#HIGHLIGHTS

(NOTES FROM AROUND THE MOUNTAIN WEST IN 140 CHARACTERS OR LESS)

- .@NevadaFootball opens the Jay Norvell era on Sat., Sept. 2. This is Norvell's first head coaching job.
- .@FresnoStateFB head coach Jeff Tedford begins his FS career when the Bulldogs host Incarnate Word on Sat., Sept. 2. Tedford spent 11 years as the head coach at Cal from 2002-12.
- .@CSUFootball's 31-point win over Oregon State is the largest against an Autonomous 5 opponent in program history.
- .@CSUFootball's 31-point victory is the 5th-largest by a @MountainWest member over an Autonomous 5 team since 2010.
- .@CSUFootball has sold a program-record of more than 15,000 season tickets as of the beginning of August. The previous school record was 11,500.
- .@BroncoSportsFB has been selected to win the Mountain Division for the fourth consecutive season.
- .@GoAztecs are the first team in MW history to be selected as unanimous divisional champs in back-to-back seasons.
- .@BroncoSportsFB has defeated an Autonomous 5 team in five of six seasons since joining the @MountainWest.
- .@BroncoSportsFB has won 23-consecutive nonconference home games, the last loss came on Dec. 28, 2005 vs. Boston College.
- .@AFFootball enters 2017 tied for 4th nationally with a 6-game win streak, trailing only USC (9), Western Kentucky (8) & Coastal Carolina (7).
- .@unlvfootball's Devonte Boyd enters his senior season needing 1,005 receiving yds to hold the @MountainWest record for career receiving yds.
- .@MountainWest teams have compiled a 97-74 (.567) record, including 75 victories at home, in season openers since the league's inception in 1999.
- .@MountainWest institutions have recorded Top-25 victories in three of the last four years.
- .@SJSUSpartanFB is 1 of 3 teams nationally to play at least 3 ranked opponents in the first 4 weeks.
- .@SJSUSpartanFB is seeking its first win against a ranked opponent since Nov. 29, 2013 (#16 Fresno State, 62-52).
- In the 18 seasons since the league's inception, the @MountainWest's champion or a current MW member has been a BCS/CFP participant 8 times.
- Seven first-team All-Mountain West selections from 2016 return this season, including two on offense and four on defense.

JOSH ALLEN ATTENTION

Wyoming junior quarterback Josh Allen is one of the nation's top quarterbacks heading into the 2017 season, and he has the national interest to accompany the talent.

After the 2017 NFL Draft, ESPN NFL Insider Adam Schefter said of Allen, "one personnel director told me this weekend, you can put it in the books, Josh Allen will be the No. 1 pick in the NFL draft next year."

If Allen were selected with the top pick, the Mountain West would have the most No. 1 overall selections among Group of 5 conferences.

BOISE STATE'S AUTONOMOUS 5 SUCCESS

Boise State has defeated an Autonomous 5 institution in five of six seasons since joining the Mountain West. This year, the Broncos travel to Washington State (Sept. 9) and host Virginia (Sept. 22).

Since 2010, BSU has compiled an 11-6 (.647) record against current Autonomous 5 programs. The Broncos have defeated Arizona, Arizona State, Georgia, Oregon State, Utah, Virginia, Washington and Washington State.

JOHN URSUA'S BIG DAY

Hawai'i sophomore WR John Ursua caught 12 passes for 272 yards at UMass on Aug. 26. This is the fourth-most receiving yards in program history and fourth-best in Mountain West annals. Ursua's 272 receiving yards are the most by a MW pass-catcher since Thomas Sperbeck's (Boise State) 281 yards on Nov. 14, 2015.

According to Pro Football Focus, Ursua caught all 12 passes from the slot.

MOUNTAIN VS. WEST

The Mountain Division holds an all-time record of 48-28 (.632) against opponents from the West Division since divisional play was established in the Mountain West in 2013.
