

## ***NEW MEXICO 90 VS. MCNEESE 80***

### Matchup Notes:

- Starting Lineup: JJ Caldwell, JaQuan Lyle, Vance Jackson, Makuach Maluach, and Carlton Bragg Jr.
- The Lobos and the Cowboys have met just once before in both the teams' program history, a 90-46 New Mexico victory at home on December 21, 1998.
- Attendance: 10,501

### Coach Weir Notes:

- UNM Record: 37-33
- Overall Record: 65-39

### Post-Game:

- The Lobos are now 2-0 in the Legends Classic after a 10-point victory over McNeese.
- The Lobos close their homestand having scored 90 or more points in each of their first four contests of the season.
- Five Lobos racked up double figures in the game including Corey Manigault (24), JaQuan Lyle (18), Makuach Maluach (12), Zane Martin (12), and Vance Jackson (11).
  - This is the third game in a row for Lyle and Jackson's first time to score in double figures this season.
- Corey Manigault tied his career high of 24 points which he last scored on Jan. 6, 2018 while at Indian Hills CC.
  - This marks his first 20-point game this season and his third at UNM.
- JJ Caldwell posted 10 assists marking a new career high. He surpassed his previous career high of seven assists, which he achieved during his redshirt-freshman season at Texas A&M against Florida on Jan. 2, 2018.
- Carlton Bragg Jr. registered 18 rebounds marking a new season high after posting 16 against Green Bay on Nov. 13, 2019.
  - Bragg's 18 rebounds contributed to UNM's total of 38, and McNeese finished the game with 27.
- Along with his 18 rebounds Bragg also recorded five steals on the day.
- The Lobos have now posted two games with 22 assists this season. The last time the Lobos registered 22 assists was on Nov. 9 in UNM's second game of the season against CSUN.
- The Lobos outscored the Cowboys off turnovers (25-18), in the paint (40-28), in second-chance points (18-9), on the fast break (32-10) and off the bench (43- 23).
