Matchup Notes:

- Starting Lineup: Keith McGee, Anthony Mathis, Makuach Maluach, Vance Jackson, Carlton Bragg
- The Lobos lead the series with the Rams 78-47 including a 51-13 advantage in Albuquerque, 46-6 inside The Pit. UNM is now 4-2 over the last six games in the series.

Post-Game Notes:

- Four Lobos finished in double figures: Makuach Maluach (23), Anthony Mathis (16), Vance Jackson (12) and Keith McGee (10).
- The Lobos out rebounded the Rams 47-25.
 - Redshirt-junior Carlton Bragg posted 14 rebounds marking his seventh time posting double figures in rebounds.
 - Junior Corey Manigault notched 11 boards tying his season high against Bradley on Dec. 1.
 - The last time the Lobos had two or more 10+ rebounders was against No. 5/6 Nevada on Jan. 5, (Bragg (10) and Jackson (10)).
- Sophomore Makuach Maluach set new season highs in scoring (23), made free throws (6) and offensive rebounds (5).
- Maluach also posted a new career-high 10 rebounds in addition to:
 - Posting his first career double-double with 23 points and 10 rebounds.
 - His previous season high for rebounds was eight at Utah State on Feb. 20, 2019.
- With his pair of 3-pointers on the night, senior Anthony Mathis tied his total from last year of 98 made threes in a single season, tying for third place in program history.
- Mathis has racked up 22 double-digit scoring games this season while Jackson has tallied 19.
