Post-game Notes:

- Three Lobos finished in double figures including: redshirt-sophomore Keith McGee (19), senior Anthony Mathis (17), sophomore Makuach Maluach (11).
 - Tuesday's game marked Mathis' third consecutive game scoring 16 points or more. Mathis has registered double-digit scoring in all but four games this season.
 - Tuesday's game marked Maluach's 11th game on the season scoring in double digits.
- McGee set new season highs with 19 points and eight made field goals.
 - His previous season high for points scored came against Wyoming on Jan. 19
 (14), while his previous season high for made field goals came at UNLV on Jan. 22
 (five).
- Mathis was a perfect 6-for-6 from the foul line. Tuesday's game marked Mathis' 10th game on the season in which he has been perfect from the stripe.
- Maluach registered three blocks, tying his previous season high set against UTEP on Nov. 24, 2018.
- The Lobos finished with 83 points, shooting 53.8 percent from the floor.
 - The Lobos are now 7-0 when scoring between 80-89 points and 9-1 when shooting a higher field goal percentage than their opponents.
 - San Diego State's defense has been holding opponents to 68.9 points and a 41.4 shooting percentage from the floor.
 - UNM's 53.8 percent marks the Lobos' second-highest field goal percentage on the season.
- The Lobos registered a 16-0 run in the second half starting at 18:30 and ending at 14:28. The run gave the Lobos their first lead since 10 minutes left in the first half (22-20) and their largest lead of the game thus far (14). This lead was later eclipsed by a 20-point lead with 8:09 left in the game.

- During the run, Mathis' scored a pair of threes with three free throws, redshirtjunior Carlton Bragg scored a layup and two free throws. McGee hit a jumper and Maluach made a free throw.
- Tuesday's game marked San Diego State's first loss this season when outrebounding its opponent (34-32). SDSU was previously 9-0.
- The Lobos are now 9-2 when outscoring their opponents in the second half.
