## #GoLobos at a Glance (#GoLobos)

#### The Season:

The University of New Mexico Lobos are in the seventh year of the Bob Davie era, and the team is 2-1 on the season. The Lobos before their bye went to Las Cruces and went on a 35-3 run to defeat New Mexico State 42-25. Liberty is 1-2 on the season. The Flames had an unscheduled bye when Hurricane Florence forced the moving of their game with Norfolk State to the end of the season. The Flames are coming off a 47-7 loss to North Texas.

#### The Coaches:

The University of New Mexico Lobos are coached by Bob Davie, who is 32-46 in his seventh season with the Lobos, and he is 67-71 overall in his 12th season. He spent his first five seasons as a head coach manning the Notre Dame Fighting Irish. After leading the Lobos to back-to-back bowl games in 2015 and 2016, Davie has now been the head coach for five bowl teams, three at Notre Dame and two at New Mexico.

Liberty is coached by Turner Gill, and he is 42-31 in his seventh season with the Flames, never producing a losing record over that time. He also spent four years at Buffalo and two at Kansas, and has a 67-80 overall record in his 13th year as a head coach.

All player interviews must be arranged through the UNM athletics communications office. The main time for interviews is after practice. Wednesday is the last day for player interviews. For lengthier interviews, please call the communications office to arrange, which we are happy to do, working around class schedules. These will normally take place in the communications suite in the Maloof Center.

Postgame: The UNM locker room is closed. Requested players will be brought to the second floor team room after home games and outside the locker room for road games.

For road games, all interviews will be posted to UNM's Media Dropbox account, along with selected highlights. These are provided for your useage, but please credit LoboTV.

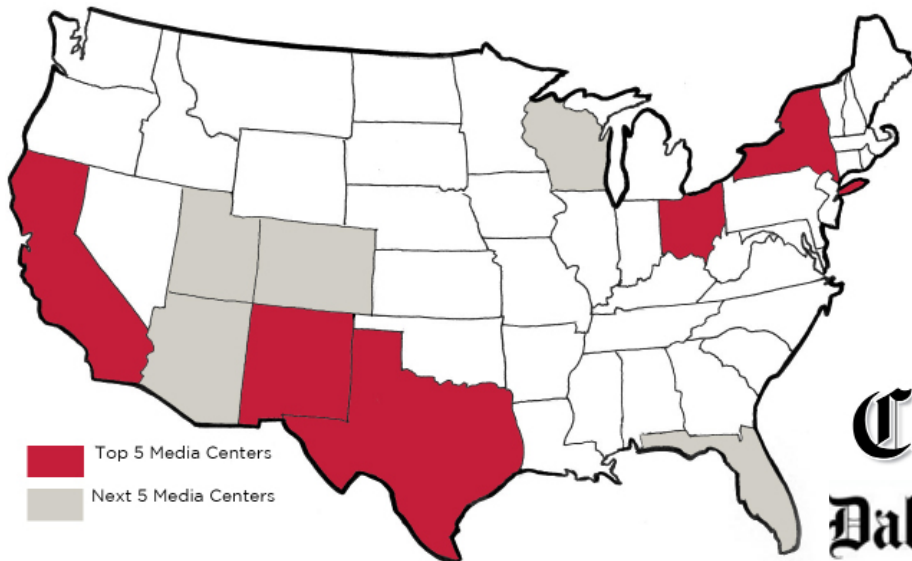

**The Opening List**

The Lobo defense came up big last Saturday. Big as in five interceptions. That was a number that tied the school record, and each interception had a return, to the tune of 148 yards, which also broke the previous UNM record. **Homecoming Records**

Saturday is Homecoming for UNM, and the Lobos own an all-time record of 45-45-3 on Homecoming, a .500 percentage. Since becoming head coach, Bob Davie is 4-2 on Homecoming, having won three in a row.

The September 29 date is one day earlier than last year's game for Homecoming, which was against Air Force on September 30. This will be the 12th Homecoming game played by UNM in the month of September, and all but one of those have occurred from 1990 on. UNM is 4-7 in September for Homecoming.

UNM's current three-game Homecoming winning streak is the best since winning six straight from 1999-2004 under Rocky Long.

**Give Me Liberty, or Give Me ... Another First Time Opponent**

Liberty is the third of three first-time opponents on the UNM schedule this year, following Incarnate Word and Wisconsin. The Flames are the second independent team that UNM is facing (New Mexico State being the other) and next year it will be three of four non-conference opponents that are independents as the Lobos travel to face Notre Dame as well next year.

Since 1894 (yes we are going back that far for this), the Lobo have faced 36 teams just once. Amazingly, UNM is 18-18 in such games after going 1-1 to open the season.

**Deja Vu All Over Again**

What if I told you...

\*UNM would lose its No. 2 quarterback to injury in the second half of a home game...

\*UNM would be forced to play against a nationally-ranked caliber opponent in its next game with just its number one and number three quarterbacks.

\*UNM would be forced to turn to the No. 3 quarterback in the second quarter due to an injury.

\*UNM would see that quarterback perform well, move the ball a bit and get one long touchdown drive in the fourth quarter.

\*UNM would then go on the road without a Division I win looking to beat a bowl winning team that started out poorly on its own, needing its third string quarterback to lead the way.

That sounds like what just happened with UNM, losing Coltin Gerhart in the Incarnate Word game, then playing Wisconsin, losing start Tevaka Tuioti, and having Sheriron Jones go in and help UNM to a road win at New Mexico State. However, that EXACT scenario happened in 2017.

UNM lost Tevaka Tuioti in the New Mexico State game at Dreamstyle Stadium, then went to Boise State, where Lamar Jordan got hurt. Coltin Gerhart led one TD drive against Boise State after entering in the second quarter, and then started at Tulsa, beating a bowl winning Golden Hurricane team.

**2-1 Musings**

With New Mexico sitting at 2-1 for the first time since opening 2-1 in the 2007 season. UNM is looking to move to 3-1, and if it can do that, it would again be the first time since the 2007 season. It would also mark just the 11th time since the 1955 season that the Lobos would be 3-1 or better after four games. The following chart has those other 10 seasons, what happened afterwards, and who the coach was.

**Shot at a Third Non-Conference Win Doesn't Always Happen**

The last time UNM won three non-conference games in a season (not counting bowl games) was under Bob Davie in his opening season when UNM defeated Southern, New Mexico State and Texas State. UNM went 3-2 that season as UNM played five non-conference games.

The last time UNM won three non-conference games in-season and just played four games (like this season) was in 2007 when UNM defeated Arizona, New Mexico State and Sacramento State. In the last 20 seasons, 2007 and 2012 are the only two in which UNM picked up three non-conference wins in a single season.

**This is a Three Year Trend Worth Bragging About**

As head coach Bob Davie coaches in his seventh season with the Lobos, one can really break up his career at UNM into two three-year segments. You couple that with the three years previous to his arrival and it's easy to see the truly remarkable job he has done in bringing back Lobo football to respectability and making UNM a team no one wants to play.

From 2009-11 under Mike Locksley (and for a few games George Barlow), the Lobos went 1-11 in 2009, 1-11 in 2010, and 1-11 in 2011, putting the Lobos 30 games under .500. Enter Bob Davie and the world's hardest reclamation project. All he did in those first three years was go 4-9 in 2012 (in a season without a bye week), 3-9 in 2013 and 4-8 in 2014. That 11-26 record was a 15-game improvement, as the team went from 30 games under the previous three-year span to 15 games under.

Fast forward to 2015-17, and the squad has gone 19-19. The team went 7-6 in 2015, 9-4 in 2016 and 3-9 in 2017. That marks the second straight 15-game improvement over a three-year stretch, virtually unheard of. Also, it's not just the wins that improved as well, as the following chart attests:

**Seriously, How Good is Aaron Jenkins?**

Aaron Jenkins will go down as one of the top linemen in UNM history. Jenkins was well decorated in the preseason, earning First Team All-Mountain West honors from both Athlon Sports and Lindy's. Jenkins would have played as a true freshman in 2014, but he injured his shoulder against Arizona State in the second game of the season and earned a medical redshirt, and that medical redshirt will work to his advantage in a chase for the record for most games played by a Lobo.

This season, Jenkins has played all but six snaps this year (225 of 231). He hasn't allowed a sack in 80 pass blocking snaps, has hasn't committed a penalty, and he hasn't allowed any of UNM's quarterbacks to be hit either. He has allowed just one hurry, the lowest total on the team.

Among the Mountain West's 45 lineman that have played 200 snaps, Jenkins is second in fewest total pressures. The only lineman in the league with fewer total pressures (sacks + hurries + hits) is Wyoming's Kaden Jackson.

Jenkins now has 43 games played, having started all 41 in the last four seasons, That means that he needs just eight more games to break the record of 50, held by six other players. Additionally, none of those six started all 50 games, meaning Jenkins can set the career record for starts and consecutive starts as well.

Jenkins has done it all over as well, playing four positions along the line, with center the one position he hasn't played in a game, although he has practiced there and been listed third on the depth chart there at times.

**Sgt. Takeraway and Booker**

UNM had one interception in each of its first two games (Jalin Burrell in the opener, Evahelotu Tohi in the second) before getting five against New Mexico State. That gave UNM nine takeaways on the season, including seven interceptions.

New Mexico needed to improve its takeaways in 2018 after getting just 13 in 2017 and just 13 in 2016. So far in 2018, so good.

UNM's nine takeaways would extrapolate to 36 for the season, and the last time UNM had at least 30 takeaways in a season was in 1991 when the team had 32 with 19 fumble recoveries and 13 interceptions.

Why is winning that turnover battle so big? Dating back to October 10, 2014, the Lobos are 13-0 when winning the turnover battle. The last time they won the battle and lost was on that date, when UNM got four takeaways to SDSU's one. Those four takeaways all occurred in the fourth quarter over the span of six plays, including the final three in a row. UNM lost the turnover battle against Wisconsin, getting two but losing three.

### Taking a TO

Tyrone Owens became the 17th Lobo with 2,000 career yards rushing when he scored on a 6-yard run late in the first quarter of the season opener.

For the third straight game, Owens moved up on the list. Owens rushed for 110 yards against New Mexico State on a career-high 30 carries, and he now has 2,210 yards, moving him ahead of Gordon Lennox, who had 2,131 yards rushing in his career.

Owens is 155 yards from passing Mike Carter for 11th place on the all-time Lobo rushing list.

### Out Work, Out Hit, Out Discipline

Throughout his tenure with UNM, coach Bob Davie installed a team mantra of "Out Work, Out Hit, Out Discipline". The 2018 off-season saw UNM take that mantra to new heights.

The Lobos historically under Davie have hit the community hard, with plenty of trips to local elementary schools, trips to the UNM Children's hospital, visits to Ronald McDonald house and Joy Junction, and other projects. After the 2017 season, the team did that and more. Additionally, Coach Davie wanted a bigger emphasis in the classroom, and he got that as well.

UNM football players turned in a 2.85 GPA in the Spring semester, the second-best GPA for the team in any semester since the department started keeping full track in 1988. The Lobos also picked up a program record 23 Mountain West All-Academic selections. The four highest Mountain West All-Academic totals have occurred in the last four seasons under Davie's watch.

### Literally Big Shoes to Fill

The AFC East will be followed very closely by the UNM coaching staff. Jason Sanders was a seventh round draft choice of the Miami Dolphins, and he won the starting placekicker job for the Dolphins. Corey Bojorquez was signed by New England as a free agent after winning a spot in a free agent tryout. The Patriots

## Lobos in the NFL

**Byron Bell** Green Bay Packers **Offensive Tackle**  
Bell was an undrafted free agent and is his seventh season in the NFL and first with the Green Bay Packers after one with the Dallas, one with Tennessee and four with the Panthers. He has started 72 games in his NFL career, playing in 90 games.

**Glover Quin** Detroit Lions **Safety**  
Quin is in his 10th season in the NFL, and sixth with Detroit. Glover was a 4th round draft choice, and the 112th overall pick by the Houston Texans in 2009. He has played in 145 out of a possible 146 games in his career with 663 total tackles, 3.0 sacks, 10 forced fumbles, four fumble recoveries, 24 interceptions, 82 passes defensed and two touchdowns.

**Jason Sanders** Miami Dolphins **Kicker**  
Sanders is in his first season with Miami after getting drafted in the seventh round by Miami.

**Corey Bojorquez** Buffalo Bills **Punter**  
Bojorquez is in his first season with Buffalo. He spent the 2018 camp with New England after earning an invite to tryout camp and then getting signed to a free agent contract. He didn't punt in the preseason and was cut and then claimed by Buffalo on waivers.

**Jhurrell Pressley** New York Giants **Running Back**  
Pressley is in his third season in the NFL, and is with his fourth team after playing with the Packers and Vikings and earning a Super Bowl trip in 2017 with the Atlanta Falcons. The Giants cut Pressley on September 1 and added him to the practice squad on September 2.

cut Bojorquez and then was headed to their practice squad, but Buffalo claimed him off waivers and then cut their punter of the last four seasons. Bojorquez is now the starting punter and holder for Buffalo. Those are two big shoes to fill.

Punting-wise, Tyson Dyer is the replacement for Bojorquez, and he is averaging 43.5 yards per punt, and that's good for 27th nationally. Dyer had a huge punt late in the game, flipping the field with a 62 yard punt, as UNM punted from inside its own end zone and NMSU eventually started from inside its 20.

The placekicking job went to Andrew Shelley, who is now 16-for-17 on extra points, hitting the right upright on his only miss. For Shelley, he is the third kicker in the last four years under Davie to hail from the metro area, joining Justus Adams (2013, Albuquerque) and Zack Rogers (2014-15, Rio Rancho). He has not attempted a field goal yet this season.

## Hot Take, Cover Me is Springsteen's Best Song

New Mexico's kickoff coverage unit never had to do much in 2017 with all of the touchbacks by Jason Sanders, as UNM's average opponent starting field position after a kickoff was the 25-yard line. UNM has used three kickoff specialists so far this year, with Danny Sutton missing the opener due to illness. But Sutton, combined with Dylan Kelly-Romero and Stephen Ruiz, have turned in a better job. The three have combined for eight touchbacks on 20 kickoffs, but opponents are starting on average at its own 21-yard line.

UNM is allowing just 14.5 yards per return over 10 returns this year, which puts UNM's kickoff coverage tied for fifth nationally. Ironically, UNM is tied with another Mountain West team, San Diego State. Wyoming leads the nation, allowing just 10 yards per return on just two returns.

## It Was Bound to Happen

When NMSU's Dylan Brown missed a 35-yard field goal in the third quarter, one could be forgiven if Lobo fans didn't know what they had witnessed. UNM opponents had made 14 straight field goals, dating back to week one of the 2017 season before that miss. In fact, the last time a Lobo opponent missed a field goal inside of 40 yards was October 1, 2016 when San Jose State missed a 29-yard field goal.

## Ch-Ch-Ch-Changes

UNM made some changes to its coaching staff for the 2018 season. Along with the addition of a 10th assistant coach, UNM has two new coaches and a couple of responsibility switches.

Calvin Magee has replaced Bob DeBesse as offensive coordinator, the first new offensive coordinator for Bob Davie in his seven-year tenure. Additionally, Magee will coach running backs, necessitating a switch from running backs to receivers for Scott Baumgartner. Baumgartner coached receivers previously at UNM.

The Lobos added Perry Eliano to replace Al Simmons as the cornerbacks coach. Eliano, who came to UNM from Bowling Green, will also take over as special teams coach from Apollo Wright, who has more to do with quarterbacks and UNM's passing game.

The final coaching addition is Archie McDaniel, who previously coached at UNM before moving to SMU. McDaniel will coach outside linebackers as Kevin Cosgrove will handle inside linebackers. Additionally, Jordan Paterson is now the defensive passing game coordinator. UNM has also added a pair of former players as G.A.s for the 2018 season with Jacob Girdle aiding the offense and Jake Rothschilder helping out on defense.

## You Get a Scholarship...and You Get a Scholarship!

Prior to Spring Football Camp, head coach Bob Davie announced that three Lobos were getting put on full scholarship, including a pair of New Mexico walk-ons. Rafael Hidalgo from New York earned a scholarship along with Albuquerque natives Thomas Vieira and Javohn Jones.

Vieira and Jones were both honored this past season as New Mexico Man, with Javohn Jones earning the honor of carrying the state flag against Abilene Christian in the opener and Thomas Vieira getting the nod in the season finale against UNLV. All told over Bob Davie's first six seasons with UNM, 23 different New Mexico walk-ons have earned the right to be called "The New Mexico Man" and carry the state flag onto the field, leading the team. Of those 23, eighth have eventually earned a full scholarship.

## Lilly Helps Extend UNM's Streak

One of the hallmarks of Bob Davie's teams at New Mexico are kickoff returns. Specifically kickoff return touchdowns. Through nine games in 2017, it was starting to look like a crazy streak for UNM was going to end, but then Elijah Lilly happened. Lilly went 100 yards against Texas A&M for a touchdown, extending UNM's streak of consecutive seasons with a kickoff return touchdown to eight straight. The University of New Mexico now has had 10 in the last six seasons, and it could have been 12, but Elijah Lilly's 100-yard return for a touchdown was called back against New Mexico State due to a holding call, and a 93-yarder earlier in the Texas A&M game was called back via a replay review. Still the 10 over the last six-plus seasons is one behind San Diego State and Kansas State for the most kickoff return touchdowns over the last six-plus years. Below are the top 10 FBS teams in terms of kickoff return touchdowns since 2012 and the top streaks in years.

Chemotherapy (This was first tested in 1942 by Alfred Gilman, Louis S. Goodman and Frederick S. Philips)

## UNM Excelling in the Classroom As Well

For 2017, the Lobos picked up 23 Mountain West All-Academic selections, the most in the history of the program. The previous school record was under Coach Davie as well, in 2014 when the team picked up 20. Overall the 81 honorees over the last four years is the best four-year stretch in school history.

The Lobos in 2017 had a team GPA of 2.85, and that was the second-best grade point average over the past 30 Spring semesters. ### Ended That Streak

UNM trailed 17-7 after one quarter against New Mexico State but won 42-25. That ended a streak of 10 straight games lost when trailing after the first quarter. UNM's last win in such a game was November 12, 2016 when the Lobos trailed 14-0 after the opening quarter and won 24-21 at Utah State.

### It's a Shame They're Charter Flights Because Sky Miles Would Be Great

New Mexico will play 10 games in the Mountain Time Zone in 2018, and an interesting scheduling quirk has occurred out of this round of the schedule. With the Mountain West's eight-game conference schedule, the road games within the division are the same every two years, but the cross over games are different, and when you couple in UNM's two non-conference games, you can at least say that the Lobos shouldn't be too jet-lagged.

The 2018 Lobos have five flights and a road trip in the busses to New Mexico State. All told, UNM will travel 7,286 miles road trip from its six road games. Two years ago, UNM also went to New Mexico State, Colorado State and Utah State. However, the Lobos played Air Force in Dallas, and went to Hawai'i instead of UNLV, and Rutgers instead of Wisconsin. Two years ago, the Lobos logged 7,248 miles ... one way, meaning this year's round trip travel is just 38 miles less than what the team traveled just one way in 2016. The team in 2016 traveled 14,048 miles round trip.

## vs. Ranked Opponents

New Mexico is 6-51 all-time against ranked opponents dating back to the 1940 season. UNM is 4-23 at home vs. ranked opponents and 2-17 on the road. UNM's last win over a ranked opponent was on October 25, 2003 when the Lobos won at No. 23 Utah 47-35. UNM's last win over a top 10 program was also against Utah, a 23-21 win on November 5, 1994. UNM is 1-16 all-time against top-10 teams, and this will be just the fifth top-five team UNM has played. Bob Davie enters his seventh season at The University of New Mexico, where he has led the program to back-to-back bowl games, a 2016 Gildan New Mexico Bowl title, and increased respect in the form of nationally televised games and increased media attention.

The 2017 season saw him complete his 31st season as a collegiate football coach, and it marked his 41st season overall in the sport, including 10 years as a broadcaster at ESPN.

While the 2017 season did not see the results on the field that Davie and the Lobos got used too, it still had many successful moments. The season culminated with four Lobos making it into NFL camps, including the program's first draft choice in eight years with Jason Sanders as a seventh-round selection of the Miami Dolphins. Additionally, Lamar Jordan signed a free agent contract with the Atlanta Falcons and Corey Bojorquez did likewise with the New England Patriots.

The Lobos finished among the national leaders in kickoff coverage and punt coverage, and running back Richard McQuarley tied the school record with five touchdown runs against Air Force.

In addition, the Lobos continued their streak in which the team has returned a kickoff for a touchdown in all six of Bob Davie's seasons as Elijah Lilly took one back against Texas A&M. The touchdown was the 10th in the last six seasons, and that is tied for the third-most in the nation over that time period, and UNM's streak of one kickoff return for a touchdown over the last eight years is the second-longest active streak nationally.

UNM was also strong off the field, with a program record 23 Mountain West All-Academic selections and a 2.85 GPA in the Spring semester, the highest under Davie.

It's safe to say that his first five years at New Mexico has seen him orchestrate one of the best rebuilding jobs in the history of the sport. When he arrived on campus in 2012, he inherited a program that had gone just 3-37 in the previous 40 games and had the lowest number of scholarship players in Division I. Knowing that back story makes UNM's recent stretch all the more remarkable.

After a big season in 2015 which saw UNM go 7-5 and tie for second place in the Mountain Division of the Mountain West, his team not only met that mark but surpassed it in 2016 as New Mexico went 8-4 overall and 6-2 in the Mountain Division, tying for first place and delivering UNM's first division title since 1997. The Lobos defeated four 2016 bowl teams in Air Force (45-40), Hawai'i (28-21), Wyoming (56-35) and UTSA (23-20), giving the program seven wins over bowl teams in the last two years after going seven straight seasons without a win over a bowl team. The 2016 Lobos feature the nation's best rushing attack, as UNM leads the nation in rushing yards, yards per game, yards per rush, and runs of 10, 20, 30, 40, 50, 60 and 70 yards. The 2016 squad has also set school records for total points scored, points per game, and total offense, nearly hitting the 6,000-yard mark.

The Lobos also tied for the most conference wins in a single season, going 6-2, a mark that was also accomplished in 1982 and 1997. In addition, the Lobos have excelled on national television, winning four games on ESPN's various networks, including a pair of games in November on ESPN2 with a 24-21 win at Utah State and 56-35 over Wyoming, a game in which UNM totaled 690 yards of total offense and 568 yards on the ground.

Defensively, UNM showed vast improvement in its rushing defense, going from 98th nationally to top 40. Dakota Cox led the team in tackles, marking the first time that a Lobo has ever led the team in tackles four straight seasons. Once again, New Mexico got three defensive scores, making UNM one of eight teams in the last two years to register three defensive touchdowns in 2015 and 2016. UNM's defense also had a stretch in 2016 where it allowed 350 yards or less in three straight game, the first time since 2007 it accomplished that feat. The Lobos had eight players earn All-MW honors, including four on the second team.

**LAS CRUCES, N.M.** --- Down 14-0 in the first quarter, down to a third-string quarterback in Sherion Jones, UNM's defense needed to make a stand. Boy did it ever. The Lobos picked three New Mexico State quarterbacks a total of five times, tying a school record, and the defense led the way in a thriller in Las Cruces, winning 42-25 to end a two-game losing streak in the Rio Grande Rivalry.

The win pushed New Mexico to 2-1 for the first time in 11 years, and it kept a hungry New Mexico State squad winless at 0-4 on the season. UNM heads into its bye week with some momentum before hosting Liberty at 4 p.m. on Saturday, September 29 at Dreamstyle Arena.

New Mexico found itself down 14-0 just 4:10 into the contest. On the game's third play, and Jones' first pass, Terrill Hanks picked off a screen and went 28 yards for a 7-0 lead. After a punt, the Aggies behind Matt Romero went 57 yards, the last 2 by calling his own number and just 4:10 into the game it was 14-0.

New Mexico State had the ball again with a chance to go up more, but UNM forced a punt, and freshman Marcus Hayes returned it 27 yards to the Aggie 30-yard line. That field position allowed for UNM to go the distance in five plays, the last a 1-yard run by Ahmari Davis, his first career touchdown. It was the first of four on the night for Davis, whose four were tied for the third most in school history.

NMSU's Dylan Brown tacked on a 42-yard field goal and after one quarter it was 17-7, but that would be the last real salvo for the Aggie offense. On 3rd-and-8, Romero threw the first of his five interceptions as D'Angelo Ross picked it off and returned the ball to the Aggie 27. With that field position, UNM got a second straight 1-yard touchdown run and it was 17-14.

After each team punted, Romero was picked off again as DeJean Rogers did the honors, returning the ball to the 6-yard line. Tyrone Owens, who led UNM with 110 yards rushing, scored to give the Lobos the lead for good, and make it 21-17 at the break after Nick Jeanty was picked off to end the half.

UNM got two more Davis touchdown runs to make it 35-17. The first was the caper of a brilliant 16-play, 80-yard drive that thrice saw Jones convert third downs. One was a 16-yard Jones run on third-and-13, the second was a 12-yard pass to Brayden Dickey and the third was a Davis 1-yard run. Davis' 3-yard TD capped it.

In the fourth, Davis' fourth TD made it 35-17 after Jones led a 12-play, 77-yard drive and Davis scored from 16 yards out. That looked like it was it, but the Aggies made one last push. They went to third string quarterback Josh Adkins, and his wheeler pass to Jason Huntley went for 58 yards, and after a two-point conversion it was 35-25 with 11:06 to go.

After both teams punted NMSU got the ball back and marched to a first and goal at the Lobo nine, and then somehow ran seven plays, recording two first downs, but not scoring. After getting to the Lobo three, a pass interference penalty moved the ball to the 2-yard line. Jason Huntley then scored, but a hold on NMSU moved the ball back to the 12. UNM held and it looked like the Aggies would have to settle for a field goal, but a personal foul on UNM made it first and goal at the 4-yard line. After an incompletion, Adkins tried to hit Huntley in the flat, but Marcus Hayes read it and turned in UNM's fourth interception of the night.

UNM couldn't get a first down and Tyson Dyer unloaded a 62-yard punt into the wind and pinned NMSU after a penalty at its own 19. On third-and-12, Hayes stepped in front of an Adkins pass for a record-tying fifth Lobo interception, and he housed it from 60 yards out for the final score.
