Post-Game Notes:

- Three Lobos finished in double figures: Vance Jackson (30), Corey Manigault (16) and Anthony Mathis (13).
- Redshirt-sophomore Vance Jackson set new season highs in scoring (30), made free throws (10), and made threes (4).
 - His previous season high for scoring came against New Mexico State on Nov. 17, 2018 in which he scored 27 points off eight made field goals.
 - His previous season high for made free throws also came against the Aggies on Nov. 17,
 2018 where he made seven free throws.
 - His previous season high for made 3-pointers also came against New Mexico State on Nov. 17, 2018 where he made three 3-pointers.
 - Saturday's game marked Jackson's second game on the season scoring over 20 points and his eighteenth double-digit performance of the season.
- Senior Anthony Mathis went a perfect 4-4 from the free throw line. Mathis has been perfect from the foul line the previous four games having made 13 straight free throws.
 - His longest streak this season was 20 starting against North Texas on Dec, 16, 2018 and ending on Jan, 5, 2019 vs Nevada.
- New Mexico set a new season high in free throws made with 28 on 37 attempts.
 - Their previous season high of 26 came against North Texas on Dec. 18, 2018.
- The Lobos shot 41.2 percent from behind the arc going 7-17 registering their highest 3-point percentage over the last five games.
 - Fresno State's defense has been holding opposing offenses to under 30 percent from behind the arc (29).
- The Lobo defense held the Bulldogs' leading scorer redshirt-sophomore Braxton Huggins scoreless in the first half.
 - Huggins averages 19 points per game.
