ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Lobos enter Friday night's game 2-0 on the season after posting back-to-back 100+ point games for the first time since December 1998.
- NMSU is 1-1 after a 81-55 win vs East Central University and a 92-74 loss at Saint Mary's.
- Friday night's game will be one for the books as Lobo head coach Paul Weir completed his last season as the head coach at NMSU, leading the squad to a WAC Championship and an NCAA Tournament appearance.
- The Lobos lead the series history between the teams 121-97 but are 46-59 on the road at the Pan American Center.
- The first meeting between the two squads was on December 22, 1904 and yielded a 21-9 victory for the Lobos in Las Cruces.
- Last season, the Lobos opened the season 3-0 with NMSU as their third opponent, marking the second straight season that UNM opened with three straight wins.
- New Mexico enters the contest with seven players averaging in double figures including Troy Simons (21.5), Chris McNeal (16.5), Sam Logwood (16.0), Antino Jackson (15.5), Makuach Maluach (13.5), Anthony Mathis (12.5) and Joe Furstinger (10.0).

SCOUTING NEW MEXICO STATE

The NMSU Aggies are entering Friday's game 1-1 on the season after claiming the 2016-17 WAC Championship under current Lobo head coach Paul Weir.

The Aggies currently have three players averaging in double figures including Zach Lofton (21.5), Jemerrio Jones (15.0) and AJ Harris (12.5).

As a team, NMSU is averaging 77.5 points per game while its opponents have posted an average of 73.5. On the perimeter, NMSU has just 14 three-pointers on the year compared to 35 for the Lobos.

A RIVALRY LIKE NO OTHER

The heat between the Lobos and the Aggies has been ongoing since the early 1900s with the first meeting between the two squads occurring on December 22, 1904. It was a 21-9 victory for UNM and was followed by seven consecutive victories for the Lobos. NMSU earned its first win over New Mexico on Feb. 11, 1916 and went on a 10-win streak before UNM reclaimed the crown with 19 straight. The squads have continued to battle it out.

Until last season, when UNM fell on December 10, the Lobos had won their last five straight meetings with the the Aggies. Here are the most recent results in Rio Grande Rivalry history:

- First back-to-back 100-point games since December of 1998
- #PandemoniUNM defense averaging 29.5 turnovers forced per game to start the season.
- Held the visiting Mavericks to 38.6% from the field (22-57) and 33.3% from three (10-30).
- Lobos scored 39 points off of turnovers
- In two games, the Lobos have hit 35 3-pointers. Last season, it took nine games to reach that mark. UNM has hit at least 17 threes in the last two games to open the season.
- Lobos averaging 58.5 bench points per game to start the season.
- Shot 43.6% from three overall (17-39), 68.4% in the second half (13-19)
- Shot 34.1% from the field in the first half (14-41), followed by a 55.6% second half (20-36)

NLI SIGNING DAY

The Lobos signed their first recruit of the 2018-19 season to NLI just before game time on Saturday, adding 4-star point-guard Drue Drinnon to the roster.

ABOUT THE 2017-18 LOBOS

The 2017-18 Lobos have just five returning student-athletes from the 2016-17 squad and feature an outstanding nine newcomers. Under first-year head coach Paul Weir, the Lobos look to improve on their 17-14 overall record last season, 10-8 in Mountain West play.

Top returners for the Lobos include lone regular starter Sam Logwood who averaged 7.3 points per game for a .449 field goal percentage and a .671 percentage from the free throw line. All four other Lobos to return to UNM this season played in at least 10 games, including junior Dane Kuiper who started 13 games, averging 6.0 points per game.

NEW COACH, NEW ERA

At the helm of the Lobos in the 2016-17 season will be head coach Paul Weir, officially named the 21st head coach in UNM men's basketball history on April 11, 2017. Weir spent the last season with New Mexico State where he finished 28-6 and led NMSU to a WAC Tournament Championship and an NCAA appearance. Weir is the first basketball coach to serve as the head coach for both New Mexico DI institutions.

LOBO TRANSFERS

Of the nine fresh faces to the UNM squad, the Lobos welcome in six new transfers, four of which will be eligible to compete in the 2017-18 season. Those that are eligible and will don the Lobo Cherry & Silver this season include junior Chris McNeal (Indian Hills), senior Antino Jackson (Akron), junior Jachai Simmons (Midland College) and junior Troy Simons (Polk State). The pair of transfers that will not see action this season is JaQuan Lyle (Ohio State) and Vance Jackson (UCONN) due to NCAA transfer rules.

LOBOS ON TV

games selected for TV while three non-conference road games, at New Mexico State, at UTEP and at Colorado are expected to be broadcast as well. The Lobos will be on ATT SportsNet/ROOT eight times, on CBS Sports Network five times, ESPN3 five times, and ESPNU and the Mountain West Network on Stadium once. Additionally, two games (at UNLV on January 17 and January 27 at home against Colorado State) are flex games that will be either on ESPNU or ESPN3.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

After two years as WisePies Arena - The Pit, the famous home of Lobo basketball has been given a new name. While it will still be referred to as "The Pit," this season will be the first that the Lobos will compete in "Dreamstyle Arena" as part of an exciting \$10 million agreement for naming rights by Dreamstyle Remodeling of both of UNM's largest-capacity athletic venues. In addition to the official renaming of the Lobo basketball arena, the UNM football stadium, formerly referred to as "University Stadium" is now officially named "Dreamstyle Stadium."

In conjunction with the new name, The Pit was given a new floor this season, featuring both "New Mexico" and "The Pit" on the baselines, the new university interlocking UNM logo, fresh Mountain West logos customized in the Lobo cherry and silver, cherry free throw lines and dual Dreamstyle Arena logos on both sides of center court.

"The Pit" is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball venues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico men's basketball program. Since the Mountain West conference began in 1999-2000, New Mexico has ranked in the top two in home attendance among MW teams in every year except one, including 12 seasons as the top-ranked MW team in overall attendance.

LOBOS FROM NEAR AND FAR

Just one Lobo on the 2017-18 roster hails from near as a New Mexico native, freshman Matt Vail. Of the remaining 13 players on the roster, two are from California (Joe Furstinger and Vance Jackson) and two more are from Indiana (Sam Logwood and JaQuan Lyle). That leaves nine players all from different states or countries.

The Lobo melting pot includes players from as close as Arizona (Connor McDougall) and Texas (Antino Jackson) and as far as Alaska (Dane Kuiper), New Jersey (Jachai Simmons), Oregon (Anthony Mathis), Pennsylvania (Troy Simons) and Tennessee (Chris McNeal).

Not only are the Lobos' home towns spread across the United States, but two come from overseas including freshmen Makuach Maluach from Sydney, Australia, and Vladimir Pinchuk from Schwelm, Germany.

Lobos Top Omaha with Second Straight 100+ Game

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team posted its first back-to-back 100+ point games since December 1998 on Tuesday night as the Lobos routed the visiting Omaha Mavericks 103-71 in their Nike N7 game. Junior transfer Troy Simons paced the Lobos with 24 points that included six 3-pointers on the night.

The Nike N7 jersey auction in Dreamstyle Arena raised over \$2,500 for the NB3 Foundation and American Indian Student Services (AISS).

Four Lobos scored in double figures including Simons and seniors Antino Jackson (19), Sam Logwood (18) and Joe Furstinger (11). Furstinger's 11 points marks a new career-best for the senior, who has tallied a previous high of nine points twice in his career, including Saturday's game against Northern New Mexico. He also tied his career-best in free throws (5) and blocks (4).

Coach Weir earned his 30th career victory on the night as the Lobos improve to 2-0. Omaha falls to 0-3 on the season.

The Lobos opened the game with an 8-0 run over the first 2:30, half which came from Furstinger. Omaha followed with a 7-0 run as the Lobos struggled to find a consistent offensive flow, closing the gap to make it 19-16 UNM midway through the first half.

Alternating scoring droughts for both teams caused the score to remain close through the remainder of the first half, sending UNM into the locker room up by just one, 35-34. The Lobos shot an unimpressive 34.1 percent from the field and 20 percent from 3-point range compared to 37 percent from the floor and 35.7 percent from the arc for the Mavericks.

The second half was another story as the Lobos stormed past Omaha and didn't look back. In the second half, the Lobos shot 55.6 percent from the field and an outstanding 68.4 percent from 3-point range, hitting 13 triples en route to a 68-point second-half performance while limiting Omaha to just 37 points.

"I thought in the second half, we kept our defensive energy up and our offensive energy ended up coming around," head coach Paul Weir said. "I was much more pleased with our defensive energy in the second half."

"As far as our style of play, it's how we want to play and it went the way we wanted to. We were able to shoot the way we wanted to and hopefully we continue playing this way moving forward."

Simons's six 3-pointers combined with five from Jackson, three from junior Anthony Mathis, two from junior Chris McNeal and another from freshman Makuach Maluach - his first as a Lobo.

The UNM advantage was held within single digits until midway through the second half when the Lobos pulled away - fast. Sparked by a pair of Furstinger free throws and a three from McNeal, the Lobos took off on a 9-0 run in just one minute, taking a reachable 63-57 game to a 72-57 contest. McNeal's three was set up after he snagged a steal and, just 10 seconds later, Simons grabbed another steal in the Lobos' full-court press and posted the layup.

The 15-point lead was stretched to a 30-point blowout with four minutes left, 92-62 on a pair of Logwood free throws. Logwood went 10-for-11 from the stripe on the night, doubling his previous career-best five free throws in a single game.

It was a Jackson three that put the Lobos over 100 with 1:09 left. With seven seconds left on the clock, Omaha's Alex Allbery hit a three to cut the 35-point Lobo lead to 32 to close the game.

The Lobos are averaging 29.5 turnovers forced per game to start the season to go along with 44.5 field goals and 58.5 bench points. In the last two games, UNM has hit 35 3-pointers, at least 17 per game. Last season, it took nine games to reach that mark.

UNM outrebounded the Mavericks 48-37 including 19-9 offensive boards and forced 26 turnovers on the night.

The Lobos are back in action on Friday night, Nov. 17, as they hit the road for their first game away from The Pit against Coach Weir's former team, New Mexico State. The Lobos will take on long-time, in-state rival NMSU at 7 p.m.

Men's Basketball Falls Late to No. 21/22 Saint Mary's Monday Night

MORAGA, Calif. – The New Mexico State men's basketball team kept within striking distance of No. 21/22 Saint Mary's Monday night at the McKeon Pavilion, but just couldn't keep up with the Gaels in the second half and fell 92-74.

"In the second half, we just kind of wore out a little bit," Jans said. "To beat Saint Mary's, with as well coached as they are and as well schooled as they are, you are going to have to play really, really good. We felt good about it going into the game. We felt like we had a chance. They were just too much in the end."

New Mexico State (1-1) got the jitters all out of its system last Friday, as it exchanged blow-for-blow with No. 21/22 Saint Mary's (2-0) the entire first half.

After 13 of the 14 total lead changes in the first half, the Aggies found some spark from beyond the arc at McKeon Pavilion. Deep shooting from Zach Lofton, AJ Harris and Johnathon Wilkins saw NM State take its largest lead of the game, 29-21, and forced Saint Mary's head coach Randy Bennett to call 30-second timeout to gather his team.

Neither team was able to hang on to their lead for very long as both teams knocked down shot-after-shot. It wasn't until 2:03 mark late in the first half that the home team took the lead that eventually gave them the 47-42 edge heading into the break.

Both teams shot well in the first-half with NM State shooting 53.6-percent from the floor to go with its .583 clip from three while Saint Mary's was 54.8-percent from the floor.

The Aggies started the second-half with a 6-2 run to tie the game up at 48. However, a 14-4 run by the Gaels gave them a 62-52 lead that they never surrendered.

NM State got within three points of Saint Mary's twice early on during that stretch, but it would be the closest it got from that point on.

Jemerrio Jones did his best to close the gap with nine of his 10 rebounds coming in the second half while Lofton poured in nine of his team-best 18 points in the second-half.

Three-point shooting kept New Mexico State on par with the Gaels in the first-half, knocking down 7-of-12 from beyond arc, but was just 1-of-9 in the second-half. That, coupled with foul trouble for the Aggie big men kept their bench limited.

Saint Mary's top two returners in Emmett Naar led all players with 22 points while preseason All-American forward Jock Landale posted a double-double with 20 points and 10 boards.

Jemerrio Jones has now posted back-to-back double-doubles for NM State after scoring 11 points with 10 rebounds Monday night...the last time NM State had four players reach double-figures was against UT Rio Grande Valley on March 4 of last season...the Aggies only turned the ball over eight times tonight, the last time that occurred was vs. Seattle U (7) on Feb. 25...with the loss, NM State is now 0-22 against ranked teams since its last win against a ranked squad...Leston Gordon scored his first Division I basket with 25 seconds remaining in the game.

THE GREATEST GAME EVER PLAYED

The Pit was the site of one of the greatest college basketball games ever played. It hosted the 1983 national championship game that saw the NC State Wolfpack upset Hakeem Olajuwon, Clyde Drexler and the Houston Cougars. Coach Jimmy Valvano and the Wolfpack downed the Cougars on a last second put back by Lorenzo Charles. The iconic shot of the late Valvano running onto the court looking for a hug is one of the lasting images in college basketball history.

- Less than 30 of 345 NCAA Division I basketball programs play in a college-only arena named after a business or organization founded or headquartered in its home state.
- The Lobos have averaged an astounding 15,410 fans the past 49 years, an amazing 95% of capacity
- The Pit has ranked in the top 25 in attendance nationally nearly every season since the 1966-67 season with 35 seasons in the top ten in the NCAA in attendance
- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.

Game 1 - New Mexico 147, Northern N.M. 76 Nov. 11, 2016 | Dreamstyle Arena

Lobos Break Records in Season Opener, Win 147-76

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team shocked a crowd of over 10,500 fans in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit in its first regular-season outing under first-year head coach Paul Weir on Saturday night. The Lobos shattered the UNM record for points scored in a game (136), claiming a 147-76 victory over Northern New Mexico.

The 71-point victory margin also ties the nearly 45-year-old record for largest victory margin, which occurred on December 29, 1972 against Dartmouth at The Pit.

Northern New Mexico is now 2-8 on the season while the Lobos start out 1-0 for the 15th straight season.

"I am extremely thankful to every fan that came through the door tonight and hopefully they'll continue to come out and support us as we try and earn their trust and their respect as a basketball program," Coach Weir said. "Obviously (this was) the kind of offensive game we've been looking for. Our last scrimmage was a very similar outcome, so we're thankful that we're shooting the ball the way we are."

The fiery Lobo offense dominated early and refused to let up. UNM got out to a 15-point lead less than five minutes into the first half, taking a 22-7 advantage with 15:38 still remaining in the first half. The Eagles went on an ensuing 7-0 run, testing the Lobo defense and cutting the home lead to eight, but UNM quickly pushed back ahead and extended the lead to 20 on three from junior Troy Simons with 9:43 left.

The Lobos concluded the first-half performance with a trio of back-to-back-to-back 3-pointers, two from junior Anthony Mathis and a third from junior transfer Chris McNeal. McNeal collected four threes in the first half alone and helped pace UNM to a 74-point first-half showing, just two points shy of the UNM record for most points in a single half. The record is 76, which occurred on November 23, 1990 against Texas-Arlington.

The Lobos shot 61 percent from the field in the first half (25-41) and 50 percent from 3-point range (10-20). Three players had reached double digits including McNeal (13), senior Sam Logwood (12) and freshman Makuach Maluach (11).

Junior Dane Kuiper opened the second half with a pair of free throws to put the Lobos up 40, 75-35.

Simons and freshman Vladimir Pinchuk shined in the second half, putting up 11 and 10 points, respectively en route to the victory.

McNeal burst on the scene in his first regular-season game as a Lobo with the first UNM double-double in points and assists since March 2, 2014. He posted a team-best 24 points on the night to go along with 10 assists.

Led by McNeal, eight of the 11 Lobos to hit the floor scored in double digits including Simons (19), Maluach (18), Kuiper (17), Mathis (16), Logwood (14), Pinchuk (12) and senior Antino Jackson (12).

As a team, the Lobos collected 40 assists and 22 steals, both ranking high in Lobo history. Forty assists ties the record for most in a game, which the Lobos had done twice previously, the first on December 16, 1978 against Central Florida and again on November 23, 1990 against Texas-Arlington. Twenty-two steals is the second-most in a game in team history (25 is the record).

On the night, UNM shot 64.7 percent (55-85) from the floor including 46.2 percent from three and 86.4 percent from the free-throw line. The Lobos' 55 field goals is just four shy of the record for most in a game. The Lobos posted 59 in the November 23, 1990 game against Texas-Arlington.

The Lobos also posted an outstanding 18 3-pointers on the night, just two short of the record 20 set on November 13, 2004 against Santa Clara, while defensively UNM posted six blocks and collected 32 defensive rebounds (45 overall). Senior Joe Furstinger led the way with three blocks.

Game 2 - New Mexico 103, Omaha 71 Nov. 14, 2016 | Dreamstyle Arena

Lobos Top Omaha with Second Straight 100+ Game

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. --- The University of New Mexico men's basketball team posted its first back-to-back 100+ point games since December 1998 on Tuesday night as the Lobos routed the visiting Omaha Mavericks 103-71 in their Nike N7 game. Junior transfer Troy Simons paced the Lobos with 24 points that included six 3-pointers on the night.

The Nike N7 jersey auction in Dreamstyle Arena raised over \$2,500 for the NB3 Foundation and American Indian Student Services (AISS).

Four Lobos scored in double figures including Simons and seniors Antino Jackson (19), Sam Logwood (18) and Joe Furstinger (11). Furstinger's 11 points marks a new career-best for the senior, who has tallied a previous high of nine points twice in his career, including Saturday's game against Northern New Mexico. He also tied his career-best in free throws (5) and blocks (4).

Coach Weir earned his 30th career victory on the night as the Lobos improve to 2-0. Omaha falls to 0-3 on the season.

The Lobos opened the game with an 8-0 run over the first 2:30, half which came from Furstinger. Omaha followed with a 7-0 run as the Lobos struggled to find a consistent offensive flow, closing the gap to make it 19-16 UNM midway through the first half.

Alternating scoring droughts for both teams caused the score to remain close through the remainder of the first half, sending UNM into the locker room up by just one, 35-34. The Lobos shot an unimpressive 34.1 percent from the field and 20 percent from 3-point range compared to 37 percent from the floor and 35.7 percent from the arc for the Mavericks.

The second half was another story as the Lobos stormed past Omaha and didn't look back. In the second half, the Lobos shot 55.6 percent from the field and an outstanding 68.4 percent from 3-point range, hitting 13 triples en route to a 68-point second-half performance while limiting Omaha to just 37 points.

"I thought in the second half, we kept our defensive energy up and our offensive energy ended up coming around," head coach Paul Weir said. "I was much more pleased with our defensive energy in the second half."

"As far as our style of play, it's how we want to play and it went the way we wanted to. We were able to shoot the way we wanted to and hopefully we continue playing this way moving forward."

Simons' six 3-pointers combined with five from Jackson, three from junior Anthony Mathis, two from junior Chris McNeal and another from freshman Makuach Maluach - his first as a Lobo.

The UNM advantage was held within single digits until midway through the second half when the Lobos pulled away - fast. Sparked by a pair of Furstinger free throws and a three from McNeal, the Lobos took off on a 9-0 run in just one minute, taking a reachable 63-57 game to a 72-57 contest. McNeal's three was set up after he snagged a steal and, just 10 seconds later, Simons grabbed another steal in the Lobos' full-court press and posted the layup.

The 15-point lead was stretched to a 30-point blowout with four minutes left, 92-62 on a pair of Logwood free throws. Logwood went 10-for-11 from the stripe on the night, doubling his previous career-best five free throws in a single game.

It was a Jackson three that put the Lobos over 100 with 1:09 left. With seven seconds left on the clock, Omaha's Alex Allbery hit a three to cut the 35-point Lobo lead to 32 to close the game.

The Lobos are averaging 29.5 turnovers forced per game to start the season to go along with 44.5 field goals and 58.5 bench points. In the last two games, UNM has hit 35 3-pointers, at least 17 per game. Last season, it took nine games to reach that mark.

UNM outrebounded the Mavericks 48-37 including 19-9 offensive boards and forced 26 turnovers on the night.
