In-Game Notes

- First back-to-back 100-point games since December of 1998
- #PandemoniUNM defense averaging 29.5 turnovers forced per game to start the season.
- Held the visiting Mavericks to 38.6% from the field (22-57) and 33.3% from three (10-30).
- Lobos scored 39 points off of turnovers
- In two games, the Lobos have hit 35 3-pointers. Last season, it took nine games to reach that mark. UNM has hit at least 17 threes in the last two games to open the season.
- Lobos averaging 58.5 bench points per game to start the season.
- Shot 43.6% from three overall (17-39), 68.4% in the second half (13-19)
- Shot 34.1% from the field in the first half (14-41), followed by a 55.6% second half (20-36)
- Averaging 44.5 field goals and 81 field goal attempts per game to begin the season.
- First win by 30 to 40 points since November 17, 2013 when they beat Alabama A&M 88-52.
- Joe Furstinger had a career-high in points with 11 (previous high was 9) and tied his career-highs in blocks (4) and free throws made (5).
