THIS GAME

- » GCU is 4-3 in its seven most recent matchups against the Mountain West Conference with wins over San Diego State. Boise State and New Mexico.
- » New Mexico is the third team of a challenging three-game stretch of opponents with two or fewer losses. The combined record of the three opponents is 35-3 (.921).

TRENDS

- » Of the four remaining unbeaten teams, GCU has faced two (Liberty, San Diego State). Opponents GCU has previously played are 79-49 (.617).
- » Alessandro Lever scored his 1,000th career point on Dec. 8, joining DeWayne Russell and Joshua Braun as GCU's 1,000-point scorers at the Division I level.
- » Alessandro Lever is the only WAC player to average over 13.0 ppg while also shooting over 45% from the field.
- » Jovan Blacksher Jr. (7th), Carlos Johnson (11th), and Isiah Brown (14th) rank in the top 15 in total minutes.
- » GCU ranks 41st in the country in fewest turnovers (11.7) and 50th in free throw percentage (74.9%).

LAST GAME

» GCU went down 11-0 and never recovered in 24-point loss.

STORYLINES

- » Last year, the Lopes won 20 games for the fourth straight season, one of just 29 D-I teams to accomplish the feat.
- » GCU Arena was the fullest venue in college basketball at 102.43% of capacity, averaging 7,170 fans.
- » The Lopes return their two leading scorers for the first time in four years in Preseason All-WAC picks Carlos Johnson (14.3 ppg) and Alessandro Lever (12.5 ppg).
- » In one offseason, Majerle has gone from having his tallest roster (6' 6.13") to his shortest (6' 4.46").
- » New assistants Marvin Menzies and Isaac Chew join the staff as assistant coaches, joining Chris Crevelone.

HEAD COACH DAN MAJERLE

"You saw what happened. It was ugly. We started on an 11-0 run. We couldn't make a shot, couldn't stop anybody and just snowballed. Overall just a poor performance. That's it.

"They knew this was a big game, and we started off again by missing a lot of jump shots and not stopping anybody. They are a really good team and do a good job, but we're just not, for whatever reason, we're just not getting it done.

"I told our guys, we're going to go through stretches where we can't score, but you've still got to be able to stop the other team from scoring. I thought we had a good couple day of practice. Our guys were ready to go, and we just didn't have it. I don't know what to tell you.

"There is no such thing. I mean teams pack the paint against us because they know we can't shoot. We're going to throw it into Ale, and they're going to double-team. So there's gonna be no easy 2s, because they're gonna pack in the paint, and then we have to be tougher going in there, driving and taking contact."


"Disappointed. Liberty is a really good team obviously, 11-0, really well coached. They are great defensively and really good offensively.

AT-A-GLANCE

- » New Mexico is off to it's best start since the 2012-13 season (12-0).
- » The Lobos are in the midst of a four-game homestand and are 7-0 at home for the first time since the 2016-17 season.
- » Head coach Paul Weir is in his third season with the Lobos after guiding New Mexico State to a 28-win season and an NCAA tournament berth in his lone season at the helm in Las Cruces in 2016-17.
- » New Mexico ranks 35th in field goal percentage, shooting at a 48.2% clip.
- » The Lobos also get to the free throw line often, ranking second in the country in total free throw attempts (302) and attempts made (221).
- » Carlton Bragg ranks fifth in the NCAA in total rebounds with 127.

LAST TIME OUT

- » New Mexico completed the season sweep of New Mexico State, defeating the Aggies 69-62 at home in front of 14,000 fans.
- » It is the first time that the Lobos have swept New Mexico State since 2015-16.
- » Carlton Bragg led the Lobos with his fifth double-double of the season, scoring 17 points while grabbing 17 rebounds with four steals.
- » New Mexico outscored the Aggies 38-29 in the second half after being down by two at halftime.

CONNECTIONS

- » Lobos sophomore Vante Hendrix was on the Utah roster when the Lopes faced the Utes in the Wooden Legacy last year, although Hendrix did not see action.
- » Weir spent nine seasons on GCU associate head coach Marvin Menzies' staff at New Mexico State. Brandon Mason served on Menzies' staff at NMSU and UNLV.
- » Weir was 1-1 against GCU in his time as head coach at New Mexico State in 2016-16 with the teams trading 12-point home victories.

» LEVER JOINS 1K CLUB

With a 14-point performance against Liberty on Dec. 8 at Talking Stick Resort Arena, **Alessandro Lever** became the third GCU player to reach 1,000 career points at the Division I level.

With a year and a half remaining in his GCU career, Lever is on pace for approximately 1,700 career points and could close in on Joshua Braun's D-I record for career points.

Freshman guard **Jovan Blacksher Jr.** has slid into an immediate starting role for GCU, and he has done so aptly.

Blacksher was the first Lopes freshman to start his career with double-figure scoring in his first two games. He added a double-double to his early ledger with 14 points and 10 rebounds at San Diego State. Against Montana State, he had 10 assists and one turnover, the only freshmen in the nation to accomplish that feat against a D-I school.

"He's going to be the face of this program for a long time," Majerle said. "He is going to have some growing pains as a freshman, especially at the point guard position."

More experienced teammates have picked up on Blacksher's poise.

"He's a stud," junior guard Isiah Brown said. "The kid is going to continue to get better. He's just going to continue to learn. He's going to make shots. He's going to be a pest on defense. He's going to create opportunities for our offense.

» RETURNING SCORERS

For the first time in four years, Grand Canyon returns its top two scorers for the 2019-20 season. **Carlos Johnson** led the Lopes with 14.5 points per game while **Alessandro Lever** averaged 12.5 points. Not by surprise, both Johnson and Lever earned spots on the Coaches Preseason All-WAC first team.



Average attendance for GCU men's basketball games has steadily increased since the jump to Division I, going from 4,373 fans per game in 2013-14 to its highest mark yet of 7,170 in 2018-19.

» LIGHTER LEVER LOOKS LIMBER

Primed for his junior season, Alessandro Lever is handling the intensity of GCU's practices with more ease. The center changed his eating habits after last season and dropped at least 20 pounds before practices began in September.



"I definitely feel a difference," Lever said. "I feel like I can run faster, jump higher, move quicker. I feel way better."

GCU director of sports performance Gabe Bourland said Lever did not need to lose weight, but he prompted Lever to see what improved nutrition could do for him.

"Alé has been unbelievable," GCU head coach Dan Majerle said. "He's had a great offseason, so I'm expecting him to have a really good year."

Lever made his change by learning how to cook and avoid fast-food temptations.

"I quit eating the stuff my body didn't need," Lever said. "I'm trying to keep to more lean food. I cut out burgers, McDonald's, Chick-fil-A and those places that don't help me as a basketball player. It was a lot of diet and a little bit of a workout."

» DEEPER 3's NOT 'BIG DEAL AT ALL'

The NCAA Playing Rules Oversight Panel voted in June to move the 3-point arc to the international competition distance of 22 feet, 1 3/4 inches, which is 1 feet and 4 3/4 inches farther than where the line has been since 2008. The new distance was used as an experiment during the past two NITs.



"I think guys will shoot when they shoot anyway," Majerle said. "It might spread the floor a little bit more but I don't think it's a big deal at all."

"For most 3-point shooters, we'll shoot the 3 wherever the line is," **Isiah Brown** said. "I don't think it'll affect how many 3s are shot. It'll probably make it a little easier for guys to transition from college to the pros, and the spacing will be a little bit better, too, and make it a little more like the pro game."

Alessandro Lever, who was second on the team behind **Oscar Frayer** in attempted 3s last season, will be the least affected by the change. Growing up in Italy, Lever played with an international line for most of his life, continues to play with it for his national team in offseason competition and takes long 3s at GCU anyway.

"It's going to be more normal for me than shooting closer to the basket," Lever said. "I have been playing my whole life with the international FIBA, one so I'm more used to it. I'm more comfortable with the longer one."

» TOURNEY TIME

For five straight seasons, the Lopes have participated in a nonconference tournament or showcase game. In 2019-20, they'll do both once again.

GCU headed to St. Thomas in the U.S. Virgin Islands for the **Paradise Jam** on Nov. 22-25. The Lopes fell to Valparaiso and Fordham before salvaging the tournament with a win against Illinois State in the finale.



And for the third time in as many years, the Lopes will make the short trip downtown to play at Talking Stick Resort Arena, home to the Phoenix Suns. The Lopes will be matched up with Liberty in the final game of a **Colangelo Classic** tripleheader.



Dan Majerle, a former NBA All-Star and Olympian, is in his seventh year at the helm of GCU men's basketball in 2019-20 after taking over the program on March 18, 2013, as the program's 13th head coach.

It has been quite an impressive run in the Valley for the former Phoenix Suns star, broadcaster and assistant coach. In six years at GCU, Majerle has amassed 123 wins and five postseason berths on the sideline. His teams have posted the 31st-best winning percentage (.684) in Division I over the past four seasons and is one of 29 programs to win 20 or more games in each of those seasons. In each of the past two seasons, the Lopes came within one win of an NCAA tournament berth in their first two years of full Division I postseason eligibility.

Majerle has made his mark with teams that have finished in the top three of the WAC in each of his six seasons. Majerle also has attracted many high-profile opponents during his tenure, including Kentucky, Duke, Arizona, Nevada, Texas, Seton Hall, West Virgina and a home-and-home series with Louisville.

Behind Maierle's presence and a rising team, GCU Arena has been among the fullest venues in college basketball in recent years. In 2018-19, GCU led all Division I programs for attendance capacity percentage (102.4) and topped the WAC with 7,170 fans per game. The average attendance has increased every season as a Division I program, including a spike of 3,343 fans for Majerle's first season -- a 325 percent bump from the previous season.

Majerle completed his first year at GCU in 2013-14 by being named a finalist for the Joe B. Hall Award, which is given to the most outstanding first-year Division I head coach. He had guided the team to a 15-15 record in its first year of reclassification to Division I. The Lopes, tabbed to finish eighth in the WAC, used a 10-6 conference mark to claim third place. GCU also received a bid to its first Division I postseason tourney, the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament.

Before starting his tenure at GCU, Majerle spent five seasons (2008-13) as an assistant coach and four years as a broadcast analyst (2002-06) with the NBA's Phoenix Suns. "Thunder Dan" is one of the most popular figures in Suns history, having been inducted into the Suns Ring of Honor in 2003 for his eight playing seasons (1988-95, 2001-02) with Phoenix.

Majerle played 14 seasons in the NBA and averaged 11.4 points over 955 career games. He made three All-Star appearances and was named to the 1990-91 and 1992-93 All-Defensive second team. He led the league in 3-pointers made (192) in 1993-94.

Majerle, the 14th overall selection in the 1988 NBA Draft by the Suns, was runner-up by one vote to the Indiana Pacers' Detlef Schrempf for the NBA Sixth Man Award in 1990-91, when he averaged 13.6 points and 5.4 rebounds. He averaged a career-best 17.3 points during the 1991-92 season, his first All-Star season.

Majerle made his second consecutive trip to the All-Star Game in 1992-93, also a NBA Finals season for Phoenix, and finished tied for the league lead in 3-pointers with 167. He set a Suns record with eight 3-pointers made on Jan. 30, 1993, and did it again in Game 5 of the Western Conference Finals against Seattle.

Following the 1993-94 season, Majerle was named to Dream Team II, the U.S. squad that won gold at the 1994 World Championship in Ontario, Canada. This was Majerle's second time representing his country. Before his NBA rookie season, he was part of the U.S. team that won the bronze medal at the 1988 Olympics in Seoul, South Korea, where he played for coaching great John Thompson. That same year, he was named the Olympic Athlete of the Year.

He was chosen as a starter for his third All-Star Game in 1994-95 after averaging 17.4 points in the first half of the season, becoming the first reserve to be voted as an All-Star starter since fan balloting began in 1975.

Majerle, originally from Traverse City, Mich., played collegiately at Central Michigan, where he averaged more than 20 points in three of his four seasons and was an All-Mid-American Conference selection each year. During his senior season, he averaged 23.7 points and 10.8 rebounds while hitting 52.2 percent from the field. He completed his career at CMU ranked second for career points, steals and field goal percentage.

Since 2003, the Suns have handed out the Dan Majerle Hustle Award to the player who most personifies the hustle and determination displayed by Majerle in his playing career.

MILESTONE VICTORIES

Grand Canyon University Arena is Phoenix's premier mid-sized indoor venue and serves as the primary home of Lopes men's and women's basketball and men's and women's volleyball teams as well as a wide assortment of university-sponsored and outside events.

The arena has provided the Lopes a definitive home-court advantage since opening its doors before the 2011-12 basketball season. With a seating capacity of 7,000 and a prime location on campus, the venue is regularly packed to the rafters with students and fans, providing an electric atmosphere ripe for success. Since its opening, the men's basketball team has been dominant in the arena, posting an overall record of 112-24 (.830), including five seasons of at least 15 wins.

GCU Arena hit new levels in 2018-19. With an average crowd of 7,170 fans, GCU Arena was the fullest venue in college basketball with a percent capacity of 102.42%.

Home attendance has tripled since the arrival of the arena, with a per-game average of over 7,100 fans coming through the doors in 2018-19. While crowds of over 7,000 used to represent milestones, it has become a common occurrence at GCU Arena. All but two nonconference games were filled above the arena's 7,000-seat capacity in the 2018-19 season.

The facility originally broke ground in the summer of 2010 and was completed before the start of the following basketball season. It is owned and operated by the university.



The Havocs are some of the most dedicated and rowdy fans in all of collegiate sports. Over 4,000 students strong, they turn GCU athletic venues into some of the rowdiest environments in all of college sports.

Known for their constant energy, support and pride, the Havocs support and encourage GCU athletic teams, promote school spirit and build Lope pride.

Tabbed as the "Biggest Party in College Basketball," the Havocs bring the noise and excitement every game with different cheers and chants to give every team a competitive advantage when playing at home. In 2018, GCU Arena was ranked 22nd in the country for best college basketball atmospheres, and was quoted as "easily one of the rowdiest fan bases in the entire country.".



The Havocs mission is is to be the most spirited, energetic and disruptive student section in the country. Havocs strive to create the most unique game day experience in college basketball and a sense of camaraderie for all students.

The Havocs cheer at more than just home events, sending droves of students to rival New Mexico State and to the WAC Tournament in Las Vegas. The support has garnered national attention over the past five years including being featured on ESPN's Scott Van Pelt's SportsCenter show.


