SERIES HISTORY

The Lobos are 16-6 all-time against Utah State, including four in a row and an 80-47 win over the Aggies on Jan. 31 in Albuquerque. The Lobos had four players finish in double figures in the game, led by Jaisa Nunn's 20 points and 12 rebounds. UNM is 7-3 all-time in Logan.

HEADING INTO THE MATCHUP

The Lobos rallied from a 48-44 fourth-quarter deficit by ending the game on a 13-1 run – including a crucial four-point play from Laneah Bryan – to defeat a scrappy Air Force squad 57-49 Saturday afternoon at Dreamstyle Arena – The Pit.

UNM called timeout with 5:56 remaining after a 5-0 run by Air Force gave the Falcons a 48-44 advantage. Out of the timeout, Tesha Buck found Jaisa Nunn under the basket and she scored as she was fouled (she missed the free throw) to cut the deficit to 48-46. Following a stop on the defensive end on Air Force's next possession is when UNM's key momentum-shifting play of the game came.

Cherise Beynon drove the ball in and attracted a pair of defenders, leaving Bryan open from the left wing. The senior took the 3-pointer, and as she was knocked to the ground by an Air Force player trying to box out, the ball bounced off the rim, high off the glass, back off the rim and in as the official called the foul. Bryan connected on the free throw to give the Lobos the lead back at 50-48. UNM scored seven of the next to come away with the win. Nunn finished with 25 points while Beynon had 15 and Bryan added nine.

Utah State has dropped three straight after falling to Boise State 68-60 on Saturday in Boise. The Aggies held a 31-29 lead at the half before being outscored 39-29 in the second half. Shannon Dufficy led Utah State with 13 points and seven rebounds while Victoria Price added 12 and Olivia West had 11.

NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES**SCOUTING UTAH STATE**

The Aggies will look to slow things down as they are second-to-last in the conference in scoring at 57.9 points per game and are seventh in the MW in scoring defense at 67.3. Utah State does its offensive damage inside the arc for the most part as the Aggies are second-to-last in the MW in 3-pointers per game at 4.3 (UNM leads the conference at 9.4 per game).

Olivia West continues to lead the Aggies in scoring at 12.0 per game and is the team's top 3-point threat with 36 (shooting 32.7 percent). Rachel Brewster is averaging 9.4 points while Hailey Bassett is at 9.0 per game. Shannon Dufficy is the team's top rebounder at 8.0 per game to go along with scoring 8.0 points per contest. Eliza West leads the Aggies in assists (88) while Deja Mason leads the team and MW in blocks per game at 1.7.

PLENTY OF 30-POINT PERFORMERS IN 2017-18

The Lobos entering the 2017-18 season had a total of 20 3-point performances in its history. This season? UNM has racked up seven for the 2017-18 campaign - including the first two 40-point performances in program history (Cherise Beynon had 41, Tesha Buck had 40). Beynon and Jaisa Nunn each have three 30-plus point games while Buck has one.

BEYNON, LAPEYROLERIE CLIMBING 3-POINT UNM RANKS

Cherise Beynon and Alex Lapeyrolerie are both sitting in the UNM all-time top 10 when it comes to 3-pointers as Beynon is fourth with 173 while Lapeyrolerie is ninth with 128. Katie Montgomery (2004-07) owns the UNM all-time record with 221.

ALBUQUERQUE IS A HOOPS TOWN - LOBOS 15TH IN ATTENDANCE

The Lobos have long had a great home-court advantage and much of that comes from a great fan base that has UNM 15th in the NCAA in women's basketball attendance at 5,132 per game. The Lobos are ahead of Kentucky, Oregon State and Texas and are just behind Iowa.

BEYNON FIRST TO REACH 1,500-500-500 CLUB

Cherise Beynon with her 41 points against San Diego State on Jan. 20 became the first UNM basketball player - male or female - to reach the 1,500-point, 500-rebound and 500-assist mark as the senior now has 1,608 points, 710 rebounds and 559 assists. Mandi Moore was the first to reach the 1,000, 500 and 500 club as she finished her career with 1,057 points, 603 rebounds and 651 assists for the Lobos from 2002-05.

A DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE

UNM's Jaisa Nunn with her 25 points and 10 rebounds against Boise State on Feb. 7 racked up her 14th double-double - ranking eighth in the NCAA, tops in the Mountain West. On the season Nunn is averaging a double-double with 16.6 points and 10.1 rebounds (tops in the Mountain West).

THREE-SHA BUCK LIGHTING IT UP FROM LONG RANGE

Lobo senior transfer Tesha Buck has made an immediate impact in several facets, but particularly from 3-point range as the Minnesota native ranks in the NCAA top 25 in

3-pointers made (80 - 18th) and 3-pointers per game (3.1 - 23rd). Her 80 3-pointers this season is second on the Lobos' single-season list. The record is 82 set by Abby Garchek during the 1997-98 season.

LOBOS LIGHTING UP SCOREBOARD

UNM is 26 games into the season and hasn't slowed down in putting up big numbers offensively as the Lobos are 14th in the nation and lead the Mountain West in scoring at 82.7 points per game. UNM also has four of the top 16 scorers in the conference in Cherise Beynon (16.9 - first), Jaisa Nunn (16.6 - third), Tesha Buck (14.2 - ninth) and Alex Lapeyrolerie (11.2 - 16th).

RECORD PERFORMANCE FOR BEYNON

Though the Lobos lost at San Diego State on Jan. 20, it wasn't because of a lack of production from senior Cherise Beynon. The Las Vegas, Nevada, native poured in a school-record 41 points while adding eight assists, five rebounds and four steals and no turnovers in 40 minutes. It's tied for the fourth-most points scored in a game in Mountain West history while she also set a MW and UNM record for field goals made with 17.

It's the third time this season a Lobo has broken the school record for scoring – Jaisa Nunn did it against Marquette with 39 points and Tesha Buck scored 40 against Lamar. It's the third time in Beynon's career she's scored 30-plus points.

BEYNON CLIMBING CAREER UNM CHARTS IN ... ALMOST EVERYTHING

Cherise Beynon's first three seasons as a Lobo have been spectacular to say the least and the do-it-all guard will continue to climb the Lobo all-time lists this season. The Las Vegas, Nevada, native is in the career top 10 in points (1,608 - fifth), field goals made (604 - sixth), field goals attempted (1,662 - first), 3-pointers made (173 - fourth), 3-pointers attempted (578 - second), assists (559 - second), steals (239 - second), rebounding (710 - seventh) and minutes played (3,636 - seventh).

NO TEAM HAS STARTED BETTER IN UNM HISTORY

The Lobos with their 90-56 win over Texas Tech on Dec. 6, set a new record for most wins to start the season at 10, bettering the 1996-97 team that started 9-0 (that team finished 18-10).

The 94-87 overtime victory over Navy on Dec. 10 tied another Lobo record as it tied the program's mark for most consecutive victories at 11 - something it did in the 2003-04 and the 1977-78 season. With UNM's 90-58 victory over Lamar on Dec. 20, it also set the Lobo record for best start to a season with only one loss at 12-1 - breaking the record of 11-1 set during the 2008-09 season.

BUCK HUNTS DOWN UNM, MW 3-PT RECORDS

Tesha Buck had a performance for the ages against Lamar on Dec. 20 as she set a then-UNM record (Cherise Beynon scored 41 against San Diego State on Jan. 20) with 40 points to go along with UNM and Mountain West records for 3-pointers made with 10. She's just the seventh player in Mountain West history (started 1999-2000) to reach the 40-point mark in a game while she's the first to reach 10 3-pointers in a game. It was the 58th time a player has hit 10 3-pointers in a game in NCAA Division I women's basketball history. Overall, Buck went 15-for-21 from the field and 10-for-16 from 3-point range - including hitting her first five 3-pointers (all in the first quarter as she had 17 points in the opening period).

FIRST OT WIN IN A LONG TIME

The Lobos' 94-87 victory over Navy in overtime on Dec. 10 was the program's first victory in overtime since beating Air Force on March 5, 2011 - but it was a stretch of only two overtime losses during that time. UNM lost to Pepperdine in OT on Nov. 26, 2011 and to Fresno State on Jan. 2, 2016. It's the Lobos' first overtime win at home since beating California in double overtime on Nov. 11, 2010.

UNM WRAPS UP UNDEFEATED NOVEMBER

UNM wrapped up a perfect opening month of the season after defeating UTEP in its first road of the season, 59-35, on Nov. 30. The Lobos finished the month outscoring their opponents by an average of 19.3 points per game (85.5-66.2) and had a turnover margin of plus 7.0 per game for the month. They also had twice as good a turnover-to-assist ratio as their opponents (1.6 to 0.8).

LOBOS WIN UNM THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT, BUCK NAMED MVP

For the first time since 2008, the Lobos won their own Thanksgiving Tournament by beating Wichita State, UC Irvine and Illinois - winning each game by double figures and two of the games by 20-plus. Tesha Buck was named the tournament's MVP while she

BRADBURY GETS WIN NO. 200

UNM coach Mike Bradbury has had a successful 10-plus seasons as a head coach and now he's hit win No. 200 in just his 11th season when the Lobos defeated Illinois 97-68 on Nov. 26. The second-year Lobo coach averaged 19.3 victories per season in his first 10 years as a head coach.

LOBOS MAKE IT 3-FOR-3, BUCK NAMED MW PLAYER OF WEEK

For the third week in a row with a third different player, the University of New Mexico women's basketball program has earned the Mountain West Player of the Week honor as Tesha Buck's stellar and steady performance while guiding the Lobos to the UNM Thanksgiving Tournament title was honored Monday by the conference. Buck averaged 17.3 points, 5.7 assists, 4.3 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game in helping the Lobos to three convincing victories. Along with her averages, the senior shot 50 percent (12-for-24) from 3-point range during the tournament.

Buck joins Cherise Beynon (first week) and Jaisa Nunn (second week) in earning Mountain West Player of the Week honors this season, marking the first time since the 2008-09 season the Mountain West has awarded the same school three straight weeks (was also to three different players). It's the first time the Lobos have ever won the award three straight weeks and is the first time since the 2010-11 season the program has had three honors in the same season as well as three different players win the award in the same season.

NUNN NAMED MOUNTAIN WEST PLAYER OF THE WEEK

A near flawless – and Lobo-record – performance by Jaisa Nunn that helped The University of New Mexico women's basketball team defeat a ranked opponent highlighted a week that saw the junior average 17.7 points and 10.7 rebounds and be selected the Mountain West Player of the Week for the week of Nov. 20. Nunn broke a 35-year-old New Mexico scoring record by piling up 39 points (the old record was 35 set by Yvonne McKinnon in 1979) and adding 13 rebounds in the Lobos' 88-87 victory over No. 16 Marquette on Nov. 13 at Dreamstyle Arena – including converting on a three-point play with 1.8 seconds remaining to give UNM the victory. The Kirkland, Wash., native was 14-for-15 from the field and 11-for-12 from the free-throw line while committing no turnovers in 34 minutes of play.

RECORD SCORING NIGHT FOR THE LOBOS

The Lobos broke a 38-year-old scoring record Wednesday, Nov. 15, when they defeated Northern New Mexico 107-66 - breaking the old record set March 3, 1979, when UNM defeated Northern Arizona 106-81. It's the first time the Lobos have reached 100 points in a game since beating Morgan State 101-22 on Jan. 4, 2005.

WASHINGTON NEARLY SETS RECORD OFF BENCH VS. NNMC

UNM freshman Madi Washington came off the bench against Northern New Mexico and scored 27 points during the Lobos' win Wednesday, Nov. 15 - tied for the second-most points off the bench and tied for the sixth-most points for a freshman in UNM history. The UNM record for points off the bench is Jordan Adams who scored 30 against Utah Feb. 3, 2000. The Lobo record for points by a freshman was the previous UNM overall scoring record set by Yvonne McKinnon with 35 points against Adams State on Feb. 19, 1982.

FIRST WIN OVER A RANKED TEAM SINCE 2010

In the Lobos' 88-87 victory over No. 16 Marquette, it marked the first Lobo win over a ranked team since beating No. 25 SMU March 17, 2010 - a stretch of eight consecutive losses to ranked teams. It's the highest-ranked opponent the Lobos have defeated since UNM beat No. 16 BYU March 4, 2006.
