 - Mathis led the Lobos in scoring after the first half, finishing with
 11 points on 4-4 shooting (3-3 from three).
 - Mathis' eight field goals tied his career-high.
- UNM's bench outscored Fresno State's 21 to six in the first half and finished the game with 44 points compared to the Bulldogs' 12.
