Preseason All-MW selection Nico Carvacho is averaging a double-double scoring 12 points and grabbing a conference best 10.5 rebounds per game.

ALFORD SEEKS 600TH CAREER VICTORY ON SATURDAY VERSUS NEW MEXICO

First-year head coach Steve Alford will seek his milestone 600th career win on Saturday when Nevada (12-8, 5-3 MW) hosts New Mexico (16-5, 5-3 MW) for a 5 p.m. tip • Alford won 155 games at UNM from 2007-2013 • Both teams are tied for third in the MW standings along with Colorado State • The Wolf Pack has won five of the last six meetings in the series and trail overall 7-6 • All 13 games have come since Nevada joined the MW • Nevada has won its last 16 MW home games and is 29-2 in its last 31 MW home games.

STATS OF NOTE

Jalen Harris (18.9 ppg) and Jazz Johnson (17 ppg) rank second and fifth in the MW in scoring, they are the highest scoring duo in the conference • Harris has scored in double figures the last 16 games and Johnson a team-high 18 times this year • Harris scored 31 points at Utah State and at Air Force • Harris scored game highs in the last four games and in nine games this season • Johnson scored a career-high 34 points and made eight 3s in the Pack's win over Boise State • Johnson's 34 points, 13 made field goals and eight 3s made against BSU all rank second in the MW • The eight made 3-pointers is tied for the third most in school history • Johnson's 43 3-point percentage is 22nd nationally, he is ninth with 65 made 3s and 13th making 3.3 per 3s per game • In 14 games Johnson has made three or more 3-pointers.

HARRIS SCORES 28, NEVADA BEATS UNLV 86-72 FOR FIFTH CONSECUTIVE TIME

RENO, Nev. (AP) Jalen Harris had 28 points, six rebounds, six assists and three steals and Nevada beat UNLV 86-72 on Wednesday night.

Jazz Johnson added 19 points, Lindsey Drew scored 14 and Nisre Zouzoua 11 for Nevada.

UNLV's Nick Blair made two free throws to open the scoring but the Wolf Pack (12-8, 5-3 Mountain West) answered with an 11-0 run and led the rest of the way.

Bryce Hamilton had 26 points and Aumari Hardy scored 23 for UNLV (11-10, 6-2). The Runnin' Rebels had their three-game win streak snapped and lost for just the second time in their last nine games.

Game Notes:

Head coach Steve Alford is one win away from 600 in his college career and will seek that milestone victory on Saturday versus New Mexico, a team he coached for six seasons. Alford is 599-306 in 29 seasons as a college head coach.

Nevada's win over UNLV was the fifth in a row in the series.

The Wolf Pack has won its last 16th Mountain West home games and is 29-2 in its last 31 home MW games.

Jalen Harris posted a game-high 28 points. It was the ninth time Harris scored a game-high, 12th time he led the Pack in scoring and 10th game of 20 or more points which are all team highs. Harris has scored in double figures in the last 16 games. In the last four games Harris has scored a game-high. For the seventh time this season Harris posted a game-high dishing out six assists with no turnovers. He also had a game-high three steals.



WOLF PACK LAYUPS

- ▶ First-year Nevada head coach Steve Alford is one win from 600 after the Pack's 86-72 victory over UNLV. Alford is 599-306 in his 29th season. He celebrated his 55th birthday on Nov. 23.
- ▶ Nevada has won its last 16 MW home games and is 29-2 in its last 31 MW home contests.
- ▶ Jazz Johnson scored a career-high 34 points and made a career-best eight 3-pointers on 12 attempts in the win over Boise State. The 34 points, 13 made field goals and eight made 3s all ranks second in the MW this season. The eight 3s is tied for the third most in a game at Nevada.
- ▶ Johnson's 65 made 3-pointers is ninth in NCAA I, his 3.3 made 3-pointers per game is 16th and 43 3-point percentage is 24th. He leads the MW in all three categories. He has made three or more 3-pointers in 14 games. His 17 points per game is second on the team and fifth in the MW.
- ▶ Junior Jalen Harris has scored in double figures in the last 16 games including two 31-point games at Utah State and Air Force. Harris leads the team in scoring (18.9 ppg), rebounding (6.3 rpg) and is second in assists (4.0 apg). His 18.9 points per game is second in the MW and 23 points per game in conference only play is first. He is one of three MW players to have scored 30 or more points in game twice this season.
- ▶ Senior Lindsey Drew scored a career-high 30 points in the Utah game. Drew set his career high by halftime with 18 points as his previous high was 17. It was his 100th career game with 94 starts. Drew has made 113 starts and appeared in 119 games at Nevada. His 12 double figure scoring games this season is his most in any season at Nevada.
- ▶ A Nevada player was the leading scorer in 15-of-20 games this season. Lindsey Drew with his 30 vs. Utah and 24 vs. LMU. Jalen Harris scored a game-high 24 vs. UT Arlington, 22 vs. Fordham, 25 against Valpo, 31 at Air Force, 20 vs. CSU, 31 at USU, 20 vs. Wyoming, 19 at SDSU and 28 vs. UNLV. Jazz Johnson's 26 points against USC, 25 vs. Bowling Green, 20 vs. SCU and the 34 vs BSU.
- ▶ Johnson (34), Harris (31 twice) and Drew (30) have all scored 30 or more points in game this season.
- ▶ Drew posted the first double-double by a Nevada player this season with 10 points and 10 rebounds in the Paradise Jam championship game win over Bowling Green. Against TSU he recorded another with 18 points and 10 rebounds, the fourth of his career. Harris posted his first career double-double with 16 points and 11 rebounds in the SCU victory.
- ▶ Of the Pack's 11 players to have played this season, eight are wearing the Silver & Blue for the first team. Johnson and Zouzoua played last season while Drew missed the 2018-19 season recovering from an achilles injury he suffered a Boise State on Feb. 14, 2018.
- ▶ Nizré Zouzoua has scored in double figures in two of the last three games and nine times on the season. Zouzoua scored a Pack career-high 16 points in the UTA game.
- ▶ Graduate transfer John Carlos Reyes scored Pack season-high 12 points in the win over TSU. It was his second double figure scoring game at Nevada with the first being 10 points in the win over LMU. Reyes has started 19 games this season and came off the bench in the SMC contest.
- ▶ Redshirt freshman K.J. Hymes was selected by the MW media as the preseason Freshman of the Year. Hymes made his first start versus SMC. He leads the team and is fourth in the MW averaging 1.2 blocks per game. His four blocks against LMU is tied for the second most by a player in the conference this season. In the win over Fordham he scored in double figures for the first time in his college career finishing with 11 points.
- ▶ Freshman Zane Meek has scored in double figures in six of the last 14 games. Meek's three-game streak of scoring in double figures was snapped in the BSU game when he totaled six points. In the last 12 games he is 23-of-52 (44.2%) from behind the arc. In the CSU and SCU games he made four 3s.
- ▶ Freshman Kane Milling was a perfect 3-for-3 from behind the arc at Air Force to score a season-best nine points.
- ▶ Sophomore Robby Robinson scored in double figures for the first time with his 10 points and also grabbed seven rebounds in the win over SCU.
- ▶ Nevada has three players averaging double figures; Harris (18.9 ppg), Johnson (17 ppg), and Drew (11.8 ppg) with Zouzoua (8.5 ppg) close behind. Four times this season five Pack players scored in double figures vs. Valpo, Santa Clara, at Air Force and vs. TSU.
- ▶ During its five-game win streak Nevada trailed for just 74 seconds, 2-0 to Bowling Green and 2-0 at Air Force.
- ▶ Associate head coach Craig Neal was on coach Alford's staff at Iowa and New Mexico. Neal and Alford have been friends since third grade.
- ▶ Five members of the staff have ties to the state of Indiana. Alford and Kory Barnett played at Indiana. Neal is from Indiana and Kory Alford is the oldest son of head coach Steve Alford. Bil Duany is a graduate of Indiana.
- ▶ Nevada has two 1,000 point scorers on the squad in Johnson (1,442) and Zouzoua (1,221). Drew has scored 864 points at Nevada in 119 games.
- ▶ Jalen Harris was the MVP of the 2019 Paradise Jam and Jazz Johnson earned a spot on the all-tournament team. Harris averaged 22.3 points, six rebounds and 6.3 assists in the three games. Johnson scored 19.3 points per game and made 60 percent of his 3-pointers knocking down 15-of-25 from behind the arc.
- ▶ Alford became the first coach to lead a team to two Paradise Jam championships after the Wolf Pack's 77-62 victory over Bowling Green. In 2012 Alford led his New Mexico team to the title at the Paradise Jam defeating No. 21/23 UConn 66-60 for the championship. His son Kory who is the Pack's director of player development was a member of that New Mexico team.
- ▶ Nevada has won 20 or more games in 12 of the last 16 seasons. In the last four seasons the Pack has won 110 games including tying the school record with 29 wins each of the last two years. The 29 wins has been accomplished three times at Nevada.
- ▶ Drew was named the Nov. 11, MW Player of the Week after averaging 27 points, 7.5 rebounds and 7.5 assists as the Pack split its first two games of the season. It was his first MW weekly honor.
- ▶ Harris was named the Dec. 9, MW Player of the Week after averaging 23.5 points, 8.5 rebounds and five assists as the Pack's season-high win streak reached five games. It was his first MW weekly honor.
- ▶ Nevada unveiled two banners on in the home opener versus Utah, the 2019 NCAA tournament appearance banner and the Mountain West regular season banner after winning a third consecutive title.
- ▶ Nevada has won the last three Mountain West regular season titles. The 2017 and 2018 titles were outright while the 2019 title was shared with Utah State. Nevada and BYU are the only MW schools to win back-to-back outright titles. The Pack, SDSU and BYU are the only schools to win three in a row with one being shared.

DREW MAKING MARK IN NEVADA RECORD BOOK

Senior Lindsey Drew has played 119 games at Nevada and started 113. The 113 starts is tied with Matt Williams (1988-91) for fifth with Kevin Soares (1989-92) fourth with 116.

Drew's 148 steals is seventh in Wolf Pack history and 471 assists is fourth. Ramon Sessions (2004-07) is third with 478 career assists. In the win over Colorado State he scored his 800th point and now has 864.

PACK PLAYERS RANKED AMONG NCAA I ACTIVE CAREER LEADERS

Jazz Johnson, Lindsey Drew, Jalen Harris and Nisré Zouzoua are all ranked among the NCAA I career leaders.

Johnson's 1,442 points is 54th, 42.4 percent 3-point shooting is 20th, 118 games played is 73rd, and 230 made 3s is 26th. Drew ranks 97th with 572 rebounds, 22nd with 471 assists, 41st with 148 steals, ranks 10th with a 2.2 assists turnover ratio and is 61st with 119 games played.

Harris is 38th shooting 85.1 percent at the free throw line and is 68th scoring 14.4 points per contest. Zouzoua's 178 made 3-pointers is 109th.

JOHNSON AND ZOZOUA 1,000 POINT SCORERS

Jazz Johnson scored his 1400th point and Nisré Zouzoua his 1200th in the win over Wyoming. Johnson has 1,442 points in 118 games for a career averaged of 12.2 points per game.

Zouzoua has netted 1,221 points in 103 games giving him a career average of 11.9 points per game. At Bryant he scored 1,025 of those points.

NEVADA IN THE NET

Nevada has a NET ranking of 96 which is the tool that the NCAA uses to rank teams for post season play. The NCAA Evaluation Tool, which will be known as the NET, relies on game results, strength of schedule, game location, scoring margin, net offensive and defensive efficiency, and the quality of wins and losses.

The Wolf Pack's overall strength of schedule is 67th and non-conference strength of schedule is 42nd. The Pack's basketball power index is 96 and kenpom.com ranking is 98.

HARRIS LEADING THE PACK

Junior Jalen Harris has scored in double figures in the last 16 games which includes a pair of 31-point games on the road at Air Force and Utah State. The 31 points is his career high. In the last four games he has scored a game high.

Harris' layup with just under 9 seconds to play against Wyoming gave the Pack the 68-67 victory.

Harris tops the team in scoring (18.9 ppg), rebounds (6.3 rpg) and is second in assists (4.0 app). The 18.9 points is second in the Mountain West and 23 in MW play is first. The assist numbers rank sixth in the MW and the rebounds eighth.

Eight times in the last 15 games he has scored 20 or more points including the two 31-point games. In the win over Santa Clara he posted his first career double-double with 16 points and

11 rebounds. His game-high eight assists left him two shy of a triple double.

In nine games he posted game highs in points, six times he posted a game-high in assists and four times a game-high in rebounds.

From the field he is shooting 43.2 percent and 36.8 percent from behind the arc. At the free throw line he had a streak of 19 in a row snapped at BYU going 5-of-8. He has made 58 of his last 67 free throws. Overall is shooting 84.1 percent at the free throw line to rank second in the conference.

Harris injured his foot in the season opener with Utah playing just 8 minutes and missed the LMU game. He returned to the lineup against UT Arlington and scored a game-high 24 points in the victory.

JOHNSON LEADING MW AND NATIONALLY RANKED IN 3-POINT SHOOTING

Wolf Pack senior Jazz Johnson scored a career-high 34 points in the Pack's win over Boise State. Johnson made a career-best eight 3-pointers on 12 attempts. The 34 points, eight made 3s and 13 made field goals all rank second in the MW this season.

The eight made 3s is tied for the third most in a game at Nevada. He also tied for game honors with a career-high seven rebounds.

His 18 double figure scoring games is tops on the team. Johnson scored his 1,400th career point in the Wyoming win with 740 coming at Portland. Currently in 118 games he has scored 1,442 points.

He has made a 3-pointer in each game this season and three or more in 14 contests. Johnson has been knocking down the 3-pointers at a high rate this season having made 65-of-151. The 65 made 3s is ninth nationally, 3.3 per game is 16th, and 43 3-point percentage is 22nd. He tops the MW in all three categories.

Johnson is second on the team and is fifth in the MW averaging 17 points per game. Five times he has scored 20 or more points; 20 vs. LMU, 26 vs. USC, 25 vs. BGSU, 20 vs. SCU and the 34 vs. BSU. In the USC, BGSU, SCU and BSU games the point totals were game highs.

He is shooting 82.6 percent at the free throw line.

At the Paradise Jam he made 60 percent of his 3-pointers connecting on 15-of-25 in three games. In the title game he made 7-of-10.

DREW DOING IT ALL IN FINAL SEASON AT NEVADA

The versatile Lindsey Drew is doing it once again in his fifth and final season at Nevada. Drew missed all last year after rupturing his right achilles tendon at Boise State on Feb. 14, 2018.

The do everything guard returned with a flair scoring a career-high 30 points in his senior debut against Utah. He also grabbed six rebounds and dished out eight assists. In the next game he scored 24 points, had nine rebounds and five assists in a win over Loyola Marymount. Both point totals were game highs.

In 12 games he has scored in double figures which is the most double figure scoring games for him in a season passing the 10 he had his junior year before the injury. He leads the team in assists (4.4 apg) and is second in rebounding (6.1 rpg). From the field he is shooting 48.6 percent. In total he is ranked in six categories in the conference.

Twice he has posted double-doubles with 10 points and 10 rebounds in the Paradise Jam Championship game win over Bowling Green. Against TSU he scored 18 points and had 10 rebounds for his second double-double of the season and fourth of his career.

In seven games he posted highs in assists; vs. Utah (8), LMU (7), UTA (4), at Air Force (6), vs. CSU (6), vs. BSU (9) and at SJSU (5). The nine assists in the BSU game tied his career high and is the high for a Nevada player this season. In another four games he posted game highs in rebounds; LMU (9), vs. Bowling Green (10), at Air Force (8) and TSU (10).

ZOUZOUA PROVIDING SPARK OFF THE BENCH

Senior Nisré Zouzoua has provided a spark off the bench in his second year in the program. Zouzoua is fourth on the team averaging 8.5 points per game.

In two of the last three games he has scored in double figures and nine times on the season. He scored nine points in each of the first two games of the season which were then Nevada career highs. Against UT Arlington he nearly doubled that netting 16 points, making 6-of-8 shots from the field of which 3-of-5 were from behind the arc.

At the Paradise Jam he averaged 11 points per game. He scored 11 points in the win over Fordham and 15 in the victory against Valparaiso.

HARRIS PARADISE JAM MVP

Junior Jalen Harris was selected as the 2019 Paradise Jam MVP after helping the Wolf Pack to the title. Harris was named the game MVP in each of the Pack's three games. He scored 20 or more points in each game and posted games high highs with 22 vs. Fordham and 25 vs. Valparaiso. In the three games he averaged 22.3 points, six rebounds and 6.3 assists. He had 19 assists and just three turnovers.

WOLF PACK IMPRESSIVE DURING FIVE-GAME WIN STREAK

Nevada won a season-high five in row prior to the loss at BYU. All five wins were by double figures. The Wolf Pack swept its way to the 2019 Paradise Jam Championship with a 74-60 victory over Fordham, downed Valparaiso 84-59 in the semifinals and knocked off Bowling



Green 77-62 in the title game. The largest margin of victory came in the fourth win as Nevada defeated Santa Clara 98-67. At Air Force the Pack made it five in a row scoring 100 points for the first time this season in a 100-85 road victory. It was the team's first true road win of the season. In the last two games Nevada has scored 198 points.

The Pack did not trail in three of the five games; Fordham, Valpo and SCU. In the BGSU game Nevada trailed for just 41 seconds, 2-0 before a 3-pointer put them ahead to stay 3-2. At Air Force the Pack trailed for 33 seconds, 2-0 before an 8-0 run put them ahead to stay.

In the five games Nevada averaged 86.6 points and held opponents to just 66.6 points. From the field the Pack shot 48.9 (150-of-307) percent and 47.7 (63-of-132) percent from behind the arc. Opponents shot 37.7 percent overall and just 23.7 percent on 3-pointers.

Jalen Harris averaged 22.8 points, seven rebounds and 5.8 assists per game. Jazz Johnson scored 18.4 points per contest and shot 58.8 percent from behind the arc making 20-of-34. Nizré Zouzoua contributed 11.4 points per game and made 12-of-23 3-pointers. Freshman Zane Meeks scored 10 points per game and made 41.7 (10-of-24) percent on his 3-point attempts.

NEVADA WINS 2019 PARADISE JAM

The University of Nevada captured the 2019 Paradise Jam championship winning three games by double figures. The Wolf Pack won the three games by an average of 18 points per game. The Pack did not trail in the first two games and for a total of 41 seconds in the championship game 2-0 before going in front to stay 3-2.

Head coach Steve Alford became the first coach to lead a team to two Paradise Jam titles. In 2012 his then New Mexico squad won the championship.

Nevada open with a 74-60 victory over Fordham followed by a lopsided 84-59 win over Valparaiso. In the title game the Pack defeated Bowling Green 77-62.

Junior Jalen Harris and senior Jazz Johnson were named to the all-tournament team. Harris earned MVP honors after averaging 22.3 points, six rebounds and 6.3 assists per game. He was also selected as the game MVP in all three Pack victories.

Johnson scored a game-high 25 points in the title game and made 7-of-10 from behind the arc. In the three games he averaged 19.3 points and made 60 percent of his 3-pointers (15-of-25). Nizré Zouzoua also scored in double figures contributing 11 points per game.

NEVADA TIED FOR THIRD IN MW STANDINGS

After eight Mountain West games Nevada is 5-3 and tied for third place in the conference standings with New Mexico and Colorado State. San Diego State leads the MW with a perfect 9-0 mark followed by UNLV at 6-2.

Boise State and Utah State are tied for sixth at 4-4 followed Air Force in eighth at 3-4. Fresno State and Wyoming are tied for ninth with 2-6 records. Wyoming is 11th with an 0-9 record.

HARRIS NAMED MW PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Junior Jalen Harris was named the Dec. 9 Mountain West Player of the Week after helping the Wolf Pack to a pair of wins. Harris averaged 23.5 points, 8.5 rebounds and five assists as the Pack's season-high win streak reached five games. He joins Lindsey Drew as the second Nevada player to earn the MW weekly honor this season.

In Nevada's first road win of the season at Air Force he scored a career-high 31 points with 22 coming in the first half. The 31 points is the high for a Pack player this season and tied for the second most points scored by a MW player this season.

In the Pack's non-conference home win over Santa Clara Harris recorded his first career double-double finishing with 16 points and a game-high 11 rebounds which is also a career high. The 11 rebounds is the high for a Nevada player this season. His game-high eight assists in the SCU game left him two shy of a triple-double. The eight assists is tied with Drew for the high this season for a Nevada player.

From the field Harris shot 57.7 (15-of-26) percent, 50 (5-of-10) percent from behind the arc and was a perfect 12-of-12 at the free throw line during the week.

DREW NAMED MOUNTAIN WEST PLAYER OF THE WEEK

University of Nevada senior Lindsey Drew was named the Nov. 11, Mountain West Player of the Week for his play in the Wolf Pack's first two games of the season. Drew averaged 27 points, 7.5 rebounds and 7.5 assists as the Pack split its first two games of the season.

Drew had a big night in his first regular season game since Feb. 14, 2018 when he ruptured his achilles at Boise State, on a last second shot to end the first half. In his 100th game and 94th start for the Wolf Pack he scored a career-high 30 points in against Utah.

Drew had a new career high by halftime with 18 with his previous high of 17 coming against UNLV on Feb. 6, 2018. He made 12-of-19 field goals and 5-of-9 three-pointers all are career bests. In addition he dished out a game-high eight assists and tied for team honors with six rebounds in 36 minutes. He did not commit a turnover.

In the Pack's win over Loyola Marymount he scored a game-high 24 points in leading Nevada to the 72-67 win over the Lions. Drew just missed a double-double as he tied for game honors with nine rebounds. He also dished out a game-high seven assists.

ALFORD INKS FIVE DURING EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

First-year University of Nevada head men's basketball coach Steve Alford has inked five high school seniors to play for the Wolf Pack in 2020-21. Alem Huseinovic, DeAndre Henry, Tre Coleman, Daniel Foster and Je'Lani Clark have signed National Letters of Intent to play at Nevada.

"This class fills a lot of future needs for our program," Alford said. "As we build our culture each of these young men are exactly what we look for; interested in their education, unselfish approach to winning and a commitment to be better daily."

The 6-3, 180-pound Clark is from Oakland, Calif. and attends Archbishop Riordan High School. As a junior he averaged 15.5 points, 6.1 rebounds, 3.4 assists and two steals. From the field he shot 51 percent and 35 percent from behind the arc last season. He has averaged double figures each of his three seasons of high school increasing from 10.8 as a freshman to 15.2 his sophomore season and 15.5 as a junior. In 82 career games at ARHS he is averaging 13.9 points, 4.8 rebounds, 3.3 assists, and 1.6 steals per game.

Henry a 6-7, 225-pound forward averaged a double-double at Mountain Point High School in Phoenix where he scored 12.2 points and grabbed 10.2 rebounds per game as a junior. Henry blocked 1.5 shots and shot 62 percent from the field and 72 percent at the free throw line. He is playing his senior season at PHHoenix Prep.

Foster is a 6-6, 185-pound guard from Melbourne, Australia but plays Golden State Preparatory School in Napa, Calif. He has represented Australia in the FIBA 3x3 U18 Asia Cup and earned all-tournament honors. Foster was a member of the Victoria State Championship team the Hume City Broncos and was nominated as the Youth Player of the Year. At the Australian Under 20 National Tournament he represented Victoria and was named to the all-state team. He averaged 4.9 assists and 3.6 steals per game in the tournament.

Huseinovic is a 6-3, 180-pound shooting guard who helped Chaparral High School in Phoenix to the 6A Arizona state championship game last season. In the state championship game he scored 18 points. Internationally he played for Bosnia & Herzegovina. He averaged 14.2 points and 1.9 rebounds per game as a junior at CHS. He is attending PHHoenix Prep this season.

Coleman is a 6-7, 185-pound small forward who plays for Jeffersonville High School in Jeffersonville, Ind. As a junior he averaged 16 points, 6.4 rebounds, 2.5 assists, 2.4 steals and 2.1 blocks per game. From the field he shot 59 percent, 38 percent from behind the arc and 65 percent at the free throw line. The Indianapolis Star ranked him as the fourth best recruit in the state of Indiana.

On April 11, 2019 University of Nevada director of athletics Doug Knuth announced the hiring of Steve Alford as the head coach of the nationally ranked Wolf Pack men's basketball program.

Alford, a highly successful coach with 11 NCAA Tournament berths and four Sweet 16 appearances, signed a 10-year deal to lead Nevada.

"There is no better coach than Steve Alford to continue the rise of Nevada basketball and we are excited for the next chapter," Knuth said. "To get a leader of Coach Alford's caliber is a testament to the support of our community and our University. There is a great tradition of Wolf Pack basketball and the future is even brighter."

Alford becomes the 19th coach in the history of the Nevada program. Alford has a career record of 587-298 (.663) in 28 seasons as a collegiate head coach and is 509-269 in 24 seasons as a Division I head coach. With Division I stops at Missouri State, Iowa, New Mexico and UCLA, his teams have averaged 21 wins per year with only two losing seasons.

"To be able to continue my career in a tight-knit community that has demonstrated its support for the basketball program is exactly the opportunity that Tanya and I were looking for, and we are thrilled to be in Northern Nevada," Alford said. "I can't wait to get to work as we look to build off the established tradition and momentum of this great program. I want this to be the last stop of my coaching career."

Alford is no stranger to the Mountain West having coached New Mexico to four MW regular season titles and two MW tournament championships with six postseason appearances in his six seasons in Albuquerque. With Alford now coaching the Wolf Pack, seven of the last 11 Mountain West championships have been won by Nevada, or Nevada's current coach.

Alford joins the Wolf Pack after five plus seasons at UCLA where he led the Bruins to four NCAA Tournament appearances advancing to the Sweet 16 three times in a four-year span in 2014, 2015 and 2017. The Bruins won the 2014 Pac-12 Tournament. During his tenure at UCLA he posted a record of 124-63.

He inherits a Nevada team that finished 23rd in the final USA Today Coaches poll after posting a 29-5 record. The 29 wins tied the school record that has been accomplished three times, twice in each of the last two seasons. The Pack has won the last three Mountain West regular season titles.

Nevada will be Alford's fifth Division I head coaching job after making stops at Missouri State (1995-1999), Iowa (1999-2007), New Mexico (2007-2013) and UCLA (2013-2018). He began his collegiate coaching career at Division III Manchester College (1991-1995) and led the team to a runner-up finish in 1995 as the squad ended the year 31-1. The only loss came in the NCAA Division III title game.

In each of his previous coaching jobs he led his team's to NCAA Tournament victories. In 14 seasons his squads advanced to the NCAA Tournament, 11 at the Division I level and three at Division III. In addition to leading UCLA to three Sweet 16 appearances he guided Missouri State to its first Sweet 16 in 1999. Seven times he led squads to the National Invitation Tournament.

A proven winner Alford's teams have won eight conference tournaments, the Big 10 twice (2001, 2006), the Mountain West twice (2012, 2013), Pac-12 (2014) and the Indiana Collegiate Conference (1993, 1994, 1995) three times during his time at Manchester.

No stranger to the MW, Alford led New Mexico to four regular season and two tournament titles in six seasons as the Lobos head coach. In 2009, 2010 and 2013 he was named the MW Coach of the Year. He posted a record of 155-52 at UNM and was 68-26 in conference play. Three of his UNM players; JR Giddens (2008), Darrington Hobson (2010) and Kendal Williams (2013) were named MW Player of the Year. The Lobos 30 wins in 2012 and 29 in 2013 are the two highest win totals in program history. The 2012 and 2013 team secured No. 3 seeds in the NCAA Tournament which tied UNM's record for highest seeded team.

In 15 seasons he had led his teams to 20 or more wins and three times 30 or more victories. His 2016-17 UCLA squad posted a 31-5 record with the 28 regular season victories tying the Bruins record for wins.



During his time at UCLA he coached 11 NBA draft selections, seven were chosen in the first round. In 2015 (Kevon Looney), 2014 (Zach Lavine, Jordan Adams, Kyle Anderson), 2017 (Lonzo Ball, TJ Leaf) and 2018 (Aaron Holiday) were all first round selections. While at UNM, JR Giddens and Tony Snell were first round NBA selections.

At Manchester College he earned conference coach of the year honors three times. The 1994-95 team was inducted into the school's hall of fame and in 1999 Alford was inducted into the Manchester Hall of Fame.

As a college senior Alford led Indiana to the 1987 NCAA Championship. The 1983 Indiana Mr. Basketball was a two-time consensus NCAA first-team All-America selection in 1986 and 1987. A three-time first-team Big 10 selection, he was the conference MVP his senior year. He ended his college career as the leading scorer at Indiana and currently ranks second. He played for Hall of Fame coach Bob Knight at Indiana. In 1984 Alford earned an Olympic gold medal playing for the United States in Los Angeles for a team coached by Knight. It was the last United States' amateur team to win Olympic Gold.

In 1997 he was inducted into the Indiana University Hall of Fame and in 2001 was one of 15 players named to Indiana's All-Century team.

Following his career at Indiana he was selected 26th overall in 1987 NBA Draft by the Dallas Mavericks. He played four years from 1987-1991 in the NBA for Dallas and Golden State.

He is married to the former Tanya Frost. The couple has two sons Kory and Bryce and a daughter Kayla.
