

UNM VS ARIZONA GAME NOTES

UNM-73 ARIZONA-89

Match up Notes:

- Starting Lineup: Antino Jackson, Joe Furstinger, Makuach Maluach, Jachai Simmons, Dane Kuiper
- Game marks the first time this season the Lobos have played a ranked team (Arizona is ranked 23rd).
- The Lobos and the Wildcats last met Dec. 20, 2016, where the Lobos fell 76-44. Prior to that game, the teams had not met since 1999.
- Attendance: 13,207- Season high

- Season Record: 3-8

In-Game Notes:

- UNM tied its season low turnovers, committing just 4 in the first half and 3 in the second.
- Top scorer for the Lobos was Dane Kuiper, who scored 24 points to surpass his career record of 17. He also breaks his career record for number of threes made with 6 (previous was 4 against Air Force on Feb. 18, 2017).
- Troy Simons was the second Lobo to score in double figures, tallying 12 on the night.
- UNM shot 38.7 percent from the floor, 35.3 percent from three and 92.9 percent from the free throw line (13-14)
- UNM did not score a field goal in the last 5:05 of the game.
- Arizona's Rawle Alkins tallied a season-high 26 points.
- The Wildcats led points in the paint, 42-20.
- Arizona outrebounded the Lobos 35-23.
- Arizona shot 64.0 percent from the floor, 69.2 percent from 3-point range, and 80.0 percent from the free throw line.
- The Lobos outscored the Wildcats 32-11 from the bench.
- Arizona had 17 assists to UNM's 15.
- Ayton of Arizona had a double-double with 14 points and 13 rebounds.
