#GoLobos at a Glance (#UNMvsRU)

The Game:

The University of New Mexico Lobos (11, 0-0 MW) will look to get a win over a Power 5 school when UNM heads East to take on Rutgers (1-1, 0-0 Big Ten).

The Coaches:

The University of New Mexico Lobos are coached by Bob Davie, who is 19-33 in his fifth season with the Lobos, and he is 54-58 overall in his 10th season. He spent his first five seasons as a head coach manning the Notre Dame Fighting Irish. For the Scarlet Knights, they are coached by Chris Ash who is in his first season as a collegiate head coach. He previously was at Ohio State as co-Defensive Coordinator.

Series History:

Well, this is pretty easy. This will be the first meeting between the two teams. In fact for UNM, this will be the first time ever playing a Big Ten school (UNM has faced Nebraska, but they weren't in the Big Ten at the time).

For Rutgers, they have played against current Mountain West teams six times, going 2-4, but this will only be the second actual game for them against a Mountain West team, as they lost to Fresno State 52-51 in Fresno.

Coach Davie has several media availability times during the week. He is available after practices on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday. He also meets with the local media on Tuesday at noon as part of UNM's weekly fall sports media luncheon (other fall sport coaches meet with the media at 11:30 a.m. prior to Davie speaking).

For South Dakota (Thursday game), the entire week is pushed backwards two days.
 For Boise State week (Friday game), the entire week is pushed backwards one day.

The New Mexico Media Luncheons are Tuesdays from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Coach Davie is available at approximately noon. Audio and video clips from Davie are available at www.golobos.com. The press conferences are also streamed on GoLobos.com by LoboTV. Please note that the Mountain West no longer will conduct a football coaches teleconference. The luncheon is on the Zia II level of the West Pressbox.

New Mexico Player Interview Opportunities

All player interviews must be arranged through the UNM athletics communications office. The main time for interviews is after practice. Wednesday is the last day for player interviews, and Tuesday is the last day for quarterback interviews. For lengthier interviews, please call the communications office to arrange, which we are happy to do, working around class schedules. These will normally take place in the communications suite in the Maloof Center.

Postgame: The UNM locker room is closed. Requested players will be brought to an area to be determined after home games and outside the locker room for road games.

For road games, all interviews will be posted to UNM's Media Dropbox account, along with selected highlights. These are provided for your usage, but please credit LoboTV.

Game Credentials

Visiting team media should request single-game credentials through their team's media relations office. Parking passes for the Baseball East and media lots will be needed.

For media members picking up credentials at will call without parking passes, it is located in the Northeast corner of the stadium by Gate 7 or 8. For media members picking up with parking passes, credentials will be located at the University Drive entrance to the Baseball & Pit East lots with the parking attendant. This should allow you to get your credential without having to wait in line or deal with parking on the north side of the stadium.

The Opening List

New Mexico's defense, despite the loss, allowed just 307 yards of offense to New Mexico State, meaning for the season, the Lobos are allowing just 315.0 yards per game over the first two games of the season. Compared to last season's final number of 437.4 yards per game, UNM's defense is currently the 29th-most improved defense in the nation. However, where does UNM stack in the Mountain West so far after two weeks? Right now, UNM is the second-most improved defense in terms of yards in the Mountain West, behind only Fresno State. UNM and Fresno State are the only two schools that are currently doing at least 100 yards better than last year.

UNM Defense, Doing It's Best for Carbon Dioxide Awareness

The 350.org website is an international effort to raise awareness of the need to decrease carbon dioxide concentration in the atmosphere to 350 parts per million. The number 350 in terms of yards allowed is a benchmark for New Mexico's defense, and the Lobos have now come in under that mark in both games this season. In the opener, the Lobos allowed 323 yards of total offense to South Dakota, and then last week allowed just 307 yards of offense to New Mexico State.

It marked the first time since October 18 and 23, 2008 that the Lobo defense has allowed 350 or fewer yards in back-to-back games.

Three Dog Night had a hit song with "One", saying it's the loneliest number. As far as UNM is concerned, that number is 20. Under Bob Davie, the Lobos have attempted fewer than 20 passes in a game 40 times, going 18-22. However, when UNM has attempted 20 or more passes in a game under Bob Davie the Lobos are just 1-11. Against New Mexico State, the Lobos were 12-of-23 throwing, passing that number 20, and UNM dropped a heartbreaker 32-31.

Teriyon Gipson scored two more rushing touchdowns, giving him four for the season, and 23 for his career. Gipson has now moved into a tie for eighth place on the UNM career rushing touchdowns list with 23, tying with Fred Henry.

Ironically, Gipson's touchdown 12 seconds into the season tied for the fastest score in UNM history to start a season, tying with Fred Henry, who returned a kickoff 100 yards to open the 1972 season against New Mexico State.

New Mexico also did it in other ways. UNM had 19 Mountain West All-Academic selections, which was the second-most in program history (UNM had 20 two years ago). Also, the Lobos had their second-highest GPA in the last 30 years this past Spring.

It's a Shame They are Chart Flights Because Sky Miles Would Be Great

New Mexico last year only had five road games, with the furthest being a trip to Boise, Idaho. That is most certainly not the case in 2016. After a short bus ride to Las Cruces, the Lobos will make the first of five flights, two of which are over 1,900 miles one way, and all of which are over 1,000 miles round trip.

All told, UNM's road trips will see the Lobos play in four time zones (amazingly enough missing the Pacific Time Zone but hitting Eastern, Central, Mountain and Hawaii) and travel 7,248 miles ... one way. The total airline miles for UNM is approximately 14,048 round trip airline miles.

An Interesting Streak

Jason Sanders hit all four extra points he attempted on Saturday, running his streak to 32 in a row. He would need 14 more to break into the top three on the UNM list, behind Wes Zunker, who hit 46 in a row over the 2003 and 2004 seasons. Joe Hartshorne made 47 in a row over the 1970 and 1971 seasons for the second-most, and Justus Adams hit 76 in a row over the 2012 and 2013 seasons.

Counting his streak with former kicker Zack Rogers, who hit 32, UNM has a current streak of 64 consecutive extra points made dating back to November 22, 2014.

The Land of Ensackment

New Mexico sacked Tyler Rogers of NMSU five times on Saturday, giving UNM eight sacks on the season. That total is not just good for the current Mountain West lead, but it's actually tied for 10th nationally.

The 50 yards lost on those eight sacks is currently tied for 19th in the NCAA with Washington.

Teriyon My Wayward Son

Teriyon Gipson rushed 12 times on Saturday for 62 yards, a 5.2 yards per carry average. While that certainly isn't bad, and it did lower his season average, Gipson is still the best in the business as it stands right now. Gipson now has 20 carries for 243 yards and four touchdowns, and that equates to a 12.2 yard per carry average, and that leads the FBS.

When you are The University of New Mexico, every play is a scoring opportunity. While teams do all this fancy dandy no-huddle, hurry-up call the play quickly stuff, UNM just lines up and scores. From everywhere. From anywhere really.

Last season UNM led the nation in plays of 60 yards or more and of 70 yards or more. Also, UNM, a team that runs the ball, was the only one in the nation with three pass plays of 80 yards or more (and those all came in the last five games).

What did the season opener bring to the table? Rushes of 60 yards, 75 yards and 84 yards, and a pass play of 62 yards.

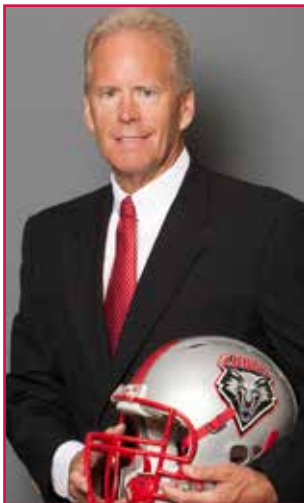

Bob Davie enters his fifth season at The University of New Mexico, where he has led the program back to bowl eligibility and a level of national respect as UNM qualified for the 2015 Gildan New Mexico Bowl, the first bowl game for the Lobos since 2007.

Davie's 18 wins in his first four seasons already has him tied for eighth on the career wins list at UNM, and he has helped the program achieve levels not seen in Albuquerque for many years. Yet it's how he has been able to do it that is what has Lobo fans excited for the program.

Davie has completely flipped and turned his rosters over, combining an energetic mix of talent from Texas and California while averaging nearly 25 native New Mexican players per season on the roster, with many of those major contributors.

It all clicked in 2015 as after 11 wins in his first three seasons which nearly quadrupled the previous three seasons' total, the program took a big leap, picking up three signature wins in the month of November as the Lobos clinched its first winning season and bowl game since the 2007 season. The Lobos knocked off three 10-win teams from a year ago, including a pair of stunning upsets to open November. First UNM took down first place Utah State 14-13. Then, UNM announced their presence to the college football world with a 31-24 victory on the road over Boise State to clinch bowl eligibility. UNM then defeated Mountain Division champions Air Force 47-35. Those wins were the first three wins over bowl eligible teams in the last seven seasons.

The Lobos tied for its most conference wins since the 1997 season with five. Offensively the team tied a school record with 42 rushing touchdowns and finished in the top 10 in the NCAA in rushing for the fourth straight season and was ninth nationally in fourth down conversion percentage and 11th in total conversions. UNM also led the nation in total plays from scrimmage of 60 yards or more (11) and 70 yards or more (7), showcasing the explosive offense.

Defensively, UNM ranked as the fourth-most improved defense in the nation in terms of yards allowed, shaving off 81.6 yards per game from 2014. UNM also shaved 7.5 points per game off their 2014 scoring defense, and that was the 15th most improved in the NCAA. UNM's rushing defense was the nation's third-most improved in terms of yards per game (76.3 yards per game less than 2014) and it was fourth in terms of yards per carry (1.29 yards per carry less than 2014).

All of that added up to a 7-5 regular season, a 5-3 mark and second place in the Mountain West's Mountain Division and a berth in the 2015 Gildan New Mexico Bowl, which UNM fought down to the wire in a 45-37 loss to Arizona. UNM picked up four All-Mountain West honors, including a Second Team selection as a returner for Carlos Wiggins. The Lobos also picked up 19 Mountain West All-Academic honors, the second-highest total in program history.

An overall hallmark of the program under Davie has been special teams, as UNM's eight touchdowns on kickoff returns over his first four seasons are tied with Kansas State for the most in the FBS over that time frame.

And the success and improvement isn't just on the field ... it's off it. In the first four seasons under Davie, the Lobos have picked up 69 Mountain West All-Academic selections, including a program record 20 in 2014, and 19 in 2015, the second-best total for football in school history. UNM also had five Mountain West Scholar-Athletes in 2013, the second-best total among the MW's 12 football programs.

Over his time, the Lobos have posted the second-highest single semester GPA in program history (Spring of 2016) and two of the top three Fall semester GPAs in program history (Fall of 2013 and Fall of 2015).

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. — The University of New Mexico Lobos scored 31 unanswered points to wrestle away a quick lead by South Dakota, taking down the Coyotes 48-21 in the season opener for both teams. UNM's offense rolled up 615 yards, the 15th-best total in school history.

If the opening play is any indication of how a season will go, it's going to be explosive. Teriyon Gipson took the opening handoff and raced 75 yards for a touchdown just 12 seconds into the contest. South Dakota did have an answer, as they went 75 yards in five plays, and then after a fumble, USD went 90 yards in nine plays to make it 14-7 9:10 into the game.

To that point, the Coyotes had 165 yards of offense, but UNM's veteran defense took charge after that, limiting the USD squad to just 158 the rest of the game, 75 of which came on the only scoring drive of the final three quarters for the Coyotes.

UNM was led by starting quarterback Austin Apodaca, who was nothing short of brilliant, rushing 41 yards on seven carries and going 12-for-16 through the air for 172 yards and two touchdowns. Both of those TDs were on brilliant catches. The first was over the middle by Matt Quarells, who caught a pass with a defender draped all over him and broke away for a 62-yard score. The second was at the end of a perfect two-minute drill as Apodaca hit Q' Drennan near the five yard line, leaping for the grab and then spinning into the end zone for his first career catch.

That made it 35-14 at the break and it was pretty much over from there as USD never really threatened.

Gipson, who scored on that opening 75-yard run, went 84 on his next touch to make it 14-14 just 59 seconds after USD went up 14-7. Quarells' catch gave UNM its lead for good, and then Richard McQuarley scored the first of his two touchdowns.

In the second half, Jason Sanders hit a pair of field goals sandwiched around USD's lone touchdown, but with the game at 41-21, McQuarley scored on a bruising 14-yard run through the middle for the final score of the game.

However, while the offense was rolling, the defense did as well over the final three quarters. Dakota Cox, who is looking to become the first player to lead the team in tackles all four seasons, got off to the right start with 14 tackles, 2.0 for loss, a sack, a forced fumble and an interception. Both turnovers he had a hand in turned into second half scores.

Overall, the Lobos recorded three sacks and six tackles for loss along with forcing three turnovers. After allowing two touchdowns on the first two drives, UNM forced five punts, two turnovers, a turnover on downs and two end of halves, getting 10 stops on the final 11 possessions, only two of which saw the Coyotes gain more than 20 yards.

LAS CRUCES, N.M. --- The New Mexico Lobos led for almost the entire game. They didn't have the lead when it counted though...the end. New Mexico State took advantage of a short field and scored on an 8-yard pass with 5:46 to go, and UNM's fourth and 15 try fell three yards short as New Mexico State won the Rio Grande Rivalry for the first time since 2011 with a 32-31 victory in front of 17,852.

After two straight seasons in which UNM needed second half comebacks in order to win, it was NMSU's turn to pull the same trick. The Lobos took the opening kickoff and marched right down the field without an issue, going 75 yards in eight plays with Teriyon Gipson barreling over from 12-yards out just 4:35 into the game. UNM would then lead for the next 49:44, but the Lobos never could put away NMSU, and that would prove costly.

The Lobos took a 31-22 lead with 14:04 remaining when on a fourth-and-goal play, quarterback Austin Apodaca fakes a handoff to Richard McQuarley, and pitched to Gipson who walked into the end zone.

New Mexico State drove to the UNM 28, but back-to-back sacks moved the Aggies out of field goal range at the 37, facing third and 19. Tyler Rogers however converted, hitting a 26-yard pass, setting up Parker Davidson's fourth field goal of the game to make it 31-25 with 10:12 to go.

The killer for the Lobos came on the next drive. Facing third and five, Apodaca threw behind his intended receiver, and instead of a first down, NMSU's Terrill Hanks picked it off, giving the Aggies life at the Lobo 27.

On third and 2 from the 8-yard line, Rogers hit Gregory Hogan for a touchdown, and Davidson, who missed an earlier extra point, hit this one for NMSU's only lead at 32-31.

UNM wasn't done. Starting from their 30, the Lobos got a key fourth down conversion to Chris Davis, Jr.to the NMSU 45, and with just over two minutes left, it looked like one more first down would give kicker Jason Sanders a shot at being a hero.

That shot never came.

A pass to Patrick Reed was incomplete, and then NMSU's only sack of the game made it third and 15. After another incompleton, UNM was left facing a fourth-and-15. Apodaca hit Gipson underneath for 12, falling three yards short, although a UNM penalty would have negated the gain. From there the Aggie ran off the final 1:28 for the win.

It looked early like NMSU would never stop UNM. After the opening 75-yard drive for UNM was answered with a field goal, The Lobos drove 80 yards, with Apodaca keeping and scoring from 23 yards out for his second career touchdown. From there, UNM's offense dried up in the first half, mustering only a field goal with 28 seconds left to lead 17-9.
