

GAME QUOTES V BOISE STATE

Head Coach Mike Bradbury:

“That game was probably everything that both teams expected – I know it’s what we expected. Clearly this was not a 17-point game, it was a one-possession game. It seems like every time we play Boise, they’re so good and they are as well-coached as anyone we play all year long or that I ever play. Nothing is ever going to be easy, but I thought we played hard, we competed and we made a bunch of shots in the second half - and we needed every one of them.”

“We have a team that is capable of having a lot of different people score. Today we needed it, and when we move the ball and play unselfish like we did today, we can score.”

“I thought the key was Cherise offensively. It seemed like every time we had somebody open, she made the right play, and that ‘s not easy to do against them. I thought it might have been her best game, too.”

Cherise Beynon:

“We were just focusing on our offense, because in the Nevada game we shot so poorly. Our focus throughout practice and for this game was to get the ball moving and just attacking like (Bradbury) said. I’d attack and put so much pressure on their defense that it left Jaisa, Alex, or Tesha open for a wide open three or a layup, so we just played unselfishly tonight and found open people.”

“We know how to score the ball, that’s not a problem. I think now we just need to focus on how to defend the ball and not let them score, because most of the teams in our conference can score the ball as well. We need to work on the defensive part, because the offense is always going to come for us.”

Tesha Buck:

“I think rebounding is just the will to want to get the ball. Going into this game and going into every game, I try to just remind myself to just crash the boards.”

“I think I play best when I let the game come to me and I just take open shots. If I have to pass to get in a rhythm or if I have to rebound, or whatever. Whatever I have to do I’ll do it.”
