

POSTGAME NOTES: BYU 79, NEW MEXICO 73

Matchup Notes

- All net proceeds from the game will be donated to Hurricane Harvey relief.
- BYU leads all-time series vs. UNM 76-55
- First time UNM and BYU have met since December 23, 2015 at the Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic. BYU won the game 96-66.
- BYU played in the Mountain West until the 2011-2012 season, when they joined the West Coast Conference.

Team Notes

- This is the first time Paul Weir has coached the Lobos against another school, with his only other public Lobo coaching appearance being the first annual Cherry v. Silver Scrimmage.
- The Lobos welcome six new transfers this season, four of which are eligible to play in the upcoming campaign. The team also signed three freshmen.
- Starting Lineup: Chris McNeal, Sam Logwood, Joe Furstinger, Dane Kuiper and Troy Simons
- First game in The Pit under its new name, Dreamstyle Arena
- Senior Sam Logwood is the top returning scorer for the Lobos, averaging 7.3 PPG last season, good for third on the team.

In-Game Notes

- Lobos forced 23 turnovers in the game, 12 in the first half
- Sam Logwood led all scorers with 23 points (8-15 FG, 7-11 FT)
- Junior Troy Simons led the Lobos in minutes played with 28
- Team shot 37.1% from the field (26-70), 66.7% from the free throw line (16-24)
- 12 lead changes in the game
- Lobos were outrebounded by the Cougars 48-33
