The Game:

The University of New Mexico Lobos (0-0) look to go 2-2 in season and home openers under head coach Bob Davie when the squad faces off with the Mississippi Valley State Delta Devils of the FCS and the SWAC. It's the first FCS opponent faced by UNM since the 2012 opener when UNM beat Southern 66-17. That was the first game at UNM for Bob Davie. For Mississippi Valley State, whose most famous football alums are Hall of Famers Jerry Rice, Willie Totten and Deacon Jones, the Delta Devils are coming off a 2-9 season in 2014.

The Coaches:

The University of New Mexico Lobos are coached by Bob Davie, who is 11-26 in his third season with the Lobos, and he is 46-51 overall in his ninth season. He spent his first five seasons as a head coach manning the Notre Dame Fighting Irish. For the Delta Devils, they are coached by Rick Comegy, who is in his second season with MVSU, but he is a veteran coach, having served for 10 years as head coach at Tuskegee and seven years at Jackson State. He is 2-9 at Mississippi Valley State, but in his 19th year he is 158-91 overall.

Series History:

This is the first meeting between the two programs.

Broadcast Information:

The game will be broadcast on the Lobo Radio Network with Robert Portnoy and DonTrell Moore calling all the action, with Michael Carlyle serving as engineer. Scott Stiegler will man the sidelines and host the postgame call-in show. The flagship station is 770 AM KKOB out of Albuquerque.

The game will also be broadcast on ESPN Deportes with Carlos Fourzan and Ben Becerra on 1450 KRZY and José 105.9 FM.

The Opening List

The University of New Mexico opens its 117th season on Saturday, September 5. The date equals the latest date for a UNM season opener since 1986, when UNM opened the season at Tennessee on September 6, losing 35-21. Overall, the Lobos have gone 64-49-3 in 116 season openers, a .565 winning percentage. The Lobos are also 53-23-2 in season openers when that season opener is at home, which is a .692 mark (a mark that is better than UNM's 73-39-4, .647 mark in all-time home openers).

While UNM has a solid season opening record, the program has struggled of late, going just 2-8 in the last 10 season openers, and those 10 season openers are the subject of this week's "Opening List"

Just Pacing Ourselves...

This sort of came to a head in the 2014 season finale when New Mexico defeated Wyoming 36-30 despite Wyoming running 94 offensive plays and New Mexico running just 39. UNM didn't run many plays in 2014.

Overall the Lobos ran 735 plays (127th out of 128) and their 61.25 offensive plays per game was the lowest average in the FBS. At the other end was Arizona and Baylor. Arizona ran 1,139 offensive plays, 404 more than UNM. Baylor ran 1,138, but in one less game than Arizona (13), and the Bears averaged 87.5 offensive plays.

Over the course of the season, Baylor ran approximately four more games worth of plays than UNM's offense. Baylor averaged 6.64 yards per play to UNM's 6.52, both ranking in the top 20 nationally in that category (Baylor 15th, UNM 20th).

And What's Ahead for 2015?

With 47 letter winners returning, the Lobos have a few interesting percentages when you look at what returns and what doesn't return statistically. Certainly on the offensive side of the ball, where UNM loses just nine letter winners, the Lobos have a lot of offense returning.

That's was New Mexico's red zone touchdown percentage, which was good for a tie for 18th in the NCAA last year. Among Mountain West schools, only Colorado State (72.0%) and Boise State (70.42%) were better an UNM.

And He Was Only Number 5 By The Way

Due to redshirting and things like that, there are many cases of graduates playing football and working on a Master's degree. Almost always, those are players in their senior year, or they are graduate transfers, in the case of UNM's Travis Green, who graduated from Kansas State and is now with UNM.

The harder trick is to graduate with two years of eligibility, but that's exactly what UNM offensive lineman Garrett Adcock has done. Adcock was named by NFL.com as the fifth-smartest football player in the FBS. He earned his degree in biology in three years, and despite his eventual goal of being a surgeon, Adcock was accepted into UNM's law school.

He is one of nine FBS players in 2015 that will be juniors in eligibility but holding a Bachelor's degree. Here is the complete list of those nine.

Adcock is the only one of those nine in law school. To make the story even better (and slightly more unbelievable), Adcock has spent part of his summers with his family in Africa building hospitals and schools.

You Can See Why He Was Mr. Explosive

Jhurell Pressley finished 46th in the nation in rushing, and his 1,083 yards ended up the 13th-most rushing yards in a single season at UNM. Pressley's 114 carries is easily the fewest amount of carries of any of the 57 rushers in the FBS who hit the 1,000-yard mark. The next fewest carries was 166 by Elijah McGuire, who rushed for 1,264 yards.

Pressley averaged 9.41 yards per carry in 2013, but he had just 29 attempts. His 9.50 yards per carry in 2014 obliterated the previous UNM record of 7.79 yards per carry, by Billy Brown. That record had held up for 55 years, set in 1959.

Pressley was named the No. 7 Most Explosive Runner by NFL.com for the 2015 season, mostly off of this stat: Pressley reeled off five runs of 60 yards or more. Only four TEAMS had more 60-yard runs than that (Indiana, Wisconsin, Marshall and Georgia Southern).

Pressley also finished the season with 12 rushing touchdowns, giving him 24 for his career, and his last TD put him in seventh on the career list. While catching DonTrell Moore would seem a stretch, Pressley has a shot at climbing all the way to number two next year.

DonTrell is Safe...Not Quite so Sure About the Others...

DonTrell Moore's record of 51 rushing touchdowns in his career is safe for the season, unless something really amazing happens with Jhurell Pressley. Pressley will enter the 2014 season with 24 career rushing touchdowns, and would need an out-of-this-world 27 to tie Moore. However, he certainly will have to opportunity to move up the list, with second place just 10 touchdowns away.

It's worth noting that Teriyon Gipson, who is entering his junior year this season, has 13 rushing touchdowns in his career. Here is the top nine in rushing touchdowns in UNM history.

What Else is Ahead for Jhurrell

Jhurrell Pressley will spend the 2015 season moving up the UNM career rushing list. Pressley will start the season at No. 19 with 1,818 yards, and he needs just 272 yards to catapult himself into 10th place all-time. Of course he should become the 14th back in school history with 2,000 career yards, and he has an outside shot of being one of six with 3,000 yards.

Back-to-Back Great Rushing Seasons

The University of New Mexico in 2013 set a UNM record for the highest average yards per carry for the team with a 6.14 average yard per carry. UNM rushed for 3,706 yards on 604 carries. Well, chuck that one out the window because the 2014 Lobos topped it. UNM rushed for 3,725 yards of 586 carries, an average of 6.36 yards per carry (only Georgia Southern, Marshall and Wisconsin averaged more yards per rush than UNM did)

The Lobos' 3,725 yards is the third-most in UNM history, and the Lobos have now run for three of the top four rushing totals in each of the last three seasons under Bob Davie.

Dialing Long Distance

In 2014 the Lobos scored 12 times from their own side of the field with two long kickoff returns, two long touchdown passes and eight long touchdown runs. In the opener, Cole Gautsche went for 68 yards in the first quarter and 51 yards in the third, both against UTEP. Jhurrell Pressley has a 50-yarder against Air Force, a 75-yarder against Boise State and a 77-yarder against UTSA. Add to that Ridge Jones had a 75-yard run and a 100-yard kickoff return against Boise State. Against Utah State, Romell Jordan had a 72-yard touchdown run and Tyler Duncan hauled in a 59-yard touchdown pass from Lamar Jordan. In the finale Jordan hit Duncan for a 75-yard score, Jhurrell Pressley had a 69-yard run, and Carlos Wiggins had a 97-yard kickoff return.

The Reason Jason Sanders is Smiling

After a season in which Zack Rogers was the punter and placekicker and true freshman Jason Sanders just kicked off, this year Rogers will just punt and Sanders will kick off and handle all the place kicks.

Since Bob Davie became the head coach in 2012, Lobo kickers have enjoyed kicking plenty of extra points. Justus Adams in 2012 and 2013 hit 89 total, which is the fourth-most in school history. In fact Adams kicked a school record 49 in 2013. Last year Rogers hit 43 extra points, which tied for the third-most in school history.

With UNM kickers hitting at least 40 extra points in each season, Sanders can realistically break the UNM career extra points record, which is 100, set by Colby Cason from 1995-97.

He's Baaaaack

Dakota Cox, who led the Lobos in tackles in each of the past two seasons, is back after tearing his ACL against Boise State on November 8, 2014.

Last year Cox finished sixth nationally with 77 assisted tackles, and tied for 37th overall with 116 total tackles. His 12.9 tackles per game was just a shade better than Texas State's David Mayo, who averaged 12.83 per game. His 12.4 tackles in conference games ranked fifth nationally, and his 13.5 in non-conference games is was second nationally.

Cox has 215 tackles in his career. He is just 75 away from moving into the top 20 at UNM, as Dallas Bollema, Cox's former teammate, is sitting in 20th with 290 tackles. Should Cox double his career total, that would give him 430 tackles, which would be fifth all-time at UNM. Below are the top 20 tackles for a career at UNM.

Nothing Like Some Real Cynodon Dactylon

When the Lobos visit the Arizona State Sun Devils, they will be playing on a rather strange surface. The surface is from the kingdom of Plantae, of the phylum angiosperm, of the class commelinids, or the order of poales, of the family of poaceae, of the genus of cynodon, and it has a scientific species name of cynodon dactylon. Most folks know it is bermuda grass.

While all those words look a little foreign, the game surface will seem foreign for the Lobos. UNM has not played a football game on natural grass since November 2, 2013, when the Lobos lost 35-30 to San Diego State in San Diego at Qualcomm Stadium.

Well I Thought About the Army...

UNM's rushing offense last year finished fourth nationally, averaging 308.8 yards per game and totaling 3,706 yards overall. That number of 3,706 was the third-highest mark in school history, behind the 1971 team which rushed for 4,229 yards, and Bob Davie's first Lobo squad, which had 3,917 yards over 13 games. But why think about the Army? Because over the last two years, the only two teams in the FBS to average 300 or more yards per game on the ground are the Lobos, and the Army Black Knights.

Whelp, you can scratch Army off that list. The Lobos finished fourth in rushing with 310.4 yards per game, making UNM the only team to finish in the top five and average over 300 yards per game. Army is off the list, despite finishing fifth as the were at 296.5 yards per game.

Byron Bell Tennessee Titans **Offensive Tackle**
Bell was an undrafted free agent and is his fifth season in the NFL and first with Tennessee after four with the Panthers. He has started 54 games in his NFL career, playing in 60 of 62 games.

SaQwan Edwards Oakland Raiders **Cornerback**
Edwards was an undrafted free agent and is in his first season with the Oakland Raiders.

Dillon Farrell San Francisco 49ers **Center**
Farrell was an undrafted free agent entering his second season with the 49ers. He played in six games this season.

Daryl Johnson Buffalo Bills **Offensive Line**
Johnson was an undrafted free agent and is in his second season with the NFL. He is entering his first season with the Bills.

Glover Quin Detroit Lions **Safety**
Quin is in his sixth season in the NFL, and second with Detroit. Glover was a 4th round draft choice, and the 112th overall pick by the Houston Texans in 2009. He has played in 95 out of a possible 96 games in his career with 449 total tackles, 3.0 sacks, four forced fumbled, four fumble recoveries, 15 interceptions and 68 passes defended.

This is Progress

Last year New Mexico finished the season 4-8, going 0-7 against winning teams (or .500) and 4-1 against teams with losing records (and the one loss to Fresno State which got to the Mountain West championship game and then lost in a bowl game. Under Bob Davie the Lobos have gone 10-6 against FBS teams that did not have a winning record. In the previous three seasons New Mexico was 3-12 against such opponents.

32 Out of 37 > 0 Out of 24

In the 2010 and 2011 seasons, the Lobos had as many 100-yard rushers as the fan-base did ... zero. However, enter Bob Davie, Bob De-Besse and the pistol triple option and that two-year rushing skein is a long distant memory. The Lobos in the last three seasons over the span of 37 games have had 32 100-yard rushers. UNM pulled off 11 100-yard games last year in 12 contests after having 10 in 13 contests in 2012. So far this year, the Lobos have had nine 100-yard games. Cole Gautsche's 184-yard effort in the opener, and then Crusoe Gong-bay's 139-yard effort against New Mexico State and his 163-yard night against Fresno State. Lamar Jordan and Jhurell Pressley had 106 and 102 respectively against UTSA, giving UNM five 100-yard rushing games on the season, and then Pressley had 148 against Air Force and 138 against UNLV for UNM's sixth and seventh of the season. Against Boise State, Pressley had 154 yards and Teriyon Gipson had 205 for the eighth and ninth 100-yard games. Pressley then went for 109 against Colorado State and 101 against Wyoming.

Another Record Goes Down

When New Mexico rushed for 505 yards against the Boise State Broncos, those yards came on just 49 carries. That game UNM a 10.3 yard per carry average, and that average is the best ever in a single game in UNM history. The number tops the previous best of 10.0, set against Northern Arizona on September 23, 1950, when the Lobos rushed for 549 yards on 55 carries.

99 Luftballons

The number 99 is a magical one in football, because it represents the longest play from scrimmage. It also represents the longest possible drive, and that has happened just four times in the last 30 years at UNM. Last year UNM went 99 yards against the league's best defense, Utah State.

That drive marked the sixth 90+ yard drive for a touchdown of the Bob Davie era, and the program had six 90+ yard drives the previous nine seasons from 2003-2011. It was the first 99-yard touchdown drive since October 8, 1988, when UNM went 99 yards in 12 plays against Utah. Below are the 10 drives longer than 95 yards in the 30 years, and you can see four have come in the Bob Davie era.

Verily a Rookie Shall Lead Them to the Promised Land...Twice

Leading fourth quarter comebacks isn't easy. Leading fourth quarter comebacks when needing a touchdown is harder. Leading fourth quarter comebacks when you twice are down in the fourth quarter and twice need touchdowns to take the lead is ridiculously hard. So it stands to reason that a freshman would do it for the Lobos...twice.

When the Lobos took over the ball at their own 35-yard line with 4:41 to go needing a touchdown to win against New Mexico State, the burden rested on the shoulders of preseason third-string quarterback Lamar Jordan, who entered the game after slight injuries to Cole Gautsche and Clayton Mitchem. Turns out those are some pretty big shoulders, despite the fact he had already led the Lobos into the lead with a touchdown earlier in the fourth quarter.

Jordan calmly led UNM down the field again, helping to convert a 2nd-and-16 situation (and eventually 3rd-and-7) into a first down. Getting UNM to the New Mexico State 5-yard line, Jordan faked a hand-off, faked a run and hit Reece White with a perfectly executed touch pass for the win.

Jordan did it again a few weeks later, leading a 15-play, 66-yard drive with a fourth-down conversion in the mix, as Teriyon Gipson put UNM in front with a 3-yard touchdown with 1:22 left against UNLV in a game UNM trailed 21-17 and 28-24 in the fourth quarter.

The question is how often has that happened once, let alone twice? The answer...not a lot.

While in the last few years the Lobos have been able to drive for a winning score while tied, and even a winning field goal while trailing, the last time New Mexico got a fourth quarter drive needing a touchdown to win was back in 2007. In that game, sophomore Donovan Porterie started a drive at the UNM 35-yard line with 1:46 to go, and led UNM on an eight-play drive. That culminated in a 6-yard touch-down run by Rodney Ferguson with just 15 seconds left, that turned a 17-13 deficit into a 20-17 Lobo win. The last time a freshman

On This Date

The game on September 5 will be just the seventh for the Lobos on that particular date, since it was 1979 that the NCAA moved the season back a week, meaning games started the first weekend in September, not the second. For the Lobos, it's been hit or miss...with the hits at home and the misses on the road. The Lobos are 3-3 on September 5, with a perfect 3-0 record at home and an 0-3 mark on the road. Included in that span is the only FCS opponent that the Lobos have played on September 5, and that was Idaho State. Ironically, there is one person with the Lobo football program that was around for that contest ... and it was Lobo football media relations director Frank Mercogliano, who was Idaho State's SID at the time. The Lobos won that game 38-9. Here are the six games previously that were played on September 5.

Plenty of things have happened on September 5 in history. Hurricane Fran made landfall in North Carolina in 1996, causing \$3 billion in damages. In 1986 Pan Am Flight 72 was hijacked at Karachi International Airport, with 20 passengers killed. It was much better two years earlier in 1984 when the maiden voyage of the Space Shuttle Discovery landed. Back in 1975, Lynette "Squeaky" Fromme, a member of the Manson Family, attempted to assassinate President Gerald Ford in Sacramento. Two major Summer Olympic events happened on September 5 as well. In 1972, Palestinian terrorists took 11 Israeli athletes hostage, killing two (nine would die the following day), and 12 years previous in 1960, Cassius Clay won the light heavyweight boxing gold medal in Rome.

1882 saw the very first Labor Day Parade, held in New York City and 1836 saw Sam Houston elected the first president of the Republic of Texas. In 1774, the first Continental Congress assembled in Philadelphia.

The most pertinent thing that happened on September 5 happened in 1906. On that date, St. Louis University quarterback Bradbury Robinson completed a pass to Jack Schneider in a 22-0 win over Carroll College of Wisconsin. That was the first legal forward pass ever completed in college football, changing the game forever.

Famous people born on September 5 include basketball player Lance Stephenson (1990), basketball player Elena Delle Donne (1989), quarterback Colt McCoy (1986), baseball player Randy Choate (1975), actress Rose McGowan (1973), Journey lead singer Arnie Pineda (1967), actor Michael Keaton (1951), cartoonist Cathy Guisewite (1950), singer Freddie Mercury (1946), actress Raquel Welch (1940), former James Bond George Lazenby (1939), comedian/actor Bob Newhart (1929), Jack Valenti, the inventor of the MPPAA ratings system (1921), the criminal Jesse James (1847), King Louis XIV of France (1638) and King Louis VIII of France (1187).

Sadly, on this day the world lost Candid Camera's Allen Funt (1999), Mother Teresa (1997), General Arthur MacArthur (General Douglas MacArthur's father (1912), Crazy Horse (1877) and Catherine Parr, the last of King Henry VIII's six wives (1548 from complications of child birth).

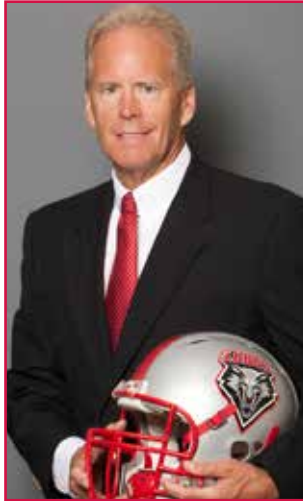

With the foundation now starting to take shape, Bob Davie enters his fourth season as coach at New Mexico. Davie's 11 wins in three seasons nearly quadruples the program's total from the three seasons prior to his arrival, but it's how he has been able to do it that is what has Lobos fans excited for the upcoming seasons. Davie has completely flipped the roster, with over 90% of the players on the 2014 roster recruited by his staff, and all but five for the 2015. New Mexico's three fifth-year seniors were the fewest of any non-service academy in the nation, and 2015 will be more of the same with just two fifth-year seniors on the roster. Davie has also done it with a New Mexico flavor, getting major contributions from local and state players, including 2014's leading receiver Jeric Magnant, 2014's second-leading scorer Zack Rogers, and starters such as quarterback Cole Gautsche and running back David Anaya. And the success and improvement isn't just on the field ... it's off it. In three seasons under Davie, the Lobos have picked up 50 Mountain West All-Academic selections, including a program record 20 in 2014, and 16 in 2013, the second-best total for football in school history. UNM also had five Mountain West Scholar-Athletes in 2013, the second-best total among the MW's 12 football programs. Over the course of 2012-13 and 2013-14, the football team posted the highest back to back football team GPAs in school history. The 2014 Lobos also featured three players on the Capital One/CoSIDA All-District team in Reece White, Garrett Adcock and Dakota Cox. The three players were exactly half of the honorees in the Mountain West as the rest of the league had three players combined. The 2014 season was another huge stepping stone for the program, one that saw the Lobos improve their win total from a season ago, and one that saw the Lobos competitive in

basically every game, no matter the stature of their opponent. New Mexico went 4-8 in 2014, a one-game improvement from 2013, but the improvement was certainly bigger than the win column. The Lobos shaved a full touchdown off of their points allowed, and 14.5 points off their defensive average against unranked opponents from a year ago. The 2014 Lobos again represented the Davie way of doing things, rushing the ball consistently. After Air Force's led the Mountain West in rushing for every year of the league's existence from 1999 (14 in all), UNM repeated as conference rushing champion in 2014. The Lobos' 301.4-yard average per game ranked fourth nationally, and UNM is the only team in the last three years to average 300 yards per game on the ground and finish in the top five nationally. The Lobos were in the top five nationally in runs of 10, 20, 30, 40, 50 and 60 yards as well. The Lobos also saw some success through the air, with seven touchdowns on the season and an average of 89.1 yards per game. Once again, UNM's special teams lived up to billing, with UNM leading the Mountain West in average return with a 22.4-yard average. UNM was the only school to return a kickoff for a touchdown, and it accomplished that twice, with two different returners. The kickoff return for a touchdown has become a hallmark of the Bob Davie era, as UNM now has seven kickoff returns for touchdowns in his three years as the head coach.
