### ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- The Lobos enter Saturday's season-opener against Northern New Mexico coming off of a narrow 79-73 exhibition loss to visiting BYU.
- UNM's exhibition game against BYU was a charity match that was approved by the NCAA
  through the Legislative Relief Process which allows for schools to compete in an additional
  exhibition game given that the net proceeds are donated to a disaster relief Charity.
- The UNM vs BYU exhibition was successful in donating over \$21,147.60 to the Hurricane Harvey Relief Fund.
- This season, the Lobos have just five returners and nine new faces including three freshmen and six transfers.
- Four of UNM's transfers will be eligible to play this season including Chris McNeal (Indian Hills CC), Antino Jackson (Akron), Jachai SImmons (Midland College) and Troy Simons (Polk State).
- Northern New Mexico has already played eight games, entering Saturday 2-6 overall on the season.
- Northern New Mexico has three players averaging double-digit scoring including Bryce Simmons (16.0 ppg, 1.9 rpg), Walid Aly (11.0 ppg, 4.0 rpg) and Eric Coca (10.9 ppg, 2.9 rbg).
- The Lobos will celebrate Heroes Day on Saturday, sporting camouflage shooting shirts honoring first responers.

### SCOUTING NORTHERN NEW MEXICO

The Eagles have already played eight games this season and come into Saturday's match with a 2-6 record. The squad averages 88.6 points per game while their opponents average 94.5.

As a team, the Eagles shoot 46.8% from the field and 32.7% from three-point range. In addition, Northern N.M. posts a 72.7 free-throw percentage.

### HEAD-TO-HEAD HISTORY

While the Lobos have never faced Northern New Mexico in the history of the two programs, Coach Weir has coached against the Eagles as recently as last season.

Weir led the New Mexico State Aggies to a 98-75 victory over the Eagles on January 30 at Santa Ana Star Center in Rio Rancho.

### LOCAL TIES

Between the two squads, there will be 10 players from New Mexico on the court on Saturday, and just one of them is a Lobo. Northern New Mexico has nine players on its 18-man roster from New Mexico, two of which are from Albuquerque.

### LOOKING BACK AT LAST SEASON

The 2016-17 Lobos finished the season 17-14 overall including a 10-8 mark in conference play. UNM did, however, have a weighty advantage at home, accumulating an 11-4 record in The Pit. The New Mexico season was brought to a close after a narrow Mountain West Quarterfinal matchup in which UNM fell to Fresno State 65-60. Statistically, the Lobos outshot the Bulldogs 40.7 percent to 36.8 percent on the night.

### ABOUT THE 2017-18 LOBOS

The 2017-18 Lobos have just five returning student-athletes from the 2016-17 squad and feature an outstanding nine newcomers. Under first-year head coach Paul Weir, the Lobos look to improve on their 17-14 overall record last season, 10-8 in Mountain West play.

Top returners for the Lobos include lone regular starter Sam Logwood who averaged 7.3 points per game for a .449 field goal percentage and a .671 percentage from the free throw line. All four other Lobos to return to UNM this season played in at least 10 games, including junior Dane Kuiper who started 13 games, averging 6.0 points per game.

### NEW COACH. NEW ERA

At the helm of the Lobos in the 2016-17 season will be head coach Paul Weir, officially named the 21st head coach in UNM men's basketball history on April 11, 2017. Weir spent the last season with New Mexico State where he finished 28-6 and led NMSU to a WAC Tournament Championship and an NCAA appearance. Weir is the first basketball coach to serve as the head coach for both New Mexico DI institutions.

### **LOBO TRANSFERS**

Of the nine fresh faces to the UNM squad, the Lobos welcome in six new transfers, four of which will be eligible to compete in the 2017-18 season. Those that are eligible and will don the Lobo Cherry & Silver this season include junior Chris McNeal (Indian Hills), senior Antino Jackson (Akron), junior Jachai Simmons (Midland College) and junior Troy Simons (Polk State). The pair of transfers that will not see action this season is JaQuan Lyle (Ohio State) and Vance Jackson (UCONN) due to NCAA transfer rules.

### LOBOS ON TU

The 2017-18 schedule includes many national and regional broadcasts of New Mexico basketball. The Lobos are currently slated for TV 22 times, including 13 of 16 Mountain West games. UNM had 22 of 26 UNM and MW controlled games selected for TV while three non-conference road games, at New Mexico State, at UTEP and at Colorado are expected to be broadcast as well. The Lobos will be on ATT SportsNet/ROOT eight times, on CBS Sports Network five times, ESPN3 five times, and ESPNU and the Mountain West Network on Stadium once. Additionally, two games (at UNLV on January 17 and January 27 at home against Colorado State) are flex games that will be either on ESPNU or ESPN3.

### THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME

After two years as WisePies Arena - The Pit, the famous home of Lobo basketball has been given a new name. While it will still be referred to as "The Pit," this season will be the first that the Lobos will compete in "Dreamstyle Arena" as part of an exciting \$10 million agreement for naming rights by Dreamstyle Remodeling of both of UNM's largest-capacity athletic venues. In addition to the official renaming of the Lobo basketball arena, the UNM football stadium, formerly referred to as "University Stadium" is now officially named "Dreamstyle Stadium."

In conjunction with the new name, The Pit was given a new floor this season, featuring both "New Mexico" and "The Pit" on the baselines, the new university interlocking UNM logo, fresh Mountain West logos customized in the Lobo cherry and silver, cherry free throw lines and dual Dreamstyle Arena logos on both sides of center court.

"The Pit" is nationally recognized as one of the top basketball ven-

ues. Need more evidence? How about Sports Illustrated ranking it as one of the top 20 sporting venues, of any sport, in the world for the 20th century. The Pit is truly a special place, and it has created an unparalleled environment for the New Mexico men's basketball program. Since the Mountain West conference began in 1999-2000, New Mexico has ranked in the top two in home attendance among MW teams in every year except one, including 12 seasons as the top-ranked MW team in overall attendance.

### Lobos from near and far

Just one Lobo on the 2017-18 roster hails from near as a New Mexico native, freshman Matt Vail. Of the remaining 13 players on the roster, two are from California (Joe Furstinger and Vance Jackson) and two more are from Indiana (Sam Logwood and JaQuan Lyle). That leaves nine players all from different states or countries.

The Lobo melting pot includes players from as close as Arizona (Connor McDougall) and Texas (Antino Jackson) and as far as Alaska (Dane Kuiper), New Jersey (Jachai Simmons), Oregon (Anthony Mathis), Pennsylvania (Troy Simons) and Tennessee (Chris McNeal).

Not only are the Lobos' home towns spread across the United States, but two come from overseas including freshmen Makuach Maluach from Sydney, Australia, and Vladimir Pinchuk from Schwelm, Germany.

### Weir's Lobos Shine in BYU Charity Exhibition

**ALBUQUERQUE, N.M.** --- The energy in Dreamstyle Arena - The Pit was electric on Friday night as the new-look Lobos took to Bob King Court for the first time under first-year head coach Paul Weir. Nearly 5,000 fans filled the chairbacks for the charity exhibition that saw the Lobos fall to former rival BYU by just six points in the final minute, 79-73.

In a match that was tied 12 times with 12 lead changes, the squads were tied with 4:13 left to play at 67-67. The Cougars went up by as much as five with 2:18 left until the Lobos came back with a fury on a pair of driving layups by senior Sam Logwood, making it 73-72 in favor of the visitors with 1:06 left.

From there it was a series of unfortunate events that would ultimately allow the Cougars to go 6-for-7 from the free throw line over the final stretch to claim the six-point victory.

Overall, the Lobos shot 37.1 percent from the field (26-70) compared to 51.9 percent (27-52) for BYU. The Lobos also shot 17.9 percent from three and 66.7 percent from the line. UNM played aggressively, dominating the Cougars in steals 13-5 while forcing 23 turnovers and committing just 12.

"I think, outside of the three-point shooting percentage, we played a pretty good basketball game," head coach Paul Weir said. "I thought the atmosphere was terrific. I thought (the fans') volume was great and I felt it for sure. It was a really neat game and I'm really thankful for all the people that gave us a chance."

Logwood led the Lobos with 23 points, despite finishing the last six minutes with four fouls. Logwood went 8-for-15 from the field, 7-for-11 from the stripe while collecting six rebounds and a pair of steals.

Also a key contributor Friday was fellow senior Joe Furstinger who not only registered the second-most points for UNM (9), but the forward also tallied his first shot from downtown since his freshman year (counting official games). He has only attempted 11 shots in his career from the three-point line and was 1-for-3 on the night. Furstinger was eliminated with 5:06 left in the game on his fifth personal foul.

The Lobo offense was well spread, with transfers Troy Simons and Antino Jackson putting up eight points apiece and juniors Chris McNeal and Anthony Mathis adding seven each.

Leading BYU was Yoelie Childs who posted a double-double on the night with 17 points and 19 rebounds. Childs was one of four Cougars to hit double-digit scoring on the night.

The teams remained close all game both in score, and in statistics, however BYU did have a significant advantage in rebounds, 48-33. BYU had a slight edge in points in the paint (40-34) and points off of turnovers (18-17) while the Lobos came out on top in second-chance points (11-10) and bench points (23-21). Both teams finished with 12 fast-break points.

While there were several key Lobo highlights that lit up the arena, one of which included a Mathis three with 3:39 left in the first half to cut the once 10-point deficit to just two nearing the break. At the end of the half and down by one, Simons snatched a last-second rebound and immediately put it back up at the buzzer to thrill the crowd. The referees originally counted the shot, putting the Lobos up by one at halftime, but as the teams were clearing the court the officials changed the ruling, sending the teams into the half with UNM down one.

- Led the Mountain West in attendance in 10 of the conference's 15 years of existence
- The floor is named Bob King Court in honor of the former head coach who led the Lobos from 1963 to 1972.


