:

The University of New Mexico Lobos are coached by Bob Davie, who is 19-32 in his fifth season with the Lobos, and he is 54-57 overall in his 10th season. He spent his first five seasons as a head coach manning the Notre Dame Fighting Irish. For the Aggies, they are coached by Doug Martin, who is 7-30 in his fourth season with NMSU. Overall, counting seven seasons with Kent State, he is 36-83 in 11 seasons.

Series History:

In a series that is older than the actual state of New Mexico, UNM leads 70-31-5, having won the last four, all under head coach Bob Davie. UNM has won 10 of the last 13 as well, and two a row in Las Cruces. The 70 wins over New Mexico State are the most for UNM over any particular program. The very first game of this series was played on January 1, 1894, some 18 years before statehood.

UNM's 18-game winning streak over NMSU from 1938-58 also represents the longest winning streak for UNM against a single opponent.

Coach Davie has several media availability times during the week. He is available after practices on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday. He also meets with the local media on Tuesday at noon as part of UNM's weekly fall sports media luncheon (other fall sport coaches meet with the media at 11:30 a.m. prior to Davie speaking).

For South Dakota (Thursday game), the entire week is pushed backwards two days.
 For Boise State week (Friday game), the entire week is pushed backwards one day.

The New Mexico Media Luncheons are Tuesdays from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Coach Davie is available at approximately noon. Audio and video clips from Davie are available at www.golobos.com. The press conferences are also streamed on GoLobos.com by LoboTV. Please note that the Mountain West no longer will conduct a football coaches teleconference. The luncheon is on the Zia II level of the West Pressbox.

New Mexico Player Interview Opportunities

All player interviews must be arranged through the UNM athletics communications office. The main time for interviews is after practice. Wednesday is the last day for player interviews, and Tuesday is the last day for quarterback interviews. For lengthier interviews, please call the communications office to arrange, which we are happy to do, working around class schedules. These will normally take place in the communications suite in the Maloof Center.

Postgame: The UNM locker room is closed. Requested players will be brought to an area to be determined after home games and outside the locker room for road games.

For road games, all interviews will be posted to UNM's Media Dropbox account, along with selected highlights. These are provided for your usage, but please credit LoboTV.

Game Credentials

Visiting team media should request single-game credentials through their team's media relations office. Parking passes for the Baseball East and media lots will be needed.

For media members picking up credentials at will call without parking passes, it is located in the Northeast corner of the stadium by Gate 7 or 8. For media members picking up with parking passes, credentials will be located at the University Drive entrance to the Baseball & Pit East lots with the parking attendant. This should allow you to get your credential without having to wait in line or deal with parking on the north side of the stadium.

New Mexico wasn't the only FBS team to score in the opening play of the 2016 season, as both Troy, Old Dominion and Navy did as well. Kind of.

Troy scored when Jordan Chunn scored on a 48-yard run against Austin Peay and Navy scored on a 7-yard run by Tago Smith. While those were the first plays on offense, they weren't the first play of the season. UNM's came after a touchdown on the opening kickoff, making it truly the first actual play of the season. Troy's touchdown was after a defensive series for the Trojans, and it came 2:36 into the game. For Navy, it was the second play of the game, after Fordham fumbled the opening kickoff.

Only Old Dominion equaled UNM in scoring on the first play from scrimmage, but ODU actually returned the opening kickoff, so it ended up being the second actual play.

Navy's touchdown did equal UNM's in that it came 12 seconds into the season.

New Mexico's 428 yards on the ground currently has UNM ranked first in the nation in rushing yards per game.

In 2015's version of the Rio Grande Rivalry Game, New Mexico State hit a field goal with 11:40 to go in the third quarter. When that happened it pushed UNM's deficit to 15 points at 29-14, and things looked a little bleak in Lobo Land. New Mexico had never come back from a 15-point deficit against New Mexico State in its history.

However, last year's Lobos were something special, and UNM fought back, behind Lamar Jordan and UNM's stout running game.

Jordan, who twice as a freshman led UNM on fourth quarter game-winning touchdowns drives, helped the Lobos come all the way back, scoring 24 straight points to wipe out that deficit and win 38-29. The comeback was tied for the seventh-largest comeback in school

Cox and Sanders Earn Mountain West Players of the Week

Dakota Cox and Jason Sanders were honored by the Mountain West as the league's Defensive and Special Teams Player of the Week, announced league officials on Monday. The honor is the second of Cox's career, and the first for Sanders.

It was nearly a sweep, but the Offensive Player of the Week went to Wyoming quarterback Josh Allen.

Cox had his best day since injuring his knee against Boise State in 2014, racking up 14 tackles, nine of which were solos. Of his 14 tackles, two were for losses and two were for no gain. He also added a forced fumble on a sack and a diving interception. Both of his forced turnovers came in the second half and led to 10 second half points.

The sack/fumble thwarted South Dakota's opening second half drive and led to a UNM field goal. The interception came on the opening play of the fourth quarter, and UNM cashed in with a touchdown on it. Overall, Cox helped lead a defense that allowed just 158 yards over the final 11 drives of the game, keeping USD scoreless on 10 of those.

For Sanders, he was perfect on the night in tying a career-high with 12 points. He went 6-for-6 on extra points and 2-for-2 on field goals, hitting from 27 and 22 yards out. He also had eight touchbacks on nine kickoffs, with the only returned kick going for just 13 yards. Sanders' 12 points equaled the 12 he scored last year against Mississippi Valley State, a game in which he went 9-for-9 on extra points.

Ironically, Cox's only other Mountain West Defensive Player of the Week honor came two years ago after a career night against New Mexico State, which is UNM's opponent this week.

New Mexico also did it in other ways. UNM had 19 Mountain West All-Academic selections, which was the second-most in program history (UNM had 20 two years ago). Also, the Lobos had their second-highest GPA in the last 30 years this past Spring.

That's One Way to Keep the Percentage at 0.0%

Last year UNM was fourth nationally in red zone defense. Technically speaking, UNM is first this year, not allowing a red zone score. Of course, it's easy to not allow a red zone score when the other team never runs a red zone play. South Dakota ran 64 plays on Thursday, and not a single one was in the UNM red zone.

Apodaca On Fire

Austin Apodaca was masterful on Thursday, throwing a career-high 12 completions on 16 attempts and rushing for 41 yards on seven carries. His 12 completions bettered his previous best of 10, set against Nevada in relief last year, going 10-for-12.

In fact, the 12 completions tied for the most by a single quarterback in the Bob Davie era. The only other time a Lobo quarterback picked up 12 completions was in the final game of the 2012 season, when B.R. Holbrook went 12-for-21 against Colorado State, throwing for 205 yards.

He's Number One

Jason Sanders had eight touchbacks on Thursday night, and that's tied for the most in the nation so far. Zane Gonzalez of Arizona State and Diego Gonzalez of Colorado also had eight touchbacks. Ironically, all three kickers had eight touchbacks on nine kickoffs

Good to Know It's There if It's Needed

For a triple option team, it's good to know that when it's needed, New Mexico can throw the ball. The Lobos last season threw for 1,768 yards, and it's the most yards that UNM has thrown in the Bob Davie era. In fact, it's more yards than UNM threw for in 2008, and if you compare all of the past eight years, the 2015 season holds up pretty well with some of the other non-option years.

An Interesting Streak

Jason Sanders hit all six extra points he attempted on Thursday, running his streak to 28 in a row. He would need 18 more to break into the top three on the UNM list, behind Wes Zunker, who hit 46 in a row over the 2003 and 2004 seasons. Joe Hartshorne made 47 in a row over the 1970 and 1971 seasons for the second-most, and Justus Adams hit 76 in a row over the 2012 and 2013 seasons.

Counting his streak with former kicker Zack Rogers, who hit 32, UNM has a current streak of 60 consecutive extra points made dating back to November 22, 2014.

Make It 22 of 25

The Lobos picked up three takeaways against South Dakota, marking the 22nd time in the last 25 games that UNM has recorded a takeaway. The only games in the stretch in which UNM didn't get a takeaway was against Boise State in 2014, a game which saw no turnovers, and San Jose State and Colorado State in 2015.

Oh Hey, Another Big Play for UNM

When you are The University of New Mexico, every play is a scoring opportunity. While teams do all this fancy dandy no-huddle, hurry-up call the play quickly stuff, UNM just lines up and scores. From everywhere. From anywhere really.

Last season UNM led the nation in plays of 60 yards or more and of 70 yards or more. Also, UNM, a team that runs the ball, was the only one in the nation with three pass plays of 80 yards or more (and those all came in the last five games).

What did the season opener bring to the table? Rushes of 60 yards, 75 yards and 84 yards, and a pass play of 62 yards.



Bob Davie enters his fifth season at The University of New Mexico, where he has led the program back to bowl eligibility and a level of national respect as UNM qualified for the 2015 Gildan New Mexico Bowl, the first bowl game for the Lobos since 2007.

Davie's 18 wins in his first four seasons already has him tied for eighth on the career wins list at UNM, and he has helped the program achieve levels not seen in Albuquerque for many years. Yet it's how he has been able to do it that is what has Lobo fans excited for the program.

Davie has completely flipped and turned his rosters over, combining an energetic mix of talent from Texas and California while averaging nearly 25 native New Mexican players per season on the roster, with many of those major contributors.

It all clicked in 2015 as after 11 wins in his first three seasons which nearly quadrupled the previous three seasons' total, the program took a big leap, picking up three signature wins in the month of November as the Lobos clinched its first winning season and bowl game since the 2007 season. The Lobos knocked off three 10-win teams from a year ago, including a pair of stunning upsets to open November. First UNM took down first place Utah State 14-13. Then, UNM announced their presence to the college football world with a 31-24 victory on the road over Boise State to clinch bowl eligibility. UNM then defeated Mountain Division champions Air Force 47-35. Those wins were the first three wins over bowl eligible teams in the last seven seasons.

The Lobos tied for its most conference wins since the 1997 season with five. Offensively the team tied a school record with 42 rushing touchdowns and finished in the top 10 in the NCAA in rushing for the fourth straight season and was ninth nationally in fourth down conversion percentage and 11th in total conversions. UNM also led the nation in total plays from scrimmage of 60 yards or more (11) and 70 yards or more (7), showcasing the explosive offense.

Defensively, UNM ranked as the fourth-most improved defense in the nation in terms of yards allowed, shaving off 81.6 yards per game from 2014. UNM also shaved 7.5 points per game off their 2014 scoring defense, and that was the 15th most improved in the NCAA. UNM's rushing defense was the nation's third-most improved in terms of yards per game (76.3 yards per game less than 2014) and it was fourth in terms of yards per carry (1.29 yards per carry less than 2014).

All of that added up to a 7-5 regular season, a 5-3 mark and second place in the Mountain West's Mountain Division and a berth in the 2015 Gildan New Mexico Bowl, which UNM fought down to the wire in a 45-37 loss to Arizona. UNM picked up four All-Mountain West honors, including a Second Team selection as a returner for Carlos Wiggins. The Lobos also picked up 19 Mountain West All-Academic honors, the second-highest total in program history.

An overall hallmark of the program under Davie has been special teams, as UNM's eight touchdowns on kickoff returns over his first four seasons are tied with Kansas State for the most in the FBS over that time frame.

And the success and improvement isn't just on the field ... it's off it. In the first four seasons under Davie, the Lobos have picked up 69 Mountain West All-Academic selections, including a program record 20 in 2014, and 19 in 2015, the second-best total for football in school history. UNM also had five Mountain West Scholar-Athletes in 2013, the second-best total among the MW's 12 football programs.

Over his time, the Lobos have posted the second-highest single semester GPA in program history (Spring of 2016) and two of the top three Fall semester GPAs in program history (Fall of 2013 and Fall of 2015).

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. — The University of New Mexico Lobos scored 31 unanswered points to wrestle away a quick lead by South Dakota, taking down the Coyotes 48-21 in the season opener for both teams. UNM's offense rolled up 615 yards, the 15th-best total in school history.

If the opening play is any indication of how a season will go, it's going to be explosive. Teriyon Gipson took the opening handoff and raced 75 yards for a touchdown just 12 seconds into the contest. South Dakota did have an answer, as they went 75 yards in five plays, and then after a fumble, USD went 90 yards in nine plays to make it 14-7 9:10 into the game.

To that point, the Coyotes had 165 yards of offense, but UNM's veteran defense took charge after that, limiting the USD squad to just 158 the rest of the game, 75 of which came on the only scoring drive of the final three quarters for the Coyotes.

UNM was led by starting quarterback Austin Apodaca, who was nothing short of brilliant, rushing 41 yards on seven carries and going 12-for-16 through the air for 172 yards and two touchdowns. Both of those TDs were on brilliant catches. The first was over the middle by Matt Quarells, who caught a pass with a defender draped all over him and broke away for a 62-yard score. The second was at the end of a perfect two-minute drill as Apodaca hit Q' Drennan near the five yard line, leaping for the grab and then spinning into the end zone for his first career catch.

That made it 35-14 at the break and it was pretty much over from there as USD never really threatened.

Gipson, who scored on that opening 75-yard run, went 84 on his next touch to make it 14-14 just 59 seconds after USD went up 14-7. Quarells' catch gave UNM its lead for good, and then Richard McQuarley scored the first of his two touchdowns.

In the second half, Jason Sanders hit a pair of field goals sandwiched around USD's lone touchdown, but with the game at 41-21, McQuarley scored on a bruising 14-yard run through the middle for the final score of the game.

However, while the offense was rolling, the defense did as well over the final three quarters. Dakota Cox, who is looking to become the first player to lead the team in tackles all four seasons, got off to the right start with 14 tackles, 2.0 for loss, a sack, a forced fumble and an interception. Both turnovers he had a hand in turned into second half scores.

Overall, the Lobos recorded three sacks and six tackles for loss along with forcing three turnovers. After allowing two touchdowns on the first two drives, UNM forced five punts, two turnovers, a turnover on downs and two end of halves, getting 10 stops on the final 11 possessions, only two of which saw the Coyotes gain more than 20 yards.
