### COLORADO STATE

- Colorado State goes back on the road for the fourth time in its last five games, Friday night at New Mexico. The Rams are 2-1 on the road this season, having won their last two road games (Hawaii and Utah State). CSU has won four of its last six true road games, dating back to last season.
- The Rams are 3-0 in Mountain West play for the first time since 2002 when they started 6-0. CSU won the MW in 2002, their last league title.
- The Rams' offensive line has not allowed a sack in six of seven games this season. CSU has allowed only two sacks all year, both versus Colorado (Sept. 1), and now ranks second in all of FBS for fewest sacks allowed (0.29 per game).
- Defensively, the Rams rank ninth in the FBS in red zone defense (66.7%), and have allowed opponents into the red zone just 12 times in 2017.
- WR Michael Gallup posted the second-best receiving game in school history in the win over Nevada with 263 yards on a career-high-tying 13 receptions. Gallup leads the nation in receiving yards (948), ranks second in receiving yards per game (135.4) and third in receptions per game (8.3).
- QB Nick Stevens is fourth all-time at CSU in passing yards (7,006) and completions (517), and sixth in pass attempts (827). He has 59 passing TDs for his career, and is now just five behind all-time leader Garrett Grayson (64).
- Colorado State ranks ninth in the FBS in total offense (520.7) and 12th in passing offense (322.1). Both figures lead the MW. CSU has gained at least 600 yards of total offense three times this season.

### THE MATCHUP

- The University of New Mexico Lobos are coached by Bob Davie, who is 30-38 in his sixth season with the Lobos, and he is 65-64 overall in his 11th season.
- The Lobos are 3-3 on the season and 1-2 in the Mountain West.
- After leading the Lobos to back-to-back bowl games, Davie has now been the head coach for five bowl teams, three at Notre Dame and two at New Mexico.
- The Lobos are coming off of a 38-0 loss to Fresno State
- New Mexico was held to under 100 yards rushing for the first time since 2012
- Quarterback Tekava Tuioti passed for 200 yards in the loss to Fresno State
- The Lobos enter the game 19th in the country in rushing offense, 26th in fewest sacks allowed per game and 21st in net punting.
- New Mexico won the New Mexico Bowl last season, beating UTSA 23-20. The Lobos have played in the New Mexico Bowl two seasons in a row.

THIS WEEK IN CSU HISTORY

A PICTURE IS WORTH A THOUSAND WORDS

**October 18, 1919** – There is an old idiom in the English Language that says, “A picture is worth a thousand words.” Today 1,000s of photos are taken during one football game, but only five have survived from the 1919 Utah game at Colorado Field. Stored in the Colorado State University Historic Photograph Collection archives in the Morgan Library is one photo that may be worth 10,000 words.

The photo is labeled “Aggie Player Scoring Touchdown”. Upon closer examination of this nearly 100-year-old priceless gem of CSU football history the viewer can see several things happening at Colorado Field as the Aggie player scored the first of five touchdowns that afternoon.

First is the Aggie player, sophomore halfback Charles Bresnahan running with the ball as he crosses the goal for the touchdown. Bresnahan was a four-sport athlete at CAC and holds the school record for earning the most athletic letters of any student-athlete. He would go on to a brief professional baseball career, referee high school sports in Colorado and was inducted into the CSU and Colorado Sports halls of fame.

Next is the Utah player, wearing a white helmet, presumably with a red stripe across the top and a red jersey. The Utes (then known as the Redskins) were guided by first-year head coach Thomas Fitzpatrick and looking for a championship season. The program had not won its first conference championship yet, but in the coming decade their strength on the gridiron would increase immensely.

As one looks at the background of this classic football photo there is a sense of what it was like to attend a game at Colorado Field in the last year of the 1910s. Built in 1912, Colorado Field only had a grandstand that sat 1,000 people, but at this time it was permissible to park your car on the east side of the field. A small set of bleachers stood between the 40-yard markers and cars parked on the sideline north and south of those bleachers.

In the photo, fans are seen sitting on cars we only see in museums cheering enthusiastically; one man in a sport coat and tie gripping the wire fence with a huge smile on his face as the woman next to him, sitting on the fender of a car clasps her hands on her head in joy. Smiles on the faces of women and children are seen at the left while men at the right of the photo appear to be bored by the action.

The last and most interesting part of this photo is found lying on the ground, tied to a fence post just above where the word “touchdown” is written on the photo. It is a black bear cub, then mascot of the Colorado Agricultural College Aggies for that one lone season of 1919. His, or her name is still unknown today; this is likely the only still photo of the bear on the sidelines of a game.

The Aggies would go on to beat Utah easily, an 80-yard interception return for a touchdown by John Ratekin and touchdowns by Claude Wood and two by Harry Scott put the game away. The Aggies finished 1919 with a 7-1 record and won their third conference championship in five years. Two years later the Colorado Field grandstand would be expanded to seat 5,000 fans and by 1925 no cars could park on the sideline during games. It was easily the glory days of Coach Harry Hughes’ football career and as this photo shows the game was enjoyed by fans, players and even bears in Fort Collins.

- CSU became bowl eligible for the fourth consecutive season, its best stretch since going bowling five years in a row from 1999-2003.
- Saturday was the final game at Hughes Stadium, the 49-year-old facility that had served as the Rams' home since 1968. CSU went 146-114-2 (.562) in 262 games at the stadium.
- CSU's 49 points and 576 total yards were season highs. Over the past four games, the Rams are averaging 43.5 points and 524.0 yards.
- A trio of running backs – Marvin Kinsey, Jr. (127 yards), Izzy Matthews (107) and Dalyn Dawkins (102) – reached the century mark in rushing, helping CSU total 412 total yards on the ground. It was the Rams' highest rushing total since 2001 (440 vs. BYU on Nov. 1).
- CSU is the first opponent to out-rush New Mexico this season (412-285). The Lobos entered the game ranked No. 1 in the nation, averaging 347.8 rushing yards per game. Prior to Saturday, New Mexico had out-rushed all of its opponents by at least 112 yards.
- CSU scored on its opening drive to take a 7-0 lead. It marked the sixth game in a row that the Rams have scored first, and the fifth time in their last six games that they've scored on their opening drive.
- QB Nick Stevens finished the game completing 9-of-10 passes for 164 yards and two touchdowns. In addition to his passing totals, QB Nick Stevens rushed for two first-half touchdowns. His quarterback rating of 293.8 was the highest by a CSU quarterback since Garrett Grayson vs. Wyoming on Oct. 25, 2014 (320.3).
- RB Izzy Matthews finished the game with a season-high 107 yards on 14 carries (7.6 average), including a scoring drive in which he carried four times for 77 yards – with all four going for at least 12 yards.
- RB Marvin Kinsey, Jr. led all players with a career-best 127 rushing yards (12.7 average), including a touchdown.
- WR Michael Gallup was over the 100-yard receiving mark for the third game in a row (5 catches for 116 yards). Since an Oct. 8 win over Utah State, he is averaging 132.2 yards with a touchdown in all six games.
- P Hayden Hunt, who earlier in the week was named a finalist for the Ray Guy Award, punted twice, averaging 58.5 yards. His first punt traveled a season-long 66 yards.

**SERIES NOTES**

- CSU is 40-25-0 all-time against New Mexico, including 17-11 in Fort Collins.
- The Rams have won seven consecutive meetings in the series.
- Dating back to a 2009 loss, CSU has won three in a row in Albuquerque.
- The Rams faced the Lobos in their final game at Hughes Stadium, defeating them 49-31 in a bowl-clinching victory.
- CSU is averaging 50.3 points per game over the last four meetings, including 66 points in 2013, 58 in 2014 and 49 in 2016.
- The 2016 matchup featured a trio of Ram 100-yard rushers in Marvin Kinsey, Jr. (127), Izzy Matthews (107) and Dalyn Dawkins (102).
- QB Nick Stevens is 28-of-40 for 445 yards and three touchdowns in three games (two starts) vs. New Mexico.
- The Rams have punted just four times total in their last four matchups against the Lobos.

**CSU ALL-TIME TOP PERFORMERS VS. NEW MEXICO**

Many of the Rams' all-time great rushing performances have come at the expense of the New Mexico Lobos.

In 2013, Kapri Bibbs had arguably the best game by a running back in school history, rushing for 291 yards and six touchdowns. Dee Hart nearly duplicated the prolific performance just a year later, scoring five touchdowns and rushing for 230 yards.

Last season, the Rams rushed for 412 yards against the Lobos, the most by CSU in a game since 2001. The game featured a trio of 100-yard rushers in Marvin Kinsey, Jr. (127), Izzy Matthews (107) and Dalyn Dawkins (102).

Jeff Champine recorded 192 receiving yards in the 1983 matchup against the Lobos, which is the top receiving performance in series history.

**NOTES FROM WEEK 7 - NEVADA**

- CSU is 3-0 in MW play for the first time since 2002 (started 6-0). The Rams won the MW in 2002, their last league title.
- CSU had 608 yards of total offense, marking the third time this year the team has had 600+ yards, and fourth time in the last 8 games, dating back to last season. The Rams have exceeded 500 yards of total offense five times this season and 14 times under Head Coach Mike Bobo and Offensive Coordinator Will Friend.
- The Rams scored a touchdown on their opening drive of the game, marking the third game in a row—and fourth in the last five—the team has done so. The drive was capped by a 56-yard TD pass from Nick Stevens to Michael Gallup, and took 1:26 (4 plays, 75 yards) – the second-quickest scoring drive of the year for CSU.
- Two of CSU's four longest plays from scrimmage of the season came in tonight's game:
  - Dalyn Dawkins – 59 yard TD run – 3:06 3Q
  - Nick Stevens 56-yard TD pass to Michael Gallup – 13:34 1Q
- CSU is 3-0 at home this season at its new stadium. The Rams have won six consecutive home games, nine of their last 10 and are 19-4 over their last 23 home outings.
- The Rams' offensive line did not allow a sack for the fifth consecutive game, and for the sixth time in seven games this season. CSU has allowed only two sacks all year, both versus Colorado (Sept. 1). Entering the day, CSU ranked fourth in the NCAA for fewest sacks allowed.
- In addition, the Rams allowed just one tackle-for-loss to a Nevada team that came into the game ranked sixth in FBS with an average of 8.3 TFLs per game.
- CSU's two-point margin of victory was the narrowest scoring margin in any game it has played since a 33-31 win at UTSA on Sept. 26, 2015, a span of 28 games.
- WR Michael Gallup finished with a career-high-tying 13 receptions for a career-high 263 yards. He also tied his career high with 3 TDs (3rd time; most games in school history with 3 or more TDs). It's the second time he's eclipsed 200 yards receiving this season and the third time in his career. It's also the fourth time he's surpassed 100 yards receiving this season and the 10th time in his career.
- RB Dalyn Dawkins had 17 carries for a career-high 191 yards.
- QB Nick Stevens was 26-of-37 for 384 yards and 4 TDs with 0 INTs
- RB Izzy Matthews' 1-yard second-quarter touchdown run was the 23rd of his career, moving him into a tie for 10th all-time at CSU.
- S Jordan Fogal and LB Josh Watson led the team with 7 tackles each. Watson has led or co-led the team in tackles five times this season.

**SENIORS STEAL SHOW IN HOMECOMING WIN**

The Rams were led by a collection of seniors in their thrilling 44-42 homecoming victory over the Nevada Wolf Pack. Quarterback Nick Stevens passed for 384 yards and four touchdowns, while running back Dalyn Dawkins rushed for a career-high 191 yards on just 17 carries. Wide receiver Michael Gallup totaled 262 yards and three touchdowns—two yards short of CSU's single-game receiving record—and tight end Dalton Fackrell hauled in his third receiving touchdown in as many games.

On the defensive side, safety Jordan Fogal tied for the team lead with seven tackles including 1.0 tackle for loss, and fellow safety Jake Schlager followed closely behind with five tackles.

Anchored by three fifth-year seniors--Jake Bennett, Zack Golditch and Trae Moxley--the offensive line was its usual dominant self, extending its streak of consecutive quarters without a sack allowed to 22. The Wolf Pack came into the game ranked sixth in the country, averaging 8.3 tackles for loss per game, but mustered just 1.0 against the Rams' offensive front.

**LIKE MIKE**

Through Week 6 of the 2017 season, **Michael Gallup** ranks first in the country with 948 receiving yards, ranks second in receiving yards per game (135.4) and third in receptions per game (8.3). He has four 100-yard games already on the year, and a pair of 200-yard performances (212 at Hawai'i, 263 vs. Nevada). He has at least five catches and 65 yards in every game this season. In a matchup against No. 1 Alabama, Gallup lined up against projected first-round draft pick Minkah Fitzpatrick and pulled in five catches for 81 yards, the most by a receiver against Alabama this season.

Over his last three games (Sept. 30 at Hawai'i, Oct. 7 at Utah State, Oct. 14 vs. Nevada), Gallup has posted 28 catches for 563 yards – the best three-game receiving stretch in CSU history. For his efforts against Nevada, Gallup was named MW Offensive Player of the Week.

Gallup now has 10 100-yard games in his career, the fifth-most in program history. His career average of 110.0 yards per game leads all active FBS players.

The Monroe, Ga., native now ranks seventh all-time in receiving yards at CSU, recording 2,220 in 20 games as a Ram. He is also tied for fifth in receiving TDs (19) and fifth in 100-yard games.

A JUCO transfer, Gallup filled the hole left by WRs Rashard Higgins and Joe Hansley in 2016, recording one of the best receiving seasons in CSU history. Gallup finished his first year with the Rams with 76 catches (3rd in CSU single-season history) for 1,272 yards (3rd) and 14 touch-

downs (2nd). Gallup scored at least one touchdown in each of his final eight games, including three apiece in the final two.

### HOTTEST TICKET IN TOWN

Saturday marked the second sellout of the season and the third game of 2017 for which Colorado State sold all tickets for a game. The opening game at the new stadium Aug. 26 vs. Oregon State was a sellout (37,583) and CSU sold all of its ticket allotment for the Sept. 1 Rocky Mountain Showdown in Denver vs. Colorado (32,727). All seats for the next home game, Oct. 28 vs. Air Force, have sold out (standing-room tickets remain available).

After going 10 years without a sold-out game, from 2004-2014 (Last: Oct. 22, 2004, vs. Wyoming), the Rams have sold out seven of their last 19 home games:

### QUICK STARTS IN MW

En route to a 3-0 start in conference play, the Rams have been dominant in the first quarter, outscoring Mountain West opponents 45-14 and outgaining them 588-166 in total yardage. Dating back to last season, the Rams have not trailed at the end of the first quarter in nine consecutive Mountain West games.

### DEFENSE MAKES STATEMENT AT UTAH STATE

The Rams defense had one of its most dominant performances in recent history, recording seven sacks and 13 tackles for loss, while allowing just 212 total yards in CSU's 27-14 win at Utah State. The seven sacks are the most by the Rams defense since 2011, while the 212 yards allowed is the fewest by an FBS opponent since 2013.

In his first start of the season, sophomore DE Arjay Jean led the Rams with six tackles, two sacks, 3.5 tackles for loss and a forced fumble. True freshman LB Emmanuel Jones recorded the first two sacks of his career, while Richard King, Caleb Smith, Jakob Buys and Evan Colorito tallied the Rams' other sacks.

### NO PLACE LIKE HOME

CSU is 3-0 in the new on-campus stadium. The Rams had a 5-1 record in home games in 2016, and **have won six in a row at home and nine of their last 10 (and 19 of their last 23) games in the friendly confines of Fort Collins** dating back to a win over UNLV on Nov. 14, 2015.

Over that 10-game stretch, CSU has averaged 38.3 points, with an average margin of victory of 14.1 points.

### GOING FOR 500 (AND 600)

CSU has eclipsed 500 yards of total offense five times this season, and reached 600-plus yards three times. Under Coach Bobo and offensive coordinator Will Friend, the Rams have exceeded 500 yards of total offense 14 times (4 in 2015, 5 in 2016, 5 in 2017).

The Rams **posted 610 yards at Hawaii on Sept. 30 - a season high and the most under Coach Bobo. The total also ranks 10th all-time.**

The offense came just short of beating that mark two weeks later against Nevada (Oct. 14), putting up 608 yards of total offense.

### STEVENS STARS FOR CSU

Senior QB Nick Stevens has had an incredibly productive 2017 season. Stevens ranks 6th in the FBS in passing yards (2,255), 8th in passing TDs (18) and 10th in passing yards per game (322.1).

Stevens put on a QB clinic at Hawai'i on Sept. 30, going 18-of-22 for 351 yards and four touchdowns. He also completed his last 12 passes in a row, beginning with his first completion of the second quarter.

He is now fourth all-time at CSU in passing yards (7,006) and completions (517), while ascending to sixth place in pass attempts (827). He remains second in passing touchdowns, but with four last Saturday, to reach 59 for his career, is now just five behind all-time leader Garrett Grayson (64).

Stevens threw for 384 yards and 4 TDs against Nevada (Oct. 14). With his fifth 300-yard game of the season and eighth of his career, Stevens is now tied for second all-time, four behind Grayson (12).

Of the 73 CSU student-athletes who have appeared in a game this season, **38 are from Coach Bobo's last two signing classes**—his first two full classes as Colorado State's head coach. This included 8 of the 22 starters in the season opener versus Oregon State. Those 36 are either from the 2016 and 2017 signing classes or have joined the team as walk-ons since the end of the 2015 season, Bobo's first as CSU's head coach.

**START 'EM YOUNG**

A year after #RamFam16 took the Mountain West by storm--highlighted by true freshmen Hicks, Jean, Kinsey Jr. and McBride's dominance in Mountain West play--#RAMPAGE17 has already put the country on notice. P Ryan Stonehouse currently ranks second in the country, averaging 48.6 yards per punt. TE Cameron Butler has nine catches for 92 yards and two touchdowns, and WR Warren Jackson recorded two touchdown receptions at No. 1-ranked Alabama. LB Emmanuel Jones has 15 tackles and 2.0 sacks, while Ellison Hubbard has 11 tackles and 1.0 sack. OL Scott Brooks, CB Darius Campbell, RB Marcus McElroy, LB Patrick Moody, DL Livingston Paogofie, OL Joctavis Phillips, S Jadon Walker and WR Darius Wise are the other true freshmen to play this season.

### CSU, UNDER ARMOUR REVEAL #STATEPRIDE UNIFORMS

The Colorado State football program and CSU Athletics' official apparel provider Under Armour unveiled on Sept. 21 a special State Pride uniform that the Rams will wear for their Nov. 11 home game vs. Boise State.



"Our partnership with Under Armour provides for specialty uniforms and the UA design team does a tremendous job driving the creative process," said Joe Parker, Director of Athletics. "The use of our iconic state flag as the base element for this uniform speaks to the pride across Colorado for the University and also our mission as a land grant institution."

The State Pride uniforms are white and incorporate elements of the Colorado state flag, with the helmet and jersey displaying the red and gold "C" and the pants including a patch of the flag at the left hip. The royal blue stripes of the flag run along the center of the helmet from front to back, and down the outside of each pant leg. Jersey numbers are royal with red trim, and the words "Colorado State" appear in royal above the number on the front of the jersey.

Under Armour is in its fifth year as the official apparel and uniform provider for Colorado State's athletics programs. The partnership originated in 2013 and a multi-year renewal began in 2016. In addition to the standard home and away uniforms and the Ag Day orange jerseys for the football team, Under Armour has produced an all-gray uniform that debuted in 2016.

### STRIVE FOR FIVE

The Rams will aim to build upon their recent success and qualify for a bowl game for the fifth consecutive season – something that has only been done once before, from 1999-2003. Last year, the Rams won four of their final five games to qualify for the Famous Idaho Potato Bowl and guarantee a fourth consecutive winning season.

All-time, **CSU has played in 16 bowl games**, including 15 since 1990, in addition to the 1949 Raisin Bowl. The Rams are looking for their 16th conference title, and first since 2002.

### BREAKING IN THE NEW END ZONES

The Rams scored seven touchdowns in their first game at the new on-campus stadium, successfully breaking in both end zones.

### A LOOK AT THE SCHEDULE

With 16 starters returning from last year's bowl team, CSU will challenge itself in 2017, playing a pair of Pac-12 programs (Oregon State, Colorado) and preseason No. 1 Alabama before opening up conference play on Sept. 30 at Hawai'i.

- The 2017 season marks the first time since 2004 that CSU has played three Power-5 teams in non-conference. That year, the Rams faced Colorado, No. 22 Minnesota and No. 1 USC. According to FBSchedules.com, **CSU's 2017 non-conference slate is ranked as the second-toughest in all of college football.**
- CSU's 11 FBS opponents went a combined **84-60 (.583) in 2016**, with seven playing in bowl games and three competing in their conference title game (Alabama, Colorado, Wyoming).
- CSU has a winning record against five of its eight conference opponents (Hawai'i, Nevada, New Mexico, Utah State and Wyoming) and is tied with San José State.
- CSU begins conference play with back-to-back road contests for the first time since 1986. On the flip side, CSU will close the regular season with back-to-back home games for the first time since 2011.
- With the Oregon State date change to a Week 0 contest, CSU played Colorado during Week 1. It marked just the second time in the past six years (2015) that the Rocky Mountain Showdown has not been the season opener. Attendance for the annual rivalry game has increased each of the past five seasons, including the largest crowd since 2003 last fall.
- The Rams traveled to Hawai'i for the first time since 2013. After winning 51-21 on Sept. 30, CSU is now 15-9 all-time against the Rainbow Warriors, winning seven in a row.
- CSU won its first game at Utah State since 2011 with a 27-14 victory on Oct. 7.
- The Rams and Wolf Pack played for the first time since the 2015 Arizona Bowl. CSU is 11-3 all-time against Nevada, including a perfect 7-0 in Fort Collins.
- The Rams have beaten New Mexico seven consecutive times and hold a 40-25 advantage in the series.
- After losing to Air Force seven years in a row from 2006-12, the Rams and Falcons have split the past four meetings, each won by the home team. Air Force leads the all-time series, 33-21-1.
- The Rams have played Wyoming more than any other team, holding a 58-45-5 advantage. CSU has won three of the past four meetings, including back-to-back wins in Laramie.
- CSU is looking for its first win over Boise State. The Broncos are 6-0 against the Rams, playing each of the past six sea-

sons.

- CSU is 4-4 all-time against San José State, winning in the most-recent meeting, in 2014 in San Jose.

## A DEEPER LOOK

## #RAMPAGE17

Colorado State Football's 2017 signing class was the highest ranked in program history. Among CSU's signing class were several three-star commits, according to various recruiting sites. 247Sports lists 19 of the Rams' 27 signees as three-star prospects, while Scout named 16 - both are the most in school history. ESPN has 15 while Rivals has 12. Overall, there were 10 consensus three-star prospects among the four recruiting sites. WR Tyler Smith was named a four-star prospect by ESPN, 247 Sports and Scout.

The combined 2016 winning percentage of the Rams' 21 high school signees is .770 (197-59). Seven players won conference titles during their senior seasons (Firmont, Hubbard, Lebron, Moody, Phillips, Scott and Smith), while four others played in their state championship or semifinals (Firmont, Hubbard, Paogofie and Phillips). Hubbard helped Grayson High School to the 2016 Georgia Class 7A state championship and a No. 4 national ranking. Meanwhile, Corte Tapia led the Windsor Wizards to a 2015 Colorado 4A title.

## 2017 CSU FOOTBALL MEDIA COVERAGE GUIDELINES

We appreciate your coverage of Colorado State Athletics, and look forward to working with you to accommodate you and your organization within the framework of the following media policy. The policies are jointly established by Head Coach Mike Bobo and the Athletics Communications office. Please take a few minutes to read through and familiarize yourself with these guidelines. Violations of these policies could result in revoked credentials or limitations on access. Please feel free to contact Asst. A.D. for Communications Paul Kirk at (970) 988-3482 or via email at paul.kirk@colostate.edu, at any time with any questions.

Interview access to players and coaches throughout the calendar year is as follows:

### General Policies

- All interviews with any member of the football program, including Mike Bobo, the coaching and football staffs, and student-athletes, must be coordinated through the Athletics Communications office.
- True freshmen and other student-athletes in their first year in the program are not eligible to be included on the regular interview list.
- Regarding unique subject matter, such as human-interest angles, members of the media are welcome to approach the Communications office at least 48 hours in advance with requests to interview any member of the program, provided the requested individual is not a true-freshman player. Requests approved by Coach Bobo will be granted.
- Members of the media are strictly prohibited from directly contacting any coach, staff member or student-athlete by any means, including text messages, e-mail, phone calls (cell, office or home) or social media, without first approaching the Athletics Communications office.
- For all practices, no live reporting of practice details is permissible, nor live streaming of any method. Upon conclusion of practice, questions based on observations made during practice may be asked of Coach Bobo, and reported on as answered.
- Designated student-athletes from the interview list will be made available on specified days during the spring and pre-season practice periods, and on Tuesdays and Wednesdays during the regular season.
- Head Coach Mike Bobo will be available following most practices. Exceptions include, during pre-season camp, night practices on two-practice days.
- All interviews take place in the interview room of the stadium, located at field level, one level down from the media entrance on the west side of the stadium. Media are not permitted to enter the football offices, or the training room, locker room, weight room or meeting rooms unless arrangements have been made through the Communications office.
- Media may not photograph or report on individuals or groups participating in workouts outside of organized team sessions within campus practice or competition locations.

### Preseason camp

- Coordinators will be made available on Media Day. No other assistant coach access is available during preseason camp.

### Regular-season game weeks

- On Mondays, Head Coach Mike Bobo will conduct a weekly press conference in the stadium interview room. Bobo will begin speaking at 12 p.m. and the press conference will end at approximately 12:30-35. The press conference is livestreamed at CSURams.com/watch, and the archive will be available on YouTube and on CSURams.com. Audio from the press conference also is made available to media.
- Following practice on Tuesday and Wednesday, student-athletes on the interview list will be made available, with either offensive or defensive players being available Tuesday and those from the other side of the ball on Wednesday. Regarding unique subject matter, such as human-interest angles, members of the media are welcome to approach the Communications office at least 48 hours in advance with requests to interview any member of the program, provided the requested individual is not a true-freshman player. Approved requests will be granted, but those interviews need to take place on Tuesday following practice.
- On Wednesday, Bobo will be available following practice.
- Following Wednesday availability, there is no further access to members of the program until the end of the game Saturday, except for contractual broadcast obligations.

### Gameday

- Every member of the program must report to the locker room following the game before conducting interviews. Other than network TV and radio obligations, CSU does not allow on-field interviews in the minutes following the game's conclusion.
- Postgame press conferences take place in the home and visiting team interview rooms, located just off the elevator from the press box at field level. From the field, enter the southwest tunnel and proceed right and down the hall to reach the interview rooms on your left.
- Head Coach Mike Bobo and requested players will be available to the media in the interview room after a reasonable

cooling-off period. Head Coach Mike Bobo will conduct his postgame press conference after a brief cooling-off period, and requested players from the interview list will be made available following Coach Bobo's press conference. Assistant coaches or true freshmen players are not available.

- The visiting team press conference and media availability will take place in the visiting team interview room adjacent to the home team interview room, down the hall from the visitors' locker room.

### Recruiting period...

Access to Head Coach Mike Bobo will be less regular during this time, from the end of the regular season through signing day, the first Wednesday in February, due to recruiting responsibilities. Assistant coaches are not available during this period.

### All other times...

- Head Coach Mike Bobo is available either in-person or by phone, by appointment through Assistant A.D. for Communications Paul Kirk (paul.kirk@colostate.edu).
- Assistant coaches do not have regular availability throughout the year. Requests for their participation in interviews must be made through Asst. A.D. for Communications Paul Kirk, and will be granted only by approval of the head coach.
- Phone calls (cell, office or home) to any coach, staff member, or student-athlete are strictly prohibited, unless previously arranged through the Athletics Communications office.
- Media should contact the Athletics Communications office, rather than the individual coaches and/or student-athletes, when needing personal contact information, such as phone numbers or e-mail addresses, or contact information for family members and friends where such interviews will enhance a feature story.

### Injuries

- At all times throughout the calendar year, including spring practice, Head Coach Mike Bobo will serve as the sole source for injury information. All questions related to injuries should be directed to Bobo, and not to any other member of the program, including athletic trainers, doctors, the injured student-athlete, or his teammates.
- If Bobo is unavailable, please contact Paul Kirk.

### Practice guidelines

- All Colorado State football practices are open for the first few periods unless otherwise noted.
- Videography, provided it is not live-streamed, is allowed during the media viewing period, but no sound may be recorded.
- No live reporting of practice details is permissible, nor live streaming of any method. Upon conclusion of practice, questions based on observations made during the media viewing period may be asked of Coach Bobo, and reported on as answered by the coach.
- During the spring, all regular practices (not scrimmages) are open to the media.
- All media should remain on the sidelines, standing a safe distance from the boundary to prevent collisions. Also for safety reasons, media are asked to stand rather than sit or kneel, and should either hold personal bags or set them behind a barrier, so they are not a potential injury source for players or the media.

### Photography/Videography guidelines

- Cameras are restricted from shooting/filming any 11-on-11 period, as well as selected other periods (Athletics Communications staff will notify). Photography must be tight, "iso" shots that do not reveal alignments or strategy.
- No sound may be captured during the shooting of practice video.
- Photographers are allowed to shoot individual drills and group activity as directed by the Athletics Communications staff. No photography is allowed of players receiving treatment from medical staff, or of injured players, whether participating in individual workouts or observing practice.
- Photographers and videographers are not allowed to bring tripods onto the practice field.
- Photographers and videographers should remain on the sidelines, or behind the end lines. They are not permitted in any drill or in close proximity to any team or position-group huddles at any time.
- Photographers should stand a safe distance from the boundary to prevent collisions. Also for safety reasons, photographers are asked to stand rather than sit or kneel, and should either hold personal bags and/or camera equipment, or set them behind a barrier, so they are not a potential injury source for players or the media.
- All posed photo shoots must take place at times arranged prior to the beginning of practice, working through the Athletics Communications office. Posed photo shoots are not permitted during any practice.

### Telephone interviews

- Head Coach Mike Bobo is available for phone interviews as time permits. Media should call to make an appointment through Paul Kirk (paul.kirk@colostate.edu).
- Phone calls (cell, office or home) to any coach or student-ath-

lete are strictly prohibited, unless previously arranged through the athletic Communications office.

- Media should contact the Athletics Communications office, rather than the individual coaches and/or student-athletes, when needing personal contact information, such as phone numbers or e-mail addresses.

### CSURams.com / Social Media

- The official Web site of Colorado State athletics is CSURams.com, featuring the latest news, information, statistics, and rosters for all of the Rams' 16 athletic programs. Rams fans worldwide can also listen to the live play-by-play coverage offered by the Colorado State Sports Network through the website, and can watch livestreamed video of most home events. Fans can click on www.CSURams.com, then click on the schedule pages to access the radio broadcast for live radio coverage of football, volleyball and men's and women's basketball. For video, click "Watch Online" or directly access the URL CSURams.com/videos. News also will be disseminated via the Colorado State football program's official twitter account, @CSUFootball, as well as the general athletics account, @CSUAthletics, and Asst. A.D. for Communications Paul Kirk (@PaulKirk\_CSU).

### Media credentials

- Credentials must be requested through Paul Kirk in writing at least seven days in advance of an event. Approved requests will be mailed or can be picked up in the Communications office, or at the game.

### Photographer credentials

- Photo credentials are issued only to accredited photographers. Passes must be displayed at all times. All photographers must remain outside the 25-yard lines on both sides of the field.

### Game-day services

- A pregame meal is served 90 minutes prior to kickoff in the press box. In-game services include statistics and play-by-play information following each quarter and notes and statistics following the conclusion of the game.
- Colorado State's stadium offers complimentary wireless Internet access in the press box, interview room and photo workroom. Ethernet lines also are available in the photo workroom, located just inside the southwest tunnel at field level, near the visiting team locker room. Check the seat-assignment label on press row for wireless access information.

### Parking

- A limited amount of media parking is available in lots to be determined at the new on-campus stadium. Please contact the CSU Communications office to request a gameday parking pass.
- Parking in all campus parking lots requires a permit from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. on weekdays. A limited number of single-day passes are available through the Communications office. Annual permits can be purchased through the Office of Parking Management Web site: <http://pts.colostate.edu>, and many lots offer a payment kiosk to purchase a daily pass.
- The CSU Communications office will provide complimentary annual passes to the Moby/McGraw Center lot and spaces and a designated lot near the on-campus stadium for select media organizations and members of the press who demonstrate a consistent willingness to cover the Rams. Those passes are not replaceable and should be treated like cash.

### Stadium directions/will call

- Colorado State's on-campus stadium is located between Pitkin and Lake Streets, just west of Shields Street in Fort Collins. The mailing address is 751 W. Pitkin Street. From I-25, media should take the Prospect exit, turn left, and proceed west toward the mountains. Media entrance is on the west side of the stadium and press box access is via elevator just inside that entrance.
- Ticket will call is located at the main stadium ticket windows on Pitkin Street, at the Northwest corner of the stadium. Media will call is located at the media entrance to the stadium, near the southwest corner of the west tower.

### Video highlights

- Please contact the CSU Athletics Communications office to request video highlights. Broadcast-quality video highlights and soundbites will be emailed to media frequently throughout the year by the Athletics Communications staff.

### Weekly releases

- The weekly game release will be available by approximately 12 noon each Monday during the season on the school's official Web site, CSURams.com. News releases also are e-mailed to media outlets upon request, and available via Twitter at @CSUFootball.

### Colorado State media e-mail list

- To receive e-mail updates on the Rams, e-mail Paul Kirk at paul.kirk@colostate.edu with a message stating that you would like to receive the news releases via e-mail.
