

Coach Mike Bradbury:

On the team's defensive performance:

"Yeah, we were good. We were really good. You know, it got a little sloppy in the last five minutes. I don't know what the biggest lead was, it looked like it was close to 30 when we subbed out. But we were much more focused and played much better."

On if offensive adjustments were made from the previous games:
