• With the win, the Lobos are now tied for third in the Mountain West standings.

Notes:

- Joe Furstinger hit his 100th career block making him tied for 8th all-time in UNM history.
- Five of the Lobos scored in double-digits including Anthony Mathis (18), Sam Logwood (17), Joe Furstinger (13), Makuach Maluach (13) and Dane Kuiper (10).
- Sam Logwood notched his first double-double of the season with 13 points and 10 rebounds. It also marks his second of his career.
- Sam Logwood's 10 rebounds marks a new career-high.
- The Lobos' field goal percentage was 50% compared to 48.3% for UNLV.
- From behind the arc, UNM shot 50% (11-22) compared to 57.1% for UNLV (4-7).
- The Lobos shot 82.8% from the free-throw line while UNLV shot 70%.
- The Lobos led for 30:37 of the game with the largest lead of 11, which happened twice at the 14:07 and 11:49 marks in the second half.
- Anthony Mathis now scored in double-digits for 16 straight games.
 - He now has 88 3-pointers on the season (record is 102).
 - He shot 60% (3-5) from the arc which is above his average. He entered the game ranking fourth in the nation in 3-point percentage (49.1).
- The score was tied six times in the game and the lead changed 11 times.
- Attendance for the game was 12,080.
