POST-GAME QUOTES

HEAD COACH PAUL WEIR

On SDSU:

"SDSU is a great basketball team. They are athletic and are playing very well right now, so for us, this is a good win."

On Keith McGee and Drue Drinnon playing point guard:

"I thought they were exceptional tonight. They are both very talented young players who have very bright careers ahead of them. Keith was terrific offensively to start the game and kept us hanging around. Drue, in the second half, did some things down the stretch that were enormous for us."

On playing zone defense:

"San Diego State was awesome to start, but over the course of the game, we got a feel for our defense. We are growing into it every day. We've been tinkering with our team all season, but we will keep chipping away at it."
