- Attendance: 10,010
- The Lobos now lead the all-time series 17-14 with a 12-2 advantage in The Pit.

Coach Weir Notes:

- Coach Weir earned his diamond victory with 75 career wins

Postgame Notes:

- Four Lobos finished in double figures: Redshirt-Junior Vance Jackson (29), Redshirt-Senior JaQuan Lyle (14), Junior Makuach Maluach (13), Senior Corey Manigault (10)
- Vance Jackson registered a double-double scoring a season high 29 points grabbing 13 boards, coming one point shy of tying his previous career high in scoring.
 - Tuesday's game marks the second straight game Jackson has recorded a double-double and scored over 25 points.
 - The last time Jackson had back-to-back 25+ point games was in the Mountain West tournament in which he scored 26 against Wyoming and 25 against Utah State.
 - 13 boards ties his previous career high in rebounds which he last posted in UNM's most recent game against San José State.
- Jackson set a new career high in three pointers made going 6-7 from beyond the arc.
 - He recorded his previous career high on March 14, 2019 against Utah State in which he went 4-8 from downtown.
- JaQuan Lyle finished with 14 points and 10 assists, his first double-double of the season.
 - Lyle shot a perfect 6-6 from the charity stripe marking the sixth time this season he has not missed from the line.
 - Tuesday's game marks the first assists and points double-double for the Lobos since February 10, 2018 vs Air Force in which Antino Jackson scored 10 points with 10 assists.
- The Lobos are now 11-0 at home and 3-0 after losses this season.
 - The last time the Lobos were 11-0 at home was during the 2005-06 season where they would go on to win 12 straight at home before falling to BYU, 71-77.
- The Lobos held a four-point lead at halftime, going on to win 78-64. The Lobos are now 10-0 when leading at the half and 5-0 in games decided by 10-19 points.
- The Lobos finished with just nine turnovers tying the second fewest this season.
 - The Lobos have finished with less than 10 turnovers three times this season, the lowest being six against Boise State on December 4, 2019
- The Lobos led by just seven points with 5:35 left in the game before going on an 11-0 run to extend the lead to 18 with 2:02 left to play.
 - Scorers during the run: Jackson (5), Martin (4), Lyle (2).
